### Cyclone Notebook

- Iowa State is coming off the biggest win in school history, a 37-31 victory over No. 2 Oklahoma State. The Cyclones have won three straight Big 12 games under quarterback Jared Barnett heading into a road game vs. No. 12/11 Oklahoma.
- ISU's victory was its first ever against a foe rated sixth or higher in the AP Poll (1-56-2).
- Iowa State set an all-time attendance record this season of 53,647 fans per game. All six Iowa State home games drew more than 50,000 fans, a school record.
- Redshirt freshman QB Jared Barnett has thrown for 695 yards and four TDs and run for 301 yards and another score in wins over No. 17 Texas Tech, Kansas and No. 2 OSU.
- Iowa State running backs James White (138) and Duran "Duck" Hollis (101) gave the Cyclones two 100-yard rushers at Texas Tech. ISU had its best running day (368) since 1999. The 368 yards were the most in a conference game since 1996 (407 vs. Missouri).
- Linebacker Jake Knott ranks second in the Big 12 at 9.3 tackles per game. Fellow linebacker A.J. Klein, who earned Big 12 Defensive Player of the Week honors this week, has averaged 8.6 tackles per game, ranking third in the league.
- Running back James White notched his second 100-yard game at Texas Tech. He has scored eight rushing touchdowns this season and is averaging 4.8 yards per carry.
- Iowa State head coach Paul Rhoads is in his third season as head coach of the Cyclones. He is 18-17 as head coach.

### Series Notes

- Iowa State and Oklahoma are meeting for the 76th time overall. The Sooners lead the series 68-5-2. OU leads the series 35-3-1.
- Oklahoma beat Iowa State, 52-0 last season in Norman. Iowa State's last win in the series was a 33-31 victory over the Sooners in Norman in 1990. OU has won 12 straight in the series.
- Iowa State head coach Paul Rhoads is 0-1 all-time against Oklahoma. OU head coach Bob Stoops is 6-0 against the Cyclones.

In his first meeting with his team in January of 2009, new Iowa State head coach Paul Rhoads told his Cyclones they were going to win a bowl game. His players were somewhat taken aback. Iowa State had lost its last 10 games in 2008 and hadn't had a winning season or gone to a bowl game in four years.

Iowa State's players followed their leader in 2009 en route to a 7-6 record that included a 14-13 win over Minnesota in the Insight Bowl. The final results could not have been better. The Cyclones tied Washington as the most improved BCS teams nationally with five more wins than the previous season.

The seminal moment of the season was a 9-7 win at Nebraska, accomplished by an Iowa State team that played without its starting quarterback or running back. It was the Cyclones' first win in Lincoln in 32 years. Rhoads was the first Iowa State coach to post a winning season in his inaugural season since 1931.

In 2010, he coached Iowa State to its first win against Texas, beating the 22nd-ranked Longhorns in Austin. The victory was the Cyclones' first road win against a ranked opponent in 20 years.

Rhoads' third "signature win" was a 44-41 3 overtime victory over Iowa on Sept. 10 in Ames. On Oct. 29 Rhoads' Cyclones scored their biggest ever win over a ranked team, beating No. 19 Texas Tech in Lubbock, Texas 41-7. What followed was the biggest win in school history, 37-31 in double overtime against No. 2 Oklahoma State last weekend in Ames.

Rhoads came to Iowa State after serving as Auburn's defensive coordinator during the 2008 season and Pitt previously. Rhoads is a 1989 graduate of Missouri Western University with a degree in economics. He earned his master's from Utah State in 1991.

**Iowa State Win Over Tech Breaks Multiple Records**

► The historical perspective of Iowa State's demonstrates just how significant the Cyclones' 41-7 win at No. 19 Texas Tech stands.

- \*Most points (41) against a ranked opponent since 1996.
- \*Largest margin of victory (36) over a ranked opponent (22 vs. Nebraska, 2002)
- \*Largest margin of victory over ranked opponent on road (28-21 at Texas, 2010)
- \*Largest margin of victory (36) since Sept. 7, 2002 (58-6 vs. Tennessee Tech)

**Barnett is 3-0 as QB Starter with Two Wins over Ranked Opponents**

► Barnett, who spent the spring behind Iowa State veteran Jerome Tiller and junior college transfer Steele Jantz, made his first career start against Texas Tech. The Garland, Texas native completed 16-of-26 passes for 180 yards and ran for 66 yards against the Texas A&M after replacing Jantz. His performance was enough to earn him the starting job at signal-caller at Texas Tech.

