The Game

Oklahoma (No. 6 AP, No. 6 ESPN/USA Today Coaches) and Iowa State meet in Norman for OU's Homecoming. The Sooners, who owns a seven-game winning streak and are 5-0 for the seventh time in Bob Stoops' 12 season, are fresh off their only bye week of the season. Before that, they knocked off then-No. 21 Texas, 28-20, in the 105th edition of the Red River Rivalry at Dallas' Cotton Bowl. The Cyclones entertained Utah last week and dropped a 68-27 decision.

The Series

Oklahoma leads its series with Iowa State by a count of 67-5-2 and has won the last 11 in a row. The Sooners lead in games played at Norman, 34-3-1.

The Coaches

- Oklahoma: Bob Stoops (Iowa '83) is 122-29 in his 12th season. He is 78-17 vs. the Big 12, 43-12 vs. the Big 12 South, 35-5 vs. the Big 12 North, 6-1 in the Big 12 title game, 44-12 vs. non-conference opponents, 69-2 at home, 33-14 on the road, 20-13 on neutral fields, 38-16 vs. ranked opponents, 5-0 against Iowa State.
- Iowa State: Paul Rhoads (Missouri Western '89) is 10-9 in his second season at Iowa State, 0-0 vs. Oklahoma.

The Program

- Oklahoma's all-time record stands at 804-302-53 in 116 seasons. Since WWII, OU leads the nation with 564 victories.
- The Sooners have captured seven national championships (1950, 1955, 1956, 1974, 1975, 1985, 2000).
- Oklahoma has 43 bowl appearances (No. 7 nationally) with 25 bowl victories (No. 4 nationally).
- OU has 42 conference titles, including three of the last four Big 12 crowns and six overall (no other team has more than three).
- Oklahoma has produced 150 All-Americans and five Heisman Trophy winners. Sooners have also won the Bednarik (1), Butkus (4), Walter Camp (4), Lombardi (3), Maxwell (2), Nagurski (2), O'Brien (3), (Outland (5), Tatupu (1), Thorpe (3) and Unitas (1) Awards.
- Oklahoma leads the nation with 31, 10-win seasons.

The luncheon begins at 11:15 a.m. Lunch is served at 11:30 a.m., and OU head coach Bob Stoops steps to the podium at 12:05 p.m. A limited number of players are on hand for interviews.

CREDENTIALS

Requests must be submitted by a sports director/editor at least eight days prior to the contest. Media must show government issued photo identification upon entering the stadium. If the name on the credential and the photo ID do not match, the credential is void.

PRACTICE

All practice sessions are closed to media and public unless otherwise posted. OKLAHOMA'S MOST RECENT GAME

- Oklahoma led wire-to-wire in winning the 105th edition of the Red River Rivalry at the Cotton Bowl in Dallas, a 28-20 decision over No. 21 Texas ...
- RB DeMarco Murray had a big day, rushing for 115 yards and two touchdowns and catching four passes for 31 yards. He finished with 160 all purpose yards.
 - Landry Jones completed 24-of-39 passes for 236 yards with two touchdowns and no interceptions.
 - True freshman Kenny Stills led the receivers with five grabs for 78 yards and one TD.
 - Travis Lewis and Tom Wort led OU with 10 tackles each.
 - OU jumped to a 14-0 first-quarter lead and upped the advantage to its biggest at 28-10 with 12:54 remaining in the game.
 - For the 12th straight time, the team that rushed for the most yards won the OU-Texas game. The Sooners picked up 124 on the ground to 107 (60 on one play) by Texas.
 - Texas out-gained Oklahoma in total yards, 373-360, but was flagged nine times for 81 yards and lost two turnovers. OU committed just five penalties for 29 yards and had no turnovers.
 - One of the key stats in the game was third-down conversion. OU was 9-of-20 to just 5-of-16 by Texas.
 - Both teams punched in all of their red zone opportunities, but the Sooners got four touchdowns in four trips, while UT produced just one TD in three trips.

