## DeRoo sets school record, places second at Paul Short

**Center Valley, Pa.** — Colgate's Elise DeRoo made a splash at the rainy 37th annual Paul Short Run at Lehigh University Friday.

Her school record time of 20:10 placed her second in the race and won her the Patriot League Female Runner of the Week award.

Navy's Andrew Hanco had similar success, placing seventh at the Paul Short Run to win his fourth straight Male Runner of the Week award.

Lehigh's freshmen had a great weekend, too, with Jimmy Miller and Jessica Kendzor winning the Rookie of the Week awards.

## Team Notebooks

**AMERICAN** The Eagles men's team placed 15th at the Notre Dame Invitational and the women finished second at the George Mason Invitational.

Craig Brown led the men's team at the competitive Notre Dame Invite that featured eight top-30 teams, including No. 3 Oregon and No. 5 Alabama.

Octavia Rinehardt led the women with her third straight top-three finish, placing second at the George Mason Invite. She set a personal record with her time of 21:01.6 in the 6K.

**ARMY** The Black Knights competed at the Paul Short Run Friday, with the men placing 33rd and the women finishing 28th in the Gold Race.

Senior Bryce Livingston was Army's top finisher for the third time in four races. He placed 35th in 24:41.

Army will be idle this week and will return to the course for a dual-meet at Navy at 11 a.m. Oct. 16.

**BUCKNELL** The Bison women had a strong showing at the Paul Short Run, finishing 14th out of 41 teams in the Gold Race. It was the women's third straight top-15 performance at the Paul Short. The men placed 40th out of 42.

Sarah Moniz led the women's team with her 48th-place finish out of 367 runners. She ran the 6K race in 21:28.

The Bison will be idle this week, and they will compete at Pre-Nationals at 11 a.m. Oct. 16.

**COLGATE** The Raiders left the Lehigh Valley with two second-place finishes Friday. The women's team, led by Elise DeRoo, placed 10th in the Gold Race of the Paul Short Run.

Colgate was the top Patriot League team and DeRoo was the top League finisher, placing second (20:10), six seconds behind the winner. The Raiders' best finish in school history at the Paul Short helped them move into the Northeast Regional rankings at 11th.

The men's team placed second in the Brown Race of the Paul Short Run,

led by Ed Sheridan, who was third with a 25:23. Colgate placed two runners in the top five to score their best finish at the Paul Short in school history.

The Raiders will take the week off and return to action at 11 a.m. Oct. 16 for the Albany Invitational.

**HOLY CROSS** The Crusaders competed in a dual-meet at Maine, with the men falling 19-38 and the women losing 18-38. Holy Cross will compete at the New England Championships at noon Saturday.

**LAFAYETTE** The Leopards women's team placed 18th in the Brown Race of the Paul Short Run and the men were 30th. Lafayette is idle this week and it will return to the course when it hosts the Leopard Invitational at 10 a.m. Oct. 16.

**LEHIGH** The Mountain Hawks hosted the Paul Short Run Friday, with the men's team placing 32nd and the women placing 24th in the Gold Race. Evans Kosgei led the men's team for the third straight meet with a 45th-place finish (24:51).

Katherine Pierce was the women's top finisher, placing 38th with a 21:22 in the 6K.

The Mountain Hawks had the top Patriot League freshmen finishers in the Gold Race with Jimmy Miller placing 109th (25:14) and Jessica Kendzor 118th (22:17).

Lehigh will be idle this week and it will travel to Lafayette for the Leopard Invitational at 10 a.m. Oct. 16.

**NAVY** The Midshipmen men's team shined in the Gold Race of the Paul Short Run, placing 11th, while the women's team won the team title at the Great American Festival Friday.

Andrew Hanco led the men with his seventh-place finish (24:03).

Jess Palacio won her third individual title with a time of 17:35 in the 5K, as the women's team edged out 10 other teams for first place.

The Mids are idle this week and will host Army at 11 a.m. Oct. 16.

## Patriot League Notebook

### Colgate women make statement at Paul Short

Picked to finish fourth in the Patriot League's women preseason poll, the Raiders placed four spots ahead of the pre-season favorite Bucknell Bison at the 37th Paul Short Run Friday. Led by last season's Patriot League individual champion Elise DeRoo, Colgate placed 10th in the Gold Race, which included a few of the nations top teams — Virginia, Georgetown, William and Mary, Dartmouth and Columbia.

It also included Bucknell and Army, which were selected to finish ahead of Colgate in the Patriot League.

Colgate placed two runners in the top 25 en route to its 10th-place finish, which was the highest finish all-time for the Raiders at the event. DeRoo posted a personal-best time of 20:10 to finish second overall among 367 runners. Georgetown's Emily Infeld won the individual title with a time of 20:04. Infeld was eighth in the NCAA Championships last season and is a five-time all-American, and Georgetown is ranked No. 6.

The Raiders moved into the 11th spot in the USTFCCA Northeast Region poll after being unranked last week.

### Navy men, women lead Patriot League in Mid-Atlantic polls, Colgate women join Northeast poll

The Navy men's team is ranked fifth in the most recent United States Track and Field and Cross Country Coaches Division I Mid-Atlantic Region poll and the women are ranked seventh to lead Patriot League schools.

Also ranked in the Mid-Atlantic men's poll are American (eighth) and Lehigh (13th). In the women's poll, Bucknell sits right behind Navy at eighth, Lehigh is 14th and Lafayette is 15th.

The Colgate women jumped into the Northeast Region poll for the first time this season, ranked 11th.

### Returning champs on a roll

The individual champions from 2009 are gearing up for a chance to defend their title.

Navy's Andrew Hanko and Colgate's Elise DeRoo were impressive at the Paul Short Run Friday, leading all other Patriot League runners in their respective races.

Hanko, who has won fourth straight Runner of the Week awards, placed seventh while helping the Mids finish 11th.

DeRoo cut off nearly a minute from her personal record in an 6K with her second-place finish in the Gold Race of the Paul Short Run.

### Navy men, Bucknell women selected to win Patriot League titles

Both the Navy men's team and the Bucknell women's team return strong runners from their 2009 championship squads and the 2010 preseason poll reflects their strength in returners.

Navy and Bucknell were selected to repeat as Patriot League champions in the Preseason Coaches Poll, which was released Sept. 1.

The Navy men, who have won two straight Patriot League titles, will rely on last year's individual champion, Andrew Hanko, along with the last two Patriot League Rookie of the Year winners — Jeremy Haney and Dean Black. Navy received 13 first-place votes and collected 97 points in the poll. The Midshipmen will be challenged by American, which earned three first-place votes and earned 86 points to place second in the poll.

The battle for third place was close with Army edging out Bucknell 64-63 in points, and Lehigh is fifth with 60 points.

Holy Cross had 33 points to place sixth, and Colgate (27) and Lafayette (18) rounded out the poll.

In the women's poll, Bucknell, which returns its top five runners from last season, scored 96 points with 12 first-place votes. Navy was second with 79 points and three first-place votes. Army was third with 75 points, and Colgate (65) and Lafayette (41) round out the top five. Colgate also received a first-place vote. Holy Cross (38) was selected sixth, Lehigh (34) seventh and American (20) eighth.

### 2010 Patriot League Championship

The 2010 Patriot League Cross Country Championships will take place Oct. 30 at Lafayette College. The top-14 finishers in both the men's and women's race will be awarded All-Patriot League status, with the top seven being named to the First-Team and the next seven earning Second-Team recognition.