Barnett produced a 14-of-26 passing performance at Texas Tech, accounting for 144 passing yards and a touchdown to lead ISU to victory over Tech. He also rushed for 92 yards on 19 carries and a score. Against Kansas, Barnett rushed for 125 yards on 22 carries while hitting on 16-of-30 passes for 175 yards.

Last weekend, he completed 31-of-58 passes for 376 yards and three touchdowns against No. 2 Oklahoma State. He had career highs in completions (31), attempts (58), passing yards (376), passing TDs, total plays (72) and total offense (460). This passing yards total ranks fifth in school history. His 460 yards of total offense ranks third all-time.

**Rhoads Solid Start**

► In 2009, Rhoads was the first coach to win seven games in his first ISU season since Clyde Williams in 1907. He was the first Cyclone coach to post a winning record in his first season (7-6) since George Veenker in 1931. He currently is 18-17.

**A.J. Klein Has Been Taking It To The House**

► Junior linebacker A.J. Klein returned interceptions for touchdowns in games against UNI and Kansas State in 2010, making him the first Iowa Stater to accomplish the feat in a single-season since Dawan Anderson in 1996. Klein's 78-yard interception runback against Missouri made his the all-time ISU leader with three TDs off of interceptions. It tied the record

## The Magic Number is 24

► Iowa State is 15-1 under head coach Paul Rhoads when holding teams under 24 points and 3-16 when allowing more than 24 points. The 52-38 win over Texas Tech in 2010 broke the mold. It was the most points ever scored by Iowa State against a Big 12 opponent and the most points allowed in a conference victory since the Missouri Valley Conference began in 1907. The Cyclones 44-41 victory over Iowa Sept. 10 went three overtimes, while the 37-31 win over Oklahoma State was in double OT.

## Osemele Garnering Attention

► At 6-6, 347 pounds there is no doubt offensive lineman Kelechi Osemele has the body to be an NFL lineman. A number of outlets agree and have projected the Houston native as a first round NFL draft pick. Entering the season, CNN.com has Osemele going at No. 19, NFL.com has him at No. 19 and FoxSports.com projects him as the No. 26 pick in the 2012 NFL Draft.

## They Are Regulars

► For the last three years, Iowa State fans have been certain of one thing on gamedays and that is seeing WR Darius Darks, CB Leonard Johnson, K Grant Mahoney and OL Kelechi Osemele on the field. Johnson and Mahoney have played in all 47 games, with Osemele just missing the Kent State game as a redshirt freshman and Darks the season the 2011 opener against UNI. Osemele has the most starts on the team with 41 in his career.

► Senior wide receiver Darius Darks has 124 career receptions, ranking ninth all-time at Iowa State. Darks' top season came as a freshman when he finished with 49 catches.

## Placekickers Share Duties

► Kicker Grant Mahoney served as Iowa State's player kicker the last three seasons but now shares duties with fellow senior Zach Guyer. Mahoney ranks among the top 10 in nearly every ISU category, including his boots from 57 yards out last season against Nebraska and 54 against Iowa this season. To view the record book turn to page 17 in this packet. During this season, Guyer moved in as the primary field-goal man and has made 8-of-11 this season.

## Numbers Tell Story About Big ISU Win over No. 2 Oklahoma State

► Iowa State has allowed a combined 48 points over the last three games at No. 17 Texas Tech, vs. Kansas and against No. 2 Oklahoma State. Note the numbers from Saturday night vs. what the Cowboy offense had achieved while winning their first 10 games.

► Iowa State held Oklahoma State to just 17 offensive points in regulation (ISU suffered a pick six.). The Cowboys came into the game second nationally in scoring offense at 51.7 points per game.

► Iowa State's defense held Oklahoma State without a rushing touchdown for the first time this season.

► Oklahoma State led the nation in turnover margin coming into the game. ISU forced five OSU turnovers.

► Iowa State boasted 33 first downs to Oklahoma State's 24. Iowa State compiled a total offense advantage of 568-536. Iowa State ran an incredible 101 plays to OSU's 76. The numbers in regulation was 97-71. ISU's regulation time of possession was 35:13 to 24:47.

► Oklahoma State came into the game averaging 171 yards per contest on the ground. The Cyclones held OSU to 60 yards rushing on 18 carries. The average Cowboy yard per rush coming into the game was 5.2 yards per carry. OSU garnered 3.3 yards per rush vs. Iowa State.

