PATRIOT LEAGUE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR

CAROLYN SCHLIE FEMOVICH

In selecting Carolyn Schlie Femovich as its fourth Executive Director, the Patriot League Council of Presidents continued its adherence to equity and innovation in its approach to intercollegiate athletics. Femovich brought 17 years experience at the NCAA Division I level to the Patriot League when she was appointed Executive Director in July of 1999. She is one of three women to hold the top post of a combined men and women's conference at the NCAA Division I level.

Throughout her tenure at the Patriot League, Femovich has focused on key areas including the development of a comprehensive multimedia package, expansion of League membership, improvement of League competitiveness, and quality of services to the membership.

Under her direction, Patriot League basketball has gained increased television exposure through contracts with national outlets and as a result of the League's broadband initiative, which streams more than 100 men and women's basketball games live annually via the Internet. Additionally, selected Patriot League Olympic sports have found a home as a part of the League's all-sport packages with various television entities and have seen increased visibility through the streaming of Patriot League Championship events.

In 2001 Femovich orchestrated the addition of American University as a full member and Georgetown as an associate member in football, which has helped to strengthen and stabilize the membership. She has also increased service to the membership with improvements in championship administration, League governance and a focus on the student-athlete experience. During her time with the Patriot League, emphasis has been placed on the competitiveness of its men and women's basketball programs, as well as other key sports that present unique opportunities for the League.

Femovich currently chairs the NCAA Division I Championships/Competition Cabinet and recently finished a four-year term as the League's representative on the NCAA Management Council. She was also the chairperson of the prestigious Collegiate Women's Sports Awards Program where she continues to serve as a board member. Prior to her appointment as Executive Director, Femovich served in a leadership role in the administration of a highly-successful Ivy League program at the University of Pennsylvania.

During her tenure as Senior Associate Athletics Director (1986-99) and Associate Athletics Director (1982-85), her responsibilities included administration of intercollegiate sports and recreation programs, strategic planning and facilities development, human resource management and event planning. In her initial years with the Quakers, Femovich supervised 15 intercollegiate programs, coaching staffs and athletics facilities. She also served as Penn's Interim Director of Athletics in 1985. Femovich represented the University in a variety of external capacities with the Ivy League and NCAA, and on a number of sports committees and boards.

Femovich's career in intercollegiate athletics began in 1974 at Indiana University as a graduate teaching assistant. In 1975, she moved to Gettysburg College as head coach of women's basketball, women's tennis, assistant professor of health and physical education and the Coordinator of Women's Athletics.

Included in the impressive list of regional and national committees Femovich has served on are the NCAA Basketball Marketing Sub-Committee, the NCAA Division I Business/Finance Cabinet and the NCAA Division I Women's Basketball Committee, arguably the most prestigious women's sport committee in the NCAA. She played a primary role in bringing the 2000 NCAA Women's Basketball Final Four to Philadelphia and is a member of the executive

board of the Philadelphia Sports Congress. She also held the office of President of the Eastern College Athletic Conference (ECAC) in 1996, which now includes more than 300 member institutions.

Femovich is a graduate of Valparaiso University and received a master of science degree from Indiana University. Femovich and her husband Robert reside in Hellertown, Pa.

PATRIOT LEAGUE ACADEMIC AND ATHLETIC SUCCESS

In its second decade of combining academic and athletic excellence, the Patriot League sponsors championships in 23 men and women's sports. Initially started as an NCAA Division I-AA football conference in 1986, the Patriot League became an all-sport conference in 1990 and includes American, Army, Bucknell, Colgate, Holy Cross, Lafayette, Lehigh and Navy as full members, and Fordham and Georgetown as associate members. These institutions are among the oldest and most prestigious in the nation and their alumni have, and continue to play leadership roles in shaping our country.

Since 1998, the Patriot League has ranked first each year among all Division I conferences awarding athletic aid in the NCAA Graduation Rate Report. The League finished at the top spot with 97 percent of its teams reporting a graduation rate of 90 percent or higher in the most recent data. In addition, 79 Patriot League teams earned NCAA Academic Performance Program Public Recognition Awards after posting academic progress rate scores in the top 10 percent of all squads in their respective sports.

