## Ohio State at 2012 NCAA Championships

**COLUMBUS, Ohio** - Ten members of the 10-0 Ohio State women's swimming and diving team travel to Auburn this week for the NCAA Championships at the James E. Martin Aquatics Center. The competition begins Thursday.

The 14th-ranked Buckeyes, who have been ranked as high as 13th this season, won both the Pitt and Ohio State Invitationals and are 10-0 in dual meet action. Ohio State finished third in the Big Ten championships for the second straight year.

Along with two-event Big Ten diving champion Bianca Alvarez, nine Ohio State swimmers are competing at NAAs:

- Kelly Ann Baird: 1650 free
- Phoebe Cater: 400 free relay
- Emily Creran: 200 back
- Megan Detro: 100 free; 200 medley relay; 400 free relay
- Shannon Draves: 100 fly; 200 fly; 200 medley relay
- Kelsey Moran: 100 back; 200 medley relay
- Alex Norris: 400 free relay
- Angela Severn: 200 medley relay
- Michelle Williams: 100 free; 400 free relay

The list of nine swimming invitees continues a steady climb for the Buckeyes in NCAA participation. In 2009, Coaches Dorenkott and Williams' first season at Ohio State, the Buckeyes had no NCAA swimming qualifiers. That number improved to three competitors in 2010, five in 2011 and now, nine this season.

### Big Ten History

Ohio State has won five Big Ten championships; those were captured consecutively between 1982-86 under Coach Jim Montrella. Ohio State also has won 79 Big Ten swimming, diving and relay titles. The breakdown:

- 47 swimming champions; last was Shannon Draves (200 butterfly) in 2012;
- 24 diving champions; last were Bianca Alvarez (1-meter and 3-meter); and Cheyenne Cousineau (platform) in 2012;
- 12 relay wins; last came in 1991 (400 and 800 free relays).

## CSCAA Rankings

Ohio State ranks 14th nationally in the latest Top 25 poll of Division I women's teams for 2011-12 as conducted by the College Swimming Coaches Association of America, up three spots from its previous ranking. California is the top team in the latest poll. The top ranked Big Ten team is Indiana at No. 12; other Big Ten schools ranked include Minnesota (15), Michigan (17), Wisconsin (19), and Penn State (20).

## Victory Against Michigan

Ohio State dominated its dual meet with rival Michigan 164.50-132.50, defeating the Wolverines for just the third time in four decades.

In the 50 freestyle, Megan Detro won in a time of 23.16; fellow Buckeye Michelle Williams was third (23.51). In the 100 free, Williams was the winner (50.25) with Detro placing second (50.84). Ohio State finished one-two in the 200 freestyle, behind the performances of Alex Norris (1:49.45) and Phoebe Cater (1:49.87); Lisa Narum (1:51.60) was fourth in that race.

Buckeyes Angela Severn (1:03.55) and Catherine Eitel (1:03.59) were one-two in the 100 breaststroke, with Ashley Vance finishing fourth (1:04.85). Severn was the winner of the 200 breaststroke (2:20.26), followed by OSU's Lisa Narum (2:20.71) in second.

Junior Kelsey Moran captured the 100 backstroke in a time of 55.24; OSU's Emily Creran (56.79) and Lauren Massey (57.00) were fourth and fifth in that race. Michigan's Ashley Cohagen was the winner in the 200 back (2:00.01), followed by Buckeyes Creran (2:01.92) and Massey (2:02.68).

Shannon Draves of Ohio State and Caitlin

Dauw of Michigan tied for the fastest time in the 200 butterfly, both swimming that race in 1:58.87. Ohio State's Darcy Fishback (2:01.44) took third. Dauw was the winner of the 100 fly (53.77), with Draves second (54.43) and Fishback third (56.33) in that race.

Michigan's Adrienne Bicek won the 1000 freestyle (9:51.62); Ohio State swimmers Kelly Ann Baird (9:54.39), Natalie Nichols (10:01.47) and Kelly Titus (10:02.04) finished second, third and fourth in that event. Bicek also won the 500 free in a time of 4:53.18. OSU's Alex Norris was second (4:53.89) in the 500, with Titus placing third (4:55.05) and Baird fourth (4:55.55). Val Barthelemy of Michigan won the 200 IM (2:07.84)

Buckeye Bianca Alvarez won the three-meter diving competition with a score of 360.23; her teammates Cheyenne Cousineau (328.50), Kristen Asman (321.08) and Taylor Ford (300.45) finished third through fifth in the one-meter event. In three-meter diving, Michigan's Amanda Lohman was the winner (319.43). Cousineau (299.70), Alvarez (297.08), Ford (288.90) and Asman (288.83) were second through fifth.

