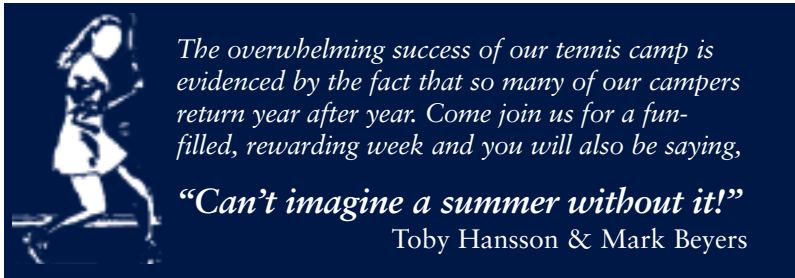

INSTRUCTION

The camp is open to any and all entrants (limited only by number, age, grade level and/or gender.) Whether this is your first time to hit a tennis ball or you’ve competed on a tournament level, this camp is designed for you.

OBJECTIVES:

- Sportsmanship
- Stroke analysis—covering all shots of tennis
- Strategy and tactics—doubles and singles
- Footwork and mobility drills
- Consistency and accuracy

The same coaching and teaching techniques that have brought the Rebel tennis program national recognition are used with each camper. The format is a combination of individual and group instruction presented in a positive learning atmosphere. In addition, Quickstart tennis is available for our younger campers.

FACILITIES

Headquarters for the camp is located at the Palmer-Salloum Tennis Center, one of the finest college sports facilities in the nation. Facilities available to campers include audiovisual rooms, recreational facilities, closed circuit TV, the Ole Miss Union and the Turner HPER Complex. On the Ole Miss campus, we have 15 outdoor courts.

RESIDENT CAMPERS

The fee for resident campers is \$550. Campers must pay a deposit of \$75 with the balance due at registration on the Ole Miss campus. The fee includes the cost of instruction, housing, meals, accident insurance and a T-shirt. Campers are housed in modern, air-conditioned University dormitories and are supervised 24 hours a day by trained personnel. Meals are served in the Ole Miss Union Food Court and local restaurants.

DAY CAMPERS

The fee for day campers is \$425. Campers must pay a deposit of \$75 with the balance due at registration on campus. The fee includes the cost of instruction, accident insurance, a T-shirt, first night’s dinner and lunch Monday-Wednesday at the Ole Miss Food Court.

ACCIDENT INSURANCE

Campers are insured while on the Ole Miss campus, there is a \$250 deductible. This is a supplemental policy and covers accidents only. If a camper is covered under an existing health insurance policy, the existing policy must be claimed upon first. Camp insurance pays any charges not covered by your insurance. If a camper is without any present health insurance coverage, the camp insurance pays 100% of all medical bills associated with a camp injury. Please inform camp personnel of any special medical conditions or drug allergies. The camp insurance does not include coverage to and from the Ole Miss campus.

Professional athletic trainers are on duty at all times during the camp.
