A LOOK AT THE 2011 SEASON

The University of Oklahoma volleyball team finished the 2011 with a 21-12 overall record and 8-8 mark in the Big 12 Conference. The Sooners graduate five seniors in **Brianne Barker**, **Suzy Boulavsky**, **Kylie Cowan**, **Caitlin Higgins** and **Carlee Roethlisberger**. Oklahoma advanced to its third consecutive NCAA Championship and fifth in the last six years. Barker earned her second consecutive All-America third team honor, while Boulavsky and sophomore **Sallie McLaurin** were named to the All-America honorable mention team. Barker and Boulavsky earned first team All-Central Region honors from the AVCA, while McLaurin was named to the All-Central Region honorable mention team. Boulavsky also became the first player in program history to earn first team Academic All-America honors from the College Sports Information Directors of America.

A LOOK AT OKLAHOMA AS A TEAM

- ▶ Oklahoma finished the year 21-12 overall and 8-8 in Big 12 play. OU was fifth in the league standings.
- ▶ The Sooners are 8-8 all-time in the NCAA Championship and 5-5 in the event under head coach **Santiago Restrepo**.
- ▶ OU made its third consecutive appearance in the Championship. OU has made the tournament five out of the last six years.
- ▶ Oklahoma hit .246 as a team this year, its highest hitting percentage since 2006 (.262).
- ▶ OU secured its 15th 20-win season and fourth under Restrepo (2010, 2007, 2006).
- ▶ Oklahoma is 13-114 all-time against ranked opponents and 12-56 under Restrepo.
- ▶ The Sooners went 2-3 against ranked teams with wins over (8) Texas and (15) Colorado State.

A LOOK AT OKLAHOMA INDIVIDUALLY

- ▶ **Brianne Barker** was named to the AVCA All-America third team.
- ▶ **Suzy Boulavsky** and **Sallie McLaurin** were honorable mention All-America.
- ▶ Barker and Boulavsky earned first team All-Big 12 and AVCA All-Central Region honors.
- ▶ **Carlee Roethlisberger** was named Newcomer of the Year.
- ▶ McLaurin was the Defensive Player of the Year and honorable mention All-Big 12.
- ▶ McLaurin was also an honorable mention selection to the AVCA All-Central Region team.
- ▶ **Tara Dunn** earned a spot on the All-Big 12 Freshman Team.
- ▶ McLaurin led the league with 1.45 bps in conference matches and 1.35 bps in all matches.
- ▶ McLaurin had 137 block assists on the year, an OU single season record for the current scoring era.
- ▶ The last player to have that many block assists in a single year was 137 by **Eliane Santos** in 2006.
- ▶ **María Fernanda** (1,624) became the Oklahoma career digs leader on Oct. 15 (**Melissa Peterson**, 1,436 from 1994-97).
- ▶ Fernanda had 585 digs on the year, also a single season record for any scoring era.
- ▶ Fernanda is the only active Big 12 player to rank in the top 10 of Big 12 career leaders in eight categories.
- ▶ Fernanda is seventh all-time on the Big 12 digs list.
- ▶ Boulavsky led OU with 3.32 kps and is second on the team with 84 block assists, fourth most in a season at OU.
- ▶ Barker ended her career ranked third on the career assists list (4,592).
- ▶ Barker is one of five players in OU history to rank in the top four of two or more career categories.
- ▶ The others include **Patrice Arrington**, **Gloria Holcomb**, **Joanna Schmitt** and Peterson.
- ▶ Boulavsky earned first team Academic All-America and All-District honors from CoSIDA.
- ▶ Nine OU student-athletes earned Academic All-Big 12 honors.

BOULAVSKY NAMED ACADEMIC ALL-AMERICAN

Senior **Suzy Boulavsky** was named to the Capital One Academic All-America® Division I Volleyball first team, the College Sports Information Directors of America announced on Dec. 15. Boulavsky was named to the third team Academic All-America team last year. She is a three-time Academic All-District selection and maintains a 3.97 grade point average in public relations.

TRIO EARNS ALL-AMERICA HONORS

Senior **Brianne Barker** was named to the American Volleyball Coaches Association All-America third team the organization announced Dec. 14. Senior **Suzy Boulavsky** and sophomore **Sallie McLaurin** were named to the All-America honorable mention team.

