BIG 12 FOOTBALL QUICK HITS

- Every Big 12 team will compete in conference action for the first time this season during Week 7. All six games will be televised, beginning with Thursday night's Kansas State at Kansas game. The remaining five will be played on Saturday.
- This week marks the third consecutive for a Thursday night Big 12 matchup. The previous two have fared very well in the ratings, drawing better than a 2.0 rating.
- The Big 12 has four of the nation's 13 remaining undefeated teams - Missouri, Nebraska, Oklahoma and Oklahoma State, all at 5-0. No other league has more than two unbeaten squads.
- The Big 12 is 36-8 (.818) in non-conference games with four more left to play in the regular season. Two will be played on Nov. 20 with the final two scheduled for Nov. 27. The Big 12 currently has the second-highest winning percentage among FBS leagues in non-conference outings. Every team will complete the non-conference slate with a .500 or better record for the fourth time in Conference history. It also occurred in 2002, 2004 and 2008.
- Four teams were ranked in the season's first Harris Poll with three others receiving votes - 5. Nebraska, 6. Oklahoma, 18. Oklahoma State and 19. Missouri. Texas, Kansas State and Baylor received votes.
- The same four squads continue to be rated in the coaches and AP polls - 4/5. Nebraska; 6/6. Oklahoma, 18/20. Oklahoma State and 19/21. Missouri. Texas earned points in both polls while Kansas State received votes in the media edition.
- Big 12 Players of the Week were awarded to Offense: Taylor Martinez (Nebraska); Defense: Lavonte David (Nebraska); and Special Team: Dan Bailey (Oklahoma State).
- There were 13 rushing touchdowns and 19 passing touchdowns last week - and the average distance of the runs was longer than the throws. The 13 rushing TDs averaged 23.9 yards while the distance of the 19 passing touchdowns averaged 23 yards.
- The Big 12 has 13 field goals made from 46 yards or longer this season. Six of those were from last week, including two by Dan Bailey (Oklahoma State) from a Big 12 season-long 52 yards.

15th Annual Dr Pepper Big 12 Football Championship

The Dr Pepper Big 12 Football Championship returns to Cowboys Stadium in Arlington, Texas for the second consecutive year. The 2010 game takes place on Saturday, December 4, at 7:00 p.m. CT and will be nationally televised by ABC. In 2010, the North representative will be the home team.

Dr Pepper Big 12 Championship Winners

In the 14-year history of the event, there have been six different winners. All-time titlists include Texas (1996, 2005, 2009), Nebraska (1997, 1999), Texas A&M (1998), Oklahoma (2000, 2002, 2004, 2006, 2007, 2008), Colorado (2001) and Kansas State (2003).

BCS Sightings

The 2009 season marked the Conference's 17th BCS game in the 12-year history of the structure. The Big 12 is 7-10 all-time in BCS games and has advanced two teams in the same season five times (2001, '03, '04, '07, '08).

Television Partners

ABC begins its 15th season as the Conference's national network television partner. The Big 12 also continues its long-standing relationship with FSN for its cable rights. FSN has sublicensed select television games in 2010 to ESPN.

Television Selections

Television selections will be announced on either a 12-day or six-day advance by the Conference office. The 12-day advances will be released on Mondays while the six-day will be available on Sunday's prior to that week's games.

Home Win Streaks

Oklahoma's nation-leading home win streak is at 33 games. The Sooners' next home game is Oct. 16 vs. Iowa State.

BAYLOR (4-2, 1-1)

This Week: at Colorado
Next Week: Kansas State

QB Robert Griffin III established career highs for completions (31), attempts (42) and passing yards (384) last weekend. He has thrown for 300 or more yards in two consecutive starts for the first time in his career and ranks fourth nationally in passing yards.

In their last trip to Boulder in 2007, the Bears won a three-overtime thriller, 34-31. The winning team has scored 34+ points in each of the last five meetings.

Baylor is averaging 21.0 first-half points as compared to 12.5 second-half points through six games. Conversely, Baylor opponents are averaging 13.8 points in the first half and 6.0 in the second half.

Baylor ranks seventh nationally in passing offense (312.67) and 12th in total offense (476.67).



