BIG 12 NOTEBOOK

- Week 3 will feature nine Big 12 squads in action while three have an open date. #11/13 Kansas gets the weekend underway with a Friday night Top 25 matchup at #18/19 South Florida. The other games will be played on Saturday. All nine will be televised, including pay-per-view.
- Big 12 squads went 12-0 last week marking the first time in conference history that all 12 teams have played and won on the same weekend. The league is now a FBS leading 22-2 (.917) in non-conference games.
- Five Big 12 teams continue to be listed in the national polls, all ranked 13th or better with Oklahoma leading the conference contingent at No. 3 in both polls.
- Big 12 Player of the Week honors were awarded to: offense - Dez Bryant (Oklahoma State), defense - (co) Courtney Herndon (Kansas State) and Ch'pelle Brown (Colorado), special teams - Niles Paul (Nebraska).
- The Big 12 swept the Walter Camp National Player of the Week awards with Dez Bryant (Oklahoma State) earning offensive honors and Courtney Herndon (Kansas State) claiming defensive accolades.
- Last week Big 12 quarterbacks combined for 250 completions in 365 attempts (68.4 percent) for 3,475 yards with 39 TD passes and eight interceptions. Through two weeks of the season, Big 12 QBs have thrown for 64 touchdowns with 21 interceptions.
- Kansas leads the nation in pass efficiency defense (51.84) while Iowa State tops the chart in turnovers gained (10) and is tied for the lead with zero passes intercepted.
- The league is home to the following NCAA individual leaders:

13th Annual Dr Pepper Big 12 Football Championship

For the fifth time in league history the Dr Pepper Big 12 Football Championship game will be held in Kansas City. The 2008 game takes place on Saturday, December 6, at Arrowhead Stadium. Previous Big 12 Championship games staged in Kansas City were in 2000 (79,665), 2003 (79,451), 2004 (62,130) and 2006 (80,031).

In 2008, the South representative will be the home team and utilize the sideline on the press box side of the field.

General public tickets are priced at \$85, \$75, \$65 and \$55, plus handling fees. Tickets are available through Ticketmaster outlets, ticketmaster.com or (800) 676-5488 in addition to in-person at Arrowhead Stadium.

Dr Pepper Big 12 Championship Winners

In the 12-year history of the event, there have been six different winners. All-time titlists include Texas (1996, 2005), Nebraska (1997, 1999), Texas A&M (1998), Oklahoma (2000, 2002, 2004, 2006, 2007), Colorado (2001) and Kansas State (2003).

Attendance

Attendance in the Big 12 surpassed 4.6 million fans the past two seasons, including 4,652,267 in 2007. Stadiums in the Big 12 were filled to 96.6 percent of capacity last year, the ninth straight year over 90 percent. Average attendance in 2007 was 60,419, the highest in league history and first time to average over 60,000.

Home Win Streaks

Oklahoma's nation-leading home win streak is at 20 games. Kansas is fifth with 11 consecutive victories at home while Missouri is tied for sixth with eight.

Non-Conference Schedule

The non-conference portion of the 2008 Big 12 schedule features five tilts against teams that were ranked in the preseason Top 25 polls. Fourteen of the 48 non-conference games are against teams that played in a bowl game last season. The league has compiled a 429-174 (.711) non-conference record since 1996 and is 22-2 in 2008.

Big 12 Media Preseason Poll

Media covering the conference have correctly predicted the division champions in four of the last six seasons (OU/NU-06, UT/CU-05; OU/KSU-03, CU/OU-02). Overall, the top spot in each division has been accurately picked by the league's media corps 14-of-24 times.

BAYLOR (1-1, 0-0)
This Week: Washington State
Next Week: at Connecticut (Sept. 19)

Head coach Art Briles recorded his first win at the helm of the Bears. Baylor snapped a nine-game skid and a five-game losing streak at home.

The Bears' first-quarter points were the most by a BU team since scoring 24 points against Rice in 1992.

BU had its largest margin of victory (+45) since defeating SMU (+46) in 1989.

RB Jay Finley established career highs for rushing yards (91), rushing touchdowns (2), receiving yards (47), total yards (138) and total touchdowns (3).