TRIO EARNS ALL-REGION HONORS

Brianne Barker and **Suzy Boulavsky** were named to the American Volleyball Coaches Association All-Central Region first team the organization announced Dec. 6. **Sallie McLaurin** earned a spot on the All-Central Region honorable mention team. It marks the second consecutive first team honor for Barker and the first for Boulavsky. It is McLaurin's first All-Region honor of her career.

BEST HITTING PERCENTAGE SINCE 2006

Oklahoma's .246 hitting percentage in 2011 was its highest since hitting .262 in 2006.

FIVE SET THRILLERS

Oklahoma went 5-3 in five-set matches this year. While that seems like a lot, it's not the most for the Sooners under **Santiago Restrepo**. OU played nine five-set matches in 2008 (4-5) and 2006 (7-2). OU last played eight five-set matches in 2007 (6-2).

BARKER, BOULAVSKY NAMED FIRST TEAM ALL-BIG 12

Seniors **Brianne Barker** and **Suzy Boulavsky** earned All-Big 12 First Team honors, the conference office announced Nov. 28. It is the second consecutive first team honor for both. Barker commanded OU to a .245 hitting percentage this year and averaged 10.40 assists per set. Boulavsky led the Sooners with 3.28 kills per set, hitting .291 on the year. Boulavsky averaged 0.77 blocks per set with 93 total.

MCLAURIN NAMED DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE YEAR

Sophomore **Sallie McLaurin** earned the Big 12 Defensive Player of the Year award and was named to the honorable mention All-Big 12 team on Nov. 28. McLaurin earned Freshman of the Year honors last year. She is the first Sooner to earn Defensive Player of the Year honors since Eliane Santos in 2006. McLaurin led the Big 12 in blocks on the year, averaging 1.35 per set. McLaurin had 25 block solos and 132 block assists during the regular season.

ROETHLISBERGER IS BIG 12 NEWCOMER OF THE YEAR

Senior **Carlee Roethlisberger** was named Big 12 Newcomer of the Year on Nov. 28. Roethlisberger is the second OU player to earn Newcomer of the Year accolades, following Cathy Cook in 1999. Roethlisberger hit .300 on the year, averaging 1.65 kills per set. She was second on the team in blocks with 74 total, including 12 block solos for a 0.83 per set average.

DUNN NAMED TO ALL-FRESHMAN TEAM

Tara Dunn was named to the All-Big 12 Freshman Team on Nov. 28. Dunn was second on the team and in the top 10 in the league with 2.92 kills per set. She also averaged 1.58 digs and 0.52 blocks per set.

OU SPLITS SEASON SERIES WITH TEXAS

The Oklahoma volleyball team took the opening set from fifth-ranked Texas but was unable to come away with a win Nov. 26 as the Longhorns downed OU 3-1 (25-21, 16-25, 21-25, 19-25). **Caitlin Higgins** registered her third double-double of the year. Higgins led OU with 13 kills and added 13 digs, one shy of a match high. Higgins hit .333 with four errors in 27 attempts.

OKLAHOMA SWEEPS TEXAS TECH

OU closed out the home portion of the 2011 schedule Wednesday Nov. 23 evening with a sweep of Texas Tech (-12, -19, -33). The Sooners hit .333 in the match and had four players hit .300 or better as Oklahoma held the Red Raiders to a .118 hitting percentage. **Sallie McLaurin** led OU with a team-best 13 kills and had just one attack error, hitting .706 with 17 attempts. McLaurin tied a season high with three block solos and added four block assists for seven total blocks. The 35 points in the third set were the most in a single set by an OU team in the 25-point rally scoring era.

TEXAS A&M CRUISES PAST SOONERS

The Sooners dropped a four-set decision to Texas A&M on Nov. 19 (26-24, 16-25, 22-25, 17-25). The Sooners hit just .154 and had 52.5 points, while the Aggies hit .300 and put up 83 points on OU. **Grace Whitley** led the Sooners in kills, registering eight in just two sets played. Whitley hit .615, connecting on eight of her 13 attack attempts. She added a block solo and two block assists for a team-best 10 points.