HISTORICAL PROPORTIONS

- DeMarco Murray (55) is two touchdowns shy of Steve Owens' (57) record for career touchdowns at Oklahoma. If he breaks the mark, it will erase a figure that has been in place for 41 years.
- The longest standing record that was broken at OU came in 2009 when Sam Bradford (184.87) eclipsed Eddie Crowder's career mark for passing efficiency (165.94). That record had been in place for 57 years.
 - Seven times, OU players have broken school records that had been on the books for 40 or more years.
 - There are currently 10 OU records that were set in 1969 or earlier including six by Owens.

HOME WINNING STREAK AT 33

- A look at data during the 33-game home field winning streak. With its beginning on Sept. 1, 2005, with a 31-15 victory over Tulsa, it is the nation's longest active streak ...
- The Sooners outscored their opponents by nearly 1,000 points -- 1,467-505, an average score of 44.4 to 15.3.
 - OU scored 50+ pts., 11 times, 60+ five and a high of 79 vs. North Texas in '07 opener, Sam Bradford's first game.
 - The low OU scoring total was 24 points twice.
 - Oklahoma's defense has posted four shutouts and held the foe to single digits eight times.
 - QBs: R. Bomar, P. Thompson, S. Bradford, L. Jones.

THE NATION'S NO. 9 SLATE

Based on the records of the Oklahoma opponents this season -- both past and future -- the Sooners currently own the nation's ninth-most difficult schedule. The first five foes are 13-6, the future opposition is 22-11 thus far.

- Oklahoma's 2010 schedule has featured three teams -- Florida State, Air Force and Texas -- that have been or are currently ranked among the top 25.
- Last season, Oklahoma played the nation's No. 2-ranked slate (Mississippi State was tops).
- Iowa State's schedule is currently ranked No. 1.

STOOPS ERA YIELDING RECORD-SETTING ATTENDANCE

- Oklahoma has drawn 5,633,511 fans for Bob Stoops' 71- home games (started in 1999) and all have been sold out.
- The Sooners are 69-2 on Owen Field under Stoops and have won 33 straight, a school record and the nation's longest current streak.
 - The current string of sellouts is the longest in school history, bettering a string of 69 from 1971-84.
 - The average home attendance of 85,075 in 2008 was a school record. The top nine seasons for football attendance at Oklahoma came on Stoops' watch.
 - The largest home crowd in school history was 85,646, on hand for the 2008 OU-Texas Tech game.
 - Oklahoma has exceeded its listed seating capacity of 82,112 at Gaylord Family - Oklahoma Memorial Stadium in 45 consecutive home games.
 - Oklahoma has played before sellout crowds in 123 of the 151 games (home, away, neutral) since Stoops became the head coach. During that time, a total of 10,240,663 (average of 67,818) have watched the Sooners. .

ABOUT THE OFFENSE

- Under Stoops, OU produced career leaders in passing and receiving, its No. 3 & No. 5 career rushers and season record holders in rushing, passing and receiving yards.
- Some 57 offensive records have been set in Stoops' tenure at Oklahoma.
- OU has scored in every game since Nov. 7, 1998.
- OU has rushed for 200 yards 44 times under Stoops, 38 in the last six years.
- Also under Stoops, OU has 149 touchdowns of 25+ yards and 303 scoring drives of 2:00 or less.
- OU is the highest scoring program in college football history. In 1,159 games, the Sooners have scored 31,033 points. Michigan has 30,136 points in 1,218 games and Nebraska 30,068 in 1,223.

DEMARC-ABLE

DeMarco Murray became has become only the second player in Oklahoma history to surpass 1,000 yards in three statistical categories: He has 3,022 rushing yards, 106 receptions for 1,119 receiving yards and 1,337 return yards. His all-purpose total is 5,478. George "Buster" Rhymes (1980-84) is the only other Sooner to accomplish the feat with 1,158 rushing yards, 1,118 receiving yards and 1,237 kick return yards. Rhymes finished his career with 3,800 all-purpose yards.

- For his career, Murray has 106 receptions for 1,119 yards. That yardage figure is No. 2 for an OU back behind 1,337 by Quentin Griffin (1999-02). Griffin also has the receptions mark for backs at 169 with Murray second.
- Murray leads all OU backs in TD receptions with nine.
- Murray's has cracked OU's prestigious top-10 list for career rushing. Despite a pair of Heisman-winning QBs during the same era, three of the backs currently on that list played under Bob Stoops -- Adrian Peterson, Quentin Griffin and Chris Brown.