## Branderhorst's Circuitous Route to Scholarship

► Iowa State tight end Reid Branderhorst is the 11th Cyclone walk on rewarded a scholarship by head coach Paul Rhoads. The others: WR Joel Zitek, S Mike O'Connell, WR Jake Williams, DT Taylor Mansfield, RB Jeff Woody, LB Preston Kaufman, OL Sean Smith, LB Matt Morton, P Daniel Kuehl, TE Drew Mitchell and Branderhorst.

## Darius Reynolds, the Go-To Guy

► Iowa State wide receiver Darius Reynolds had one of the biggest games by a Cyclone wideout in recent memory. Reynolds caught seven passes for 178 yards with a pair of touchdowns at Baylor. The seven receptions equaled his career high. His yardage total ranks seventh in Iowa State single-game history. It was the most receiving yards by a Cyclone since Todd Blythe had 214 receiving yards at Texas A&M on Oct. 29, 2005. It was his third game this season with two TD receptions and his second 2011 contest with at least 100 yards receiving this season.

## Jake Knott Playing Like the Big 12 First-Team Linebacker He Is...

► Jake Knott was getting national attention for his accomplishments even before the start of his junior season. Knott, was named one of the three top linebackers in the Big 12 on the one-team preseason all-Big 12 Conference. He made a career-high 18 tackles at Baylor. Against Oklahoma State Knott made 13 tackles, his fifth double-digit effort of the season. He tipped a pass in the second overtime that resulted in an interception and led to Iowa State's winning touchdown.

► This season, Knott is averaging 9.3 tackles per game, which is second in the Big 12. He is on the watch lists of the Butkus, Rotary Lombardi, Nagurski, and the Bednarik Awards.

## ...But so is A. J. Klein - Third in Big 12 in Tackles

► Junior linebacker A.J. Klein is currently third in tackles in the Big 12, averaging 8.6 including 14 vs. Texas A&M. He had 14 against Oklahoma State Klein was an honorable mention All-Big 12 selection last season after averaging 9.25 tackles per game. He ranked fifth in the Big 12 in tackles.

## **Hitting the Sack**

▶ Defensive tackle Jake McDonough, defensive end Jake Lattimer and defensive end Patrick Neal each recorded a sack against Texas A&M. The Aggies had only allowed six sacks all season.

## **Leonard Johnson Showed the Nation vs. Blackmon on ESPN vs. OSU**

▶ Johnson had a tremendous effort against No. 2 Oklahoma State, Johnson shadowed Justin Blackmon when it counted. Johnson made an interception in the second overtime that preceded Iowa State's winning possession. Johnson made five tackles and recovered a fumble. Joe Tessitore (pbp) and Rod Gilmore (color) talked throughout the broadcast his ability to contain Blackmon.

## **Making Big Plays**

▶ Iowa State has posted nine plays of at least 40 offensive plays from scrimmage this season. In 2010, the Cyclones had just four plays total that were 40+ yards, which were all runs. This season, six of those plays have been through the air. At Texas Tech, redshirt freshman running back Duran "Duck" Hollis rattled off a 71-yard TD dash early in the third quarter of Iowa State's 41-7 win.

## **White Makes His Mark**

▶ Running back James White entered this season with just five career rushing attempts. Last weekend he scored a pair of huge touchdowns, one a 32-yard dash around left end for a third quarter score. The second on a catch and scored on a wheel route. The biggest game of his career came at Baylor as he rushed for an all-time high 148 yards on 15 carries, including a 76-yard TD dash. The redshirt sophomore has reached the end zone eight times in 141 carries this season, including a 26-yard scamper against UCONN. His first two touchdowns came against Iowa in overtime, a one-yard dash in the first and the game-winner from four yards out in the third OT. White secured his second 100-yard game after rushing for 138 yards on 31 carries at Texas Tech.

