## **Patriot League Announces Men's Cross Country Academic Honor Roll**

*Navy's John Kress named Scholar-Athlete of the Year and headlines 67 student-athletes named to the Academic Honor Roll.*

**Center Valley, Pa.** – Navy's John Kress was named the 2007 Patriot League Men's Cross Country Scholar-Athlete of the Year and is one of 67 student-athletes named to this year's Patriot League Academic Honor Roll, announced Executive Director Carolyn Schlie Femovich Tuesday. Two student-athletes achieved at least a 4.00 GPA for the fall academic term, including American's Jacob Shelly and Lafayette's Kevin Cunningham.

Kress, an aerospace engineering major with a 3.82 cumulative grade-point average, is a two-time member of the Patriot League Academic Honor Roll. The senior from Colorado Springs, Colo., has posted a 4.0 GPA in a semester three times during his career and has been honored on the Superintendent's List and the Commandant's List at Navy four times and six times, respectively. Kress also ranks 85<sup>th</sup> in his class of 1,085 in Academic Order of Merit.

At the 2007 Patriot League Cross Country Championship, Kress placed fifth in the men's race, finishing with a time of 25:46.20. Kress has been named First-Team All-Patriot League twice (2006, 2007), and also owns the 14<sup>th</sup> best time in Navy history. He has been one of Navy's top-two runners in all five meets during the 2007 season.

To be eligible for the Academic Honor Roll, a student-athlete must earn a 3.20 grade-point average in the fall semester and be awarded a varsity letter in one of the Patriot League's seven fall championship sports.

## **Patriot League Announces Women's Cross Country Academic Honor Roll**

*Bucknell's Gillian Nordquist named Scholar-Athlete of the Year and headlines 85 student-athletes named to the Academic Honor Roll.*

**Center Valley, Pa.** – Bucknell's Gillian Nordquist was named the 2007 Patriot League Women's Cross Country Scholar-Athlete of the Year and is one of 85 student-athletes named to this year's Patriot League Academic Honor Roll, announced Executive Director Carolyn Schlie Femovich Tuesday. Eight student-athletes achieved at least a 4.00 GPA for the fall academic term, including American's Greta Wicklund, Bucknell's Colleen Gavigan, Colgate's Jessica KIELTY, and Navy's Arwyn Becker, Kyleigh Millhouse, Vicki Moore, Jenny Rubin and Erica Ziel.

Nordquist, a junior who double majors in English Creative Writing and Spanish, posted a 3.91 GPA for the fall academic term, and this marks her second-consecutive year on the Patriot League Women's Cross Country Academic Honor Roll.

At the 2007 Patriot League Cross Country Championship, Nordquist placed ninth in the 6k women's race, finishing with a time of 21:50.00. Nordquist has been named Second-Team All-Patriot League twice (2006, 2007), and also competed at the 2006 Mid-Atlantic Regional Championships. She has been one of the most consistent runners for the Bison this year, finishing 25<sup>th</sup> of 147 at the Western Ontario International Invitational and 14<sup>th</sup> of 122 at the Lafayette Invitational.

## **Patriot League Announces Football Academic Honor Roll**

*123 student-athletes receive Honor Roll recognition*

**Center Valley, Pa.** – A record 123 student-athletes were named to the 2007 Patriot League Football Academic Honor Roll, Executive Director Carolyn Schlie Femovich announced on Friday.

Georgetown senior Kyle Van Fleet heads up the honorees after receiving the 2007 Patriot League Football Scholar-Athlete of the Year award in November. He recently accepted a full-time position working in the derivatives group for Goldman Sachs Investment Banking Division in New York City. A Georgetown captain in 2007, Van Fleet was a semifinalist for the Draddy Trophy, better known as football's "Academic Heisman". He was also selected to the *ESPN The Magazine* Academic All-District first-team. Van Fleet has now been named to the Academic Honor Roll in all four of his seasons.

Lehigh senior Pete Donchez and Lafayette sophomore Chris Cosgrove each earned a 4.0 grade point average in the fall semester. Donchez majors in Finance at Lehigh, while Cosgrove is a Biology major at Lafayette.

The mark of 123 honorees eclipses the previous high of 114 on the Football Academic Honor Roll in 2002. Georgetown led all schools with 36 student-athletes named to the Honor Roll, while Lafayette had 21, Bucknell had 20 and Lehigh notched 19.
