### BIG 12 FOOTBALL QUICK HITS

- Four conference games are on tap for Big 12 teams in Week 5 while Colorado hosts Georgia in a non-league tilt. Kansas State, Missouri and Nebraska are idle.
- Texas A&M travels to No. 24 Oklahoma State on Thursday to kick off the action. Saturday conference matchups include Kansas at Baylor and Texas Tech at Iowa State. In addition, No. 16/21 Texas takes on No. 8/8 Oklahoma in Dallas' Cotton Bowl stadium. All five games this week are televised.
- The Big 12 is 34-6 (.850) in non-conference games, has six undefeated teams, five teams ranked in the coaches poll and two teams ranked in the top 10 in both polls.
- Nebraska (6/6), Oklahoma (8/8) and Texas (16/21) are ranked in both polls while Missouri (23) and Oklahoma State (24) are rated by the coaches. Kansas State and Texas Tech received votes.
- Big 12 teams have scored 11 defensive touchdowns, including three this past week on two interception returns by Iowa State and a fumble return by Missouri.
- Every Big 12 team will complete the non-conference slate with a .500 or better record for the fourth time in Conference history. It also occurred in 2002, 2004 and 2008.
- Big 12 Players of the Week were awarded to Offense: Landry Jones (Oklahoma), Defense: Jake Knott (Iowa State) and Special Teams: D.J. Beshears (Kansas).
- Oklahoma State leads the nation in total offense (596.00) and passing efficiency (187.05) while placing second in scoring (57.00) and passing yards (391.67). Nebraska is fifth in rushing (309.25) while Oklahoma is 10th in passing (308.75). Texas A&M is ninth in total offense (501.33).
- Four Conference defenses are giving up under a 100 yards a game rushing - 4. Texas A&M (69.00), 7. Colorado (71.67), 20. Texas (99.00) and 22. Texas Tech (99.67). In addition, four teams are holding opponents to under 150 passing yards an outing - 3. Nebraska (126.25), 5. Kansas (128.50), 6. Texas (128.75) and 10. Iowa State (143.75).
- Total defense leaders include 2. Texas (227.75), 10. Texas A&M (255.67) and 15. Nebraska (265.00).

### 15th Annual Dr Pepper Big 12 Football Championship

The Dr Pepper Big 12 Football Championship returns to Cowboys Stadium in Arlington, Texas for the second consecutive year. The 2010 game takes place on Saturday, December 4, at 7:00 p.m. CT and will be nationally televised by ABC. In 2010, the North representative will be the home team.

### Dr Pepper Big 12 Championship Winners

In the 14-year history of the event, there have been six different winners. All-time titlists include Texas (1996, 2005, 2009), Nebraska (1997, 1999), Texas A&M (1998), Oklahoma (2000, 2002, 2004, 2006, 2007, 2008), Colorado (2001) and Kansas State (2003).

### BCS Sightings

The 2009 season marked the Conference's 17th BCS game in the 12-year history of the structure. The Big 12 is 7-10 all-time in BCS games and has advanced two teams in the same season five times (2001, '03, '04, '07, '08).

### Television Partners

ABC begins its 15th season as the Conference's national network television partner. The Big 12 also continues its long-standing relationship with FSN for its cable rights. FSN has sublicensed select television games in 2010 to ESPN.

### Television Selections

Television selections will be announced on either a 12-day or six-day advance by the Conference office. The 12-day advances will be released on Mondays while the six-day will be available on Sunday's prior to that week's games.

**BAYLOR (3-1, 0-0)**

**This Week:** Kansas

**Next Week:** vs. Texas Tech (Dallas)

The Bears are winners of all four series meetings with Kansas in Waco, averaging 30 points in those contests.

BU has allowed only one touchdown and five field goals in its three wins - holding opponents to a 7.3 points-per-game average while racking up 470.7 yards per game in total offense.

Robert Griffin III passed J.J. Joe (43) as the Baylor career leader in touchdown responsibility (passing and rushing). Griffin III has been responsible for 45 touchdowns in 19 career games.

Baylor is 10-for-12 in redzone opportunities this season — four TDs, six FGs.



**COLORADO (2-1, 0-0)**

**This Week:** Georgia

**Next Week:** at Missouri

This marks CU's first meeting with Georgia since 2006, a 14-13 loss in Athens. UGA is the second SEC team to visit Folsom Field since LSU in 1979.

