## **ODU Back in Final Four**

The Lady Monarchs return to the NCAA Final Four in 2011 for the first time since the 2005 season. ODU has made an NCAA-best 17 Final Four appearances in their history and has taken home nine national championships, also tops in the NCAA. Old Dominion has also finished runner-up on three occasions and has four third place finishes. In their last trip to the Final Four in 2005, the Monarchs lost to Maryland, 3-2.

## **Monarchs and Terps Meet Again**

Old Dominion and Maryland will meet for the third time this season on Friday in the NCAA Semifinals in Louisville. The Terps hold the slim lead in the all-time series, 26-24-1. This season, the Monarchs bested the Terps in Norfolk on Sept. 2, 4-0, as senior Emma Batten scored three goals in the shutout victory. In the return trip to College Park, Batten again came up with a hat trick as the Lady Monarchs downed the Terps, 5-2, on Oct. 14 which snapped Maryland's 39-game home win streak.

## **ODU Against the NCAA Field**

The Lady Monarchs were 10-2 against teams in the NCAA Tournament in 2011 entering the postseason with wins over North Carolina, Penn State, Northeastern, Syracuse, Richmond, Maryland, Duke and Ohio State. On the season, ODU has defeated eight top-10, including a pair of teams ranked No. 1, and 10 total ranked teams on the year.

## **Lady Monarchs and Tar Heels Split**

Old Dominion and North Carolina, the two teams that have spent the majority of the season ranked at No. 1 in the country, split their meetings in 2011 with the visiting team winning each contest. In their initial meeting in Chapel Hill on Sept. 16, the Lady Monarchs scored three unanswered goals to defeat the top-ranked Tar Heels, 3-1. It remains the only loss of the season so far for UNC. The Tar Heels returned the favor at top-ranked ODU in the return trip to Norfolk on Oct. 30 as North Carolina slipped past the Monarchs

in overtime, 3-2. Overall in the all-time series, UNC holds the slight advantage, 37-34-2.

## **Old Dominion and Connecticut History**

The Lady Monarchs lead the all-time series with the Huskies, 23-10. The two teams have not met since the 2007 season when UCONN came out with a 3-2 win in Ann Arbor, Mich. The last win for ODU against Connecticut came in 2003 in a 4-2 win in Norfolk.

## **Batten Sparks the Lady Monarchs**

After playing three seasons at the University of Bath in the United Kingdom, senior Emma Batten has transitioned very well in her first and only year in an ODU uniform. The CAA Player of the Year and CAA Tournament's Most Outstanding Player has 27 goals on the season with five assists for a total of 59 points on 86 shots. Batten has five game-winning goals on the season and has a pair of hat trick against Maryland. On the season, she has 67 shots on goal and has scored three or more goals in three different contests.

## **Solid in Goal**

Senior goalkeeper Devon Seifert has been solid in goal this year for the Monarchs as she has started all 24 games and has posted eight shutouts. Seifert has allowed just 23 goals on the year for an average of just 0.94 goals per game which is fourth in the NCAA. The senior has recorded 43 saves this season.

## **CAA Champions**

The Lady Monarchs won their 15th CAA title on Nov. 6 in Norfolk in a 5-1 win over No. 18 Northeastern at the Powhatan Sports Complex. It was the second consecutive league title for ODU as senior Emma Batten scored a career-high four goals and was named the tournament's most outstanding player. It was the third game of the season that Batten scored three or more goals.

## **Anders Honored**

Head Coach Beth Anders was selected as CAA Coach of the Year for the 11th time in her legendary head coaching career in 2011. Anders' Lady Monarchs finished the regular season with an overall record of 18-2 and a perfect conference slate of 8-0 in the league. ODU spent much of the regular season ranked No. 1 nationally in the NFHCA Coaches' Poll. Currently ranked No. 2, Anders' squad has defeated eight top-10 ranked teams, including wins over then No. 1 North Carolina and Maryland.