## **Iowa State Defense Spectacular vs. Red Raiders**

- ▶ Iowa State ended Texas Tech's string of 69 straight game with a touchdown pass.
- ▶ Texas Tech had averaged 87.8 plays per game this season. ISU's offense and defense held the Red Raiders to 64 plays.
- ▶ Texas Tech came into the game ranked 15th nationally with a third-down conversion rate of 49.6 percent. Iowa State held the Red Raiders to 3 for 13 on third down, forcing nine punts.
- ▶ Texas Tech came into to the game ranking fifth nationally in total offense at 539 per game. Iowa State held the Raiders to 290 yards.
- ▶ Iowa State's 41-7 win was Texas Tech's worst home loss since a 56-3 defeat to Nebraska in Lubbock in 2000.
- ▶ Of Texas Tech's 15 possessions, 12 ended in punts or turnovers.
- ▶ Texas Tech had averaged 29:45 of possession heading into the Iowa State game. The Cyclones controlled the clock 40:09 to 20:00.
- ▶ Texas Tech had averaged 43.4 points per game before Iowa State held the Red Raiders to seven points.
- ▶ Texas Tech had been in the red zone 39 times heading into the ISU game, scoring 36 times. The Raiders reached the red zone just twice against Iowa State.
- ▶ Texas Tech was averaging 29 first downs per game before Iowa State held the Red Raiders to 15 first downs.

## **ALL-TIME ATTENDANCE MARK**

Iowa State set an all-time home attendance mark of 53,647 fans per game. All six home games had crowds in excess of 50,000 fans, a school first.

## **3RD AND 4TH DOWN SUCCESS**

Iowa State has had better success converting third and fourth down plays into first downs and touchdowns this season. The Cyclones are converting third down plays at a 41 percent clip (73-177). In the fourth quarter, those numbers jump to 62 percent (13-21).

In 2010, Iowa State was 37.6 percent on third downs and 39.1 percent on fourth downs.

## **STATE CHAMPS**

For just the second time in 19 tries Iowa State defeated both Northern Iowa and Iowa in the same season. The only other time the Cyclones achieved the feat was in 2001 under former head coach Dan McCarney.

## **JANTZ IN ELITE COMPANY**

Steele Jantz's seven touchdowns (five passing, two rushing) were the most by a Cyclone starting quarterback in his first two starts since George Amundson tallied eight (five passing, three rushing) in 1972.

Amundson went on to become a first-round draft pick of the Houston Oilers in the spring of 1973.

## **THREE IS THE KEY**

Iowa State is now 3-7 all-time in overtime games following the win over Oklahoma State. The Cyclones also beat Iowa in three overtimes earlier this season.

# 2011 GAME RECAPS

## Northern Iowa 19 Iowa State 20

### Sept. 3 • Jack Trice Stadium • Ames, Iowa

AMES, Iowa - After struggling on offense for much of the second half, the Cyclone offense rose up when it counted. Iowa State tallied two touchdowns in the final 4:30 minutes of the game to come away with a thrilling come-from-behind 20-19 opening-game victory over UNI Saturday night in Jack Trice Stadium. Iowa State was down 13-7 and had only registered one first down in the second half when it took over possession with 5:37 left in the game following a UNI punt. Facing a 4th-and-10 at the 26-yard line, quarterback Steele Jantz made the play of the game. After getting flushed out of the pocket and running out of room on the sideline, Jantz fired a scrambling toss to a sliding Josh Lenz in the corner of the end zone to make it 14-13 Iowa State. The lead was short-lived. On the first play of UNI's next possession, quarterback Tirrell Rennie found running back David Johnson out of the backfield for an 80-yard touchdown pass to suck the life out of the frenzied Jack Trice crowd. UNI's two-point conversion was not good to make it 19-14 Panthers with 4:17 left in the game. Iowa State bounced right back and drove right down the field. A 17-yard run by Jantz on a 3rd-and-11 kept the drive alive. Jantz later found Aaron Horne on a 32-yard pass to the UNI 2-yard line with 1:36 left in the game. Three plays later, Jantz dove over on a sneak to make it 20-19 Iowa State, as the two-point conversion was unsuccessful. The game ended when Willie Scott broke up a UNI hook-and-ladder play, as the Cyclones persevered for a hard-fought 20-19 win in front of 54,672 people, the fourth-largest crowd in Jack Trice Stadium history. Jantz ended the game with 80 yards rushing and 187 yards through the air to lead the Cyclone attack. Horne grabbed seven passes for 69 yards receiving. Iowa State registered four turnovers in the game to UNI's one, but the Panthers did not score a point on the Cyclones' miscues. The Cyclones were fortunate to head into the break with a 7-6 lead. Iowa State had plenty of chances to score, but committed three turnovers in UNI's territory.

