BIG 12 FOOTBALL QUICK HITS

- The first full week of Conference action begins with all 12 teams competing in Big 12 play. Two previous Conference games were contested with Texas beating Texas Tech on Sept. 19 and Kansas State defeating Iowa State last Saturday in Kansas City's Arrowhead Stadium.
- No. 21/22 Nebraska travels to No. 23/18 Missouri on Thursday - the Big 12's third of five Thursday night games this season. The remaining five games will be played on Saturday. All six Conference contests will be televised. Including this week's games, 42 of 55 outings will have been telecast on some type of media platform.
- The Big 12 concluded the majority of its non-conference action with a 34-13 (.723) record. Five of the league's losses have been by two-or-less points with four of those by one point to nationally ranked teams. One non-league regular season game remains when Texas hosts Central Florida on Nov. 7.
- Oklahoma owns the nation's longest home win streak at 26. Texas is fourth with 12 straight victories at home while Texas Tech is tied for fifth with 11.
- Through the first five weeks of the season, the Big 12 has recorded 16 300-yard passing performances, 26 receiving performances topping the century mark and 20 rushers with 100-plus yards.
- Four Big 12 teams are in the top 20 for average home attendance - 4. Texas (101,179), 10. Nebraska (85,686), 11. Oklahoma (84,776) and 19. Texas A&M (74,047). UT, NU and OU averages are over their stadium capacity. The Longhorns are one of only four teams nationally that number over 100,000 a game.
- Six Big 12 squads are ranked in Oct. 4 polls with Texas remaining No. 2 in all three. Other teams rated include Oklahoma State, Kansas, Oklahoma, Nebraska and Missouri. Texas Tech received votes in the Harris Poll. A complete listing is on page 5.
- Big 12 Players of the Week were awarded to - Offense: Grant Gregory (Kansas State), Defense: Jeremy Beal (Oklahoma) and Special Teams: Emmanuel Lamur (Kansas State).

In 2009, the North representative will be the home team and utilize the home bench which is opposite the press box. Ticket information will be available at a later date.

Dr Pepper Big 12 Championship Winners

In the 13-year history of the event, there have been six different winners. All-time titlists include Texas (1996, 2005), Nebraska (1997, 1999), Texas A&M (1998), Oklahoma (2000, 2002, 2004, 2006, 2007, 2008), Colorado (2001) and Kansas State (2003).

Big 12 Bowl Partners

Again in 2009, the Big 12 will have eight bowl slots guaranteed. With its selection of a Big 12 team in 2008, the Gator Bowl has fulfilled the agreement the Conference has with it and the Sun Bowl of selecting a Big 12 team twice in a four-year period. Big 12 Report

On September 17, the Big 12 debuted "The Big 12 Report" a weekly magazine-style show that is available exclusively on the Conference Web site. Hosted by Big12Sports.com Correspondent Wendell Barnhouse, the show will be broadcast each week and focus on the schools and student-athletes throughout the Big 12. In addition, the broadcasts will give fans a unique look into the workings of the Big 12 Conference itself - including television, bowl games, scheduling and more - along with interviews with the Commissioner and other selected Big 12 staff.

Big 12 Heisman Winners

The Big 12 has four Heisman winners in the league's 13-year history, the most of any conference during this time span. A Big 12 player has captured the trophy four of the last 11 seasons: 2008-Sam Bradford (OU); 2003-Jason White (OU); 2001-Eric Crouch (NU); 1998-Ricky Williams (UT).

In 2008, Texas QB Colt McCoy finished second, 122 points behind Bradford, while Texas Tech QB Graham Harrell and WR Michael Crabtree finished fourth and fifth, respectively. This marked the first time in the award's 74-year history four of the top five finishers hailed from the same conference.

Television Partners

ABC begins its 14th season as the conference's national network television partner. The Big 12 also continues its long-standing relationship with FSN for its cable rights. FSN has sublicensed select television games in 2009 to ESPN and Versus.

BCS Sightings

The 2008 season marked the fifth time the Big 12 has advanced two teams to BCS games in the same season (2001, '03, '04, '07, '08). Conference teams have played in 16 BCS games in the 11-year history of the structure, posting a 7-9 mark.

Big 12 Weekly Television Shows

FSN's *Big 12 Showcase* and ESPNU's *Big 12 This Week* are telecast weekly with features on student-athletes, coaches and teams as well as highlights of Conference championships and other events in the league. Check local listings for dates and times.

Big 12 Media Preseason Poll

Media covering the conference have correctly predicted the division champions in four of the last six seasons (OU/NU-06, UT/CU-05; OU/KSU-03, CU/OU-02). Overall, the top spot in each division has been accurately picked by the league's media corps 19-of-26 times.

