Head Coach Jeff Capel



▶ Jeff Capel was named Oklahoma's 13th men's basketball head coach on April 11, 2006.

▶ The youngest head coach in the Big 12 Conference (35 years old), Capel is 87-56 in his fifth year at OU and 166-97 in his ninth year overall.

▶ Led the Sooners to a 30-6 record and an NCAA Tournament Elite Eight appearance in 2008-09. The team, which featured consensus national player of the year and No. 1 NBA Draft pick Blake Griffin, peaked at No. 2 in the national polls for three weeks in February.

▶ Coached the Sooners to a 23-12 mark and to the NCAA Tournament second round in 2007-08.

▶ Compiled a 79-41 (.658) record over four years as head coach at Virginia Commonwealth prior to arriving in Norman. His squads went 50-22 (.694) in Colonial Athletic Association play.

▶ In 2003-04, coached VCU to a CAA Tournament championship game victory over George Mason, resulting in Rams' first NCAA Tournament appearance since 1996. VCU lost in the first round to Chris Paul's No. 4-seed Wake Forest squad, 79-78.

▶ His 2004-05 team, which finished 19-13, competed in the NIT, marking just the third time in program history that VCU made consecutive postseason appearances.

▶ Served as USA head coach of this summer's FIBA Americas U18 Championship team that went 5-0 and won the gold medal in San Antonio, Texas. Was also an assistant on the gold-medal-winning USA Men's World University Games Team that went 8-0 in Turkey in 2005.

▶ Began his coaching career as an assistant at Old Dominion in 2000 before moving to VCU as an assistant for the 2001-02 season. In 2002, he became the youngest NCAA Division I head coach at age 27.

▶ A four-year starter at Duke from the 1993-94 through 1996-97 campaigns, the guard averaged 12.4 points, 3.0 rebounds, 3.4 assists and 1.7 3-pointers during his career and started in the 1994 national title game against Arkansas. He graduated with a bachelor of arts degree in history in 1997.

▶ He and his wife, Kanika, married in 2003. They have two daughters, Cameron and Sydney.

SATURDAY'S GAME BASICS

Oklahoma (5-5) plays in its 35th All-College Classic when it takes on Cincinnati (9-0) Saturday at 8 p.m. CST inside Oklahoma City Arena. The Sooners are coming off back-to-back home wins, while the Bearcats have won their nine games by an average margin of 22 points. The contest will air on the Sooner Radio Network (KOKC AM 1520 in Oklahoma City; KTZB AM 1430 in Tulsa; Sirius 125) with **Bob Barry Sr.** and **Mike Houck** announcing. The game will be televised by ESPNU with **Jon Sciambi** and **Hubert Davis** calling the action.

NOTEWORTHY

▶ The Sooners own a 52-13 (.800) all-time record in the All-College Classic and have won 15 of their last 17 games in the event.

▶ Oklahoma ranks fifth in the Big 12 in field goal percentage (.469), fourth in 3-point field goal percentage (.374) and third in free throw percentage (.727). Last year, the Sooners shot .430 from the field and .350 from 3-point distance.

▶ The Sooners are 5-0 at home this year and 0-5 away from Norman.

▶ The only game this season in which Oklahoma has failed to shoot at least 44 percent from the field was against North Carolina Central on Nov. 15 (OU shot .328). Excluding that contest, OU owns a .489 field goal mark on the year. For perspective, the Sooners have shot better than .489 for a season just once in the last 21 years (.492 in 2008-09).

▶ Sophomore guard **Steven Pledger** is averaging a team-high 17.8 points in OU's wins, but has been held to a 6.4 average in its losses.

▶ Oklahoma has outscored opponents 88-77 in points off turnovers in its five wins, but has been outscored 97-50 in the category in its five defeats.

▶ In their five wins, the Sooners are shooting .420 from 3-point range (42-for-100) and .792 from the free throw line (80-for-101). In their five losses, they're shooting .322 from behind the arc (29-for-90) and .634 from the foul line (45-for-71).

▶ Eight of OU's top nine scorers are in their first or second year of Division I basketball. Five of the nine are in their first year.