Ohio State's entry of Kelsey Moran, Angela Severn, Shannon Draves and Megan Detto captured the 400 medley relay in a time of 3:42.25. The Buckeyes' relay of Emily Creran, Catherine Eitel, Darcy Fishback and Michelle Williams placed third (3:45.01). In the 200 freestyle relay, Ohio State's unit of Michelle Williams, Megan Detto, Phoebe Cater and Kelsey Moran swam the fastest time as an exhibition, finishing in 1:33.03.

### In The Big Ten

Ohio State had three winners in 2011-12 of the Big Ten's performer of the week awards:

- junior Megan Detto was part of six first-place finishes for the Buckeyes at the Pitt Invitational. Detto was the individual winner of the 50 freestyle (23.06) and 100 freestyle (49.96), as well as part of the winning quartets in the 200 medley relay (1:39.15), the 400 freestyle relay (3:21.50), the 400 medley relay (3:39.73) and the 200 freestyle relay (1:33.06) races.
- diver Bianca Alvarez for her winning efforts against Cleveland State, Denison and Virginia Tech, winning the 1-meter competition with a score of 336.60 and also taking top honors in the 3-meter (400.35) event.
- Alvarez was honored again as she won the three-meter diving competition versus Michigan with a score of 360.23, an NCAA zone qualifying mark

### The Buckeye Season

The Ohio State women enter the Big Ten championships with a 10-0 dual meet record and first-place finishes at both the Pitt and Ohio State Invationals.

At Notre Dame's Shamrock Invitational, Ohio State posted dual meet wins over both Notre Dame (214-147) and Iowa (217-146).

The Buckeyes were one-two-three in the 100 butterfly. Shannon Draves was the winner (55.48) with Darcy Fishback second (56.42) and Michelle Williams third (56.48). Ohio State's Catherine Eitel captured the 100 breaststroke title in a time of 1:03.72. Buckeye Michelle Williams won the 100 freestyle in a time of 50.10. Megan Detto was third in a time of 51.11. Alex Norris of Ohio State won the 200 free in a time of 1:50.68. Her teammates Megan Detto (1:52.54) and Kelly Ann Baird (1:54.57) placed third and eighth in the 200 free.

Megan Detto won the 50 free in a time of 23.07, with Michelle Williams just behind her in second in a time of 23.29. In the 500 freestyle, Buckeyes Alex Norris (4:51.27), Kelly Ann Baird (4:52.70), Natalie Nichols (4:54.87) and Kelly Titus (4:58.56) finished second through fifth.

The Buckeyes had the top two times in the 200 medley relay. The quarter of Kelsey Moran, Angela Severn, Shannon Draves and Michelle Williams was first in a time of 1:42.99, while the team of Emily Creran, Catherine Eitel, Alex Norris and Megan Detto placed second in 1:43.97. In the 800 free relay, Ohio State's entry of Alex Norris, Megan Detto, Phoebe Cater and Michelle Williams was first in a time of 7:28.05. Ohio State won the 400 freestyle relay in a time of 3:22.91, behind the performances of Michelle Williams, Alex Norris, Phoebe Cater and Megan Detto.

Ohio State was the winner of the 200 freestyle relay. Michelle Williams, Megan Detto, Phoebe Cater and Jackie Brousseau swam that event in a time of 1:32.89. The Buckeyes took the first two spots in the 400 medley relay. The squad of Kelsey Moran, Angela Severn, Shannon Draves and Michelle Williams posted the fastest time of 3:43.84. The Buckeye relay of Emily Creran, Catherine Eitel, Alex Norris and Megan Detto was second in 3:45.84.

In the freestyle events, Kelly Ann Baird (9:58.12) and Natalie Nichols (10:08.24) were the first two finishers in the 1000 free. Baird won the 500 free in a time of 4:54.37; Nichols was fourth (5:02.17), followed by Alex Norris (5:03.71) and Kelly Titus (5:04.18).

The Buckeyes swept the top three spots in the 50 free behind the performances of Michelle Williams (23.72), Jackie Brousseau (24.27) and Lisa Spurling (24.96). Williams was also the winner in the 100 free (51.59), with Buckeyes Phoebe Cater (52.44) and Lisa Narum (54.03) placing third and fourth. Toledo's Carly Harter won the 200 free (1:49.72), but Buckeyes Phoebe Cater (1:50.62), Alex Norris (1:51.63) and Lisa Narum (1:55.05) finished second, third and fourth in that event.