BAYLOR (3-1, 0-0)

This Week: at Oklahoma
Next Week: at Iowa State

Baylor has scored at least one rushing touchdown in 16 consecutive games, dating back to the 2008 season opener. It's the second-longest such streak in Baylor history.

The Baylor pass defense is ranked second in the Conference, allowing an average of 166 yards per game. BU also ranks first with seven interceptions.

Sophomore wide receiver Kendall Wright had a career-high nine receptions against Kent State. Wright is tied for sixth in the Big 12, averaging six catches per game.

The victory over Kent State put the Bears above .500 for the month of October. Baylor's record in the 10th month on the calendar is 202-201-21 all-time.



COLORADO (1-3, 0-0)

This Week: at Texas
Next Week: Kansas

Receiver Scotty McKnight has caught at least one pass in 28 consecutive games, a school record. His streak ranks ninth nationally.

Cody Hawkins moved into third on the all-time passing yards list at CU with 5,630. He needs just one more touchdown pass to tie the school career record of 43, held by Joel Klatt.

Rodney Stewart recorded his fifth career 100-yard rushing game, second in a row, and second against West Virginia. Stewart ranks fourth in the Conference, averaging 90 rushing yards per game.

Colorado ranks sixth in both passing offense (261.2) and passing defense (207.2) in the Big 12.



IOWA STATE (3-2, 0-1)

This Week: at Kansas
Next Week: Baylor

Kansas holds a 48-34-6 lead over Iowa State in the all-time series. The Cyclones have won four of the last nine meetings with Kansas, but ISU has lost the last four.

ISU's last win in Lawrence was in 2001, a 49-7 victory that made the Cyclones bowl eligible for the second consecutive season.

Iowa State leads the nation in fewest quarterback sacks, giving up just one through five games. ISU ranks third in the Big 12 in rushing offense, averaging just over 207 yards per game.

Senior linebacker Jesse Smith has notched three double-digit tackle games (15 vs. North Dakota State, 13 vs. Army, 12 vs. Kansas State), the most in the Conference.



KANSAS (4-0, 0-0)

This Week: Iowa State
Next Week: at Colorado

Kansas has a six-game winning streak dating back to last season. Those six consecutive victories rank fourth in the country behind Florida (14 straight), Iowa (nine) and Texas (eight).

Wide receiver Dezmon Briscoe needs just three receptions and 33 yards to become the KU career leader in both categories.

Kerry Meier had a career-high 141 receiving yards against Southern Mississippi. Meier has at least two receptions in 26 consecutive contests which is tied for 11th in the nation. Meier also ranks fourth in the Conference in receptions per game (6.8).

In 2008, Iowa State took a 20-0 lead into the locker room at halftime, but Kansas scored 28 unanswered points in the second half to earn the win, 35-33.



KANSAS STATE (3-2, 1-0)

This Week: at Texas Tech
Next Week: Texas A&M

KSU had two student-athletes named Big 12 Players of the Week - Gregory Grant (Offensive) and Emmanuel Lamur (Special Teams). They are the second and third Wildcats to earn the honors this season.

The blocked extra point that gave KSU the win over Iowa State was the 36th blocked kick by the Wildcats since 2002. Since that season, Kansas State ranks fourth nationally in blocked kicks.

KSU is 3-4 against Texas Tech in Big 12 play, while head coach Bill Snyder is 3-3 against the Red Raiders. K-State is looking to go to 2-0 in Big 12 play for the first time since 2000.

The Wildcats are third in the Big 12 and 16th nationally in total defense, allowing 267.2 yards per game. KSU's pass defense ranks first in the Conference, allowing 152.6 yards per game.



MISSOURI (4-0, 0-0)

This Week: Nebraska (Thursday)
Next Week: at Oklahoma State

Quarterback Blaine Gabbert threw for 414 yards vs. Nevada, improving on his previous career high of 319 set in MU's season opener against Illinois. Gabbert's three touchdown passes marked the third time in four games that he has managed three touchdown passes in a game.

With the victory over Nevada, Missouri extended its school record with its 14th consecutive victory in non-conference games. The streak is the longest in school history.

Wide receiver Danario Alexander caught nine balls for a career-high 170 yards and two touchdowns to earn Big 12 Co-Offensive Player of the Week on Sept. 28.

Missouri is the least-penalized team in the Conference. The Tigers have only 20 penalties on the season for 182 yards and an average of 45.5 yards per game.



NEBRASKA (3-1, 0-0)

This Week: at Missouri (Thursday)
Next Week: Texas Tech

Nebraska starts conference action in its 102nd meeting with Missouri, with NU leading the series 63-35-3. The winner of the matchup has been the North representative in the Big 12 title game each of the past three seasons.