## Iowa 41 Iowa State 44

### Sept. 10 • Jack Trice Stadium • Ames, Iowa

AMES, Iowa - James White ran an option play from four yards out for a touchdown in the third overtime period to give Iowa State an unbelievable 44-41 win over Iowa Saturday afternoon in the Iowa Corn Cy-Hawk Series showdown in Jack Trice Stadium. The win improves Iowa State to 2-0 this season and ends a three-game losing streak to the Hawkeyes. Iowa State came from behind on three different occasions in the fourth quarter and overtime periods, as the crowd of 56,085, the second-largest contingent in Jack Trice Stadium history, rejoiced at mid-field while regaining the Cy-Hawk Trophy. Both teams traded touchdowns in the first two overtimes. Iowa State tallied a TD on a Darius Reynolds four-yard touchdown catch on 4th-and-goal in the first extra period. White scored on a touchdown run in the second overtime session. The Cyclone defense broke the touchdown string in the third overtime, forcing Iowa to kick a 34-yarder from Mike Meyer. The White touchdown run on third down was the decisive score. The Cyclones forced the overtime thanks to the exploits of Steele Jantz. Down 24-17 with 5:40 left in the game, Jantz engineered a 13-play, 59-yard drive. Jantz converted on a 19-yard pass on 3rd-and-15 and a 40-yard pass to Reynolds on a 3rd-and-20 to keep the drive alive. Jantz then hit Darius Darks on a scramble from four yards out to tie the game at 24-24 for the first overtime game in the Cy-Hawk series. Jantz was on his game. The junior college transfer bailed the Cyclones out multiple times with his feet and arm. He finished the game with 279 yards on 25-of-37 yards passing and four touchdowns. He also ran for 42 yards.

# 2011 GAME RECAPS

## Iowa State 24 Connecticut 20

### Sept. 16 • Rentschler Field • East Hartford, Conn.

EAST HARTFORD, Conn. - For the third time in as many games, the Iowa State football team rallied from a fourth-quarter deficit to come away with a 24-20 win over Connecticut Friday night at Rentschler Field. With the win, the Cyclones are 3-0 for the first time since 2005 and will have a bye week before an Oct. 1 showdown with Texas in Jack Trice Stadium. The Iowa State defense held strong, stopping two UConn drives to preserve the victory. ISU held UConn to 343 yards of total offense. Darius Reynolds was the star of the game, posting a career-high 128 receiving yards on just four catches. He had two touchdowns for the second consecutive game. UConn took the opening drive for a touchdown to go up 7-0, as Scott McCummings scored from 10 yards out to put the Huskies on the board first. Meanwhile, the Cyclone offense struggled mightily in the early going. Iowa State had three turnovers and a punt on its first four possessions, as quarterback Steele Jantz opened the game 0-for-4 with three picks. After UConn increased the lead to 10-0, Jantz rallied the troops, connecting with Reynolds for

48 yards on a 3rd-and-19 to keep a drive alive. Two plays later, James White went around the left end for a 26-yard touchdown to cut the lead 10-7. Both offenses struggled the final 11 minutes of the second quarter. The Iowa State defense stiffened in the second quarter, allowing just one first down and 13 yards. Neither team was able to score the rest of the half, as the Huskies took a 10-7 lead into the intermission. After a UConn fumble in its first possession of the second half, the Cyclones took advantage. Iowa State went to its bag of tricks and perfected a reverse pass, as Josh Lenz tossed a 40-yard touchdown pass to a wide open Reynolds to put Iowa State up 14-10 with 11:18 left in the third quarter. The Huskies inched closer on their ensuing drive with a 50-yard field goal by David Teggart to make it 14-13 Iowa State at the 9:37 mark of the third quarter.

## Texas 37 Iowa State 14

### Oct. 1 • Jack Trice Stadium • Ames, Iowa

AMES, Iowa - Turnovers and penalties proved too costly for Iowa State, as the Cyclones fell to No. 17 Texas, 37-14 Saturday night in Jack Trice Stadium. UT improved to 4-0, while the Cyclones lost for the first time this season, falling to 3-1 in front of a crowd of 56,390, the second-largest attendance figure in Jack Trice Stadium history. The Cyclones never recovered after committing three first-quarter turnovers, as the Longhorns took advantage of outstanding field position while padding their lead. Penalties also hurt the Cyclones. ISU was flagged eight times for 90 yards. The Cyclones had two touchdowns called back because of penalties. Iowa State would like to forget the first half. After stopping Texas on downs deep into ISU territory, the Cyclones gave the Longhorns prime field position with a bobbled handoff between Steele Jantz and James White. UT recovered it at the ISU 29-yard line. The Cyclone defense held strong, holding the Longhorns to a field goal as UT took a 3-0 lead. On the ensuing kickoff, Josh Lenz fumbled the ball

and the Longhorns recovered it at the ISU 29-yard line. Four plays later, Fozzy Whittaker ran it in from 16 yards out to make it 10-0 UT early in the first quarter. An interception by Blake Gideon off an errant Jantz pass, ISU's third turnover of the first quarter, led to another Justin Tucker field goal to give UT a 13-0 lead.

