## Oregon State (11-7, 1-5) vs. UCLA (10-7, 3-2)

January 19, 2012 • 7:30 p.m. PT • Gill Coliseum • Corvallis, Ore.

**THE GAME:** Oregon State (11-7, 1-5 Pac-12) plays its first nationally-televised game of the season when it hosts UCLA (10-7, 3-2) at Gill Coliseum on Thursday at 7:30 p.m. looking to snap a 13-game losing streak to the Bruins.

**QUICKLY:** In national statistics, Oregon State is fifth in scoring (82.7), sixth in assists (17.6), sixth in free throws made (339), fourth in free throws attempted (489) and third in steals (10.11) ... Oregon State tied a school record with three 100-point games this season and has scored 90 or more points in eight games, the most in a season in school history ... The starting backcourt of Ahmad Starks and Jared Cunningham have each scored in double-figures in 10 consecutive games ... Cunningham leads the Pac-12 in scoring (17.6) and steals (2.9, third in the nation) ... Starks is second in the Pac-12 in steals (2.1) and three-point field goals made (45) ... Devon Collier (.630) and Angus Brandt (.568) are first and third, respectively, in the Pac-12 in field goal percentage ... Collier is shooting 78.3 percent (18-of-23) from the free throw line the past three games after shooting 57.3 percent (43-of-75) in the first 15 games ... Eric Moreland (1.8) leads the Pac-12 in blocked shots and is fifth in the conference in rebounding at 6.7 boards per game.

**OFFENSIVELY:** Oregon State is first in the Pac-12 and fifth in the nation in scoring at 82.7 points per game. The Beavers have NEVER led the conference in scoring (team statistics began in 1959-60). Oregon State's highest scoring average in a full season was 78.4 points per game in 1989-90.

**100+ SCORING GAMES:** Oregon State has scored 100 or more points three times this season, matching a team record for 100-point games in a season that had previously been accomplished in 1978-79, 1979-80 and 1988-89.

**90+ SCORING GAMES:** Oregon State has scored 90 or more points in a school-record eight games this season (1979-80 and 1988-89 teams did it six times). The Beavers scored at least 90 points in four consecutive games for just the second time in school history to equal the 1980-81 team and scored 90 or more points in consecutive conference games (92 vs. California, 101 vs. Stanford) for the first time since 1978-79 (97 vs. Arizona State, 116 vs. Arizona).

**80+ SCORING GAMES:** Oregon State has scored 80 or more points in 11 games this season, including streaks of four consecutive games on two occasions (OSU hadn't scored 80 or more points in four consecutive games since 1989-90). The Beavers scored 80+ points 10 times in Robinson's first three years and are now 18-3 under his watch when it happens, including a 9-2 record this season.

**LARGE MARGIN VICTORIES:** Oregon State has notched eight wins by at least 20 points, the most in a season since the 1981-82 team did it 10 times en route to a 25-5 record and Pac-10 title.

**MORE OFFENSIVE RANKINGS:** In addition to leading the Pac-12 in scoring, Oregon State is first in assists (17.6) and second in field goal percentage (.483). The 17.6 assists per game is the sixth best average in the nation and the Beavers' best since 1991-92 (17.7). Oregon State also leads the conference in free throws made (339, sixth in the nation) and free throws attempted (489, fourth in the nation).

**DEFENSIVELY:** Oregon State leads the Pac-12 and is third in the nation in steals at 10.11 per game. The Beavers led the Pac-10 in steals the past two seasons, including the nation's fifth best total (9.5) last season.

**DEFENSIVELY II:** Oregon State has forced a Pac-12 best 331 turnovers (18.4 per game) this season, including 20 or more turnovers in seven games. The Beavers have fewer turnovers than their opponent in 14 games this season and are second in the Pac-12 with a +3.8 turnover margin.

**DEFENSIVELY III:** Oregon State leads the Pac-12 in blocked shots at 4.9 per game, the 36th best average in the nation. The Beavers led the conference in blocks twice since they started keeping the statistic in 1978 (3.9 in 2004-05, 4.7 in 2005-06).

**MISCELLANEOUS STATISTICS:** The Beavers are outscoring their opponent in several specialty statistics, including points off turnovers (410-257), second chance points (245-233), points in the paint (678-522) and fast break points (194-81).

**STARTING FIVE:** Oregon State has used three different starting lineups this season, including the current lineup of Ahmad Starks, Jared Cunningham, Devon Collier, Eric Moreland and Angus Brandt in the most recent game against Arizona State. Starks, Cunningham and Brandt have started all 18 games this season. The Beavers used 11 different starting lineups last season, including six different groups through the first 19 games.

