THE GAME

For the sixth time in the last eight seasons Oklahoma is playing for the Big 12 Championship. This time it is against Missouri in San Antonio's Alamodome. The winners receives the Big 12's automatic BCS berth. This will mark the first time that OU has met Missouri for the title.

THE SERIES

Oklahoma leads it, 64-23-5, and has won five in a row and 17 of the last 18 over Missouri. The Sooners notched a 41-31 win over the Tigers at Norman on Oct. 13. The two teams have never played on a neutral field.

THE COACHES

Oklahoma: Bob Stoops (Iowa '83) is 95-21 in his ninth season with the Sooners. He is 4-4 in bowls, 3-3 in January Bowls, 2-3 in BCS games, 62-13 vs. the Big 12, 35-9 vs. the Big 12 South, 27-4 vs. the Big 12 North, 4-1 in the Big 12 title game, 33-8 vs. non-conference opponents, 54-2 at home, 27-11 on the road, 14-8 on neutral fields and 27-10 vs. ranked foes. He is 4-0 vs. Missouri.
Missouri: Gary Pinkel (Kent State '73) is 48-36 in seven seasons at MU. He is 0-3 vs. Oklahoma.

THE PROGRAM

■ Oklahoma's all-time record stands at 778-294-53. ■ The Sooners own seven national championships (1950, 1955, 1956, 1974, 1975, 1985, 2000). ■ OU has 40 bowl appearances (No. 7 nationally) with 24 victories (No. 3 nationally). ■ Oklahoma has won 40 conference titles. ■ Since WWII, Oklahoma is the most successful college football program with 534 victories. ■ Some 142 All-Americans and four Heisman Trophy winners have come from the Oklahoma program.

WEEKLY MEDIA LUNCHEON

Each Tuesday during the season OU hosts a media luncheon inside the Kerr McGee Stadium Club (east side) at Gaylord Family - Oklahoma Memorial Stadium. The luncheon begins at 11:15 a.m., with comments from the head coach of OU's opponent that week (by speaker phone if the coach is available). Lunch is served at 11:30 a.m., and OU head coach Bob Stoops steps to the podium at 12:05 p.m. A limited number of Sooner players are on hand for interviews.

CREDENTIALS

Requests for credentials are accepted online. To receive the link to the web site, e-mail Kenny Mossman at kmossm@ou.edu. Requests must be submitted by a sports director/editor at least eight days prior to the contest. Media attending games will have passes scanned and must show government issued photo identification upon entering the stadium. If the name on the credential and the photo ID do not match, the credential will be voided.

FOR MEDIA ONLY

The University of Oklahoma Athletics Media Relations office has a media-only website to assist in covering Sooner sports. The site is valuable for reporters, but also to desk personnel needing stock photographs or similar support. To access the site, contact Kenny Mossman.

PRACTICE

All practice sessions are closed to media and public unless otherwise posted. On days when post-practice interviews are conducted, media should gather outside the practice site 10-15 minutes before the workout is complete. Requests for interviews will be recorded and members of the athletics media relations staff will escort media into the facility at the appropriate time.

INTERVIEWS

All interview requests should be submitted to the OU Athletic Media Relations Office ...

- **Head Coach** Bob Stoops will do general interviews following practice on Monday. All other requests must be submitted to Kenny Mossman.
- **Assistant Coaches:** The coaches are available after the Monday-Wednesday practices (coordinators who appear at the Tuesday luncheon are not available that day).
- **Players:** All interviews with players will take place at the media luncheon or after practice on Monday and Tuesday. Media should request players at least 24 hours in advance. Those who attend the media luncheon are not available after Tuesday's practice.
- **Post-Game:** The OU locker room is closed at all times. Head coach Bob Stoops and several Sooner players will be brought to designated areas. After home games, the interview area is the Switzer Center's Red Room, located under the south end zone grandstand.



OKLAHOMA, MISSOURI THE FIRST TIME

No. 6 Oklahoma vanquished No. 11 Missouri at Norman on Oct. 13 (*complete recap pg. 26*) ...

