Employment Regulations:

- Student-athletes are to be compensated only for work actually performed;
- Student-athletes are to be compensated at a rate commensurate with the going rate in that locality for similar services;
- Student-athletes will report to the compliance office any payment offered in excess of the duties performed and or greater than the going rate;
- Student-athletes may not receive any remuneration for the value or utility that the student-athlete may have for the employer because of the publicity, reputation, fame or personal following he or she has obtained because of athletics ability;
- Student-athletes will seek approval from his/her coach in regard to any employment opportunities during the academic year. If the coach grants approval, student-athletes will then complete appropriate paperwork with the compliance office.
- Student-athletes are allowed to receive compensation for teaching or coaching sports skills or techniques in your specific sport on a fee-for-lesson basis, provided:
 - You may not use ODU facilities to teach the lessons;
 - You may not be paid for 'playing lessons' (meaning they must be teaching lessons, you cannot be paid for playing someone);
 - You must document the recipient of the lesson(s) and the fee;
 - Your compensation is paid by the lesson recipient (or the recipients family) and not another individual entity;
 - You do not use your name, picture or appearance to promote or advertise the availability of fee-for-lesson sessions.