Colorado is the national leader in combined third & fourth down efficiency defense - the opponent is 8-of-34 on third down and 0-of-5 on fourth for a combined 8-of-39 (20.5%).

Colorado is having a reunion of its 1990 consensus national championship team this weekend, marking the 20th anniversary of CU's national title and 1990 Big Eight Conference crown.

On Sept. 18, Rodney Stewart (22 carries, 106 yards, 2 TDs) and Brian Lockridge (14 carries, 109 yards) became the first Colorado running backs to go over 100 yards in the same game since Chris Brown (127) and Bobby Purify (174) did it in 2002 against Iowa State.



**IOWA STATE (2-2, 0-1)**

**This Week:** Texas Tech

**Next Week:** Utah

The Cyclones rank ninth nationally with seven interceptions. Sophomore LB A.J. Klein has two interception returns for touchdowns this season. The last time that happened was 1996.

Texas Tech leads the all-time series 7-1 with the Iowa State win on Oct. 12, 2002, in Ames. Paul Rhoads served as Tommy Tuberville's defensive coordinator at Auburn in 2008.

LB Jake Knott was named Big 12 Defensive Player of the Week after making a game-high 11 tackles, forcing a fumble and intercepting his third pass of the season.

ISU has held six of its last seven opponents to 10 or fewer points in the first half. All nine wins in the Paul Rhoads era have occurred when ISU has held opponents to 10 or fewer in the first half and under 24 points total.



**KANSAS (2-2, 0-0)**

**This Week:** at Baylor

**Next Week:** Idle

D.J. Beshears returned two kickoffs for 117 yards, including a 96-yarder for a touchdown in Kansas' win over New Mexico State to earn Big 12 Special Teams Player of the Week.

While Beshears and James Sims combined for five touchdowns against NMSU, Kansas' first seven touchdowns of the season were scored by seven different players.

The Jayhawks will open league play on the road for the 10th time in the last 15 seasons. KU has won its past three conference openers and looks to stop a five-game road losing streak.

Freshman quarterback Jordan Webb had a career-high 249 yards passing, completing 17-of-27 last weekend. He completed his first six passes for 104 yards.



**KANSAS STATE (4-0, 1-0)**

**This Week:** Idle

**Next Week:** Nebraska (Thursday)

Kansas State has started a season 4-0 15 times in its history; 10 have come under coach Bill Snyder. This is the first 4-0 start for the Wildcats since 2003 when they finished 11-4 overall and appeared in the Fiesta Bowl.

Carson Coffman's 7-yard touchdown run with 24 seconds left lifted Kansas State to a come-from-behind 17-13 victory Saturday over Central Florida. KSU won despite being outgained in total yards, 344-277 and first downs 20-9.

William Powell ranks 13th nationally and second in the league in kickoff returns, averaging 31.88 yards per return.

KSU has scored 79 of its 123 points in the second half, with 45 coming in the fourth quarter.



**MISSOURI (4-0, 0-0)**

**This Week:** Idle

**Next Week:** Colorado

Sophomore wide receiver T.J. Moe's 37 receptions are the most in school history for the first four games by a Missouri receiver. Justin Gage had 30 catches in the first four games in 2002.

Five different players had rushing touchdowns in MU's 51-13 win over UCF last weekend - Blaine Gabbert, Kendial Lawrence, De'Vion Moore, Henry Josey and Marcus Murphy. The Tigers accumulated a season-high 469 yards in total offense.

Missouri's eight interceptions in four games match its total for last year's 13-game season. MU is fifth in the nation with 13 turnovers gained.

Two MU receivers rank in the top 10 nationally for receptions per game, T.J. Moe is third with 9.25 while Michael Egnew ranks sixth with 8.25.



**NEBRASKA (4-0, 0-0)**

**This Week:** Idle

**Next Week:** at Kansas State (Thursday)

QB Taylor Martinez has 496 rushing yards this season - the most by a Nebraska freshman quarterback, bettering Eric Crouch's 459 yards in 1998.

Lavonte David had 19 tackles against SDSU last weekend, including 11 in the first half. His 19 tackles are the most by a Husker since Barrett Ruud had 19 tackles at Kansas State in 2004.

Dating to last season, Nebraska has won 10 of its past 11 games, its best stretch since winning 13 straight games between the 2000 and 2001 seasons.

Senior kicker Alex Henery has made 84 consecutive PATs and 10 consecutive field goals.