**JARED SCORING AND STEALING:** Jared Cunningham leads the Pac-12 in scoring (17.6) and steals (2.9) and could become just the sixth player to lead the conference in both categories since they started keeping steals statistics in 1978. Last season, Cunningham was ninth in the conference in scoring (14.2) and first in steals (2.8).

**JARED MOVING UP THE LIST:** Jared Cunningham is third in the nation at 2.89 steals per game with 52 on the season. He has 180 in his career and is now fifth on Oregon State's career steals list. Cunningham has a steal in all 18 games this season and has a consecutive game streak of 20 games dating back to last season.

**JARED FROM THE STRIPE:** Jared Cunningham has a knack for getting to the stripe as he's fifth in the nation in free throws made (116) and second in free throws attempted (152) to lead the Pac-12 in both categories by a wide margin. He holds six different Oregon State free throw records and is moving up the career lists in makes and attempts.

**STARKS FROM DEEP:** Ahmad Starks has knocked down 30 three-pointers the past nine games, including a career-best five three-pointers in four of those games. He leads the team in three-pointers made (45) and attempted (122) after doing the same last season as a freshman (42-for-130). He has knocked down a triple in 17 of the 18 games and has two or more in 13 games.

**STARKS FROM THE STRIPE:** Ahmad Starks had a streak of 20 consecutive free throws made end against Washington State, but has made 30-of-32 (93.8 percent) this season after knocking down 24-of-28 (85.7 percent) last season.

**STARKS STEALING:** Ahmad Starks has 37 steals this season, after coming away with 18 all of last season, and is second in the Pac-12 at 2.1 per game. The 37 steals ties him with Josh Tarver and Lamar Hurd for the 10th best total by a sophomore in Oregon State history (Cunningham leads the list with 85 set last year).

**BLOCK PARTY:** Eric Moreland (1.8) and Devon Collier (1.4) are first and fifth, respectively, in the Pac-12 in blocked shots per game. Moreland has already crushed Collier's Oregon State freshman blocked shots record with 33 thus far, including six swats against Stanford to tie a single-game school record. Collier has 25 this season, after setting the frosh record with 23 last season, and moved into the top-five on the sophomore list.

**COLLIER SCORING:** Devon Collier has scored in double-figures in 12 games this season, including a career-high 25 against Hofstra, and led the team in scoring against Vanderbilt and Towson, the first time he has done that in consecutive games in his career. He leads the Pac-12 in field goal percentage at 63.0 percent (85-of-135) and has made 50 percent of his shots or better in 15 of the 18 games.

**MORELAND CRASHING THE BOARDS:** After playing in just four games last season before suffering a season-ending injury (on a blocked shot attempt at Colorado), Eric Moreland has come back strong and leads the Beavers in rebounding at 6.7 per game, the fifth best average in the Pac-12. He has led the Beavers in rebounding in eight games, including double-figures in six of those, and has a team-high two double-doubles this season. With 120 boards this season, he needs just two more to break into the Oregon State top-10 freshman rebounding list.

**EVERY SHOT IN THE BAG:** Angus Brandt is third in the Pac-12 in field goal percentage at 56.8 percent (63-of-111) and makes shots in a variety of ways, including right-handed and left-handed, inside and out. He scored in double-figures in four consecutive games, the longest streak of his career, including a career-best 21 against Howard. He is also shooting 45.5 percent (15-of-33) from three-point land, the best percentage on the team of anyone with more than six attempts.

**ROBERTO BACK IN FORM:** Roberto Nelson has regained his form after suffering an anterior/posterior talo-fibular sprain in his left ankle right before the season started. He scored in double-figures in seven consecutive games, averaging 15.7 points during that stretch, after averaging 4.8 points in the first five games of the season. He also had back-to-back 20-point games for the first time in his career.

**ROBERTO FROM DEEP:** Roberto Nelson hit three-pointers on back-to-back-to-back possessions against Illinois-Chicago and made back-to-back three-balls against Stanford without a shoe when it was knocked off in the key. After starting the season 3-for-13 from beyond the arc, he has made 25-of-58 (43.1 percent) three-point attempts, including 21-of-44 (47.7 percent) in the past 10 games.

**MAGIC BURTON THE ICEMAN:** The versatile Joe Burton said he learned his passing skills by watching old NBA games. He used those skills to lead the team in assists in seven games this season, including a career-high 11 dimes against Hofstra and nine against Portland State. He is 13th in the Pac-12 in assists at 3.2 per game and is the only non-guard among the top-15 players on the list.

**BURTON FROM THE STRIPE:** If there was one weakness in Joe Burton's game last season, it was his free throw shooting as he shot just 49 percent (35-of-71) from the line. But, like everything else, he worked hard on it during the summer and is shooting 66.7 percent (28-of-42) from the stripe this season.

**BACKCOURT HELP:** True freshman Challe Barton has played in 17 games this season to provide a rest for the starting backcourt of Jared Cunningham and Ahmad Starks. He is averaging 10 minutes per game and has played solid defense throughout the season.