Iowa State mounted a nice drive on its next possession and was poised to put its first points on the board with a 2-and-2 at the UT four-yard line. However, the offense stalled with a penalty and the Cyclones came up empty when Zach Guyer missed a 29-yard field goal. A costly personal foul by ISU on UT's next possession kept its drive alive, and the Longhorns made ISU pay. On the next play, David Ash connected with Mike Davis on a 48-yard touchdown pass to make it 20-0 UT. Two more touchdowns by the Longhorns, one on a blocked punt return, gave UT a 34-0 edge at the break. After a scoreless third quarter, Iowa State got on the board with White's two-yard touchdown run to make it 34-7 UT with 11:33 left in the game. It was White's fourth touchdown of the season.

# 2011 GAME RECAPS

## Iowa State 26 Baylor 49

### Oct. 8 • Floyd Casey Stadium • Waco, Texas

WACO, Texas - No. 25 Baylor gained 603 yards of total offense in a 49-26 win over Iowa State Saturday night at Floyd Casey Stadium. The Bears improved to 4-1 overall and 1-1 in Big 12 play, while the Cyclones fall to 3-2 and 0-2 in league play. The Cyclones were able to move the ball, amassing 425 yards of total offense, their second-best output of the season. But the Bears rushed for 391 yards, including a career-high 200 yards from Terrance Ganaway. Iowa State had an outstanding performance from senior wideout Darius Reynolds, who caught seven passes, including two for touchdowns, for a career-high 178 yards. It was the seventh-best single-game total in school history. It marked the third two-touchdown game for Reynolds this season. He has a team-high six touchdowns. Iowa State stopped Baylor on its opening drive and promptly went 82 yards on seven plays to take an early 7-0 lead. Reynolds caught three passes for 77 yards in the drive, including a 10-yard touchdown catch, his fifth of the season, from Steele Jantz to make it 7-0 Cyclones. It was the first points ISU scored in the first quarter all year. Robert Griffin scored from 1-yard out to tie the game at 7-7 early in the second quarter, but the Cyclones quickly answered.

Iowa State then went on a 9-play, 75-yard touchdown drive to regain the lead at 14-7 with 10:19 left in the 2nd quarter. Jantz hit Branderhorst on a 1-yard pass for the score. The Bears picked up steam after that. BU scored two more 2nd quarter touchdowns to take a 21-14 lead at the break. BU amassed 358 yards of total offense, including 218 on the ground, in the first half. Two Baylor turnovers allowed the Cyclones to keep the game close at intermission. After Baylor moved ahead 28-14, the Cyclones were looking to close the gap with an excellent drive. However, Jantz fumbled inside the 10-yard line and it was returned for a touchdown by Tevin Elliott for 86 yards to make it 35-14 BU.

## Iowa State 17 Missouri 52

### Oct. 15 • Memorial Stadium • Columbia, Mo.

COLUMBIA, Mo. - Missouri quarterback James Franklin hit on 20-of-28 passes for 289 yards and three touchdowns to lead the Tigers to their 10th-straight Faurot Field victory, a 52-17 win over Iowa State Saturday before a sellout Homecoming crowd of 71,004. Steele Jantz completed 17-of-32 passes for 161 yards while James White had 61 yards on 14 carries for Iowa State, which fell to 3-3 overall and 0-3 in the Big 12 Conference. Missouri is now 3-3 overall and 1-2 in the Big 12. Missouri struck first, driving 50 yards in eight plays with a 1-yard TD by Franklin, giving the Tigers a 7-0 lead with 12:03 left in the first quarter. On Iowa State's first possession, Jantz fumbled at the Cyclone 38-yard line, giving the ball to Missouri. The Tigers responded by taking the pigskin 38 yards into the endzone for a 14-0 advantage with 9:05 left in the first quarter. The Cyclones put together their first scoring drive on the ensuing possession that was capped by a Zach Guyer 26-yard field goal that made it 14-3 with 4:45 left in the first quarter. Missouri immediately countered. Franklin hit tight end Michael Egnew over the middle, and the Tiger got past the Cyclone secondary and dashed up the middle on a 39-yard pass play. Missouri went ahead 21-3 with 1:33 to go in the first quarter. Jarvis West's 51-yard kickoff return set up the Cyclones at the Tiger 45-yard line late in the first quarter. However, Iowa State drove to the Missouri 27-yard line where it was stopped on fourth down. Iowa State linebacker A.J. Klein closed the gap to 28-10 when he returned an interception 78 yards for a touchdown with 10:07 left in the first half. The pick was Klein's third defensive touchdown of his career, equaling the school record previously set by Brent Curvey (2003-06). The return equaled the seventh-longest interception return in school history. Klein finished the game with a season-high 12 tackles to pace the Cyclones.