Patriot League student-athletes and teams continue to enjoy success at the national level, with opening round victories coming in several NCAA Championship including Bucknell's victory over national No. 4 seed Florida State in baseball and Navy's triumph against national No. 4 seed North Carolina in men's lacrosse during the 2007-08 campaign. Patriot League teams previously recorded consecutive first-round wins in men's basketball, a final four appearance in men's lacrosse and a sixth-place finish at the NCAA Cross Country Championship to highlight the League's NCAA success.

The Patriot League's mission is simple, to provide successful competitive athletic experiences while maintaining high academic standards, and to prepare its student-athletes to be leaders in society.

During the 2007-08 academic year, Patriot League student-athletes and teams have accomplished the following:

*14 Patriot League student-athletes were named *ESPN The Magazine* Academic All-Americans, including first-team honors for Bucknell's Jason Buursma (Baseball), Army's Daniel Newell (Men's Soccer) and Navy's Kari Weniger (Women's Soccer), Chris Renninger (Golf) and Kelly Zahalka (Women's Swimming)

*65 Patriot League student-athletes earned *ESPN The Magazine* Academic All-District honors, including 42 on the first team.

*Bucknell won its 14th overall and women's Patriot League Presidents' Cup trophy, while Navy won its first-ever men's trophy.

*Navy's Evan Barnes won the inaugural Lowe's Senior CLASS Award for men's soccer.

*Bucknell defeated national No. 4 seed Florida State, 7-0, in the first game of the NCAA Baseball Regionals.

*Bucknell's Jason Buursma became the first baseball student-athlete to earn Patriot League Player of the Year, Scholar-Athlete of the Year and Tournament Most Valuable Player honors.

*Buursma was also named a finalist for the Lowe's Senior CLASS Award and the Brooks Wallace Player of the Year Award in addition to his All-America and Academic All-America honors.

*American's Denise Infante was named an NFHCA First-Team All-American and the ECAC Player of the Year in field hockey.

*Holy Cross quarterback Dominic Randolph and Colgate running back Jordan Scott were finalists for the Walter Payton Award, while Colgate linebacker Mike Gallihugh was a finalist for the Buck Buchanan Award as top players in the Football Championship Subdivision.

*Scott led the FCS in rushing with 170.45 yards per game.

*Two teams qualified for the NCAA Men's Lacrosse Tournament with Colgate receiving an automatic bid and Navy earning an at-large bid and then recording the Patriot League's sixth win in the event with an 8-7 victory over No. 4 seed North Carolina in the first round.

*Lehigh's Lisa Sweeney was tabbed an Academic All-American and became the first softball student-athlete in Patriot League history to be named both Patriot League Player and Pitcher of the Year.

*Lehigh posted the Patriot League's fifth win in the NCAA Softball Regionals with a 7-4 triumph over Princeton.

*A Patriot League record six student-athletes - Navy's Mitch Harris and Oliver Drake, Bucknell's Jason Buursma and Army's Drew Clothier, Chris Simmons and Cole White - were selected in the 2008 Major League Baseball First-Year Player Draft.

*Four Patriot League players were drafted by Major League Lacrosse - Army's Adam Fullerton, Colgate's Matt Lalli and Chris Eck and Navy's Nick Mirabito. The four selections are the most in a single year for the Patriot League in the Collegiate Draft.

*Lafayette's Ashley Harbin became the first Patriot League student-athlete to qualify for the NCAA Outdoor Track and Field Championship in three consecutive seasons, and also was the lone Patriot League representative at the Indoor Track and Field Championship.

*American's Brendan Fennell and Steve Hallinan and Army's John Mickowski competed in the NCAA Cross Country Championship, giving the Patriot League three competitors in the field for the first time since 1993.

*Mickowski also competed in the NCAA Outdoor Track and Field Championship along with Harbin and American's Carlos Jamieson. To advance to the Championship, Mickowski won the 1,500-meter race at the NCAA East Regional.