The Huskers hold a 3-1 advantage in the five times they've opened league play against the Tigers. MU has won three straight at home. In 2008, NU recorded 369 total yards, including 290 passing, and WR Menelik Holt caught five passes for 67 yards and a TD.

Nebraska has outscored opponents 157-28 through four games, the 7.0 points allowed per game leads the nation.

Roy Helu Jr. continues to lead the Big 12 in rushing with 464 yards and five touchdowns (116.0 ypg). He ranks sixth nationally.



OKLAHOMA (2-2, 0-0)

This Week: Baylor
Next Week: Texas (Dallas)

Oklahoma opens Big 12 play against Baylor and owns an 18-0 record in the series, including a 49-17 win last year.

In 2008, the Sooners produced 594 total offensive yards (217 rushing, 377 passing) while the defense held the Bears to 269 offensive yards. DeMarco Murray rushed for 96 yards and a touchdown, while Manuel Johnson caught five passes for 92 yards and a touchdown.

Jeremy Beal tallied three sacks for the second-straight game against Miami last week, ranking No. 3 nationally in sacks. He also ranks No. 8 in the nation with 8.0 tackles for loss for 45 yards.

Landry Jones recorded his third consecutive game with a passing touchdown. Through four games, Jones has completed 67 of 111 passes for 861 yards and 10 touchdowns.



OKLAHOMA STATE (3-1, 0-0)

This Week: at Texas A&M
Next Week: Missouri

Oklahoma State starts league play at Texas A&M with the Aggies leading the series, but OSU won the 2008 matchup 56-28. This is OSU's second consecutive year opening conference with A&M and the two are scheduled to do so through 2015.

Last year against A&M, Zac Robinson threw for 186 yards and three touchdowns, completing 10 of 13 passes without an interception. Dez Bryant logged 106 yards and three touchdowns on five catches.

Robinson holds the Cowboys' school record for career touchdowns with 56, which he achieved in OSU's lasting outing against Grambling.

Robinson has connected with Dez Bryant for 29 touchdown passes, the highest total for any active quarterback-receiver tandem in the nation. Bryant is the NCAA's active career leader in receiving yards per game (86.61) and yard per reception (16.50).



TEXAS (4-0, 1-0)

This Week: Colorado
Next Week: Oklahoma (Dallas)

Texas hosts Colorado in its conference opener. The two will meet for the 18th time with Texas holding a 10-7 advantage.

In last year's contest against CU, Texas posted 431 (169 rushing, 262 passing) total offensive yards while the Longhorn defense held the Buffaloes to 49 yards rushing and 217 yards passing.

Colt McCoy ranks sixth nationally in passing (25.75) and 11th in total offense (301.50). Jordan Shipley ranks no. 3 nationally in receptions per game (9.00) and no. 13 in receiving yards per game (109.00).

McCoy has already accumulated over 12,000 yards of total offense in his career, the 15th player to accomplish such a feat in NCAA FBS. He ranks No. 13 on the career list with 12,161 yards.



TEXAS A&M (3-1, 0-0)

This Week: Oklahoma State
Next Week: at Kansas State

The Aggies lead the series against OSU 17-7, winning four of the last five, and hold an 8-3 record at home. A&M owns a 9-4 record when opening league play in College Station.

Last year against OSU, Jerrod Johnson threw for 218 yards and two touchdowns on 24-of-43 passing. Ryan Tannehill notched 49 yards and two touchdowns on seven catches.

Johnson matched a school record last Saturday with his third 300-yard passing game this season. He ranks No. 3 nationally in total offense (376.25) and No. 11 in total passing yards (1,306). Dating back to last season, Johnson has thrown 186 passes without an interception.

Von Miller continues to lead the nation and the Big 12 in sacks (2.25). He has now posted at least one sack in four consecutive games, bringing his season total to nine.



TEXAS TECH (3-2, 0-1)

This Week: Kansas State
Next Week: at Nebraska

Texas Tech has won 11 consecutive home games and is closing in on the school record of 12. The Red Raiders have passed for at least 400 yards in four consecutive games this season, ranking No. 2 nationally with 421.40 passing yards per game.

Tech played in front of its largest sellout crowd of 52,909 at AT&T Jones Stadium when it defeated New Mexico last week.

Texas Tech faces Kansas State in its second Big 12 contest, which also marks Tech's Homecoming game. TTU holds a 7-3 overall lead in the series, 5-1 at home, against K-State and has won the last four meetings, including last season's 58-28 win.

In 2008, the Red Raiders totaled 330 more yards in offense than the Wildcats with 626 total yards (136 rushing, 490 passing).