## Texas A&M 33 Iowa State 17

### Oct. 22 • Jack Trice Stadium • Ames, Iowa

AMES, Iowa - No. 17 Texas A&M defeated Iowa State 33-17 Saturday afternoon in Jack Trice Stadium. The Aggies were powered by a pair of 100-yard rushers in Cyrus Gray and Christine Michael, who ran for 142 and 125 yards, respectively. TAMU improves to 5-2 overall and 3-1 in the Big 12, while the Cyclones fall to 3-4 overall and 0-4 in Big 12 play. Senior receiver Josh Lenz had an outstanding day for the Cyclones, setting career highs in catches (8) and receiving yards (117). The Aggies recorded 510 yards of total offense to Iowa State's 305. Two late second quarter touchdowns by Texas A&M erased an early Cyclone lead. Iowa State led 7-6 with under six minutes left to play in the half before the Aggies scored on a 10-yard touchdown catch by Jeff Fuller to make it 13-7 A&M. The drive was kept alive by a pass interference call on a 3rd-and-15. Aggies scored another touchdown with just 0:42 seconds before the half, as Michael Lamothe caught an 18-yarder from Ryan Tannehill to improve the Aggie lead to 20-7 at the break. The Cyclone defense was strong early, holding the potent Aggie offense to just six points through the first 26 minutes of the game. The Aggies scored first after Steele Jantz was intercepted on the first play from scrimmage by Trent Hunter, who returned it to the ISU 14. The Aggies could only muster a 25-yard field goal by Randy Bullock, however. After the Cyclones' first three offensive series resulted in zero first downs, head coach Paul Rhoads inserted redshirt freshman Jared Barnett into the game at quarterback. He promptly sparked Iowa State to a 9-play, 83-yard drive to catapult the Cyclones in the lead at 7-6 with 3:29 left in the first quarter. Barnett hit Lenz on a 29-yard catch for the big play on the drive. James White capped off the drive with his sixth touchdown run of the season on a 19-yard scamper.

## Iowa State 41 Texas Tech 7

### Oct. 29 • Jones AT&T Stadium • Lubbock, Texas

LUBBOCK, Texas - Iowa State posted its largest win over a ranked team Saturday night at Jones AT&T Stadium as the Cyclones ran past No. 19 Texas Tech 41-7. The victory was Iowa State's first ever win in Lubbock. Iowa State (4-4, 1-4 Big 12) defeated the Red Raiders (5-3, 2-3 Big 12) with the rushing attack, posting 368 rushing yards and four rushing touchdowns. The previous record for the largest margin of victory over a ranked opponent was Iowa State's 36-14 win over Nebraska in 2002. The 34-point margin of victory was also Iowa State's first winning margin of over 30 points against a conference opponent since its 45-3 win against Kansas in 2002. Iowa State's 368 rushing yards marked the first time Iowa State went over the 300 mark since its game at Kansas in 2001. James White and Duran Hollis both rushed for over 100 yards with White leading the way with 138 yards and a touchdown and Hollis adding 101 and a touchdown. This is the second season in a row that the Cyclones have had multiple runners with 100-plus yards rushing against Tech, as Alexander Robinson and Shontrelle Johnson pulled off the feat last season. The Iowa State defense restricted Texas Tech to 290 yards total offense. Texas Tech quarterback Seth Doege was stifled, completing just 16-of-32 passes for 171 yards and throwing two interceptions. The Red Raiders did not complete a touchdown pass, snapping a 69-game streak of TTU having at least one touchdown pass in a game. Leading 24-7 at the half, Iowa State started the second half out with the ball. After two White carries, Hollis to the handoff on a third-and-one and broke through the Red Raider secondary, going 71 yards for a touchdown and expanded the Iowa State lead to 31-7. The Cyclone defense took control from then on, holding the Red Raiders to 71 yards in the second half and keeping the dangerous Texas Tech offense off of the field. Iowa State put together another drive in the fourth quarter that was finished off through a White 1-yard touchdown run to make it 38-7. After a Jeremy Reeves interception and 33-yard return, Zach Guyer tacked on a 23-yard field goal to make the score 41-7.