- After falling behind 24-23 late in the third quarter, OU reeled off 18 unanswered points to take a 41-24 advantage before Missouri scored with 12 seconds remaining.
- Oklahoma picked off three passes (two thrown by Chase Daniel) and recovered a fumble then converted those takeaways into 24 points en route to the win.
- Sam Bradford hit 24-of-34 passes for 266 yards with two touchdowns and no interceptions.
- LB Curtis Lofton was named the Big 12's defensive player of the week after registering a career-high 18 tackles along with a 12-yard fumble return for a touchdown.
- RB Chris Brown posted touchdown runs of 4, 1 and 17 yards.
- OU won't have RB DeMarco Murray for this game. He had little statistical impact on the first meeting -- four rushes for two yards, two receptions for 26, two kickoff returns for 56.



OKLAHOMA'S MOST RECENT GAME

Oklahoma notched its fifth consecutive win over Oklahoma State with a 49-17 rout in Norman ...

- The Sooners rolled up 307 yards on the ground, including 202 by Allen Patrick. Patrick rushed for two touchdowns and caught a third.
- Sam Bradford, back from the concussion he suffered one week earlier at Texas Tech, completed 11-of-15 passes for 150 yards and four touchdowns with one interception.
- OU's defense held Oklahoma State 18 points and 202 total yards under its season averages. The Cowboys entered the game ranked No. 22 nationally in scoring and No. 6 in total offense.

SOONERS AND RANKED OPPONENTS

- Oklahoma is 6-12-2 vs. AP's No. 1-ranked team; 6-5-2 when the Sooners also are ranked.
- Oklahoma is 45-29-2 when both the Sooners and their foe are ranked in the AP's top 10.
- This is the third straight meeting for these two teams in which both are ranked.

- **Plays of 20-29 Yards** -- 50 plays and nine touchdowns.
- **Plays of 30-39 Yards** -- 25 plays and six touchdowns
- **Plays of 40+ Yards** -- 33 plays (school record besting 32 in 2003) and 14 touchdowns.
- **OU's Big-Play (20+ yards) Breakdown** -- 42 passing (16 TD), 14 rushing (9 TD), seven interceptions (three TD), one fumble return (one TD).

TEN WINS AGAIN

Oklahoma has won 10 games for the 30th time. That leads the nation. Alabama is next with 28 double-digit win seasons.

■ Seven, or nearly one-quarter (23%), of the 10+ wins have come under current head coach Bob Stoops, who is averaging 10.6 wins per year. In the 10 years before Stoops arrived, the Sooners had no 10-win seasons and averaged 6.1 wins per year. Only twice in nine seasons has a Stoops-coached Oklahoma team failed to reach 10 victories. The two that didn't hit 10 both played in bowls. OU won 61 games in the 10 years before Stoops arrived. He got his 61st victory in his sixth season at OU.

MISCELLANY

- When Sam Bradford left the Texas Tech game it marked the first time that an OU QB missed more than one quarter due to injury since 2002 when Jason White went down in game two.
- Oklahoma was picked second in the Big 12's South Division in the preseason media poll.
- Oklahoma has scored in 35 of 36 quarters this season.
- This is fifth straight season in which more than one OU back has a 100-yard rushing game.
- OU has five, one-play scoring drives. Three were rushes and the shortest was 17 yards.
- OU has three, 90-yard scoring drives: 96 vs. Utah State, 94 vs. Texas, 91 vs. Texas Tech.
- Oklahoma opponents are 6-of-38 (15.8%) on third down in the fourth quarter.
- The Sooners ran 73 plays in six games this season, 72 in another.
- OU has played 116 consecutive games against Football Bowl Subdivision foes dating to Bob Stoops' opener in 1999 (49-0 over Indiana State). That span includes regular season games vs. Notre Dame, UCLA, Alabama, Oregon, Miami, Louisville, North Carolina, Air Force and Washington. Future slates feature Miami, Washington, Tennessee, Notre Dame, LSU and Florida State.
- OU's loss at Colorado marked the fourth in the last six Sooner setbacks that was decided on the game's final play. Those four losses were by a total of seven points and all were away from Norman. OU's two losses this year, both on the road, were by a combined 10 points.