**FROM WALK-ON TO THREE-TIME TEAM CAPTAIN:** Craig Robinson can't remember another playing doing it in college basketball history, but senior forward Kevin McShane joined the program as a walk-on and will leave it as a three-time team captain. He does all of the little things on the court to help the Beavers that don't always show up in the box score and was provided a scholarship before the season for his senior campaign.

**"FIRST TIME SINCE" AND "MOST SINCE" NOTES:** Oregon State has several "first time since" and "most since" notes this season that are included in the above copy. Here are some others:

- With Ahmad Starks (22), Angus Brandt (21) and Roberto Nelson (20) all scoring 20 points against Howard on Dec. 15, the Beavers had three players reach that mark for the first time since a win against Colorado in 2004 when Chris Stephens (27), Sasa Cuic (22) and Jason Fontenet (20) all hit the 20-point mark.
- Oregon State has had six players reach double-figures in scoring twice this season (Dec. 18 vs. Portland State and Jan. 7 vs. Stanford). Against the Vikings, Ahmad Starks (17), Angus Brandt (16), Jared Cunningham (15), Devon Collier (14), Roberto Nelson (14) and Eric Moreland all scored 10 or more and Cunningham (19), Nelson (19), Joe Burton (18), Collier (16), Starks (13) and Brandt (10) did the same against Stanford. It's the first time since Jan. 25, 2003 that it has happened when Jimmie Haywood (16), Brian Jackson (12), Philip Ricci (12), Floyd North III (12), J.S. Nash (11) and Lamar Hurd (10) combined for all but nine of the team's points in a 82-62 win over Washington.
- Oregon State had 27 assists on 40 made field goals in a 101-68 victory over Portland State on Dec. 18, the most since the team dished out 34 in a 116-78 win against UC San Diego on Nov. 25, 1997.
- In the Portland State game, Joe Burton (9) and Jared Cunningham (8) combined for 17 assists, the first time two Oregon State players had eight or more assists since March 2, 1991 when Charles McKinney (10) and Will Brantley (8) combined for 18 in a 91-69 win over Arizona State.
- Also in the Portland State game, the Beavers made a season-high 13 three-pointers, the most since it knocked down 14 against Howard on Dec. 20, 2008.
- Oregon State played its first quadruple-overtime in school history when it lost to Stanford, 103-101, on Jan. 7. The 204 combined points is the second-most in a game in Oregon State history. Loyola Marymount (117) and OSU (113) combined for 230 on Nov. 19, 1989.
- Oregon State set a single-game team record with 11 blocked shots against Stanford. The Beavers had 10 blocks in three previous games (vs. Texas-Pan American, 12/28/05; vs. Oregon, 1/30/99; vs. College of Notre Dame, 12/30/98).
- Joe Burton (18 points, 10 rebounds) and Devon Collier (16 points, 11 rebounds) both notched double-doubles against Stanford, the first time since Omari Johnson (19 points, 10 rebounds) and Daniel Deane (13 points, 10 rebounds) did the same against Nebraska on Dec. 13, 2008.
- Oregon State lost back-to-back overtime games (Jan. 7 vs. Stanford, Jan. 12 at Arizona) for just the second time in school history and the first time since it fell to Washington State in OT on consecutive nights in 1938.

## HEAD COACH CRAIG ROBINSON

Craig Robinson enters his fourth year at the helm of the Oregon State men's basketball team with a full roster of players he recruited and several marquee wins during his first three seasons as he continues to rebuild the Beavers historic program.

In his third season at Oregon State, Robinson led the Beavers to their first win over a Top 25 team (vs. No. 20 Washington) and first victory in the Pac-10 Tournament (vs. Stanford) since 2006. Oregon State also defeated Arizona to open conference play 2-0 for just the second time since 1992-93, its third consecutive win over a Wildcat team that eventually came within a basket from a trip to the Final Four.

Defensively, the Beavers used their 1-3-1, 2-3 and matchup zones, with some man-to-man mixed in, to be among the top teams in the nation in steals all season. Sophomore guard Jared Cunningham shattered Oregon State's sophomore steals record of 72 set by legendary Gary Payton in 1987-88 with 85 swipes. Cunningham was named to the All-Pac-10 Second Team and Pac-10 All-Defensive Team and also joined Payton as the only Oregon State players to make the Pac-10 All-Tournament Team.

Several freshmen had impact seasons, as Devon Collier broke the Beavers freshman single-season blocked shots record (23), Ahmad Starks made the third most three-pointers (42) by a freshman in school history and Roberto Nelson scored the most-ever points by a Beaver frosh (34) in a game.