*Navy's Thuy-Mi Dinh competed at the NCAA Women's Swimming and Diving Championship and the United States Olympic Trials.

*Fordham punter Ben Dato signed a free agent contract with the NFL's Baltimore Ravens.

*Patriot League football teams combined for a record 124 selections to the League's academic honor roll.

*Seven Patriot League football student-athletes earned All-America honors, the highest total since 2003.

*American's Garrison Carr set the Patriot League single-season record and cracked the NCAA top 25 with 135 three-point field goals.

*Navy's Greg Sprink was named an Honorable Mention All-American by the Associated Press.

*Navy women's lacrosse set an NCAA record for wins by a first-year program with 13.

*American volleyball's Rubena Sukaj was named an AVCA Honorable Mention All-American.

*American field hockey's team GPA was second in the nation among NCAA Division I programs.

*Six men's lacrosse student-athletes received USILA All-America status

*Army's Eddie Kang won the USTA Arthur Ashe Sportsmanship and Leadership Award for the NCAA Men's Tennis Northeast Region.

*Lafayette led the Football Championship Subdivision in team defense at 260.91 yards per game.

*Two teams competed in postseason play in women's basketball with Bucknell representing the Patriot League in the NCAA Tournament and American in the WNIT.

*Sixteen Patriot League rowing student-athletes were named CRCA Scholar-Athletes.

PATRIOT LEAGUE HISTORY

1986 The Colonial League is founded and begins full round-robin play in football only; Lafayette College Associate Professor Alan Childs is named Executive Director.

1989 Carl Ullrich appointed as first full-time Executive Director.

1990 Colonial League changes its name to Patriot League.

1990-91 Patriot League becomes an all-sport conference, sponsoring 22 - 11 for women and 11 for men; Membership includes Bucknell University, Colgate University, Fordham University, College of the Holy Cross, Lafayette College, Lehigh University and the United States Military Academy.

1991 The United States Naval Academy joins the Patriot League as a full member.

1993 Constance (Connie) H. Hurlbut is named Executive Director of the Patriot League, becoming the first woman and youngest person to be selected as the leader of an NCAA Division I conference.

1995 Fordham University resigns its full membership, but remains in the Patriot League as an associate member in football.

1996 Change in Patriot League policy allows basketball scholarships beginning with the class entering in the fall of 1998.

1997 Creation of the Patriot League television package, which grows to 12 games on DIRECTV and ESPN, beginning with the 2002-03 season.

1999 Carolyn Schlie Femovich is selected as the fourth Executive Director of the Patriot League.

2000-01 Patriot League celebrates its 10th Anniversary; Patriot League policy regarding merit aid expanded to include all sports except football, beginning with the class entering in the fall of 2001.

2001 American University joins the Patriot League as a full member; Georgetown University joins as an associate member in football.

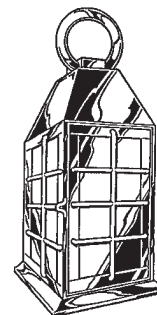
2003 United States Naval Academy increases participation from 12 sports to 18 by joining Patriot League in men's lacrosse, men's swimming and diving and men's and women's cross country and track and field.

2004 Women's rowing added as Patriot League's 23rd sport.

2005 Patriot League celebrates 20th anniversary for the sport of football.

2007 Patriot League unveils broadband package for men and women's basketball. Nearly 100 regular-season and a dozen Patriot League Tournament games are streamed. A two-year agreement for basketball TV package with ESPNU begins. Patriot League men's basketball 'Game of the Week' package on SIRIUS Satellite Radio debuts.