OU SNAPS SKID WITH WIN AT KANSAS

OU recorded its 20th win of the year in a four-set win at Kansas on Nov. 16 (25-20, 24-26, 25-23, 25-17). OU hit and had just 12 attack errors and half of those came in the second set. **Suzy Boulavsky** led the Sooners with 17 kills and a .432 hitting percentage. Boulavsky had just one attack error in 37 attempts and added a season-high five block assists to register 20.5 points. **Tara Dunn** added 15 kills, hitting .316 with three errors in 38 attempts.

NINE NAMED ACADEMIC ALL-BIG 12

Oklahoma placed nine student-athletes on the 2011 Academic All-Big 12 team. **Suzy Boulavsky** was one of two honored with a 4.00 grade point average (over last two semesters). Joining Boulavsky on the first team were **Brianne Barker, Kylie Cowan, Caitlin Higgins, Sallie McLaurin, Morgan Reynolds and Eden Williams. Mindy Gowen and Carlee Roethlisberger** were named to the second team.

SOONERS DROP FOURTH STRAIGHT

OU dropped its fourth consecutive match Nov. 12, falling to Baylor in four sets (28-26, 25-27, 22-25, 22-25) Oklahoma got a career-high 15 kills from **Carlee Roethlisberger** and a match-high 19 kills from **Suzy Boulavsky. Sallie McLaurin** added 10 kills as the only other Sooner in double figures.

BOULAVSKY EARNS ACADEMIC HONOR

For a third straight year, **Suzy Boulavsky** was named to the College Sports Information Directors of America Academic All-District team. Boulavsky boasts an overall 3.97 grade point average in public relations. Boulavsky was named to the Academic All-America third team last year and is a three-time academic All-Big 12 selection.

K-STATE DOWNS OU IN FIVE SETS

OU fell in five sets at Kansas State (25-18, 23-25-25-16, 21-25, 12-15) on Nov. 9. Despite a dominating third set win in the match, the Sooners were unable to get the win. OU out-hit the Wildcats with a .160 clip to KSU's .136 and committed fewer errors, but Kansas State scored the final seven points of the fourth set and jumped out early 5-1 lead in the fifth before a KSU error tied the set at 12-all. The Wildcats went on to score three straight to take the fifth set 15-12 and secure the win. Oklahoma has dropped three straight matches for the first time this year.

DUNN NAMED ROOKIE OF THE WEEK

Tara Dunn was named the Big 12 Rookie of the Week on Nov. 7. The honor is the second this year for the Poth, Texas, native who previously earned the honor on Oct. 24. Dunn registered her eighth double-double of the year with a team-best 18 kills and 10 digs in a four-set loss to No. 12 Iowa State. Dunn averaged 4.50 kills per set and 2.50 digs per set on the week. She added one block assist for a team-best 18.5 points, a 4.63 points per set average. The outing marked Dunn's sixth match with 15 or more kills this year and it was her third highest kill total in a single match this season.

CYCLONES HAND OU FIRST HOME LOSS

OU dropped its first home match of the year, falling in four sets to Iowa State (18-25, 25-23, 21-25, 21-25) on Nov. 2. **Tara Dunn** led OU with 19 kills and 10 digs for her eighth double-double this year. Dunn added one block assist for 18.5 points, a team-best. **Suzy Boulavsky** added 17 kills, hitting .372 with just one attack error in 43 attempts. Boulavsky added two block assists for 18.0 points.

MISSOURI SWEEPS OKLAHOMA

Oklahoma was swept for the first time this season as the Sooners fell in straight sets to Missouri (-21, -23, -23) on Oct. 29. Oklahoma committed eight service errors despite out-blocking and out-hitting the Tigers. **Suzy Boulavsky** led OU with 16 kills and a .452 hitting percentage. **Brianne Barker** added her 18th double-double of the year with 34 assists and 11 digs. **Maria Fernanda** added a match-high 16 digs. **Tara Dunn** and **Sallie McLaurin** each added seven kills, and McLaurin led OU with five block assists.

MCLAURIN NAMED CO-DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Sallie McLaurin was named the Big 12 Conference Co-Defensive on Oct. 24. McLaurin led the Sooners to a four-set win over Kansas State with seven total blocks; including a season-high two block solos. McLaurin also hit a team-best .400 with one attack error and 11 kills.

