Oregon State (14-17, 4-14) vs. Colorado (20-10, 10-8)

March 13, 2013 • 2:30 p.m. PT • MGM Grand Garden Arena • Las Vegas, Nev.

THE GAME: Oregon State looks to make another run in the Pac-12 Tournament when it faces Colorado for the second time in five days. The first-round matchup begins at 2:30 p.m. on Wednesday at the MGM Grand Garden Arena.

QUICKLY: Oregon State has three Pac-12 Tournament wins the past two years, including the biggest upset in tournament history ... Roberto Nelson became the first Oregon State player since Gary Payton in 1990 to lead the Pac-12 in scoring in league play ... Joe Burton joined Devon Collier and Nelson in the 1,000-point club when he hit the milestone with his signature hook shot at Colorado ... Burton became the first player in Oregon State history with at least 1,000 points, 700 rebounds and 300 assists ... Ahmad Starks needs 17 points to reach the 1,000-point mark ... Eric Moreland is second in the Pac-12 in rebounding (10.5), blocked shots (2.4) and double-doubles (11) ... Challe Barton is shooting 40.7 percent (11-for-27) from beyond the arc since as a starter ... Nelson was named All-Pac-12 Honorable Mention and Moreland was named Pac-12 All-Defensive Honorable Mention ... The Beavers are on pace to lead the Pac-12 in three-point percentage for the first time in school history.

PAC-12 TOURNAMENT NOTES: Oregon State is the No. 12 seed and opens the tournament against No. 5-seed Colorado at 2:30 p.m. on Wednesday:

- This is the lowest-ever seed for Oregon State. The previous low was No. 10 in 2008.
- Oregon State's last five wins in the Pac-12 Tournament have come as the lower seed.
- The Beavers won three tournament games the past two years. The only other time they won three games in back-to-back years was 1988 (80-61 vs. Washington; 74-68 vs. Washington State in overtime) and 1989 (79-66 vs. California).
- The Beavers pulled off the biggest upset in tournament history last year when they defeated No. 1-seed Washington, 86-84, as the No. 9 seed.
- The Beavers are 8-13 all-time in Pac-12 tournament games; Colorado is 4-0.
- This will be the second time Oregon State opens the tournament against a team it played in the final regular-season game. The other time was 2010 when the Beavers lost to Washington in the regular-season finale and again in the first round of the tournament.
- Gary Payton (1988 and 1989) and Jared Cunningham (2011 and 2012) each made the All-Tournament Team two times.

vs. COLORADO: Oregon State and Colorado meet for the 13th time in history with the Buffaloes holding an 8-4 advantage. This will be the first-ever meeting between the two teams at a neutral site. The Beavers beat the Buffs, 64-58, this past Saturday in the season finale. It was the first time in seven tries Oregon State defeated Colorado in Boulder and the first time in 10 games the Beavers won this season when trailing at halftime.

FAST BREAK: Oregon State is 14-2 this season when leading with five minutes to play; 0-14 when trailing ... The Beavers are 13-8 when leading at halftime; 1-9 when trailing ... Oregon State is 4-0 when shooting 50 percent or better from the field; 0-5 when shooting less than 40 percent ... The Beavers are 6-0 when scoring more than 80 points; 4-12 when scoring less than 70.

THREE DOWN, ONE TO GO: Devon Collier, Roberto Nelson and Joe Burton have all reached the 1,000-point mark this season, with Collier scoring his 1,000th career point against Colorado on Feb. 10 (on a tip in of his own miss), Nelson hitting the mark at Oregon on Feb. 28 (on a breakaway layup) and Burton reaching the milestone at Colorado on March 9 (on his signature hook shot). Ahmad Starks needs just 17 points to join his teammates in the 1,000-point club. If it happens, it will be the first time in school history a team has four 1,000-point scorers. One Oregon State team had three, the 1980-81 squad that was ranked No. 1 in the nation, and four teams featured two.

BURTON MAKES HISTORY: Joe Burton became the first player in Oregon State history to have at least 1,000 points, 700 rebounds and 300 assists, as he currently sits with 1,005 points, 728 boards and 312 dimes. Only four other players in school history grabbed more than 700 boards and none of them reached even the 200-assist mark.

