### LADY MONARCH MOMENTS:

• The Old Dominion women's basketball team won its 28th consecutive home game to tie Hartford for the nation's longest active home win streak in their last outing against Norfolk State.

• Old Dominion scored 97 points in its last outing, the most points since nabbing 105 against Hofstra on February 12th, 2004.

• Junior Jessica Canady collected a career-high 19 rebounds surpassing her previous high of 15 against Delaware on Jan. 27, 2008.

• Junior Jessica Canady posted her eighth career double-double and third of the year with 24 points and 19 rebounds.

• Senior Tiffany Green tied her career-high with 21 points on 8-of-11 shooting from the field and 5-of-7 shooting from the line. Green also posted 21 points against UNC-Wilmington back on Jan. 9, 2008.

• With her 21 points, senior Tiffany Green moved up two notches on the All-Time ODU Scoring Leaders list surpassing Sharron Francis (1998-2002) and Shonda DeBerry (1992-1996) to moved into 22nd on the list. She now has 1,103 career points.

• Sophomore Vicki Collier netted her first career points as a Lady Monarch. Collier recorded four points going 2-of-2 from the field. Collier played in her third game this season after sitting out the 2006-07 season as a redshirt and then missing the 2007-08 season with a knee injury.

• The Lady Monarchs held the Norfolk State roster to just one double figure scoring. It was the first time this season only one member of the opposition was held to double figures. Whitney Long came off the Spartan bench to net 19.

• Junior Jessica Canady put away lay-up with 2:35 remaining to give the ODU its largest lead of the game, a 47-point 93-45 advantage. It was Old Dominion's largest lead of the season..

#### **11/17/08 - CAA Co-Player of the Week:**

Green helped Old Dominion kick off the 2008-09 season with a pair of wins over St. Mary's and Dayton at the World Vision Classic by averaging 17.0 points and 11.0 rebounds per game. Green led all scorers with 19 points as six different Lady Monarchs scored in ODU's 93-63 season opening victory over St. Mary's. She followed by posting her 18th career double-double in the Lady Monarchs' 70-58 win over Dayton. The 6-2 Chesapeake, Virginia native collected 15 points along with a career-high 16 rebounds. On the week Green, shot 50 percent from the field and last year's CAA leader in shot blockers totaled six rejections.

#### **RANK 'EM UP - AP POLL:**

The Old Dominion women's basketball team will head into Friday's contest with Saint Joseph's receiving votes for the second consecutive week. The Lady Monarchs have ranked as high as No. 23 in the poll. Five opponents on the 2008-09 Lady Monarch slate are featured in the poll, including undefeated Texas at No. 6 and defending NCAA champion Tennessee coming in at No. 7. Also in the Top 25 are Maryland, the 2006 NCAA Champions, seated at No. 15 and No. 17 Virginia. Michigan State slipped out of the Top 25 after suffering three consecutive loss, but continues to receive votes.

#### **RANK 'EM UP - ESPN/USA TODAY POLL:**

The Old Dominion women's basketball team continues to receive votes in the Coach's Poll for the second consecutive week. The Lady Monarchs ranked as high as No. 20 in the poll. Also appearing in the Poll are Lady Monarchs opponents, Texas at No. 5 and Tennessee at No. 10. Also in the Top 25 are Virginia at No. 15 and Maryland at No. 16. Following back-to-back-to-back losses, Michigan State fell out of the poll.

#### **POUR IT ON IN THE PAINT:**

The Lady Monarchs scored 56 points in the paint in their last outing, two more points than the entire Norfolk State team combined.

#### **CAVALIER KILLER:**

Something about playing the Virginia Cavaliers seems to bring out the best in senior guard Jazzmin Walters. Last season, Walters nailed the game-winning three-point shot against the Cavaliers with 4.8 seconds remaining in overtime to send the Lady Monarchs to the "Sweet 16" for the first time since 2002. In the rematch last week, Walters collected a career-high 24 points going 6-of-10 from the field and 11-of-12 from the line to help the Lady Monarchs to 78-70 upset victory over #16/11 Virginia.

Tiffany Green averaged 17.0 points and 8.7 rebounds, while Jessica Canady poured in 14.0 points and 9.0 rebounds over the three-day tournament in games against #14/13 Texas, St. Mary's and Dayton.

#### **PRESEASON AWARDS:**

Three Lady Monarchs were named to Preseason All-CAA teams. Senior forward/center Tiffany Green was a First Team selection. A First Team All-CAA pick a season ago, she averaged 11.4 points, 7.6 rebounds, and led the CAA in blocks. Senior guard Jazzmin Walters and junior Jessica Canady were Second Team picks. Walters led the CAA in assists, while Canady averaged 11.0 points as the Lady Monarchs' "sixth woman" and led the league in field goal percentage.

#### **CAA PRESEASON POLL - WE'RE #1:**

Old Dominion, which has captured the past 17 Colonial Athletic Association women's basketball titles, was picked to repeat as conference champion in 2008-09 according to a vote of the league's coaches, sports information directors and media. The Lady Monarchs, advanced to the "Sweet 16" and earned a 31-5 overall record last season, were followed in the voting by Virginia Commonwealth, James Madison, Drexel, Towson, UNC-Wilmington, Delaware, Georgia State, Northeastern, William & Mary, Hofstra, and George Mason.