## **Road Warriors**

The Lady Monarchs have dropped just two games all season, both in overtime and at home. Away from home, ODU is a perfect 8-0 on the road and 3-0 in neutral site contests. In those contests, the Monarchs have defeated six nationally ranked teams, including #1 North Carolina and #3 Maryland.

## **National Ranks**

ODU is ranked in the top-5 nationally in several categories this season including scoring margin (third), goals against average (fourth), points per game (fifth), goals per game (fifth) and scoring average (fifth). Senior Emma Batten ranks seventh nationally in points per game (2.5) and eighth nationally in goals per game (1.13). Meanwhile, senior goalie Devon Seifert is fourth nationally in goals against average (0.94).

## **CAA Honors**

Old Dominion senior forward Emma Batten was named 2011 Colonial Athletic Association field hockey Player of the Year in a vote by the league's head coaches.

ODU also swept the other top field hockey honors from the conference. Lady Monarch senior back Stephanie Kratzer was selected as CAA Defensive Player of the Year, while teammate Kelsey Smither was named CAA Rookie of the Year. Old Dominion's Beth Anders garnered CAA Coach of the Year honors.

Batten transitioned very well to ODU after playing three seasons as at the University of Bath in the United Kingdom. The senior ranked fourth in the league with 19 goals and 43 points in the regular season. In addition, Batten tallied four game-winning scores for the Lady Monarchs. In two games against defending national champion Maryland, Batten recorded a hat trick in each contest and led Old Dominion to victories in both games.

Kratzer is the seventh player in ODU history to capture Defensive Player of the Year honors since the CAA began presenting the honor 12 years ago. The senior back headlined an ODU defense that posted seven shutouts and held an additional seven opponents to a lone goal this season. Kratzer and the Lady Monarchs limited league foes to just five goals in eight conference contests this season. In her senior campaign, Kratzer has also added offensive support to the ODU charge, tying for second on the team with eight goals and ranking third with seven assists.

Smither becomes the eighth Lady Monarch to be tabbed Rookie of the Year. The midfielder/back was a mainstay in the starting lineup this season, as she started all 20 games for ODU in the regular season. Smither was also part of a balanced ODU offense, ranking second on the team and sixth in the league with nine assists while also netting four goals.

Old Dominion placed a league-high three players on the All-CAA first team in Batten, Kratzer and Smither.

The Lady Monarchs also placed three players on the All-CAA Second Team. Kati Nearhouse, Maartje van Rijswijk and goalkeeper Devon Seifert were named to the 12-person squad. Freshman Lydia Velzian joined Smither on the All-Rookie Team to represent ODU.

## HEAD COACH

*Beth Anders*

**H**ead coach Beth Anders, the first Division I coach to reach the 500 victory plateau, is in her 29th season at the helm of the Old Dominion field hockey program. After leading the Lady Monarchs to the 2011 CAA Championship and their 29th appearance in the NCAA Tournament, Anders has cemented her status as one of the elite coaches throughout intercollegiate athletics.

Anders has consistently made contributions throughout her life to the game of field hockey. As a player, she has participated at every level possible, including World Cup and Olympic events. Her coaching achievements are nothing short of impressive, including nine national collegiate titles, a bronze medal at the Pan American World Cup Games, and the distinction of being the winningest Division I field hockey coach in the country. Considered by many to be a pioneer of her sport, her resume is dotted with a long list of incredible achievements and monumental firsts.



At Old Dominion, Anders has mentored the field hockey team for over 28 years and has led her teams to perennial appearances in the NCAA tournament. Under her tutelage, the Lady Monarchs have achieved more honors than any other field hockey program in NCAA history. Among the most prestigious, Anders and her teams have brought the NCAA Championship trophy back to Norfolk an unprecedented nine times. In addition, the Lady Monarchs have won the CAA crown 15 of 21 times since joining the league in 1991.

