## OHIO STATE LACROSSE THIS WEEK

The No. 19-ranked Ohio State men's lacrosse team (1-2, 0-0 ECAC) hosts No. 9 Penn State (2-1, 0-0 CAA) at 1 p.m. Saturday in Ohio Stadium in a Creator's Trophy game.

## OHIO STADIUM, PARKING DETAILS

Entrance for all fans attending the game will be through Gate 7, with the ticket office located near Gate 7. Parking will be free in lots surrounding Ohio Stadium. The OHSAA State Wrestling Championships are being held in the Schottenstein Center Saturday and will create extra traffic in the area. Fans should plan for extra travel time to reach the parking lots and Ohio Stadium for the lacrosse game.

## BUCKEYE NOTES TO KNOW

- Ohio State and Penn State have met each year since 2003, with the Buckeyes 5-6 during the stretch. In the last seven games, Ohio State has a 5-2 ledger against the Nittany Lions, including a 10-9 overtime win last season.
- The Buckeyes and Nittany Lions are battling for the Creator's Trophy, a competition between the three Big Ten schools that currently sponsor men's lacrosse. Penn State eliminated Michigan from the title with a win earlier this year. A team must be 2-0 vs. its foes to win the crown. Ohio State is the defending champion after road wins at Penn State and Michigan last year.
- Ohio State and Penn State will meet at conference foes next season, as the Big Ten adds men's lacrosse beginning in 2015. The Buckeyes and Nittany Lions will be joined by Michigan, Maryland, Rutgers and Johns Hopkins.
- Junior Jesse King was named to the Tewaaraton Award Watch List Thursday. The Buckeyes' leading scorer with nine goals and 13 points, he is on a 25-game point streak with a 49-33-82 line in the stretch.
- Ohio State is playing its 13th game in Ohio Stadium since 2008. The team is also slated to host Michigan April 12 in the Showdown in the Shoe, along with Air Force April 19, in Ohio Stadium. The Buckeyes last played in The Shoe May 12, 2013, a 16-6 win over Towson in the first round of the NCAA Tournament.
- Jake Withers was named ECAC co-Rookie of the Week after winning 14-of-21 faceoffs and picking up 11 groundballs vs. Marquette.

## THE CREATOR'S TROPHY

The game between Ohio State and Penn State is part of the competition for the Creator's Trophy, an annual traveling award among the three Big Ten schools that sponsor men's lacrosse (Ohio State, Penn State, Michigan) that was established in 2012. The trophy is awarded when a team is 2-0 against the other schools; on years the teams are all 1-1, the trophy will not be awarded.

Ohio State is the defending champion after a 10-9 overtime win at Penn State and 17-8 victory at Michigan last year. The Nittany Lions, who claimed the first title in 2012, opened Creator's Trophy competition this season with a 22-7 win at home over the Wolverines. The Buckeyes host the Wolverines April 12 in the Showdown in the Shoe in Columbus.

## BUCKEYE BIO

Ohio State opened its 2014 campaign with overtime losses away from Columbus, falling 10-9 in triple overtime at No. 11 Johns Hopkins Feb. 9 and 12-11 in overtime to Massachusetts in the Moe's Southwest Grill Classic in Jacksonville, Fla., Feb. 16. The team defeated Marquette, 11-7, inside Woody Hayes Athletic Center Saturday for its first victory of 2014.

Junior Jesse King leads the Buckeyes with nine goals and 13 points, with classmate Turner Evans first with nine assists and second with 11 points. Sophomore Carter Brown is third with 10 points, ranking second with five assists and tying senior Adam Trombley for second with five goals each, followed by junior Reagan Comeault with four. In all, nine Buckeyes have at least one goal, six have at least one assist and nine have at least one point. Senior goalie Greg Dutton, who has started all

three games and has 29 saves, is second with 11 groundballs. Freshman Jake Withers has a team-best 14 groundballs and 17 faceoff wins, including 14 last week vs. Marquette. Sophomore Robby Haus is first with seven caused turnovers, followed by senior Dominic Imbordino with six and senior Joe Meurer with five.