**OKLAHOMA (4-0, 0-0)**

**This Week:** vs. Texas (Dallas)

**Next Week:** Idle

Both OU and Texas enter the game ranked among The Associated Press Top 25 for the 34th time since the poll began in 1936 with Oklahoma holding a 16-14-3 edge in those games.

UT and OU met as conference opponents in 1996 for the first time in 77 years, with the series tied at 7-7 in Big 12 games.

OU's wide receiver Ryan Broyles has seven consecutive games with at least 100 yards receiving and QB Landry Jones has had 92 completions in the last three games.

Senior running back DeMarco Murray has 53 all-purpose touchdowns (42 rushing, nine receiving and two on kick returns). He's tied for second in school history with Billy Sims (53). Steve Owens is first with 57.



**OKLAHOMA STATE (3-0, 0-0)**

**This Week:** Texas A&M (Thursday)

**Next Week:** at UL-Lafayette (Friday)

The Cowboys are averaging 57 points a game and lead the FBS in total offense (596.0).

Kendall Hunter is third nationally with an average of 157.7 rushing yards. He is fifth in the country in scoring (12 points per game) and third in the nation with an average of 198.33 all-purpose yards.

The Cowboys are 6-8 in Big 12 openers. Under Mike Gundy, the Cowboys are 3-2 in Big 12 openers, including three straight victories. OSU is 3-1 when opening Big 12 play at home.

Mike Gundy will be looking for his 40th victory as the Cowboys head coach. He enters the TAMU game with an overall record of 39-27. Only Pat Jones (62) and Jim Lookabaugh (58) have reached the 40-win mark at OSU.



**TEXAS (3-1, 1-0)**

**This Week:** vs. Oklahoma (Dallas)

**Next Week:** Idle

Texas will bring the nation's second-ranked defense into the Cotton Bowl, giving up just 227.75 yards of total offense per game. UT ranks sixth in sacks (3.5), tackles for loss (8.5) and passing yards allowed (128.75).

UT head coach Mack Brown has been on both sidelines for the Texas/Oklahoma rivalry. Brown was the offensive coordinator at Oklahoma in 1984 when No. 1 Texas and No. 2 Oklahoma played to a 15-all tie.

UT is looking to win its fifth Red River Rivalry in the last six years. Texas holds a 59-40-5 series lead.

Although the loss to UCLA at home snapped Texas' 16-game home winning streak, Mack Brown's teams have bounced back in the past as they've lost consecutive games only four times in his 13-season tenure.



**TEXAS A&M (3-0, 0-0)**

**This Week:** at Oklahoma State (Thursday)

**Next Week:** vs. Arkansas (Arlington)

The Oklahoma State-Texas A&M series is one of the more tightly contested in the Big 12. The Aggies were one-point winners in 2006 and 2007 and OSU was a five-point winner last year in College Station. Since 1997, A&M has two overtime wins against OSU with one of those a one-point decision. Six games have been decided by five points or less since 1997.

Texas A&M leads the all-time series by a 17-8 count. The Cowboys are 4-10 vs. Texas A&M during the Big 12 era, but the two teams have split their last eight games.

RB Christine Michael is the first Aggie to top 100 rushing yards in three consecutive games since Dante Hall in 1998.

Von Miller has been hampered by a sprained knee throughout this season. Miller, who led the nation with 17 sacks last season, is still looking for his first sack of the season. Miller has gone 297 snaps without a sack since his last one against Texas late last season.



**TEXAS TECH (2-1, 0-1)**

**This Week:** at Iowa State

**Next Week:** vs. Baylor (Dallas)

Texas Tech will take a six-game win streak against the Big 12 North Division to Ames this weekend and the Red Raiders will be in search of their second consecutive win at Jack Trice Stadium.

Scott Smith became the sixth Texas Tech player – and only the second defensive lineman – since 2000 to have an interception and sack in the same game after having two sacks and a pick against then-No. 4 Texas two weeks ago.

QB Taylor Potts needs 198 passing yards to move into seventh place in career passing yardage in the Tech record books. He also needs four touchdowns to move into sixth place (career touchdowns), 28 passing attempts to move into eighth place (career passing attempts) and 21 pass completions to move into seventh place (career passing completions).

Texas Tech enters the 2010 season as the third winningest Big 12 program in this century. With 47 league wins since 2000, Texas Tech ranks behind UT and OU who lead the way with 69 and 67, respectively.