2008 United States Naval Academy adds women's lacrosse as its 19th Patriot League sport.



2008-09 PATRIOT LEAGUE MEN'S BASKETBALL NOTEBOOK

PAULSEN TAKES OVER AT BUCKNELL

After Pat Flannery ended the longest and most successful coaching stint in Patriot League history by retiring from Bucknell in April, the Bison moved to hire Dave Paulsen from Williams College as the new head coach on May 20. Paulsen experienced great success at Williams, leading the program to the 2003 Division III national title and a 170-53 (.762) record in eight seasons overall. His teams compiled a combined mark of 61-3 in the 2002-03 and 2003-04 seasons, and Paulsen won a pair of national coach of the year honors. He is the second new head coach in as many years in the Patriot League after Brett Reed took over at Lehigh in 2007-08.

MORE COACHING TIDBITS

Bucknell wasn't the only Patriot League program to have its head coach in the news in the offseason. Navy's Billy Lange was recognized by Basketball Times as a top mid-career coach after leading the Mids to a second-place finish in the Patriot League in 2007-08. While Lange and Reed comprise the under-40 group of returning Patriot League coaches, the older veterans all have impressive numbers. Army's Jim Crews and Holy Cross' Ralph Willard each have more than 300 wins in their career, while American's Jeff Jones has topped 270 career victories. Lafayette's Fran O'Hanlon and Colgate's Emmett Davis are both working on their second decade at their school, with O'Hanlon now holding the longest tenure among Patriot League coaches going into his 14th season with the Leopards.

2008 PATRIOT LEAGUE TOURNAMENT

The Patriot League Tournament will once again be played on campus sites. The quarterfinal rounds are set for March 4, the semifinals will take place on March 8 and the Patriot League Championship will be decided on Friday, March 13. Last year's tournament featured a quarterfinal round with two overtime games and all four contests decided by three points or less, and a title game between Colgate and American that was within one point in the final minute.

SIX RETURNING ALL-LEAGUE PERFORMERS

American's Garrison Carr returns for his senior season after earning First-Team All-League and Patriot League Tournament MVP honors a year ago, but he's not the only recognizable name back this year. Five players that earned Second-Team All-League status are back, with Lafayette guard Andrew Brown, Colgate guard/forward Kyle Roemer and American guard Derrick Mercer entering their senior seasons and Lehigh guard Marquis Hall and Navy guard Chris Harris beginning their junior campaigns.

MORE RETURNEES WITH ACCOLADES

In addition to the All-League players, the Patriot League also returns its Defensive Player of the Year (Bucknell junior Stephen Tyree) and Rookie of the Year (Lehigh sophomore Rob Keefer) from the 2007-08 campaign. Keefer and Hall combine to give Lehigh the last two Rookie of the Year winners in the backcourt. Seniors Brian Gilmore (American) and Alex Woodhouse (Colgate) and junior Josh Miller (Army) are back after joining Roemer and Carr on the Patriot League All-Tournament team.

THREE-POINTERS COULD BE RAINING AGAIN

The individual and team records for three-pointers in a season both fell in 2007-08, and the return of some of the Patriot League's top long-range marksman could put those numbers in jeopardy again. American's Garrison Carr enters his senior season after shattering the Patriot League record with 135 three-pointers a year ago. He toppled the old Patriot League mark of 99, and had the second-highest number of three-pointers in the NCAA last year and the 12th-best single-season mark in Division I history. Carr begins the 2008-09 season second in Patriot League history with a 42.1 percentage in his career from beyond the arc. Lafayette's Andrew Brown was in the top 20 nationally in three-pointers per game a year ago, while Navy's Chris Harris placed in the top 35 in three-pointers made per game and three-point percentage. Lafayette set the Patriot League record with 299 three-pointers made, while Navy had the second-highest mark in League annals with 288.

1,000-POINT CLUB

Eight players finished the 2007-08 season with more than 1,000 career points, and two of those return to pad their numbers this year. Colgate's Kyle Roemer begins the year 47th in League history with 1,096 points, while Lafayette's Brown is 58th with 1,031 points. Navy senior Kaleo Kina is next in line to join the group, beginning the year with 987 career points.

ANY MORE STREAKS LEFT TO FALL?

The pack caught up to Holy Cross and Bucknell a year ago, with 11 series winning streaks of seven games or more coming to an end between the Crusaders and Bison. Last year's balanced standings leave very few long winning streaks in League matchups, but American has the best stretch coming in with an eight-game win streak against Colgate. The Eagles have also won seven in a row against Lafayette, with Colgate taking seven straight against Navy.