#### THE SHOE

The game vs. Penn State is the first of three scheduled games for the Buckeyes inside Ohio Stadium. The team is also slated to take on Michigan April 12 (Showdown in the Shoe) and Air Force April 19 in Ohio Stadium. Ohio State has played 12 games in The Shoe since 2008, with a 5-7 ledger in those contests. Last year, the Buckeyes hosted just one game in Ohio Stadium, downing Towson in the first round of the NCAA Tournament, 16-6, May 12, 2013. The Buckeyes took on Penn State in Ohio Stadium March 3, 2012, a 5-2 win for the Nittany Lions.

#### OHIO STATE VS. PENN STATE

Ohio State and Penn State are meeting for the 12th year in a row, starting in 2003. Three of the last four matchups have gone to overtime, with Ohio State winning all three overtime contests, including a 10-9 victory last season in University Park, a triple overtime road victory in 2011 and an overtime win in 2010. The Buckeyes lead the Nittany Lions, 5-2, in the last seven meetings, with a 3-2 mark under sixth-year head coach Nick Myers. Overall, this is the 18th matchup between the teams in a series that dates to 1979.

The teams will face off as league foes beginning in 2015 when men's lacrosse is added as an official Big Ten Conference sport. They will be joined in the league by Michigan, Maryland, Rutgers and Johns Hopkins (affiliate member).

#### OHIO STATE VS. PENN STATE IN 2013

Then-No. 13/16-ranked Ohio State rallied from a six-goal halftime deficit to defeat No. 8 Penn State in overtime, 10-9, March 2, 2012 at Penn State Lacrosse Stadium in University Park, Pa. Buckeye Jesse King led the Buckeyes with three goals and five points and netted the gamewinner with just :00.2 seconds left in the first overtime period. The teams were deadlocked at 2 after the first quarter before Penn State outscored the Buckeyes, 6-0, in the second quarter for an 8-2 halftime lead. Ohio State then posted its own 6-0 quarter to tie the game at 8-all after 45 minutes. Ohio State took its first lead of the game at 7:01 of the fourth quarter but the Nittany Lions tied the game with 4:04 left in regulation. King gave Ohio State the win on the Buckeyes' fourth shot of overtime. Ohio State outscored Penn State, 8-1, in the second half and overtime and outshot the Nittany Lions, 21-10, in the final 34 minutes, including 9-1 in the fourth quarter and 4-0 in overtime.

Turner Evans had a hat trick and assist for four points, while Logan Schuss had three points on two goals and an assist. David Planning and Carter Brown each had a goal and an assist for two points. Greg Dutton made eight saves in the Buckeye cage. Darius Bowling won eight faceoffs for Ohio State and had a team-best six groundballs, along with two caused turnovers. Joe Meurer had a team-high three caused turnovers, as Ohio State had nine caused turnovers as a team.

#### NITTANY LION NOTES

Penn State is 2-1 this season, topping Michigan and Notre Dame and falling in overtime to Loyola. The squad is averaging 13.67 goals per game and allowing 8.67 an outing. Penn State has put 39.3 shots on goal per game and allowed 31.3 an outing.

Shane Sturgis leads Penn State with 14 goals, four assists and 18 points this season. TJ Sanders is second with nine goals and 10 points. In all, 13 Nittany Lions have scored at least one goal. Drake Kreinz is first on the team with 27 groundballs and has won 39-of-68 (.574) faceoffs. Goalie Austin Kaut has an 8.25 goals-against average and .532 save percentage.

#### LAST TIME OUT - OHIO STATE 11, MARQUETTE 7

Saturday inside Woody Hayes Athletic Center, Ohio State defeated Marquette, 11-7, in front of a sellout crowd of 916 inside Woody Hayes Athletic Center. The Buckeyes led 4-2 after the first quarter and 7-4 at halftime en route to the nonconference win over the Golden Eagles. Each team scored once in the third quarter for an 8-5 Buckeye lead after 45 minutes. Marquette outshot Ohio State, 29-26, in the game.

In the victory, Buckeye junior and leading scorer Jesse King had four goals and added two assists for a career-high tying six points, while sophomore Carter Brown had a team-high three assists and added a goal for a four-point day. Senior Adam Trombley and junior David Planning each scored twice. Freshman Jake Withers won 14 faceoffs and picked up 11 groundballs, while senior goalie Greg Dutton made nine saves and senior Joe Meurer caused three turnovers.

