Head Coach Frank Anderson

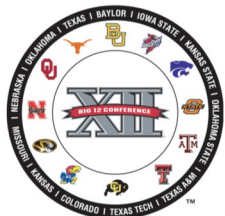
- ◆ Led OSU the Big XII Championship and an NCAA Regional birth in 2004, his first season as a head coach.

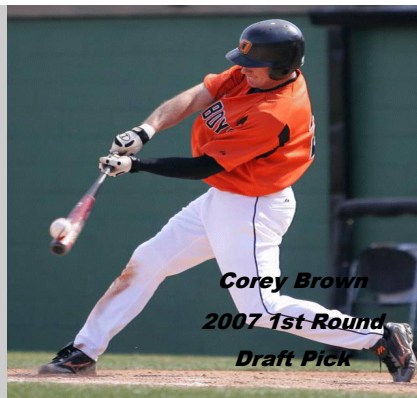