DIVISION I GAMES TO HELP RPI RISE AGAIN?

The Patriot League finished in 16th-place among 32 conferences (including Independents) in the final *Collegiate Basketball News* RPI Report last season, and was just .0004 out of the 15th position. That was a one-spot jump from the previous year, and the fourth consecutive year that the Patriot League improved its position. The jump was aided by an all Division I schedule and a League-record 62 non-League wins. In 2008-09 Patriot League teams will take on an all Division I slate for the second year in a row, and games against the likes of Oklahoma, Maryland, Syracuse, Georgetown, Wake Forest, Villanova and Washington will provide a chance for a marquee upset win.

BUCKNELL BACK IN BRACKET BUSTERS

The Patriot League enters its fourth season with ESPNU BracketBusters, and Bucknell will continue its history in playing in the event. The Bison are 1-2 in BracketBusters after losing at Old Dominion, 65-55, last year. The Bison and Holy Cross have the Patriot League's two wins in the event after the Crusaders knocked off Northeastern, 61-47, at home in 2007-08. The Crusaders and Bison will each face last year's BracketBuster opponents in return games this season.

2008-09 PATRIOT LEAGUE MEN'S BASKETBALL NOTEBOOK

TEAM NOTES

American The Eagles will try to defend their Patriot League title with most of last year's championship team returning, including Tournament MVP Garrison Carr, who was second in the League with 18.4 ppg a year ago. The top four scorers return, with Derrick Mercer (12.3 ppg), Brian Gilmore (8.9) and Bryce Simon (7.0) in addition to Carr. American won 10 of its final 12 games a year ago, and has games at Oklahoma, Georgetown and Maryland this year.

Army The Black Knights bring back Patriot League All-Tournament team member Josh Miller, who led the team in total rebounds and assists while placing second with 8.4 ppg a year ago. Doug Williams is back after scoring 7.1 points and tallying 5.3 rebounds per game. They do lose leading scorer Jarell Brown (18.2 ppg).

Bucknell The Bison will start the season at Maryland in Head Coach Dave Paulsen's first game. They return Patriot League Defensive Player of the Year Stephen Tyree, who led the team in rebounds and assists a year ago. Justin Castleberry (10.9 ppg) is the only returnee who scored in double digits last year. Top scorer John Griffin (13.1 ppg) graduated.

Colgate Leading scorer Kyle Roemer (16.2 ppg) is one of just two returning starters for last year's Patriot League runner-up. Alex Woodhouse (6.1 ppg, 64 blocks) is back in the middle, where Kendall Chones (12.0 ppg) departs. The Raiders won six of their final seven games a year ago. They led the Patriot League in field goal percentage.

Holy Cross The Crusaders led the League in scoring defense, field goal percentage defense and rebounding margin a year ago. They will have to account for the loss of center Tim Clifford (18.0 ppg). Colin Cunningham (8.1 ppg), Pat Doherty (7.4 ppg) and Alex VanderBaan (8.5 ppg) are all entering their senior year. The Crusaders host NCAA Tournament participants St. Joseph's and Siena.

Lafayette The Leopards set a Patriot League record with 299 three-pointers a year ago, but will have to account for the loss of three starters. Top three-point shooter and overall scorer Andrew Brown (15.9 ppg) does return. Head Coach Fran O'Hanlon is the longest-tenured coach in the Patriot League, entering his 14th season.

Lehigh Juniors Marquis Hall (14.1 ppg) and Zahir Carrington (12.5 ppg) are expected to lead the way again. Rob Keefer (7.8 ppg) also returns after earning Patriot League Rookie of the Year honors, but Bryan White (10.5 ppg, 8.2 rpg) is gone after leading the Patriot League in rebounding. The Mountain Hawks were 11-4 at home last year, but just 3-11 on the road.

