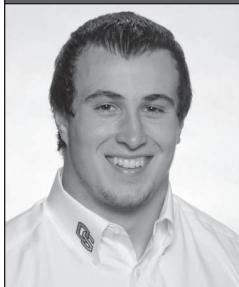

CAREER: (Juh-quizz) became the third Beaver to ever declare himself eligible for the NFL Draft, when he made the announcement Jan. 10, 2010 – joining Steven Jackson (2003) and Brandon Browner (2004) ... listed as a top Heisman Trophy candidate for the 2010 season ... 2010 Doak Walker Award semifinalist ... three-time Pac-10 Conference First Team ... Four-time Pac-10 Offensive Player of the Week ... 2008 Pac-10 Offensive MVP – the first ever freshman in Pac-10 history ... averaged 108.3 yards per game rushing for his career ... scored at least one rushing touchdown 20 of the last 24 games ... second all-time at OSU with 3,877 rushing yards ... one of eight players in Pac-10 history with three 1,000-yards rushing seasons ... sixth in the Pac-10 for career rushing ... third player in OSU history to account for 1,000 yards rushing and 1,000 yards receiving (Pat Chaffey and James Rodgers) ... second at OSU for career rushing touchdowns with 46 (Ken Simonton, 1998-01, 59) ... 19 career 100-yard rushing games; tied for second at OSU for a career – Ken Simonton had 26 ... third at OSU for career all-purpose yards with 4,933 ... third at OSU for career scoring with 312 points ... 25 straight starts, 35 for his career ... had just one fumble (at Vegas Bowl) in 952 touches ... 151 career receptions, the most ever by a Beaver running back ... career-long 74 yard run (TD) vs. Arizona State Oct. 2 ... the “wildcat” formation was implemented into the OSU offense, first unveiled Oct. 10, 2009 vs. Stanford – he lined up in the formation 33 times ... two touchdown passes out of the wildcat ... Ted Miller of ESPN.com ranked him the best player in the Pac-10 at the beginning of the 2010 season ... *Athlon Sports* and *SI.com* Pre-season First Team All-American ... 2008 Associated Press and Rivals.com third team All-American ... missed nearly all of the last three games of the 2008 season after suffering a shoulder injury at Arizona in the first quarter ... selected by the Atlanta Falcons in the fifth round of the 2011 NFL Draft ... inaugural Texas Associated Press Player of the Year in 2007 after leading Lamar Consolidated to its first ever state title ... Texas Sports Writers Association 4A Offensive Player of the Year in '07 ... rushed for 2,902 yards and 43 touchdowns as a senior – for his prep career he gained 8,245 yards, the sixth-highest total in the state ... First Team EA Sports High School All-American and 2008 *Parade* All-American ... Old Spice Red Zone and Built Ford Tough Player of the Year for Texas ... became a father Sept. 4, 2010 with the birth of his daughter Channing ... brother, James Rodgers, is a standout receiver and kick returner at Oregon State.

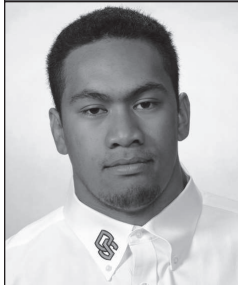

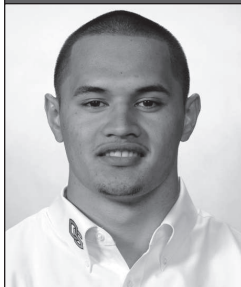

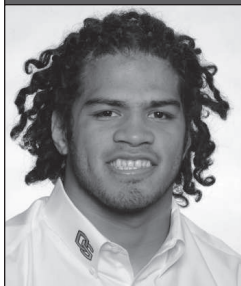