DUNN EARNS FIRST WEEKLY BIG 12 HONOR

Tara Dunn earned her first Rookie of the Week honor on Oct. 24 after recording her seventh double-double this year against Kansas State. She led OU with 13 kills against the Wildcats and hit a .316 clip with just one attack error in 38 attempts. She added 12 digs, one service ace and three blocks, including one block solo.

OKLAHOMA FENDS OFF KANSAS STATE

OU rallied on several occasions to down Kansas State in four sets (25-20, 20-25, 25-22, 25-21) on Oct. 22. The two teams split each of the first two sets and OU trailed 22-17 in the third before scoring eight straight points to re-gain the momentum to take the set 25-22.

SOONERS COMPLETE COMBACK AGAINST KANSAS

OU rebounded from a 0-2 deficit to down Kansas in five sets Oct. 15 (23-25, 19-25, 25-23, 25-19, 15-9). **Brianne Barker** ended the match two kills shy of her second career triple-double. Barker paced the Sooners with 41 assists, 14 digs, a season-high eight kills and a match-best .429 hitting percentage. **Tara Dunn** had a season-high eight total blocks. Dunn led the Sooners with 16 kills.

A&M'S ADJUSTMENTS DOWN OKLAHOMA

The Oklahoma volleyball team dropped a five set decision at Texas A&M Oct. 12 (25-22, 25-19, 17-25, 27-29, 11-15). The Sooners led 2-0 at the intermission but were unable to hang out as the Aggies remained perfect at home this year. The Sooners tied a season-high with 15 blocks in the match but after recording 12 blocks in the first two sets, Texas A&M made the necessary adjustments to hold OU to just three blocks after the intermission. Blocks were the only area on the stat sheet not controlled by the Aggies as A&M recorded more kills (71-59), digs (80-76) and aces (7-2) than OU did.

SOONERS DROP FIRST CONFERENCE MATCH

OU dropped its first conference match of the year with a four set loss at No. 16 Iowa State (23-25, 17-25, 25-22, 19-25) on Oct. 8. **Tara Dunn** led the Sooners with 15 kills, while **Suzy Boulavsky** added 14. Dunn added 15 digs to her total for another double-double.

OKLAHOMA DOWNS MISSOURI IN FIVE

The Sooners won a close-fought five-set battle Oct. 5 as OU downed Missouri (25-12, 25-17, 21-25, 22-25, 15-7). **Brianne Barker** recorded her 70th career double-double, with 48 assists and 17 digs. **Tara Dunn** also had a double-double, registering her fifth of the season with 13 kills and 16 digs. **Suzy Boulavsky** led the team in kills with 19. **Sallie McLaurin** was the team leader in blocks, with seven block assists and one block solo. **Maria Fernanda** led the team in digs with 31.

BOULAVSKY EARNS OFFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Suzy Boulavsky was named the Big 12 Offensive Player of the Week on Oct. 3. Boulavsky led the Sooners with 3.70 kills per set. She hit .360 on the week with just five attack errors in 89 attempts. She had a match-high 20 kills and hit .452 in the win over then-No. 8 Texas. Boulavsky added 17 kills at Texas Tech in the five-set win. This is the second career Offensive Player of the Week award for Boulavsky. She previously earned the honor on Oct. 19, 2009.

MCLAURIN NAMED DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Sallie McLaurin was named the Big 12 Defensive Player of the Week on Oct. 3. McLaurin led the Sooners with 1.90 blocks per set. She totaled 19 blocks, including 16 block assists and 32.0 points on the week. She had a match-high 11 total blocks against then-No. 8 Texas, including an OU rally scoring record 10 block assists. McLaurin was key in OU's win at Texas Tech with 12 kills and eight total blocks.

OKLAHOMA SQUEAKS PAST TEXAS TECH

The Oklahoma volleyball team rallied from two Texas Tech match points to down the Red Raiders in five sets Oct. 1 (22-25, 25-16, 18-25, 25-19, 17-15). **Tara Dunn** led the Sooners with a match-high 21 kills. **Brianne Barker** dished out a career-high 59 assists and had 19 digs for her 12th double-double this year.