STOOPS ERA YIELDING RECORD-SETTING ATTENDANCE NUMBERS

- Oklahoma has drawn 4,499,034 for Bob Stoops' 56 home games (started in 1999) ...
- All 56 have been sold out and the Sooners prevailed 54 times. The current string of sellouts is second-longest in school history trailing a string of 69 straight from 1971 to 1984.
 - This year's average home attendance of 84,858 was the largest in school history. The top eight seasons for OU home attendance have come on Stoops' watch.
 - The crowd of 85,357 for this year's Miami game is the largest in school history.
 - OU has exceeded its listed capacity of 82,112 in 30 consecutive games.
 - When the Oklahoma State game sold out, it marked the 99th (home, away, neutral) to do so in Bob Stoops' 117 games at OU. Some 84.6% of Stoops' games sold out as compared with 83.7 (136-of-190) for Barry Switzer and 37.1% (66-of-178) for Bud Wilkinson.
 - During Stoops' nine years, 8,466,241 fans have been in attendance for Sooner games.

ABOUT THE OFFENSE

- Under Stoops, Oklahoma has produced its career leader in passing and receiving, while turning out the No. 3- and No. 4-ranked rusher in school history and the school record holder for single-season rushing, passing and receiving yards.
- OU has scored at least one touchdown in every game dating back to Nov. 7, 1998.
- Under Stoops, OU has rushed for 200 yards 36 times, including 30 over the last five seasons.
- In the Stoops era, OU has 123 TD of 25+ yards and 244 scoring drives of less than 2:00.
- OU's 2006 team missed perfect offensive balance by just 202 yards (2,682 passing, 2,480 rushing). The 2005 team missed it by just one yard and the 2003 squad was off by only 160.

BRADFORD HAS SPECIAL TIES TO OU AND THE STATE

Redshirt freshman Sam Bradford earned the starting quarterback job in August ...

- Bradford is a certified Cherokee Indian. His great, great grandmother (father's side) was named Susie Walkingstick.
- Bradford's father, Kent, was an offensive lineman at OU. He lettered in 1977 and 1978.
- He completed his last 18 passes

vs. North Texas and his first four vs. Miami. That string of 22 broke Jason White's OU record of 18 and challenged the NCAA mark of 24 set by Tennessee's Tee Martin. Bradford then hit his last 10 vs. Miami and first 11 vs. Utah State for a string of 21.

- Multiple TD passes in nine games, school record (tied) five TD passes vs. Miami and Texas A&M, hit at least 65% in 10 games, no INT in five games, at least one 30-yard pass in all games.
- Has set the NCAA record for TD passes by a freshman with 32. The previous best was 29.

- Sam Bradford is No. 1 in passing efficiency (182.2).

JUA-KEEN IGLESIAS

- The junior entered the season with 60 career receptions for 804 yards and four touchdowns. In 2007, he has 57 grabs for 822 yards and four scores. His longest reception coming into this season was 37 yards. He already has six for longer distances in '07.
- Career bests in catches (8 vs. Tulsa, Utah St.), yards (142 vs. Tulsa) and TD (2 vs. Tulsa).
- He's averaging 29.1 yards per kickoff return (No. 12 nationally) with a long of 49.
- Iglesias' 1,521 all-purpose yards are 258 more than the next highest figure on the team.

TIGHT END TANDEM

Last season, Joe Jon Finley and Jermaine Gresham combined to average 1.9 receptions/game and scored four touchdowns. In '07, they're averaging 4.1 receptions and have 13 TD.

O-LINE OF HISTORICAL PROPORTIONS

With an average height of 6-5 (76.6 inches) and 322.4 pounds this is one of the biggest offensive lines in OU history. In the Stoops era this is the heaviest line and the third-tallest. The 2002 and 2003 lines measured 77.2 inches.

- At 6-8, Phil Loadholt is tied as the tallest football player ever at OU, and the tallest starter.

KEEPING THE QB CLEAN

OU allows 0.9 sacks per game. The school record for fewest sacks allowed in a season was set last season at 1.1 (sacks record tracked only on teams with at least 100 passing attempts).



ABOUT THE SOONER DEFENSE

■ OU has forced at least one turnover in 106 of Bob Stoops' 117 games and has at least one interception in 78 of the last 103. There have multiple picks in 32 of their last 73 outings.
 ■ Oklahoma has nine shutouts under its current head coach. Opponents failed to score more than seven points 29 times and scored less than 14 in 56 games.