#### KING NAMED TO TEWAARATON WATCH LIST

Junior midfielder Jesse King was named to the Tewaaraton Award Watch List, which includes the Top 50 players from Divisions I, II and III. The Tewaaraton Award annually honors the top male and top female college lacrosse player in the United States. The selection committees are made up of top collegiate coaches and are appointed annually by the Tewaaraton Foundation.

Players not named to the initial list have several opportunities to play their way into a spot as the season progresses. Additions will be announced March 20 and April 10. On April 24, the field will be narrowed to 25 men's and 25 women's nominees. Nominees can be players on the watch lists or players not on the watch lists, effectively allowing for a third round of additions for players who earn a spot. Five men's and five women's finalists will be announced May 8 and will be invited to the May 29 ceremony in Washington.

King leads the ECAC with nine goals and 13 points this season and is third with 4.33 points per game. He carries a 26-game point streak, with 49 goals, 33 assists and 82 points, into the game vs. Penn State.

In his Buckeye career, King has 57 goals, 36 assists and 93 points in 35 games for the Scarlet and Gray. He has two six-point outings this season, including a five-goal game at Johns Hopkins.

#### WITHERS PICKS UP ECAC AWARD

Jake Withers was named ECAC co-Rookie of the Week Monday. He won 14-of-21 (.667) faceoffs and picked up 11 groundballs in the Buckeyes' victory over Marquette Saturday. After winning 50 percent (6-of-12) of his faceoffs in the first half to help the Buckeyes to a 7-4 halftime lead, Withers lost just one in the second half (8-1) as Ohio State limited Marquette to three goals. His 11 groundballs were the most for a Buckeye since Eric O'Brien had 10 in 2007.

#### IN THE POLLS

- In the national polls released Monday, Ohio State was ranked 19th by both the coaches in the USILA poll and in the Warrior Inside Lacrosse media poll.
- Six of Ohio State's 2014 regular-season opponents are ranked by USILA: Johns Hopkins (5), Denver (6), Notre Dame (11), Penn State (9), Massachusetts (13) and Fairfield (17). Bellarmine is receiving votes in the poll.
- In the IL poll, Johns Hopkins (7), Denver (5), Notre Dame (11), Penn State (10), UMass (13) and Fairfield (18) are all in the Top 20, with Bellarmine receiving votes.

#### BUCKEYE THIS AND THAT

- Junior Turner Evans is second on the team with 11 points, with a team-high nine assists. He is on an 11-game point streak (20g, 12a, 32p). Evans is sixth in the NCAA with 3.00 assists per game.

games, with a goal and three assists vs. Marquette, and is third on the team with 10 points. Brown has at least one point in each of his last eight games, with 13 goals, eight assists and 21 points in the streak.

- J.T. Blubaugh recorded the first goal for a Buckeye freshman this season when he tallied vs. Marquette Saturday.
- Ohio State has just one failed clear this year, converting 52-of-53 opportunities.
- The Buckeyes have 25 caused turnovers this season, while their opponents have 14. Robby Haus, with seven, leads the ECAC with 2.33 caused turnovers a game. Senior Dominic Imbordino is second in the league with 2.0 a game (6 caused turnovers) and senior Joe Meurer is fourth with 1.67 (5).

### MEURER SENIOR CLASS TOP 20 CANDIDATE

Senior defenseman Joe Meurer has been named one of 20 candidates for the 2014 Senior CLASS Award. To be eligible for the award, a student-athlete must be classified as an NCAA Division I senior and have notable achievements in four areas of excellence - community, classroom, character and competition.

The candidate class will be narrowed to 10 finalists midway through the regular season and those names will be placed on the official ballot. Ballots will be distributed through a nationwide voting system to media, coaches and fans, who will select one finalist who best exemplifies excellence in the four Cs of community, classroom, character and competition. The Senior CLASS Award winner will be announced during the 2014 NCAA Lacrosse Championships in Baltimore May 24-26.