SOONER UPDATE



▶ Oklahoma bounced back from a five-game losing streak by posting a pair of home wins last week over Gardner-Webb (71-58) and Oral Roberts (73-60). The Sooners shot .500 from the field, .485 from 3-point range and .765 from the free throw line on the week. They held the Bulldogs and Golden Eagles to combined .385 field goal shooting and outrebounded them by an average of 6.5 boards.

▶ OU has shot 47 percent or better from the field in each of its last five games. Turnovers have been an issue this year, however, as the Sooners average 14.8 per game. They've committed at least 10 turnovers in all but one outing.

▶ Sophomore forward **Andrew Fitzgerald** has shot .500 or better from the field in eight of 10 games and owns a .546 season percentage to rank sixth in the Big 12. He leads the team with his 15.0 points and 6.2 rebounds per game. His free throw percentage (.711) is up significantly from last year (.638).

▶ Over the last four games, Fitzgerald is averaging 17.5 points and 7.8 rebounds while shooting .762 from the free throw line (16-for-21). He registered his first career double-

double (18 points and a career-high 13 rebounds) Dec. 1 at Arkansas and followed with a career-high-tying 22 points and five boards Dec. 5 at Arizona.

► Guard **Cade Davis** is averaging 15.8 points over the last eight outings on .474 field goal and .472 (25-for-53) 3-point shooting. Included were games of 21 points against Texas Southern, 23 points versus No. 8 Kentucky and a season-high 24 points against Chaminade. On the year, OU's lone senior averages 14.3 points to rank 14th in the Big 12.

► Davis ranks third in the Big 12 with his 2.7 treys per game and fourth with his .435 percentage. Going back to last year, he has made 58 3-pointers over his last 22 games. Davis ranks ninth on OU's career 3-point field goals list with 144 (needs nine to move into eighth place).

► In OU's five wins (all all at home), sophomore guard **Steven Pledger** has scored no fewer than 13 points and is shooting .410 from 3-point range (16-for-39) and .905 from the free throw line (19-for-21). In five games away from home (all losses), Pledger has been held to single digits four times and is shooting .222 from deep (4-for-18) and .500 from the foul line (2-for-4).

► Freshman **Cameron Clark** is coming off what are arguably his two most productive games as a Sooner. After averaging 5.5 points on .450 field goal shooting over OU's first eight games, the wing is averaging 15.0 points on .600 shooting over the last two. He recorded consecutive career highs of 13 points against Gardner-Webb and 17 versus Oral Roberts (he had been held to single digits in each of the previous seven games). Clark has five steals over the last two contests after registering just one over OU's first eight games.

► Sophomore point guard **Carl Blair** has rebounded nicely from a tough start to the year by averaging 9.0 points, 5.0 rebounds and 8.0 assists (against 2.0 turnovers) over the last two games. He had six points, five rebounds, seven assists and no turnovers in 23 minutes off the bench in the Dec. 9 win over Gardner-Webb and followed with 12 points, five boards and nine assists in 37 minutes off the bench Saturday against Oral Roberts. Blair recorded 15 assists over his first six games but has 16 over the last two. He is also shooting .536 from the field on the year.

► After scoring more points (28) in two games against Arkansas and Arizona than he scored in his first six outings (24), junior forward **Nick Thompson** missed the Dec. 9 Gardner-Webb game due to a death in the family and played just two minutes Saturday against Oral Roberts. Thompson is now averaging 5.8 points, 4.9 rebounds and 2.0 assists in 23.1 minutes per contest. The junior college transfer recorded 14 assists in OU's first two games (seven in each) but has totaled just four handouts over his last seven outings.

SATURDAY'S ORAL ROBERTS RECAP (BOX SCORE ON PAGE 11 OF THESE NOTES)

► Oklahoma overcame three 13-point first-half deficits to post a 73-60 win over Oral Roberts on Saturday, its 24th straight victory at home against non-conference opponents. For the first time this season, five Sooners scored in double figures.

► Trailing 24-12, OU closed the first half with a 22-2 run (over the last 9:55) to take a 34-26 lead at the break. ORU went 0-for-12 from the field in the last 10 minutes of the half after it started 8-for-11. The Golden Eagles went a span of 9:19 without scoring a point.

► Freshman **Cameron Clark** finished with 17 points and three steals, setting a career high in both categories for the second straight game. Clark, who played all 40 minutes, also set career highs with eight field goals (previous high was four) and 11 field goal attempts.