RYAN'S HOPE

Ryan Broyles is threatening many OU marks ...

- The junior has 100 or more yards receiving in seven of the last eight games -- his seven-game streak was snapped against Texas. He had a string of five consecutive games in which he had scored a TD snapped against Air Force, but has scored a TD in six of the last eight.
- He ranks No. 2 in the nation in receptions per game at 9.2 and No. 10 in receiving yards per game at 103.6.
- He set school records for receptions/season (89), receptions /game (13 vs. Stanford), touchdown receptions in a season (15, tied) and receptions per game (6.61).
- His Sun Bowl effort -- 13 receptions, 156 yards, three touchdowns -- was record-setting. The TD total set an OU bowl and Sun Bowl mark. The receptions total was an OU bowl record and the second-highest total in the 76-year history of the Sun Bowl.
- Broyles' 25 career TD receptions is No. 3 all-time at OU.
- With 102 points in 2010, he became the first WR to lead Oklahoma in scoring (stats tracked for 72 seasons).

KEEPING UP WITH JONES

QB Landry Jones now has five 300-yard passing games in 14 starts. He had a season-high 380 passing yards against Florida State. He is now No. 4 in 300-yard games at OU, tied with Sooner running backs coach Cale Gundy. Sam Bradford and Josh Heupel, Jones' position coach, hold the record jointly at 14.

- Had a career-best 13 straight completions at Cincinnati.
- Since opening the season against Utah State by going 17-of-36 (.472) for 217 yards with two touchdowns and two interceptions, he has gone 116-of-172 (.674) for 1,240 yards with nine touchdowns and one interception.
- The soph threw for 321 yards in the first half of the Florida State game, the second-best one-half total in school history. Sam Bradford threw for 350 yards against North Texas in 2007. Jones equalled his career best for completions against the Seminoles with 30 (out of 40).
- Jones completed at least 50% in 16 of 17 career games.

DIVERSIFYING THE COMPLETIONS

After completing 16-of-17 passes to wide receivers in the opener, the Sooners have begun to spread the ball around. Forty-six of OU's 135 completions are to tight ends and running backs. DeMarco Murray is now the second-leading receiver on the team with 20.

THE RETURN OF THE FULLBACK

True freshman Trey Millard has nine rushes for 33 yards and six receptions for another 43 and one TD. He has more rushes and rushing yards than any OU fullback since Seth Littrell had 24 attempts for 78 yards in 2000.

- The current depth chart features just two seniors in tackle Eric Mensik and guard Brian Lepak. Despite the relative youth of the line, the current two-deep includes players who have combined to play in 133 games.
- Two of Oklahoma's offensive linemen are converted tight ends -- T Eric Mensik and G Gabe Ikard.
- Eight players have started in the line this season.

ABOUT THE SOONER DEFENSE

- OU has forced at least one turnover in 134 of Stoops' 151 games and has at least one interception in 98 of the last 131 with multiple picks in 48 of the last 102 outings.
- Oklahoma has 11 shutouts under its current head coach. Opponents failed to score more than seven points 32 times and scored less than 14 in 60 games.

WEAK FREAK

Weakside linebacker Travis Lewis has led Oklahoma in tackles in each of his first two seasons. His 109 last season were 21 more than any other player on the team. He leads the 2010 with 45 and had a season-high 13 against Air Force.

- Lewis, with 298 tackles, is making a run at the prestigious career top-10 tackle list at OU. The record is held by the late Daryl Hunt at 530. The No. 10 spot belongs to Lee Roy Selmon at 335, 37 ahead of Lewis.
- Tracking down big names is nothing new for Lewis. As a freshman in 2007, he racked up 144 tackles to break Brian Bosworth's Oklahoma freshman record of 133.
- In 29 career games, Lewis has 10+ tackles 13 times.
- Trying to become only the sixth player in school history (tackles tracked since 1970) to lead OU in tackles for three straight seasons. The last to do it was Butkus Award winner Rocky Calmus from 1999-01.