DEFENSE SURGING IN NCAA RANKINGS

Oklahoma's top 25 rankings in the NCAA defensive stats ...

- No. 7 in rushing defense at 91.4 yards per game.
- No. 15 in tackles for loss at 7.6 per game.
- No. 24 in sacks at 2.7 per game.
- No. 10 in scoring defense at 18.3.
- Curtis Lofton ranks No. 9 in tackles (11.0) and Auston English No. 5 in sacks (1.1) and No. 16 in TFL (1.4).

ENGLISH LESSON

Sophomore DE Auston English redshirted after his true freshman season, but is back from that year away from competition in a big way. He leads the Sooners in sacks with 9.5 and in tackles for loss with 13.

■ With 9.5 sacks, English is tied with Torrance Marshall (1999) for the 14th-best single season total in school history. The OU record of 14 is held by Martin Chase (1997) and Cedric Jones (1994). The best total in the Stoops era was 10 by Calvin Thibodeaux (2005) and Dan Cody (2004, 2003).

PAPER OR PLASTIC?

Oklahoma is averaging 2.5 sacks per game. That average over a 13-game schedule would amount to 33 sacks. The school record of 48 was set in 1986. The sack high for this season is six vs. North Texas and Tulsa.

WHAT HAVE YOU DONE FOR ME LATELY?

- With 320 interception return yards, Oklahoma has exceeded its total for each of the four three years. It is the third-highest total in the Stoops era.
- OU has 31 sacks which is five more than the 26 it posted in 14 games last season.

TOUCHY, FEELY DEFENSE

OU defenders have touched the ball 65 times (5.4 times per game) with 39 PBUs, 18 interceptions and eight fumble recoveries. To put that in perspective, opposing teams have just 43 touches in 24 break-ups, 11 fumble recoveries and seven interceptions. OU is averaging 15.0 yards on INT/fumble returns with five touchdowns to tie the school record set in 1956, 2000 and 2001.

STOOPS ERA STAPLE: RUN DEFENSE

This season, six opponents rushed for 66 or fewer yards. Eighteen times, Bob Stoops-coached Oklahoma teams have held opponents under 40 rushing yards in a game. Four times the total has resulted in negative yards.
 ■ Sooner opponents have just 60 rushing first downs.



LOFTY ACHIEVEMENT

LB Curtis Lofton ranks No. 9 nationally with 11.0 tackles per game. His 133 stops include eight double-digit games and a career-high 18 vs. Missouri. He also has a pair of TD with a 45-yard interception return (Utah State) and a 12-yard fumble return (Missouri).

ABOUT THE SOONER SPECIAL TEAMS

Oklahoma's special teams under Bob Stoops ...

- There have been 25 special teams TDs, including 19 in the last 63 regular season games. Those 19 came via five different kinds of plays -- 10 punt returns, two faked FG, two blocked punts, four kickoff returns and a faked punt. Special teams also own one safety in that span.
- In total, OU has returned eight kickoffs and 14 punts for TDs on Stoops' watch (since 1999).
- The Sooners have blocked 20 kicks.

MANY HAPPY RETURNS

- Kickoff Returns --70 returns of 25 yards or more with eight TD.

MORE ON THE RETURNS

Oklahoma's kickoff returns have been particularly solid this season ...

- Three different players have a return of more than 35 yards.
- All five players that have returned kicks this season are averaging at least 24 yards.
- DeMarco Murray ran 81 yards for a touchdown against Tulsa on the second kickoff return of his college career. His first came earlier in the same game. He then went for 91 yards and a touchdown against Baylor.

TWO-HEADED PUNTER

Oklahoma used two punters in 2006 and 2007 with Michael Cohen and Mike Knall sharing the duties. Knall, formerly the short-field punter, handled all seven punts at Texas Tech and averaged 47.4 yards with a long of 60 (longest of the season for the team) and one downed inside the 20. He was used just once in the Oklahoma State game and got off a 41-yarder.