In national coaching records, Anders has coached more games than any other active Division I coach, having been on the sidelines of 675 games over her 29-year career. She became the first Division I coach to reach the 400-career victory mark, a milestone only reached by seven other coaches in the sport. Anders posts an amazing .809 winning percentage and her 546 overall wins are the most of any Division I coach in history. Anders' coaching experience has not been limited to the Old Dominion sidelines. Internationally, Anders guided the 1991 U.S. National Team to the bronze medal and masterminded the qualifying campaign for the 1994 World Cup. In the summer of 2003, Anders was asked to take over the U.S. National Team and prepare them for the Pan American games in the Dominican Republic, where the team finished second.

The love affair between Anders and field hockey, however, goes well beyond her immediate reign in the coaching ranks. In 1980, Anders made the first of two Olympic field hockey teams as co-captain, but was forced - because of the boycott in Moscow - to wait four more years to realize her dream of winning a medal. In 1984 though, nothing stood in the way of Anders and her teammates as they cashed in on a bronze medal at the Los Angeles games. Anders, whose strong penalty corner was consistently clocked in the 90 m.p.h. range, nearly single handedly lifted the US team to victory, scoring eight of her team's nine goals in its five-game performance for an Olympic record that still stands today.

Throughout her international playing career, Anders played in over 100 international matches, was a participant in every World Cup from 1971-84, was on the National team from 1969-1980, and was the high scorer for the United States every year she was on the team. Anders participated in the first World Cup field hockey event to have both men's and women's competition at the same venue. She was one of just 24 field hockey coaches from around the world to be in attendance for a clinic during the 1998 World Cup in Holland.

After three NCAA titles as coach of Old Dominion and a bronze medal as a player and two-time captain with the Olympic team, Anders was named Olympic Athlete of the Year and Virginia Coach of the Year in 1984. Bringing the two realms of the sport together, Anders was recognized for her many contributions with an induction into the United States Field Hockey Coaches Association Hall of Fame.

Anders' love for her sport is infectious, as many former Old Dominion student-athletes have grown into respectable players and coaches in and around the world's field hockey family. A total of 15 former Old Dominion players coached by Anders have participated in the last four Olympics, which include a bronze medalist in NCAA all-time leading scorer Marina DiGiacomo for Argentina and a silver medalist for Maacha van der Vaart of the Netherlands at the Olympics in Athens, Greece in the summer of 2004. The list grew in the summer of 2008 as four Lady Monarchs - Tiffany Snow, Angie Loy, Dana Sensenig, and Caroline Nichols - were named to the U.S. Olympic Team for the 2008 Beijing Games.

Anders challenges her teams to not only excel on the field, but in the classroom as well. Since 1989, the Lady Monarch teams have had a G.P.A. of 3.0 or better. In 2009, her team boasted the highest GPA among all Division I field hockey programs, compiling a team average of 3.51. During the Fall of 2009 and 2010, the Lady Monarchs have had a total of 24 of its members named to the Dean's List. Certainly the epitome of Anders' student-athletes is Samantha Salvia, the school's first ever Rhodes Scholar who graduated in 1996 with a 4.0 GPA in environmental and civil engineering.

The key to Anders success on and off the field hockey field seems to be her love for and dedication to the game. Her development of the Futures Program during her national coaching stint in 1993 and her active mentoring of the field hockey youth are just two examples of her will to succeed better than anyone in her vocation. A fine all-around athlete herself, Anders was a four-time All-College field hockey and lacrosse player before graduating from Ursinus College with a B.S. degree in health and physical education. The Norristown, Pennsylvania Native was also selected to the national collegiate basketball team and won the intercollegiate squash championship in 1970.

Anders is the daughter of Stanley and the late Alice Anders. She has one brother and enjoys fitness, golf, tennis, reading, and creative teaching tools. She also has authored three books, *Field Hockey: Steps to Success* originally published in 1999 and updated for a 2008 release and *Lessons in Field Hockey* released in 1996.

An avid golfer, Anders resides in Norfolk.