For the third consecutive year under Robinson's watch, Oregon State players earned Pac-10 All-Academic honors as Angus Brandt and Rhys Murphy were both named to the First Team, to join Roeland Schaftenaar who was a two-time Pac-10 All-Academic recipient.

In his second year, Robinson guided Oregon State to a tie for fifth-place in the Pacific-10 Conference, the highest finish for the Beavers since 2004-05. The Beavers finished conference play with an 8-10 record, which tied for their most Pac-10 wins since 1992-93, and made a second consecutive postseason appearance in the College Basketball Invitational.

Robinson's second season also saw Oregon State capture a number of marquee wins, most notable of which were season sweeps of Arizona and Oregon. Oregon State's win at Arizona was its first there since 1983 and the win in Eugene was the first for the Beavers since 1993.

Seth Tarver was honored as the Pac-10 Defensive Player of the Year and Calvin Haynes was named to the All-Pac-10 Second Team after Robinson's second season.

In his first season at Oregon State, Robinson helped lead a remarkable turnaround that culminated in the Beavers capturing the College Basketball Invitational title with a best-of-three series win over UTEP. With the championship, the Beavers captured their first postseason men's basketball title in school history.

Oregon State finished the season with an 18-18 record and the plus-12 win total from the previous year ranked No. 3 in the country. The 18 wins were the most for Oregon State since 1989-90 and earned Robinson the District IX Coach of the Year by the United States Basketball Writers Association.

Along the way, Oregon State won seven Pac-10 games and swept the season series from California and Stanford, marking the first time since the 1989-90 season the Beavers have swept the two schools in the same year. The seven conference wins were the most for the program since 2004-05.

The fourth-year coach has also seen success on the recruiting trail as the Beavers have added numerous top-ranked recruits in his first three signing classes. The 2009-10 class signed by Robinson is one of the most decorated in program history and was ranked in the top 25 in the nation by several recruiting services.

Prior to joining Oregon State, Robinson spent two years as the head coach at Brown, leading a revival of the Bears program that he guided to a school-record 19 victories in his final season. In his second year at Brown, Robinson led the Bears to their fourth-ever postseason tournament. Robinson's team posted an 11-3 Ivy League mark, second best in school history, and good for second place in the conference. Robinson won more games (30) in his first two years than any other head coach in Brown basketball history.

Robinson made an immediate impact on the Brown basketball team in his first year at the program and was named Ivy League Men's Basketball Coach of the Year by BasketballU.com. He guided the Bears to an improved 11-18 mark and 6-8 in the Ivy League to finish fifth in the conference. The Bears had a stunning 51-41 victory over Providence College and limited the Friars to 14 second-half points and 18-percent shooting from the floor in the second half (4-of-22) and also held NCAA-bound Michigan State to 45 points, its lowest point total of the season.

Prior to Brown, Robinson worked at Northwestern, where he spent six seasons with the Wildcats under head coach Bill Carmody (former head coach at Princeton). Robinson's relationship with Carmody dates to the 1982-83 season when, as senior captain, he led Princeton to the second round of the NCAA Men's Basketball Tournament, Carmody's first year as an assistant coach with the Tigers.

At Northwestern, Robinson developed and implemented his local, national and international recruiting technology. He was an integral part of Northwestern's dramatic turnaround, helping the Wildcats to the most wins in a four-year period in school history at the time with 57 victories from the 2001-2002 to the 2004-2005 seasons. Robinson also helped Northwestern finish ninth in the nation in scoring defense (58.8 points per game) in 2005-2006.

A 1983 graduate of Princeton with an AB (Arts of a Bachelor degree) in Sociology, Robinson is considered one of the top players in Ivy League history. He ranks fourth on Princeton's all-time scoring list with 1,441 points and led the Ivy League in field goal percentage in 1982 (.577) and 1983 (.642).

Robinson was also the league's first two-time honoree as Ivy League Player of the Year, sharing the honor in 1982 before winning it outright in 1983. He played under legendary Princeton coach Pete Carrill, leading the Tigers to two NCAA Men's Basketball Tournament appearances during his tenure (1981 and 1983). His 16 rebounds in a NCAA tournament win over Oklahoma State in 1983 ranks fifth in the Ivy League record book for NCAA games.

After graduating from Princeton with a degree in sociology, Robinson was drafted by the Philadelphia 76ers in the fourth round of the 1983 NBA draft. He played two seasons with the Manchester (England) Giants of the European Basketball League. He also served as the assistant to the general manager and public relations officer for Manchester.

Robinson began his coaching career as an assistant coach at the Illinois Institute of Technology from 1988-90. He was responsible for offense implementation, game strategy, recruiting and advance scouting. He was also the head coach at the University of Chicago High School in 1999-2000.

Robinson, who also has a MBA in Finance from the University of Chicago Graduate School of Business (1992), took a hiatus from coaching and went into private business in 1990.