## Kansas 10 Iowa State 13

### Nov. 5 • Jack Trice Stadium • Ames, Iowa

AMES, Iowa – Iowa State kicker Zach Guyer nailed a 42-yard field goal with 4:30 to go in the fourth quarter to give Iowa State a 13-10 victory over Kansas in front of 51,575 fans Saturday afternoon at Jack Trice Stadium. The win improves the Cyclones to 5-4 on the season and 2-4 in Big 12 play. The Jayhawks dropped to 2-7 and 0-6 in conference competition. The crowd was Iowa State's fifth of over 50,000 on the year, a school record for crowds over the 50,000 mark in a season. After taking a 10-7 lead into the locker room at halftime, it was not until the fourth quarter that Iowa State was able to get back on the scoreboard. The Cyclone offense composed a 12-play, 63 yard drive that ended in the Guyer 42-yard field goal. Jared Barnett relied on passes to Albert Gary and Aaron Horne, as both contributed 17 receiving yards on the drive. The Iowa State defense stepped up on the ensuing drive as it held Kansas to five yards on the first two plays of the drive before Stephen Ruempolhamer

sacked Jordan Webb to force a Jayhawk punt. The Cyclones turned to Jeff Woody to drain the clock with four consecutive carries for 45 yards to put the game out of Kansas' hands. Woody finished the game with a career-high 61 yards on nine carries. Barnett was the engine of the Iowa State offense Saturday. The redshirt freshman quarterback accounted for 300 of the Cyclones' 426 yards of total offense. Barnett's 125 rushing yards was the first time an Iowa State quarterback went over the century mark since Bret Meyer in the 2004 Independence Bowl against Miami (Ohio). Barnett was 16-for-30 through the air to total 175 yards passing. Gary led the Iowa State receivers with career-highs in both catches (five) and yards (57). Jarvis West was also effective in the receiving game, catching three passes for a career-high 35 yards. Jake Knott led the Iowa State defense with 10 tackles, his fourth game this season with a double-figure tackle total. Iowa State struck on its first drive of the game as the Cyclones went on a 12-play, 82 yard drive that resulted in a 32-yard field goal by Guyer to give Iowa State an early 3-0 lead. The Jayhawks struck on their next drive as KU went 80 yards in nine plays capped off by a 22-yard rushing touchdown by D.J. Beshears to give Kansas an early 7-3 advantage.

## Oklahoma State 31 Iowa State 37

### Nov. 18 • Jack Trice Stadium • Ames, Iowa

AMES, Iowa - Iowa State made history Friday night. With its defense keeping the high-powered Oklahoma State offense out of synch all night and an offense churning out 568 yards of total offense, the Cyclones upset No. 2 OSU in an amazing come-from-behind 37-31 double overtime victory at Jack Trice Stadium. A crowd of 52,027 watched as the Cyclones erased a 17-point second half deficit to record its biggest win in school history. The Cyclones were 0-56-2 all-time vs. teams ranked sixth or higher coming into the game. Iowa State trumped that stat, and became bowl-eligible for the second time in the three-year Paul Rhoads era. Jeff Woody sealed the victory on a 4-yard touchdown dive after Ter'Ran Benton intercepted a Brandon Weeden pass on the first play of OSU's second overtime possession. The Cyclones, now 6-4 overall and 3-4 in Big 12 play, put the only blemish on the Cowboys' magical season, as OSU falls to 10-1 overall and 7-1 in the league. OSU was averaging 51.0 points per game coming into the contest, and the inspired Cyclones held the Cowboys to just 24 points in regulation. Oklahoma State went into the half with a 17-7 lead, as ISU held the explosive Cowboy offense to just one offensive touchdown in the first 30 minutes. The Cyclone offense outgained the Cowboys, 138-80 in the first quarter, but had two long drives result in zero points. ISU marched 65 yards on 13 plays early in the first quarter, but came away empty when Zach Guyer missed a 34-yard field goal. Meanwhile, the Cyclone defense forced two turnovers, one on a fumble by Joseph Randle which was recovered by Jake Lattimer, and the second on a Jacques Washington interception. ISU then proceeded to march 52 yards on its next series, but it ended when Jared Barnett's pass was intercepted by Shaun Lewis, who returned it 70 yards for a touchdown to give OSU the 7-0 lead.