Meurer, a native of Towson, Md., has started all three games for Ohio State this season at close defense. He was a 2014 Face-Off Yearbook Preseason First Team All-American after earning USILA Honorable Mention All-America and First Team All-ECAC accolades in 2013. Meurer started all 17 games a season ago, leading Ohio State with 18 caused turnovers, and helping the squad to a Top 15 national ranking in team defense (8.82 goals allowed per game). Voted team captain for 2014, he has played in 50 career games for the Scarlet and Gray and has 91 groundballs and 37 caused turnovers, along with two goals and 10 faceoff wins. Meurer was drafted by the Florida Launch in the second round of the 2014 Major League Lacrosse Collegiate Draft with the 10th overall pick, the second-highest pick in Ohio State history. A finance major, he is a three-time Ohio State Scholar-Athlete and two-time Academic All-Big Ten choice.

### AT THE HELM

Nick Myers, who agreed to a five-year contract extension over the summer, is in his sixth year at the helm of the Buckeyes and as a collegiate head coach. He has a career record of 44-35 and led Ohio State to just the second NCAA quarterfinal appearance in school history a season ago. Under Myers', Ohio State has had nine players garner USILA All-America honors, 21 earn all-conference nods and five collect conference player of the year accolades. Under his tutelage, members of the lacrosse program have earned 87 Academic All-Big Ten accolades, 124 Ohio State Scholar-Athlete awards and 27 Academic All-ECAC honors, along with the first five USILA Scholar All-America selections in program history.

A native of Kennebunk, Maine, Myers is a 2001 graduate of Springfield College, where he was the 2000 NEWMAC Player of the Year and a 2001 All-American, finishing his career with 221 points (including 91 as a senior). Myers began his coaching career as the volunteer assistant coach at Ohio State in 2002 and '03 before serving as an assistant coach at Butler for two years. He returned to the Ohio State sidelines as a full-time assistant in 2006, remaining in that position for three seasons until he was named Ohio State's 13th head coach in July 2008. Myers was on staff for the Buckeyes' first NCAA tournament appearance in 2003 as well as when the squad reached the NCAA quarterfinals in 2008.

### OHIO STATE 1ST IN ECAC COACHES POLL

The Ohio State men's lacrosse team was slotted first in the 2014 ECAC Lacrosse preseason poll, as voted by the conference coaches. The Buckeyes, who were 13-4 last season and reached the NCAA quarterfinals, are the defending league tournament champions.

Fairfield was second in the preseason coaches poll, followed by Air Force, Bellarmine and Michigan. The Top 4 teams in the regular-season standings earn a spot in the 2014 ECAC Tournament, which will be hosted by Ohio State May 1 and 3 at Jesse Owens Memorial Stadium in Columbus. The tournament winner receives the league's automatic berth into the NCAA tournament.

### LEADING THE WAY

Seniors goalie Greg Dutton and defenseman Joe Meurer were selected after a vote by the team to serve as captains of the 2014 Buckeye squad.

Dutton is a two-time Second Team All-ECAC selection and was a 2013 ECAC All-Tournament Team choice, backstopping the Buckeyes to the league tournament title and an NCAA berth. He was 16th nationally in goals-against average in 2013 (8.96) and had a .523 save percentage, while in 2012 he ranked in the Top 7 in the NCAA in both goals-against average (6.92) and save percentage (.575). Dutton has started 44 games as a Buckeye, with a career goals-against average of 8.11 and save percentage of .536, along with 25 wins.

Meurer was voted the team's Defensive MVP in 2013 when he was a USILA Honorable Mention All-American and a First Team All-ECAC selection. He started all 17 games a season ago in his first year playing close defense, leading Ohio State with 18 caused turnovers, and helping the squad to a Top 15 national ranking in team defense (8.82 goals allowed per game). He has played in 47 career games for the Scarlet and Gray and has 90 groundballs and 32 caused turnovers, along with two goals and 10 faceoff wins. Meurer, a finance major, is a two-time Academic All-Big Ten choice and a three-time Ohio State Scholar-Athlete. He was drafted by the Florida Launch in the second round of the 2014 MLL Collegiate Draft with the No. 10 pick, the second-highest draft choice in program history.

### OHIO STATE VS. MICHIGAN - 2014 SHOWDOWN IN THE SHOE SET FOR APRIL 12

Tickets for the 2014 Showdown in the Shoe are on sale now. The Buckeyes will host Michigan at 11 a.m. April 12 in Ohio Stadium, preceding the Ohio State football team's 2014 LifeSports Spring Game presented by Nationwide. General admission tickets, which include both the lacrosse and football games, are \$12 for adults if bought in advance; \$20 (cash only) if purchased day of game.