Navy The Mids lose Patriot League Player of the Year Greg Sprink (21.8 ppg), but return double-digit average scorers in Chris Harris (14.5 ppg) and Kaleo Kina (14.0 ppg). The Mids' 76.3 point-per-game average was the highest in the Patriot League since 1995-96, and they also led the League in steals and turnover margin. Navy has improved its win total in each of the last two seasons.

TIEBREAKING PROCEDURES

In the case of ties in the Patriot League final regular-season standings, the following process will be used until all ties are broken and the seeding process is completed (ties will be broken in rank order beginning with the highest seed):

Head-to-Head Competition: The higher seed will go to the team that has won the most Patriot League contests played against the other team (s) involved in the tie.

If a Tie Still Exists: A Comparison of records will be made between the tied institutions starting at the highest possible seed and continuing through the lowest possible seed, if necessary.

If a Tie Still Exists: The Patriot League office will use the RPI according to the *Collegiate Basketball News men's RPI Report*, published on the day following the final regular-season Patriot League game to determine the higher-seeded team (or the next day that the report is available). Note - *If a game must be postponed for any reason, the first Men's RPI Report rankings calculated following the conclusion of that game will be used.* The team with the higher RPI will receive the higher seed and the opportunity to host the tournament final (should that team advance to the championship game).

2007.08 SEASON NOTES

AMERICAN WINS REGULAR-SEASON AND TOURNAMENT

American earned its first-ever Patriot League Championship with a 52-46 win over Colgate on March 14. The Eagles also captured their first outright regular-season Patriot League title since 2002, and first at all since 2004, by going 10-4 in the League this season. They claimed the outright crown with a win and a Navy loss on the final day of the year. The Eagles played as the No. 1 seed in the League Tournament for the first time since 2002. American made its first appearance in the NCAA Tournament after 41 seasons as a Division I program, and was within one point with six minutes to play before falling to Tennessee, 72-57, in the first round.

HISTORY-MAKING WIN TOTALS

For the first time in the 18-year history of the Patriot League, every team recorded at least 10 victories in a season, and each squad finished with at least 12 wins. The Atlantic Coast Conference was the only other league in the country where every member had at least 12 wins against Division I opponents. Also, every team recorded at least five wins in League play for the first time.

COMPETITIVE RACE FROM TOP TO BOTTOM

The final Patriot League regular-season standings marked the first time since the 1993-94 season and second in League history that all eight teams finished within five games of each other. First-place American recorded a 10-4 League mark, while last-place Holy Cross came in at 5-9.

QUARTERFINAL ROUND TO REMEMBER

After a competitive and unpredictable regular season, the Patriot League Tournament opened up with the closest quarterfinal round in history. The four games were decided by a combined eight points, with every contest within three points or less and coming down to the final possession. Bucknell beat Navy, 87-86, in the first triple overtime game in League history when John Griffin hit a 40-foot bank shot as time expired. Army went to overtime to win at Lehigh, 64-61, marking the first time since 2003-04 that two games went to overtime in the quarterfinals. American and Colgate both won by two points, with the Eagles scoring late to beat Holy Cross, 62-60, and Colgate topping Lafayette, 76-74.

NON-LEAGUE SUCCESS

Patriot League teams set a record with 62 non-League victories in the 2007-08 season. The 62-56 mark was the best-ever non-League record, and broke the mark of 60 wins which was set in 2006-07. It was the second all-time winning mark in non-League action, and is made even more impressive because Patriot League teams played an all Division I schedule for the first time in 2007-08. The Patriot League was the first Division I conference to have all of its teams record a road victory, and the second to have every team beat a Division I opponent.

RPI RISES AGAIN

The Patriot League finished in the 16th-place position in the *Collegiate Basketball News* RPI rating. The League had a .4870 weighted RPI, which was just .0004 behind the 15th-place West Coast Conference. American led all League teams at No. 92 in the RPI rating. The Patriot League was one of only six conferences in the nation to place all of its teams in the top 250, and the only Mid-Major league to accomplish the feat.