OSU's Shannon Draves won the 200 butterfly in a time of 2:01.78; teammates Darcy Fishback (2:04.18) and Alex Norris (2:09.72) were third and fifth in that race. Draves (55.34) was the winner of the 100 butterfly as well, and Fishback (57.52) placed second.

The Ohio State quartet of Moran, Severn, Draves and Williams won the 200 medley relay in a time of 1:42.40. In the 400 freestyle relay, the Ohio State team of Williams, Cater, Severn and Norris was the first-place finisher in a time of 3:28.18, as Buckeye relays swept the first three spots of that event.

Scoring 981.50 points, the Buckeyes won the five-team OSU Invitational in December. Individual winners for Ohio State were: Emily Creran (200 back, 1:55.39); Megan Detto (50 free, 22.71); Kelsey Moran (100 back, 53.96) and diver Kristen Asman (3-meter, 318.25).

Ohio State, with a score of 1313, won the six-team Pitt Invitational; individual event winners for OSU were: Kelly Ann Baird (1650 free, 16:21.77); Jackie Brousseau (100 breast, 1:02.47); Emily Creran (200 back, 1:56.59); Megan Detto (50 free, 23.06; 100 free, 49.96); Shannon Draves (100 butterfly, 53.98); Kelsey Moran (100 back, 54.18); Alex Norris (200 free, 1:47.71); Angela Severn (200 IM, 2:01.28).

The Buckeyes posted a 203-97 win over Ohio on November 12. Seven different Buckeyes won at least one individual race. Duplicate winners were Shannon Draves, winning the 500 free (5:01.28), 1000 free (10:16.50) and 200 butterfly (2:03.46); Kelly Ann Baird, posting top times in the 200 free (1:52.12) and 200 backstroke (2:03.33).

Ohio State swept the 3-meter diving. Bianca Alvarez placed first (400.80), followed by Cheyenne Cousineau (294.90) and Kristin Asman (278.40). In the 1-meter competition, Cousineau

was first with a score of 315.45 and Asman finished second with 301.05.

In the relays, Ohio State's unit of Kelsey Moran, Angela Severn, Michelle Williams and Megan Detto took first in the 200 medley relay (1:42.90); the team of Lauren Massey, Catherine Eitel, Darcy Fishback and Phoebe Cater placed third (1:48.01). In the 200 freestyle relay, Ohio State's quartet of Michelle Williams, Megan Detto, Phoebe Cater and Jackie Brousseau were first in 1:34.44.

On November 4, the Buckeyes defeated Virginia Tech (198.0-100), Cleveland State (232.0-66.0) and Denison (234.0-64.0) in a quad meet. The team of Kelsey Moran, Angela Severn, Shannon Draves and Megan Detto opened the meet with a win in the 200 medley relay in 1:41.38, while sophomore Kelly Ann Baird outlasted Virginia Tech's Erika Hajnal to claim the 1000 freestyle in 9:55.91. Another sophomore, Alex Norris, recorded a victory in the 200 freestyle in a time of 1:50.49 and the 200 individual medley in 2:05.33.

Severn also finished first in the 100 breaststroke (1:02.88) as well as the 200 breaststroke (2:19.86), while Draves continued to impress with wins in the 200 and 100 butterfly in 2:00.24 and 54.90, respectively. Detto had her first individual win of the night in the 50 freestyle (23.05); she later recorded her second win in the 100 freestyle (50.11), an event that ended in an Ohio State sweep with Michelle Williams (51.82) and Phoebe Cater (52.11) following in second and third. With her second win, Baird took first in the 500 freestyle with a time of 4:51.45. The meet concluded with the 400 freestyle relay; Ohio State finished first with the team of Detto, Williams, Cater and Lisa Narum in 3:26.59.

In the first diving action of the season, senior Bianca Alvarez came away with two wins, one in the 1-meter competition with a score of 336.60 and another in the 3-meter with 400.35 total points.

In their first meet of the season vs. Kenyon College (176.5-83.5), the Scarlet and Gray captured wins in 13 events. Duplicate winners for the Buckeyes were Jackie Brousseau in the 50 freestyle, 200 breaststroke and with the 200 freestyle relay; Phoebe Cater in the 200 freestyle and the 200 medley and 200 freestyle relays; Megan Detto in the 500 freestyle and the 200 freestyle relay; and Shannon Draves in the 200 IM and 200 freestyle relay.