THE REAL BEAL

Defensive end Jeremy Beal looks like a candidate to become OU's first Ted Hendricks Award winner. He has 8.5 tackles for loss and 6.0 sacks (No. 4 nationally).

- In '09, Beal was No. 14 nationally in TFL (1.46 per game/19 total), No. 16 in sacks (0.8 per game/ 11 total).
- His 11 sacks last season rank No. 4 for a season at OU.
- Beal is the only player in school history to notch two, three-sack games in the same year. He had three each against Tulsa and Miami last season.
- The senior ranks No. 2 at Oklahoma for sacks in a career with 26.5. He is moving up the top-10 list for tackles for loss. He has 47.5, which ranks No. 5.

Q TIPS

Quinton Carter has emerged as one of the top defensive backs in the nation. The safety has 26 tackles, two interceptions, two deflections and a fumble recovery.

- In 2009, he had 88 tackles, which ranked No. 2 on the team, to go with four interceptions (tied for the OU lead).

TAKEAWAY TRADE-OFF

Oklahoma has 14 takeaways this season ... by 10 different players.

- The seven fumble recoveries are by six different players while the seven interceptions are by five different Sooners.

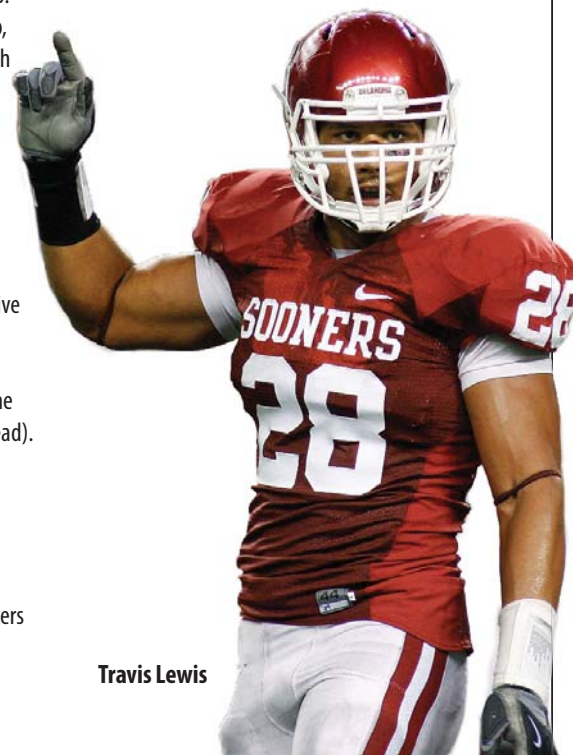
CORNER CONVERSATION

Oklahoma is replacing both starting corners from last season. Brian Jackson completed his eligibility while Dominique Franks (Atlanta Falcons) came out after his junior season. Both scored touchdowns last season, Jackson on a 52-yard fumble recovery vs. Texas A&M and Franks on an 85-yard interception return at Kansas. It was one of three defensive touchdowns Franks scored during his career.

- Jamell Fleming started the first four games at boundary corner. He had a team-high 10 tackles, an interception and two pass deflections vs. Utah State, then had four stops, including one for loss, and another pick vs. Florida State. His 11 stops against Air Force were a career high.
- Aaron Colvin got the start in place of an injured Fleming against Texas and finished with seven tackles including 1.5 for loss.
- Demontre Hurst has started the first five games at field corner. He had one tackle and one interception, which he returned 49 yards, in the opener. He has 3.5 tackles for loss, an unusually high total for a corner.
- Those two players tied for No. 3 on last year's team in special teams tackles with 9 each.
- That trio has combined for 51 games played at Oklahoma -- 31 by Fleming and 17 by Hurst.

JEFFERSON BEYOND HIS YEARS

DB Tony Jefferson is a true freshman, but he's not playing like one. He is Oklahoma's third-leading tackler with 34 (just three behind second place Jonathan Nelson) with five tackles for loss, four pass deflections and one hurry. He is one of two true freshmen to draw a start on defense this season. The other is CB Aaron Colvin.

ABOUT THE SOONER SPECIAL TEAMS

Oklahoma's special teams under Bob Stoops ...