SOONERS UPSET NO. 8 TEXAS

The Sooners ousted No. 8 Texas in five sets (25-16, 25-20, 17-25, 24-26, 15-9) on Sept. 28. The win was OU's third ever in the series against the Longhorns. **Suzy Boulavsky** led the Sooners with a match-high 20 kills. It was the Sooners first win against the Longhorns since 2008, which was a five-set win in Austin. OU's only other win before that came in Norman in 2006.

FERNANDA EARNS DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Junior libero **Maria Fernanda** was named the Big 12 Defensive Player of the Week on Sept. 26. The honor follows her performance at Baylor last Wednesday. Fernanda was OU's defensive leader in a four-set win against the Bears. She averaged 6.75 digs per set, totaling 27. She had her 24th career match with 20-plus digs and fourth this season.

OU OPENS CONFERENCE PLAY WITH WIN

The Oklahoma volleyball team won its Big 12 Conference opener on Sept. 21 in four sets at Baylor. Both teams hit well below their season averages and OU managed to commit fewer errors (20) than Baylor's 29. The Sooners doubled up the Bears in blocks, 14-7. **Suzy Boulavsky** led the Sooners with a team-high 13 kills. **Tara Dunn** recorded her second double-double of the year with 12 kills and 10 digs. Dunn added five total blocks.

SOONERS WIN OKLAHOMA INVITATIONAL

Oklahoma swept past Texas Southern, Arkansas-Little Rock and Arkansas-Pine Bluff to open the Oklahoma Invitational. OU won the title after taking a five-set match from Boise State. **Suzy Boulavsky** and **Maria Fernanda** were named to the all-tournament team, while **Sallie McLaurin** was named most valuable player.

WHITLEY PERFECT AGAINST TEXAS SOUTHERN

Grace Whitley hit a perfect 1.000 against Texas Southern on Sept. 16. Whitley connected for 11 kills in 11 attack attempts. She also added four block assists.

DUNN HAS CAREER NIGHT IN LOSS

Tara Dunn turned in a performance for the ages but it wasn't enough as the Oklahoma volleyball team fell to Wichita State in five sets on Sept. 14. The Sooners won the first two sets 27-25 and 25-23 but dropped the final three 18-25, 27-29 and 13-15. Dunn had a match-high 29 kills and recorded her first career double-double with 15 digs. Dunn's 29 kills were the most for a Sooner since Christina Maynes had 30 against Missouri on Nov. 15, 2003. In addition to setting an Oklahoma single match record for kills during the 25-point rally scoring era, Dunn set a rally scoring match record (both eras) in attempts (85). Dunn committed just two attack errors to hit .318.

OU GOES 2-1 AT HURRICANE INVITATIONAL

Oklahoma swept Florida A&M and Auburn before falling to host Miami 3-1 at the Hurricane Invitational. **Brianne Barker** and **Suzy Boulavsky** earned all-tournament team honors. Oklahoma hit .449 against Florida A&M.

DEFENSE FUELS COMEBACK AGAINST ARKANSAS

The Oklahoma volleyball team faced a tough test on Sept. 6, fending off the University of Arkansas in four sets (16-25, 25-18, 25-23, 25-20). **Sallie McLaurin** and **Brianne Barker** led the Sooners with double-doubles. McLaurin

The team made quick work of tournament host North Texas. The Sooners needed just over an hour to sweep the Mean Green (-8, -19, -12). Oklahoma's front net presence proved to be too much for the Mean Green. OU out-blocked North Texas 12.5-1.0. **Sallie McLaurin** led the OU defense with nine total blocks. Oklahoma closed out the tournament with a sweep of Sam Houston State (-25, -21, -16). The Sooners hit .278 and out-blocked the Bearkats 8.0-4.0 in the win.

OKLAHOMA TAKES DOWN NO. 15 COLORADO STATE

The Sooners improved to 4-0 and handed No. 15 Colorado State its first loss of the season in a sweep (-21, -15, -23) on Aug. 29. **Sallie McLaurin** led the Sooners with 14 kills, followed closely by **Suzy Boulavsky** with 13 kills.