COLORADO (3-2, 0-1)

This Week: Baylor
Next Week: Texas Tech

Wide receiver Scotty McKnight had five receptions for 72 yards against Missouri last week. He has caught at least one pass in 42 consecutive games, an active NCAA best streak.

Josh Hartigan extended the Buffs' sack streak to 25 games while also making his first career interception last week against Missouri.

Colorado has outscored its opponents 46-10 in the third quarter.

CU leads the all-time series over the Bears, 9-6, including a 4-2 Big 12 mark.

The Buffaloes rank first in the conference in third-down conversion efficiency and 22nd nationally at 48.1 percent.



IOWA STATE (3-3, 1-1)

This Week: at Oklahoma
Next Week: at Texas

For the second straight week, Iowa State plays a top 10 team coming off a bye week. Including the Sooners, ISU's past three opponents have had bye weeks before their matchup with the Cyclones.

Freshman punter Kirby Van Der Kamp had five punts over 50 yards last week and is averaging 43.5 yards on the season.

Tight end Collin Franklin had a 36-yard touchdown reception, his longest of the season, against Utah to score in consecutive games for the first time in his career. Franklin has a team-high 25 receptions for 279 yards.

Oklahoma leads the series, 67-5-2 overall and 34-3-2 in Norman. ISU's last win in the series was a 33-31 victory in Norman in 1990.



KANSAS (2-3, 0-1)

This Week: Kansas State (Thursday)
Next Week: Texas A&M

Kansas has won four of the past six meetings against Kansas State and, with a week off, looks to win its sixth straight contest after an idle week. KU leads the series 65-37-5 over KSU, including a 37-15-2 advantage in games played in Lawrence.

KU snapped a three-game winning streak in conference openers with its loss to BU on Oct. 2. The Jayhawks have dropped eight consecutive Big 12 games.

D.J. Beshears enters the week ranked fourth in the NCAA in kickoff return average at 33.36 per return.

QB Jordan Webb (796) needs two passing yards to pass Frank Seurer (797) for the third-best passing season by a KU freshman in school history. The school record is 1,215 set in 2001.



KANSAS STATE (4-1, 1-1)

This Week: at Kansas (Thursday)
Next Week: at Baylor

Kansas State meets Kansas in the 108th edition of the Sunflower Showdown, the rivalry is the 13th most-played in the country. The Wildcats' last win in Lawrence was in 2002, a 64-0 victory.

The Wildcats rank 11th in the nation in kickoff returns, averaging 28.24 yards, while William Powell checks in at eighth nationally with a 31.50 average. Against NU, Powell recorded 186 of his 196 all-purpose yards from kickoff returns.

Senior RB Daniel Thomas had a career-high eight receptions for 36 yards against NU last week. Thomas ranks seventh nationally in rushing, averaging 138.20 yards. He is 44 yards away from 2,000 for his career and five from moving into eighth in school history.

Since 1990, the Cats have protected a halftime lead 97-percent of the time, going 140-5 when leading at halftime.



MISSOURI (5-0, 1-0)

This Week: at Texas A&M
Next Week: Oklahoma

Missouri is one of 13 teams standing undefeated to this point. The program looks to claim just its fourth 6-0 start in the last 50 years, and only the fifth 6-0 start in school history, the last of which occurred in 2006.

The Tigers' defense leads the Big 12 Conference, and ranks third in the NCAA in scoring defense, allowing only 11.20 points per game.

MU has outscored opponents 50-3 in the third quarter and is one of only two schools (Iowa) in the nation to this point to not allow a touchdown in the third quarter.

Two Missouri receivers rank in the top 10 nationally in receptions per game with T.J. Moe at No. 3 averaging 8.80 catches and Michael Agnew checking in at No. 8 with 7.80 per game.



NEBRASKA (5-0, 1-0)

This Week: Texas
Next Week: at Oklahoma State

QB Taylor Martinez and LB Lavonte David earned Big 12 Offensive and Defensive Player of the week honors after their performances at K-State. David had 16 tackles, while Martinez put up a freshman-record 369 yards of total offense.

NU and UT have met nine times in the Big 12 with an average score of 23-19 in favor of the Longhorns. Six of those nine games have been decided by four points or less, with Texas winning each one.

