2004 Patriot League Swimming & Diving All-League Teams Announced

Bucknell Women And Navy Men Lead The Way With 11 Apiece

CENTER VALLEY - Pa. -- Two-time Patriot League Women's Diver of the Meet **Chelsea Haviland** of Army, 2004 Women's Swimmer of the Meet Navy's **Aubra Thomas** and Navy's **Noah White** and **Kevin Teague**, who were the 2004 Men's Swimmer and Diver of the Meet, respectively, headlined the list of 72 student-athletes honored on the 2004 Patriot League Swimming & Diving All-League teams, announced today by Patriot League Executive Director **Carolyn Schlie Femovich**.

The Navy men, who won the crown in its first season in the Patriot League, claimed a PL-best 11 All-League recipients, led by White, Teague and senior **Terrence Fenningham**. Army, which came in third-place, placed eight student-athletes on the list, including 2003 Men's Diver of the Meet **Doug Klein** and two-time all-star selection **Kevin Burke**. Bucknell and Lehigh had five all-stars each, while American (4 selections), Lafayette (2 selections) and Colgate (1 selection) also laid claim to post-season honorees.

On the women's side, the 2004 champion Bucknell Bison placed a League-best 11 players on the squad, including four-time all-star **Daniella Faas** as well as three-time selections **Meghan Freese** and **Jennifer Cancro**. Colgate laid claim to five student-athletes on the squad, including senior **Alice Garnett**, who makes her fourth-straight appearance on the post-season squad. Army, Lehigh and Navy also placed five student-athletes apiece, while American (4 selections) and Lafayette (1 selection) also land student-athletes on the all-star list.

All-League status is awarded to a total of 72 student-athletes, 36 men and 36 women. The winner of each individual event at the Championship earns an automatic berth on the first-team, which is then completed with the next highest point scorers, and the runner-up in each individual event gaining second-team all-star honors.

White took home Men's Swimmer of the Meet accolades after winning three events at the PL Championship, including a victory in the 100 freestyle. His time of 44.40 reached the NCAA "B" standard and edged out teammate **Joseph Smutz** by 0.30 seconds. White's other victories were in the 50 and 200 freestyle. In the 50 freestyle, White broke the PL record and became the first swimmer in League history to break the 20-second mark.

Thomas was named the Women's Swimmer of the Meet for her performances. On Saturday, the rookie picked up the gold medal in the 200 breaststroke with a time of 2:18.84 to go along with her first-place finishes in the 200 individual medley and 100 breaststroke.

Teague was tabbed the Men's Diver of the Meet after sweeping the diving events for the 16th time in 17 chances this season. The six-time Men's Diver of the Week notched 553.90 points in the three-meter dive to break the League record of 508.30 markers set by Colgate's **Greg Sobo** in 1994. Teague also took home the gold medal in the one-meter event with 319.30 points.

Haviland repeated as the Women's Diver of the Meet after sweeping the diving events at the Championship, including a victory in the one-meter event. The sophomore tallied 263.20 points in the one-meter dive to top teammate **Sarah Get** by 16.4 markers for the gold medal. In the three-meter dive, Haviland won by more than 50 points over CU's **Jen Busby**. Haviland's 476.10 points in the event were a League record.

Colgate mentor **Steve Jungbluth** was tabbed the Women's Coach of the Year, while Navy head coach **Bill Roberts** and Army mentor **John O'Neill** shared the Men's Coach of the Year accolades. For the second straight year, Black Knight diving coach **Jonathan Johnson** was named by his peers as the Patriot League Diving Coach of the Year.

The Patriot League, which was founded on the principles of admitting athletes who are academically representative of their class, is in its second decade of academic and athletic excellence. Participation in athletics at Patriot League institutions is viewed as an important component of the undergraduate experience. The Patriot League, which began as a successful Division I-AA football conference in 1986 and became an all-sport conference in 1990, includes American, Army, Bucknell, Colgate, Holy Cross, Lafayette, Lehigh and Navy as full members and six associate members. These institutions are among the oldest and most prestigious in the nation and their alumni that have played leadership roles in the shaping of our country. In the most recent NCAA Graduation Rate Report of student-athletes, the Patriot League ranked FIRST among NCAA Division I conferences.