- There have been 27 special teams touchdowns, including 21 in the last 80 regular season games. Those 21 came via five different kinds of plays -- 12 punt returns, two faked field goals, two blocked punts, four kickoff returns and a faked punt. Special teams also own one safety in that span.
- Oklahoma has returned eight kickoffs and 16 punts for touchdowns.
- The Sooners have blocked 24 kicks.

MANY HAPPY RETURNS

Information on returns during the Stoops era ...

- Kickoff Returns -- 98 returns of 25 or more yards, 8 TD.
- Punt Returns -- 62 returns of 15 or more yards, 16 TD.
- Interception Returns -- 84 returns of 10 or more yards with 21 touchdowns.
- Fumble Returns -- six returns of 15 or more yards with eight touchdowns.

OU PUNT RETURNS SUCCESSFUL

Oklahoma ranked No. 3 nationally last season in punt returns (16.26), a figure that also coincided with Ryan Broyles' individual ranking (15.87).

- The team average was the best at Oklahoma since 1974 when the average return went for 16.4 yards. What makes the average even more impressive is the fact that OU ranked No. 2 in the Big 12 last season in punt return attempts at 43, just one behind Nebraska's 44.
- For the second straight year, Broyles returned a punt for a TD, this time an 87-yarder against Oklahoma State.
- When Broyles was shelved by an injury, Dominique Franks returned 11 punts for an average of 17.0.
- This year, the Sooners are at 8.64 per punt return.

COVER TEAM A STONE WALL

Last season, Sooner foes ran back just 17 punts for a paltry 30 yards. That 1.76-yard average ranked No. 2 nationally.

- OU was No. 5 in net punting at 40.3 yards..
- The longest punt return OU surrendered last season was 19 yards. No other punt return exceeded six yards.

• The 2010 team is performing in similar fashion in 2010. Oklahoma opponents have returned 11 punts for 45 yards. That ranks No. 21 in the nation. The Sooners rank No. 18 nationally in net punting at 39.4 yards.

WAY GOOD AT PUNTER

P Tress Way had arguably the best season ever for an OU punter in 2009, and was just a redshirt freshman. He punted 61 times for an average of 45.7 yards with 22 of 50+ yards and 17 inside the 20.

- Way's '09 average ranked No. 1 in the Big 12 and No. 3 nationally. It also was the second-best average in OU history, the best by a punter with at least 35 attempts.
- He averaged a school-record 58.8 yards on six punts vs. Oklahoma St., including a 74-yarder.
- Way, a soph, has 26 kicks of 50+ yards in his career. Jeff Ferguson (1998-01) set that OU record with 52.
- In 2010, he ranks No. 21 nationally with an average of 44.3 on 30 punts. Way has six of 50 or more yards and with seven inside the 20.
- Way is also kicking off for OU. He has 30 with five touchbacks. Opponents average just 17.52 yards/ return. That figure ranks No. 8 nationally.

O'HARA, STEVENS SHARP

Patrick O'Hara handled placekicking in the first two games, making 3-4 field goals and 9-10 PATs. A muscle strain kept him out games three and four. Jimmy Stevens, who was the kicker most of last season, has stepped in to make 3-of-4 FGs all 11 PAT tries.

NEW FACES IN KEY PLACES

The Sooners have new players handling kickoff and holding chores. Tress Way is kicking off and John Nimmo is the holder. Nimmo, a senior QB, has been a regular golf partner with Sam Bradford.

WINCHESTER RIFLES TO STARDOM

James Winchester, long-snapper for OU punts, recovered the game-securing fumble late in the win over Texas. His dad, Mike, was OU's punter from 1984-85 and his sister, Carolyn, was on the Sooner women's basketball team from 2006-09.

FRANK ALEXANDER • DE • 84

Started the last three games of 2009 ... had nine total starts entering 2010, but was the preseason No. 1 at the position for the first time in his career ... sat out the Utah State game with an ankle injury ... did not start but finished the Florida State game with two sacks ... led all DEs with eight tackles against Air Force despite not starting ... picked up first start of 2010 vs. Cincinnati.