ROBERTO SETS SCORING MARK: Roberto Nelson became the first Oregon State player since Gary Payton in 1990 to lead the Pac-12 in scoring in conference play. Nelson averaged 19.1 points in 18 conference games (Jahii Carson of Arizona State was second at 17.8) with 111 field goals, 30 triples and 91 free throws for 343 points. Nelson leads the team with 26 double-figure scoring games, including a streak of 16 in a row. The Glove averaged a ridiculous 25.2 points per game when he led the league in 1990.

ROBERTO'S SCORING IMPROVEMENT: Roberto Nelson came off the bench in all 36 games last season and averaged 9.3 points per game. He moved into the starting lineup this season and has responded with a scoring average of 17.7 per game, which is fifth in the Pac-12 and the second-biggest increase in the conference from last year. Here's a look at the biggest scoring improvement among players in the Pac-12 in all games:

1. Dwight Powell, Stanford..... +9.3 (5.8 in 2011-12; 15.1 in 2012-13)
2. Roberto Nelson, Oregon State..... +8.4 (9.3 in 2011-12; 17.7 in 2012-13)

4. Spencer Dinwiddie, Colorado..... +5.4 (10.0 in 2011-12; 15.4 in 2012-13)
5. Askia Booker, Colorado +3.5 (9.1 in 2011-12; 12.6 in 2012-13)

BURTON ON THE VERGE OF ANOTHER RECORD: Joe Burton will play in his 130th career game when Oregon State faces Colorado in the first round of the Pac-12 Tournament on Wednesday. That will tie him with Josh Tarver for the most games played in Oregon State history. Burton moved into fifth on Oregon State's career rebounding list earlier this season and trails only four players who combined to earn All-America recognition seven times, including three players who have their Oregon State jersey retired (Counts, Green and Johnson).

BURTON LOOKING TO MAKE IT THREE IN A ROW: Joe Burton leads the team in assists and has a chance to lead the team in that category for the third straight year. Other Oregon State players to lead the team in assists three years include George Tucker (1975-77), Dwayne Allen (1978-80), Gary Payton (1987-90), Charles McKinney (1991-93) and Deandra Tanner (1999-01). Payton is the only player to lead the team four times.

MORELAND CLIMBING REBOUNDS LISTS: Eric Moreland has grabbed 294 rebounds this season, the highest total by an Oregon State player since Mel Counts set the single-season record with 489 in 1963-64. The 294 boards puts him seventh on Oregon State's single-season list and third on the sophomore list. Moreland is second in the Pac-12 and ninth in the nation with 10.5 rebounds per game. He could become just the 10th player in Oregon State history to average double-figure rebounds in a season, and the first since 1963-64 when Mel Counts averaged 16.9 boards per game.

MORELAND AND COLLIER'S OWN BLOCK PARTY: Eric Moreland (140) and Devon Collier (96) are second and sixth, respectively, on Oregon State's career blocks list, making them the best shot blocking tandem in school history. Collier set the freshman and sophomore records, only to see Moreland break both of them the following season. Moreland holds the single-season mark after swatting 69 shots a year ago and needs only two more this season to break his own record.

STARKS BECOMES ALL-TIME LEADER IN THREE-POINTERS: Ahmad Starks knocked down two three-pointers at Washington to become the all-time leader at Oregon State. Starks passed Chris Stephens and got the record in his 91st career game (Stephens played 119 career games) and on his 489th attempt (Stephens finished his career with 489 attempts).

STARKS CLIMBING THREE-POINT LIST ONCE AGAIN: Ahmad Starks has 62 triples this season to move him into fourth on Oregon State's single-season list and second on the school's junior list. He has a chance to lead the team in three-pointers for the third consecutive year. Other Oregon State players to lead the team three consecutive years are Gary Payton (1988-90), Charles McKinney (1991-93) and Chris Stephens (2004-06).