Freshman QB Robert Griffin recorded the first touchdown pass of his career and ended the day with four TDs.



COLORADO (2-0, 0-0)
This Week: Open
Next Week: West Virginia (Sept. 18)

Colorado's 2-0 start is its first since 2005 and fourth this decade. The win over Eastern Washington also marked the first home opener win for coach Dan Hawkins.

With a 1-yard touchdown reception, Ryan Deehan became the first true freshman tight end to record a receiving TD in 25 years (Jon Embree, 1983).

WR Josh Smith has tabbed 10 returns for 314 yards and a touchdown through two games. He has four returns of 40 yards or longer (3 KOR, 1 PR), and also recorded his first career receiving TD.

Cha'pelle Brown's third career interception resulted in the game-winning score over EWU when he returned a 27-yard pick for a touchdown with 1:44 left. He was named Big 12 co-Defensive Player of the Week for his efforts.



IOWA STATE (2-0, 0-0)
This Week: at Iowa
Next Week: at UNLV

Gene Chizik is the first Cyclone coach to start his second season with a 2-0 mark since 1980 (Donnie Duncan). He is also the first ISU coach to start 5-4 or better at home since 1983-84.

The ISU defense has forced 10 turnovers in the first two games, compared to 18 all of last season.

R.J. Sumrall set a career high with 104 receiving yards, his first career 100-yard game. He also notched his first two career touchdowns.

Grant Mahoney kicked six PATs, the most since 2005, and extended his career long field goal to 48 yards, the longest by an ISU kicker since 2006.

The win over Kent State marked the first time ISU has started the season scoring 40+ points in each of its first two games since 1976.



KANSAS (2-0, 0-0)
This Week: at South Florida (Sept. 12)
Next Week: Sam Houston State

KU's 29-0 victory over the Bulldogs marked the second shutout under head coach Mark Mangino, with the first last season against Southeastern Louisiana.

QB Todd Reesing completed 32 of 38 passes for a career-high 412 yards and three touchdowns without an interception. He became the school record holder with seven consecutive 200-yard passing games.

KU scored on its opening drive for the first time since Nov. 18, 2006 with a 74-yard drive ending in a 28-yard field goal vs. Louisiana Tech.

Dezmon Briscoe and Daymond Patterson became the first pair of receivers to record 100+ receiving yards since 2006 against Nebraska.



KANSAS STATE (2-0, 0-0)
This Week: Open
Next Week: at Louisville (Sept. 17)

The 69 points scored against Montana State were the most under head coach Ron Prince, and the most since scoring a school-record 76 against Ball State in 2000.

K-State recorded two blocked punts for touchdowns in a single game for the first time in school history.

With two blocked punt returns and a fumble return that resulted in touchdowns, KSU is second nationally in non-offensive touchdowns since 1999 (63), and is 16-0 when scoring on special teams and defense since 1990.

Courtney Herndon earned national and conference defensive player of the week honors after he returned a fumble 43 yards for a touchdown, blocked a punt that was recovered for a score, intercepted a pass to set up another TD and recorded four total tackles.



MISSOURI (2-0, 0-0)
This Week: Nevada
Next Week: Buffalo

QB Chase Daniel led MU to five TD drives in the five possessions he played as he completed 16-of-17 passes for 245 yards and 3 TDs.

Daniel's QB rating was 273.41, which broke the MU single-game record of 260.7 set by Corby Jones against Iowa State in 1997.

Sean Weatherspoon had a 65-yard interception return for a touchdown, marking the second straight game he's returned a pick for a score. He is the first Tiger in school history to record INTs for touchdown in consecutive games. He is also tied for the NCAA lead with 3 interceptions for the season.

The 52 points by Mizzou is the highest point total for the Tigers in a home opener in 80 years.

Missouri's 49-point victory marks the largest margin of victory under coach Gary Pinkel. The previous high was 48 points against Ball State in 2004.



NEBRASKA (2-0, 0-0)
This Week: New Mexico State
Next Week: Open

Niles Paul earned Big 12 Special Teams Player of the Week after his 85-yard kickoff return helped Nebraska to a win over San Jose State.