► Sophomore **Carl Blair** scored 12 points and registered nine assists, both personal highs in an OU uniform. Blair's nine assists were the most in a game by a Sooner this season. He played a season-high 37 minutes off the bench.

► Sophomore **Steven Pledger** was 4-for-6 from 3-point range and scored a team-high 19 points to lead the Sooners for the third time this year (second straight game). He hit three 3-pointers in a span of two-and-a-half minutes during OU's 22-2 first-half run.

► **Andrew Fitzgerald** contributed 14 points and brought down a team-high eight rebounds. The sophomore forward was 6-for-14 from the field on the day, marking just the second time in 10 games this year he failed to shoot at least 50 percent.

► Senior guard **Cade Davis** scored 10 points and added six rebounds, three steals and three assists (just one turnover) in 38 minutes.

► Oklahoma outscored the Golden Eagles 13-3 in fast break points. OU's 13-rebound advantage (39-26) was its third largest of the season.

PREVIEWING CINCINNATI

► Cincinnati enters Saturday's game with a 9-0 record and has beaten its opponents by an average of 21.7 points. The Bearcats have played seven home games (Mount St. Mary's, IPFW, Florida A&M, Savannah State, Wright State, Utah Valley and Georgia Southern), one on the road (at Toledo) and one at a neutral site (vs. Dayton in Cincinnati).

► UC is shooting .456 from the field, .385 from 3-point range (7.8 makes per game) and .644 from the free throw line (15.4 makes per game). Opponents are shooting .381 from the field and .303 from behind the arc (4.1 makes per outing).

► Junior guard **Dion Dixon** leads four Bearcats who are averaging double figures in scoring. Dixon, who is 15-for-35 (.429) from 3-point range on the season, averages 12.3 points, 2.2 rebounds and 1.8 assists per contest. Over the last five games he is averaging 15.0 points.

► Junior forward **Yancy Gates**, who recorded double-doubles in two of Cincinnati's first three games, contributes 11.1 points, 6.6 rebounds and a team-high 1.9 blocks per outing.

► Redshirt freshman guard **Sean Kilpatrick** comes off the bench to average 10.7 points in 21.0 minutes per game. Kilpatrick, who has performances of 21 and 26 points to his credit, leads the team with 17 makes from 3-point range and is shooting .415 from behind the arc.

► Sophomore point guard **Cashmere Wright** is averaging 10.0 points and team highs of 4.4 assists and 2.0 steals per game. He is shooting .585 from the field and .407 from 3-point distance (11 makes).

► Head coach **Mick Cronin** is 70-68 in his fifth year at Cincinnati. The former UC assistant coach returned to the Bearcats following a three-year stint as head coach at Murray State (posted a 69-24 record there).

OU-CINCINNATI SERIES HISTORY

Saturday's game will mark the fifth between Oklahoma and Cincinnati, with each team owning a pair of wins. OU won the first two meetings, 78-65 in 1985-86 in the All-College Tournament in Oklahoma City, and 89-81 (in overtime) in the second round of the 1991 postseason NIT in Norman. The third-ranked Bearcats posted a 72-59 win in Cincinnati during the 1998-99 season and, as the nation's No. 4 team the following year, beat the No. 21 Sooners by a 72-57 score in Norman.

This year's All-College Classic marks the 35th such event for Oklahoma and the 28th straight. The Sooners own a 52-13 (.800) all-time record in the All-College and have claimed 21 championships. They have won 15 of their last 17 games in the event. This marks the 10th year that the All-College features a "classic" or non-tournament format. OU lost to UTEP (89-74) last year, beat VCU (81-70) two years ago, bettered Gonzaga (72-68) three years ago, downed Tulsa (58-48) in 2006-07, lost to West Virginia (92-68) in 2005-06, and beat Tulsa (70-64) in 2004-05, Princeton (58-55) in 2003-04, Michigan State (60-58) in 2002-03 and Texas Southern (97-55) in 2001-02.