#### **HOME OPENERS:**

In home openers, the Lady Monarchs are 29-11 including a 4-3 mark at the Ted Constant Convocation Center. Old Dominion defeated Virginia 78-70 in a rematch of the NCAA Second Round overtime game in their 2008-09 home opener on Nov. 21.

#### **SEASON OPENERS:**

The Lady Monarchs are 27-13 in season openers including this year's 93-63 victory over St. Mary's in the opening day of the World Vision Classic in Austin, Texas. The 30-point victory over the Gaels was ODU's largest in a season opener since its 82-26 victory over Towson during the 2001-02 season.

#### **RACKING UP THE WIN COLUMN:**

The Old Dominion Lady Monarchs finished last season with a 31-5 overall mark. It was the most wins for the program since the 1996-97 season when the Lady Monarchs captured a 34-2 overall mark and reached the championship game of the NCAA Tournament. Old Dominion has posted six 30+ win seasons in history.

#### **500 AND COUNTING:**

Old Dominion head coach Wendy Larry cracked a half-century mark last season. In Old Dominion's 74-51 CAA semifinal victory over fifth-seeded Towson, Larry earned her 500th win at the helm of the Lady Monarch program. Junior Jessica Canady's 22 points led a trio of Lady Monarchs in double figures as the Old Dominion women's basketball team concluded the exhibition portion of its schedule with a 69-48 win over Shaw University on November 10th. Old Dominion held a 35-23 edge at halftime. Shaw was within six, 20-14, with 6:37 remaining in the first half, but the Lady Monarchs quickly established a double-digit lead shortly thereafter for good. Mairi Buchan led the newcomers with nine points and five boards. Old Dominion was untraditionally outrebounded, 43-38, by the Bears. Canady led the Lady Monarchs with six rebounds.

### EXHIBITION RECAP - UNIVERSITY OF D.C.

The Old Dominion women's basketball rolled to a 53-point exhibition win on November 3rd at the Ted Constant Convocation Center with a 79-26 win over the University of D.C. Four Lady Monarchs reached double figures led by Preseason First Team All-CAA selection Tiffany Green with 17 points. Green went 5-of-6 from the floor and 7-of-9 from the stripe. The CAA leader in blocks a year ago also registered five rejections on the evening. The Old Dominion defense held the Firebirds to 20 percent shooting and the bench to just four points. LaQuanda Brandon chipped in eight points to lead the University of D.C. The Lady Monarchs used a 22-4 run, including a string of 13 unanswered points, to take a 24-6 edge with 7:43 remaining in the first half. Old Dominion cruised to a 40-12 halftime lead and ended the second half outscoring the Firebirds, 39-14. Joining Green in double figures were sophomore Jasmine Parker with 16, junior Jessica Canady with 15, and junior Jazzmin Walters adding in 11. Canady, a Preseason Second Team All-CAA selection, went a perfect 5-of-5 from the charity stripe. The two Greens led Old Dominion on the boards as the Lady Monarchs outboarded the University of D.C., 41-29. Tiffany and Shadasia Green hauled in nine rebounds a piece.

**COLONIAL DOMINANCE:** Old Dominion has captured 17-straight Colonial Athletic Association (CAA) titles since joining the league from the Sun Belt Conference during the 1991-92 season. The Lady Monarchs are in the NCAA record books for capturing the most consecutive conference championships. In league play, Old Dominion holds a 311-17 overall record, which includes eight seasons of undefeated play. The Lady Monarchs hold a 161-2 record at home and a 150-15 road record. Only two CAA losses have occurred on Old Dominion's homecourt. The first was back at the ODU Fieldhouse, the former Lady Monarch homecourt from 1969-2002, against Richmond, now of the Atlantic-10, with a 70-74 defeat on February 19, 1992 and the second versus Delaware with a 70-73 setback on January 9, 2005. Five schools in the league have yet to beat the Lady Monarchs - Georgia State (6-0), George Mason (43-0), Northeastern (5-0), UNC-Wilmington (36-0), and Towson (12-0).

**NORFOLK, Va. --** Junior Jessica Canady hauled in a career-high 19 rebounds and senior Tiffany Green tied her career mark with 21 points to lead the No. 23/20 Old Dominion women's basketball team to a 97-54 win over Norfolk State Sunday afternoon at the Ted Constant Convocation Center.

Old Dominion, who upped their overall mark to 4-2 on the, year began the first of a four-game homestand. The Lady Monarchs will have the next week a half off as they prepare for final exams. They will return to action on Sunday, December 12th at 2:00 p.m. against Saint Joseph's, followed by meetings with defending NCAA Champion Tennessee on December 18th and 2006 NCAA Champion Maryland on December 21st.

The victory improved the Lady Monarchs' home win streak to 28 consecutive wins, tying Hartford for the nation's longest active home winning streak.

The second half had Old Dominion outscoring the Spartans, 53-34. Canady put away lay-up with 2:35 remaining to give the Lady Monarchs it largest lead of the game, a 47-point 93-45 advantage.

Old Dominion put up 56 points in the paint, two more points than the entire Norfolk State roster. The Lady Monarch bench also produced 29 points led by sophomore Jasmine Parker. Parker went 3-of-4 from the floor and a perfect 5-of-5 from the line to score 12 points on the afternoon.

The Spartans had just one in double figures. Whitney Long came off the bench for 19 points.