AMERICAN MAKES IT EIGHT

American became the eighth Patriot League program, and seventh active member, to make it to the NCAA Tournament as a Patriot League representative. Holy Cross leads all teams with five appearances, while Navy has three. Colgate, Bucknell and Lafayette each have two, while American joins Lehigh with one appearance. Fordham, which played in the Patriot League from 1991-94, made an NCAA appearance in 1992. The Eagles also added to the success of No. 1 seeds in the Patriot League Tournament, becoming the 14th overall No. 1 seed and fifth in the last six years to win the title.

LOWEST-SCORING LEAGUE TITLE GAME IN 2008

Colgate and American had the two lowest point totals in Patriot League Championship game history in the Eagles' 52-46 win. Both scores broke the low mark of 54 set by American in 2002. The Eagles made No. 1 seeds a perfect 6-0 all-time against No. 3 seeds in the title game, and no seed lower than No. 2 has ever won the League title. Home squads improved to 13-4 in Patriot League title games with American's win, including 13-2 since 1994.

KINGS OF OVERTIME

Lafayette set an NCAA record with five overtime road victories in 2007-08, and matched an NCAA mark with six overall overtime triumphs. The Leopards won their first six overtime games, setting the mark with a 103-99 victory at Navy on Jan. 19. They had a chance to win a seventh game, but fell to Bucknell, 77-75, on Feb. 20. That contest did make Lafayette the first team in League annals to play seven overtime games in a season.

FOLLOWING THE TRENDS

Comebacks, close games and an end to long series winning streaks were the defining themes of the Patriot League season. The winning team had to rally from a second-half deficit in 40 of the 63 Patriot League games this year (including Tournament contests), with 23 of those comebacks from six points or more down. Twenty-three was also the number for close games, with that many contests decided by five points or less. Forty-four of the 63 contests were within 10 points. There were 12 series win streaks of seven games or more snapped during the year, with 11 of those coming against Holy Cross or Bucknell.

SPRINK TAKES HOME A PAIR OF HONORS

After earning Patriot League Player of the Year honors, Navy's Greg Sprink capped his career with a pair of Honorable Mention nods on All-America lists. He earned that status on the AP All-America Team, and also on the CollegeHoops.Net Mid-Major squad. He became the sixth Patriot Leaguer in the last seven years to earn AP Honorable Mention status. Sprink finished 14th in the country with 21.8 points per game, and became the first Patriot League player to average more than 20 points a game since the 1997-98 campaign. Sprink closes his career fifth in Patriot League history in scoring (1,785 points), ninth in three-pointers made (237), fourth in free throw percentage (84.3) and 21st in rebounding (592). He is one of three Patriot League players to score 1,500 points, grab 500 rebounds and dish out 200 assists.

CARR LEADS THE BARRAGE FROM LONG RANGE

American junior guard Garrison Carr posted the best season in Patriot League history from three-point range, and one of the best in NCAA annals. Carr made a League record 135 three-pointers on the season, shattering the old mark of 99 and tying for 12th on the NCAA single-season list. He finished second in the nation in three-point field goals made in 2007-08. But Carr wasn't the only one to crack the Patriot League record book or show up on national lists for long-range marksmanship. Lafayette set a League record with 299 three-pointers made, with Navy coming in second all-time with 288 threes for the year. Lafayette's Andrew Brown and Army's Jarell Brown were in the top 20 nationally in three-pointers made per game while Navy's Chris Harris placed in the top 35 in three-pointers made per game and three-point percentage.

MOVING UP THE LISTS

While the records came from three-point range, there was plenty of movement on the all-time Patriot League leaderboard. Eight players finished the year in the 1,000-point club, with Army's Jarell Brown joining Sprink in the top 25 with 1,444 career points (23rd all-time). Lehigh's Bryan White finished his career 10th in League history in rebounding (643), while Holy Cross' Tim Clifford went out in third place in blocked shots (210). American guard Derrick Mercer climbed to ninth with 383 assists with one season still to play. Brown (251) and Sprink (237) place in the top 10 in three-pointers made. Carr enters next season second in all-time three-point percentage at 42.1.