Nose tackle Ndamukong Suh's 49-yard interception return for a touchdown was his second career pick and first career TD. It was the first TD by a Husker interior defensive lineman since 1992.

With kickoff and interception returns for touchdowns, Nebraska scored both a defensive and special teams touchdown in the same game for the first time since 2002.

Senior Nate Swift's 70 receiving yards pushed his career total to 1,726, 36 yards shy of moving into second on the Nebraska career receiving yardage list.



OKLAHOMA (2-0, 0-0)
This Week: at Washington
Next Week: Open

Oklahoma has been ranked in 68% of all weekly AP polls since 1936, more than half the time in the top 10 and one-third of the time in the top five.

Sam Bradford completed 28-of-39 passes for 395 yards (third-best in school history) with five touchdowns vs. Cincinnati. The completions and yards were career-highs, while the touchdown figure tied his career best.

WR Ryan Broyles had the best debut game in school history for an OU receiver in both catches (7) and yards (141).

LB Travis Lewis had 12 tackles, including seven solo, two sacks for -14 yards and 2.5 tackles for 16 yards in losses vs. UC.



OKLAHOMA STATE (2-0, 0-0)
This Week: Missouri State
Next Week: Open

OSU's 56 points were its most in a home opener since a 59-0 win over Wichita State in 1974.

The Cowboys racked up 699 yards of total offense, the second-highest single-game effort in school history (717 vs. Kansas in 1988).

Sophomore Dez Bryant produced 311 all-purpose yards with nine catches for 236 yards and three receiving touchdowns. His yardage total is the best in the country this season.

Bryant was named both Big 12 and Walter Camp National Offensive Player of the Week.

Saturday's win marked the first time in OSU history the Cowboys had a 200-yard rusher and 200-yard receiver in the same game. Kendall Hunter finished with 210 rushing yards to go with Bryant's 236 receiving yards.



TEXAS (2-0, 0-0)
This Week: Arkansas
Next Week: Rice

The Longhorns extended their non-conference road winning streak to nine games, besting the previous mark of seven from 1956-63.

LB Roddrick Muckelroy registered a team-best 16 tackles (10 solo) and returned a fumble 26 yards for a score against UTEP.

With Muckelroy's fumble return for a TD, Texas has recorded 59 non-offensive touchdowns since 1999 to rank fourth nationally.

Senior WR Quan Cosby caught eight passes for a career-high 154 yards, including a 16-yard score and three 30-yard receptions.

Texas has blocked a punt in two consecutive games for the first time since blocking punts against Oklahoma State and Kansas State in 2006. The Horns have now blocked a national-leading 50 kicks since 2000.



TEXAS A&M (1-1, 0-0)
This Week: Open
Next Week: Miami (Fla.)

The Aggies won their first non-conference road game since a victory over Pittsburgh in 2002. It was also the first win for head coach Mike Sherman.

Michael Bennett had a 37-yard fumble return, notched 2.5 tackles for a loss of nine yards and led both teams with nine tackles.

Jordan Peterson's 48-yard interception return for a touchdown was A&M's first interception return (span of 48 games) and the first defensive touchdown of any kind (39 games) since 2004.

Justin Brantly averaged 44.3 yards on seven punts, including a 61-yarder. He had three inside the 20. It was Brantly's sixth straight game with a 44.0 or better punt average.

The Aggies won their ninth straight game when averaging fewer turnovers than the opponent. A&M had four takeaways and only one turnover against the Lobos.



TEXAS TECH (2-0, 0-0)
This Week: SMU
Next Week: Massachusetts

WR Michael Crabtree had seven receptions for 158 yards and a touchdown at Nevada. The 100-plus yards marked the 12th of his career.

Eric Morris became the first Red Raider to run a punt back for a touchdown since Danny Amendola against Kansas State in 2004 (90-yard return by Amendola). Morris' punt return covered 86 yards and is the fifth-longest in school history.

LB Bront Bird had a career-best 14 tackles, 12 solo, two tackles for loss and a sack. He leads the team with 19 tackles on the season.

QB Graham Harrell and Crabtree connected for an 82-yard touchdown in the fourth quarter, resulting in the longest TD pass of Harrell's career and a career-long reception for Crabtree.