After a 48-13 victory over KSU, Nebraska moved up to No. 4 in the USA Today Coaches Poll and fifth in the Associated Press poll - NU's highest ranking since the end of the 2001 season.

The Huskers have won 30 of their past 32 conference home openers - including 12 of 14 in the Big 12 era - but Nebraska has lost its first conference home game in each of the past two seasons.



OKLAHOMA (5-0, 1-0)

This Week: Iowa State
Next Week: at Missouri

OU leads the series with Iowa State 67-5-2. The two teams last matched up in 2007, with OU defeating the Cyclones 17-7.

OU's offense is averaging 415.6 yards per game, while QB Landry Jones is throwing for 291.4 yards an outing, with 11 touchdowns against three interceptions.

LB Travis Lewis is leading the Sooner tacklers (45) for a third straight season.

WR Ryan Broyles has caught 46 passes for 518 yards and four touchdowns, while RB DeMarco Murray has run for 551 yards at 4.2 yards per carry and caught 20 passes at 7.1 a catch with 10 total touchdowns.



OKLAHOMA STATE (5-0, 1-0)

This Week: at Texas Tech
Next Week: Nebraska

The Cowboys are 2-12-3 all-time in Lubbock with the last win coming in 1944. OSU played at Tech just five times between 1944 and the beginning of Big 12 play in 1996. Coach Mike Gundy is 3-2 all-time against Tech and Oklahoma State is 5-4 against TTU entering the game ranked by the Associated Press.

Kicker Dan Bailey earned Big 12 Special Teams Player of the week. This season, he has made all 11 of his field goal attempts and 19 of his last 20 dating back to 2009. He is also perfect for his career on all 163 of his extra point attempts (an OSU record).

A win at Texas Tech would improve OSU to 21-21 in Big 12 play under Mike Gundy.

QB Brandon Weeden tops the Big 12 in passing efficiency (165.07) and is 11th in the nation. He is also No. 10 in total offense (309.40) and is tied for the nation's lead with 18 TD passes.



TEXAS (3-2, 1-1)

This Week: at Nebraska
Next Week: Iowa State

Texas owns a 9-4 all-time edge in the series between the two schools, including an 8-1 advantage since the formation of the Big 12 in 1996. Texas has won all three meetings in Lincoln since 1998, with the three victories by a total of nine points.

The Longhorns will try to avoid their first three-game losing streak since the end of the 1999 season.

The UT offense out-gained Oklahoma 373-360 in its last game with a strong showing in the second half.

Last season, UT recorded 11 non-offensive touchdowns. This season, Texas has just one - a fumble recovery by Keenan Robinson in the season-opener.



TEXAS A&M (3-2, 0-1)

This Week: Missouri
Next Week: at Kansas

Texas A&M leads the series against MU 7-2. The two teams last competed on Nov. 10, 2007, when Missouri defeated Texas A&M, 40-26.

TAMU will play its third nationally-ranked opponent in as many weeks. The Aggies have lost its last two matchups this season by a touchdown or less.

Junior wide receiver Jeff Fuller had his sixth touchdown reception and 22nd of his career, adding to his school record in that category. Fuller has at least one reception in 25 consecutive games. The school record is 29 by Martellus Bennett.

The Texas A&M defense held the Arkansas offense to just three points and 125 yards in the second half. Arkansas was held to 50 yards below its season average in the passing game.



TEXAS TECH (3-2, 1-2)

This Week: Oklahoma State
Next Week: at Colorado

Texas Tech leads the series with OSU 21-13-3. The home team has won eight straight games and Tech is 39-7 at home (.848) since 2003.

The Red Raiders had season highs for total offense (635), first downs (35), and passing yards (462) against Baylor. The 95 offensive plays were the most since running 111 against Iowa State in 2003.

Quarterback Taylor Potts' 43-yard run was the longest of his career and the longest by a Texas Tech player this season. Potts' 462 yards passing set a career high and also is the most passing yards in the history of Cotton Bowl Stadium.

The Tech and OSU passing offenses are both ranked in the top-five nationally, as the Red Raiders rank fourth with 333.20 yards per game and OSU ranks second with 362.000 yards per game.