HARTLEY SHOWING OFF BIG LEG


Garrett Hartley, who made a 53-yard field goal vs. Utah State, is averaging 66.5 yards per kickoff (ball lands at the three yard line) with 26 touchbacks in 91 attempts. To put that in perspective, opposing kickers average 60.9 yards per kickoff with two touchbacks in 47 tries.

- Opposing teams are averaging just 21.7 yards per return after Hartley's kickoffs. OU is averaging 28.2 yards per kickoff return.
- Hartley tied a school record when he made 11 point after touchdown kicks in the opener.
- He has made 18 of his last 20 field goal attempts, including a 43-yarder at Iowa State, and two at Texas Tech.

SOONERS HAVE HART-LEY

K Garrett Hartley was one of three finalists for the Lou Groza Award and is on the watch list for that award again this year ...

- Hartley ranks No. 5 in career kick scoring at OU (292), No. 4 in career field goals (43) and No. 4 in career PAT (163).
- Hartley made 19-of-20 FG and 49-of-50 on PAT in 2006. His lone field goal miss was a block at Oregon (made a career-high four FG in that game). He kicked off 78 times with 31 touchbacks.
- His FG made percentage of .950 was tops in the nation among kickers with at least 10 makes. He made his last 11 attempts of the season.
- Hartley ranked No. 20 nationally in field goals made per game with 1.36 and was No. 21 in scoring with 7.57 points per game.
- Hartley has four career makes of 50 yards or longer, including a 53-yarder against Utah State this season. He made a long of 46 yards twice last season.

History is one tough customer at Oklahoma. The tradition, so rich and so long-standing, is as daunting as it is impressive. To be among the best at Oklahoma is to be among the best in college football.

Such dramatics are lost on Bob Stoops. The Sooner head coach befriended the would-be albatross of OU's successful past from his first day on campus and remains steadfastly focused on tomorrow and the championship it holds.

It falls then to the observers and experts of the game to define Stoops' impact. Rarely have the pundits had it so easy.

Under Stoops, Oklahoma has won 96 games (96-21), been ranked for 130 weeks in the AP Poll (69 consecutive at one point) and 127 in the USA Today Coaches Poll, played in seven bowl games, four of the BCS variety, and captured three Big 12 crowns. His 2000 team won the national championship. On a playing field leveled by scholarship limits and parity, this era stares down the Oklahoma standard and does not blink.

The achievement dulls the memory of what Stoops inherited. When he arrived in Norman, the proud Sooner program was five years removed from a winning record, four from bowl play. Those atypical days of angst are so forgotten now that they might as well be mentioned with the land rush and dust bowl.

Stoops has been characterized as a grounded family man, brilliant big-game coach, relentless recruiter, disciplined leader and a person with uncommon perspective. His success emanates from a disciplined style true to his roots in the Steel Valley of Ohio, but he is far from inflexible. The principles to which he holds are the tried and true axioms of the sport ... mixed with cutting edge strategy and an appreciation for the calculated risk.

During his time, OU has produced record-setting passers and receivers, three 1,000-yard rushers, suffocating defense and special teams units that rank among the most dynamic in the land. Every facet has been impacted.

His players have snagged 16 national awards, including the 2003 Heisman Trophy won by Jason White. There have been 58 academic honorees, 53

All-Big 12 players, 22 All-Americans and 32 NFL draft choices.

Stoops has won a total of 10 national coach of the year awards and has been consensus Big 12 Coach of the year in three times.

The son of a coach, Stoops was a four-year starter at Iowa. He began his coaching career in 1983 as a volunteer in the Hawkeye program under Hayden Fry. He worked through the ranks until he became co-defensive coordinator at

Kansas State (1991-95) during Bill Snyder's rein.

With the Wildcats, he played a key role in an impressive turnaround. During his final four seasons there, K-State was 35-12 with three bowl appearances. Eventually, he left for Florida and a three-year stint as Steve Spurrier's defensive coordinator. In 1996, he was part of a national championship team. It was with the Gators that the spotlight found Stoops and made him one of the hottest names in the profession.

Stoops, who was born Sept. 9, 1960, in Youngstown, Ohio, graduated from Iowa in 1983 with a degree in marketing. He and his wife, Carol, have three children: daughter, Mackenzie, and twin sons, Drake and Isaac.