TAYLOR LEAVES SCHOOL DUE TO PERSONAL REASONS

Head coach **Jeff Capel** announced Wednesday that freshman guard **T.J. Taylor** has left school due to personal reasons. "T.J. is dealing with some things personal in nature and he informed me today that he is leaving our program," said Capel. "We wish circumstances were such that T.J. could remain with us, but we are certainly sensitive to his situation. We wish him the best."

"This is something I felt I needed to do at this time of my life," said Taylor. "I love Coach Capel and the staff at OU, and I wish everyone on the team the best of luck."

Taylor, a 6-3 guard from Denison, Texas, who was a three-time all-state player at Denison High School, sustained an injury during preseason workouts this year and did not play in any OU games.

FIVE-MINUTE RULE

The Sooners improved to 6-0 in overtime games under head coach **Jeff Capel** with their 71-63 win over North Carolina Central on Nov. 15. Other overtime wins under Capel have come at West Virginia (88-82 in two overtimes on Dec. 29, 2007), versus Baylor (92-91 on Feb. 19, 2008), against Purdue (87-82 on Nov. 28, 2008, in Preseason NIT championship game), at Utah (78-73 on Dec. 12, 2009) and versus Oklahoma State (62-57 on Jan. 11, 2010).

SOONERS SIGN JUNIOR COLLEGE STANDOUT

Junior college preseason All-American **Robert Goff** signed a letter of intent with the Sooners Nov. 15 and will be a junior at OU starting in 2011-12. Goff, a 6-9, 230-pound sophomore who attends Hutchinson (Kan.) Community College, originally hails from Indianapolis, Ind. He played at Cowley County (Kan.) Community College as a freshman in 2008-09 before transferring to Hutchinson and sitting out the 2009-10 season. At Cowley, Goff averaged 9.2 points, 6.9 rebounds and 1.5 blocked shots per game while shooting .612 from the field for head coach Steve Eck, who's now the head coach at Hutchinson.

"Robert's a perfect fit," said OU head coach **Jeff Capel**. "We identified him very early as someone we really wanted, and we're fortunate that he's a Sooner. He's a tremendous athlete and will provide size for us, which we need. Plus, he's older and will come in and contribute right away. I think he can be an anchor for our defense with his ability to clog up the lane and block shots. Offensively, he has skill. He can also really run the floor. The thing I'm excited about is he's a great kid. He has a strong desire to grow as a basketball player and as a young man."

UP NEXT

OU returns home to play Sacramento State on Tuesday, Dec. 21, at 7 p.m. CT. The game will be televised by the Sooner Sports Network.

QUANTIFYING OU'S BASKETBALL TRADITION

- ▶ This is the 104th season of Oklahoma varsity basketball (the program's first game was Nov. 26, 1907).
- ▶ OU owns a 1,516-965 (.611) all-time record, ranking it 29th in NCAA Division I history in wins and 38th in winning percentage.
- ▶ Oklahoma has participated in four NCAA Final Fours (1939, 1947, 1988 and 2002) and in two NCAA championship games (it lost to Holy Cross in 1947 and to Kansas in 1988).
- ▶ OU has made 26 NCAA Tournament appearances and seven postseason NIT showings. Its 22 NCAA Tournament appearances over the last 28 years rank as the eighth most in the nation.
- ▶ Oklahoma has made 27 postseason appearances over the last 29 years (22 NCAA Tournaments and five NIT's).
- ▶ The Sooners have won 14 regular season conference championships (most recently in 2005) and seven conference tournament titles (including the 2001, 2002 and 2003 crowns).
- ▶ The Sooners posted the eighth best NCAA Division I winning percentage (.731) in the 1980s and the ninth best (.738) in the 2000s.
- ▶ Twenty different Sooners have earned All-America honors a total of 30 times. They have earned consensus first-team All-America acclaim nine times and consensus second-team honors on four occasions.
- ▶ Wayman Tisdale was a three-time consensus first-team All-American during his three seasons at OU (1983-85).
- ▶ Oklahoma players have earned first-team all-conference accolades a total of 73 times.
- ▶ The Sooners own a winning record against 10 of the other 11 members of the Big 12 Conference (Kansas is the only league program with a series lead against OU).
- ▶ OU has played its home games in four different venues: the OU Gymnasium (1907-1919), the R.O.T.C. Armory (1919-1928), the OU Field House (1928-75) and Lloyd Noble Center (1975-present).
