RECORD SETTER

Bucknell senior Ira Reibisen recorded his 111th career victory at the Connecticut Invitational this past weekend, which vaulted him into first place on the all-time victory list at Bucknell. Reibisen is currently tied for first atop the all-time singles victory list with 60, and is second on the all-time doubles victory list with 51.

MacIntyre finished the month of September with a singles record of 5-1, including a streak of five consecutive matches won. At the Brown Invitational, MacIntyre defeated Bucknell's top player 6-4, 6-4 to finish 10th overall. He also won the Flight 1 title at the ECAC South Championships, to help the Raiders to a third place team finish.

ARMY

BUCKNELL

COLGATE
