NAVY DRAWS NO. 1 VIRGINIA AGAIN IN NCAA TOURNAMENT

No. 1 Virginia took a 4-0 victory against Navy in the first round of the NCAA Tournament as the teams met in the postseason bracket for the second straight year. The top-ranked Cavaliers improved to 36-1 on the season and advanced to a second-round match against Wake Forest, while the Midshipmen ended the 2010 campaign with a 16-14 mark.

LEHIGH'S LIST GARNERS PLAYER OF THE YEAR HONORS

Lehigh junior Troy List was named the League's Player of the Year after recording a 14-7 overall record at No. 1 singles during the season, including a 5-1 mark in the slot in League contests. At the League Tournament, he posted a 1-0 record with a victory over Army's Gary Kushnirovich, the Rookie of the Year and a fellow First-Team All-League honoree, and was leading Colgate's Michael Yassky, a Second-Team All-League selection, when the team match concluded. List was the first Mountain Hawk to be named Player of the Year in men's tennis.

BIRGER BIG IN THE CLASSROOM

Navy's Nick Birger, who posted a team-leading 19 doubles victories during the season, was named the League's Scholar-Athlete of the Year for men's tennis after balloting conducted by head coaches and sports information directors who could not vote for their own players. An honors political science major, Birger carried a 4.0 cumulative grade-point average at the Naval Academy. He was the second straight from Navy to garner the Scholar-Athlete of the Year award and the third overall. Birger added ITA Scholar-Athlete honors later in the summer.

ARMY'S SEASON ENDS IN NCAA REGIONAL

Army's 2010 campaign came to a close with a 4-0 loss to seventh-ranked UCLA in the first round of the NCAA Tournament in Los Angeles. The Black Knights earned their sixth straight Patriot League crown and trip to the national postseason tournament with a dramatic 4-3 victory over No. 2 seed Bucknell in the League Tournament. Jurelle Mendoza captured the decisive match for Army at No. 5 singles, helping her earn the John "Pat" Rooney Tournament MVP honor.

WITH 50 WINS, VARELA NAMED PLAYER OF THE YEAR

Tania Varela graduated as one of the most accomplished players in the history of Bucknell women's tennis, and she capped off her career with an impressive year that saw her voted as the League's Player of the Year by its head coaches. She won 50 total matches during the year, including 30 at No. 1 singles. Varela was equally impressive in League play, including a 5-0 mark during the regular season and an unblemished 3-0 in the League Tournament, which featured a crucial 6-3, 6-4 win over Army's Annie Houghton in the championship match. She finished the year having won a combined 37 straight, with 19 of those being in singles competition.

LEHIGH'S ARTHOFER NAMED SCHOLAR-ATHLETE OF THE YEAR

Four-year All-League honoree Julie Arthofer capped off her career in Bethlehem by being voted the League's Scholar-Athlete of the Year for women's tennis. She was the school's second student-athlete to capture the award and first since Gwen Dwyer in 2007. A four-year member of the League's Academic Honor Roll, Arthofer was also a respected member of her squad, having been named the team's Athlete of the Year.