NELSON, STARKS FROM DEEP: Roberto Nelson and Ahmad Starks have combined to make 64.8 percent of Oregon State's three-pointers (116 of 179) and have attempted 59.1 percent of the team's shots from beyond the arc (287 of 486). The 116 three-pointers are the second most by a tandem in the Pac-12, trailing only Arizona State's duo of Jonathan Gilling and Evan Gordon (126). Nelson is fifth in the Pac-12 in three-point percentage at 40.6 percent (54-for-133), while Starks is seventh at 40.3 percent (62-for-154). The only Oregon State player to ever lead the conference in three-point percentage was Sasa Cacic in 2005-06 (.493, 36-73).

AN OREGON STATE FIRST?: Oregon State is first in the Pac-12 in three-point percentage at 36.8 percent (179-of-486). The Beavers have NEVER led the conference in that category since the statistic began in 1986-87. The school record for three-point percentage is 40.6 percent (97-for-239) in 1987-88.

SCHAFTENAAR FROM DEEP: Freshman Olaf Schaftenaar has firmly established himself as a long-range shooter as 97 of his 114 field goal attempts have been from beyond the arc. His percentage from three-point range is actually better than inside the arc, as he's shooting 30.9 percent (30-for-97) from deep compared to 23.5 percent (4-for-17) from in close. He has also only missed one of his 14 free throw attempts this season.

CHALLE PLAYING WELL AS A STARTER: Challe Barton is averaging 5.2 points and shooting 40.7 percent (11-for-27) from beyond the arc since being inserted into the starting lineup 10 games ago. He also has the first two double-figure scoring games of his career, including a career-high 15 points at Utah. Barton averaged 1.8 points and made only 1-of-9 shots from the three-point line in his 21 games as a reserve. Roberto Nelson has benefitted the most with Barton as the starter by averaging 20.5 points per game.

OH, SO CLOSE: Oregon State lost seven games by four points or less this season, with five of them coming in Pac-12 play. Three of the losses have been by one point (vs. Towson, at USC, vs. California), three have been by three points (vs. Alabama, vs. Washington State, at California) and one has been by four points (vs. Colorado). On the flip side, the Beavers have only one win in games decided by four points or less, a 67-66 victory at Washington State.

A LOOK AT BOTH HALVES: Oregon State had the halftime lead in 10 Pac-12 games, but were unable to hold it in losses to Oregon, Washington State, California, Colorado, Washington, Stanford and Oregon again. In those seven losses, the Beavers outscored their opponents 252-223 (36.0-31.9) in the first half, but were outscored 309-227 (44.1-32.4) in the second frame. The biggest discrepancy was free throws, as opponents went a combined 21-for-34 in the first 20 minutes, but 83-for-106 after the break. If the Beavers were able to hold those leads, they would be sitting at 10-6 in Pac-12 play instead of 3-13.

STARTING LINEUPS: Coach Robinson has used eight different starting lineups this season, with Roberto Nelson being the only player to start all 31 games. Here is a look at Oregon State's different starting fives this season and the record with that lineup:

RECORDS UPDATE: Four Oregon State records have been equaled this season, including single-game team blocked shots (11 vs. Montana State), single-game individual blocked shots (6 by Eric Moreland vs. Towson), single-game individual three-pointers made (7 by Ahmad Starks at Kansas) and a perfect percentage from the free throw line in a game with a minimum of 10 attempts (10-for-10 by Roberto Nelson at USC).

MISSING ANGUS & GOMIS: Senior center Angus Brandt and sophomore forward Daniel Gomis both had surgery and will miss the remainder of the season. Brandt suffered an isolated tear of the ACL in his right knee against Purdue. He was averaging 11.3 points and 8.5 rebounds per game before the injury. Brandt will have to apply for a medical hardship from the Pac-12 office, which should be approved since he played in nine games or less during the first half of the season. Gomis had surgery on the left leg he broke two summers ago in his native Senegal and will redshirt this season.

BEAVERS SIGN TWO STUDENT-ATHLETES FOR 2013-14 SEASON: Hallice Cooke, a 6-foot-3, 185-pound guard from Union City, N.J., and Cheikh N'diaye, a 7-foot, 230-pound center from Carlsbad, Calif., signed National Letters of Intent to join the Oregon State men's basketball program for the 2013-14 season. Cooke attends St. Anthony High School and is ranked the 45th best guard in the nation by Rivals.com. N'diaye attends Army-Navy Academy and is ranked the 36th best center in the nation by ESPN.com.