JEREMY BEAL • DE • 44

Candidate for several post-season honors ... spread his 11 sacks over seven games last season ... sits in second place at OU career sacks with 26.5 for his career ... also fifth in OU history with 47.5 TFLs ... has multiple sacks in nine career games including two in last game vs. Texas ... first Sooner in OU history to accumulate over 200 yards lost on sacks.

AUSTIN BOX • LB • 12

Incurred a back injury in the pre-season and has yet to play this season.

CORY BRANDON • OT • 70

Saw action in 13 games last season with seven starts.

RYAN BROYLES • SL • 85

Big-play potential and both receiver and punt returner ... will have a shot at breaking all of OU's receiving records ... has one reception in 31 consecutive games, the sixth-longest streak among active players ... has gone over the 100-yard receiving mark in seven of the last eight games ... has scored a touchdown in seven of the last nine games ... became the fifth Sooner to eclipse 2,000 yards receiving in a career with 12 catches for 124 yards against Florida State ... has 12 career 100-yard receiving efforts, second best in OU history ... is third at OU with 2,325 career receiving yards ... also sits in third place at OU with 181 career receptions ... has hit double digits in receptions in a game six times, including the three of the last four games (12 - Florida State, 10 - Air Force, 10 - Cincinnati) ... had six catches in the second quarter vs. Air Force, tying a personal best for a single period.

BRANDON CALEB • WR • 8

OU's most physical receiver after the catch.

JERMIE CALHOUN • RB • 23

Put together solid spring and fall camps ... ranked No. 3 for OU last season in rushing attempts with 45.

QUINTON CARTER • FS • 20

Thorpe Award candidate and one of the team's most active community servants ... picked off fifth career pass against Utah State ... leading tackler against Florida State with seven stops ... intercepted a pass on the final play of the first half against Texas.

BRENNAN CLAY • RB • 21

True freshman listed as one of starting kick returners ... had one return for 22 yards vs. Utah State ... was carted off the field for precautionary reasons after suffering injury against Florida State and did not suit up for Air Force or Cincinnati games.

AARON COLVIN • CB • 14

True freshman cornerback is listed as No. 2 field cornerback ... played extensively against Cincinnati, finishing with seven tackles ... made first career start against Texas and finished with seven tackles.

TYLER EVANS • OG • 75

Starter in two games at right guard, he's up 36 pounds since arriving as a freshman ... has started three of five games this season at right guard.

JAMELL FLEMING • CB • 32

Athletic player who is in his first season at a starting role ... first career interception and first career double-digit tackle game (10) against Utah State ... had back-to-back games with interceptions after picking off a pass against Florida State ... career high 11 tackles against Air Force ... did not suit up against Texas after incurring an injury vs. Cincinnati.

TREY FRANKS • WR • 2

True freshman, expected to provide depth at kick returner and receiver ... had one return for 17 yards vs. Utah State ... had four touches (two rush, two receptions) against Cincinnati for 36 total yards.

STEPHEN GOOD • OG • 77

Already has 25 games played at Oklahoma, including nine starts.

BEN HABERN • C • 61

Missed the final two games of last season with a dislocated ankle, but was one of the Big 12's standout freshmen.

JAMES HANNA • TE • 82

Caught first career touchdown with a career-long 46-yard reception vs. Florida State ... recorded second career TD with a two-yard strike against Texas.

JAVON HARRIS • DB • 30

Backup at safety saw time against Air Force, finishing with three tackles and a fumble recovery.

DEMONTRE HURST • CB • 19

First-year starter at corner ... played extensively on special teams last season ... picked off first career pass against Utah State ... career-high four tackles for loss vs. Texas.

JOSEPH IBILOYE • LB • 5

Originally a safety, he has moved to outside linebacker.

GABE IKARD • OL • 64

Earned first career start against Air Force when he took over at left guard, a spot he's held for the last three games.

TONY JEFFERSON • DB • 1

True freshman who earned first career start against Utah State as a fifth defensive back ... finished game with four tackles ... led squad with three passes broken up against Florida State ... earned second start against Air Force and finished with eight tackles ... continued to hold onto a starting role against Cincinnati, leading the team with a career-high 12 tackles ... has 29 tackles in the last three games after finishing with nine vs. Texas.
