PATRIOT LEAGUE PLAY OPENS ON SATURDAY

A matchup between the top two teams in the Patriot League preseason poll and a nationally-televised rematch of one of the League's most memorable games highlight the first slate of League contests on Saturday. The schedule opens when Lehigh, picked second in the preseason, visits defending champion and preseason favorite American at 2 p.m. The afternoon slate of contests concludes with the Patriot League's 2009 debut on ESPNU, with Bucknell visiting Navy at 5 p.m. in a rematch of the triple overtime classic won by the Bison, 87-86, at Navy in last year's Patriot League quarterfinals. Lafayette is at Holy Cross and Colgate visits Army in the other afternoon matchups. All games that are not broadcast on ESPNU are available for a small monthly fee via the Patriot League All-Access package at www.patriotleague.com.

The Bucknell/Navy game is the first of six regular-season Patriot League contests to be broadcast on ESPNU. Bob Socci and John Feinstein will return to call the action together for the sixth consecutive season.

WRAPPING UP THE NON-LEAGUE PORTION OF THE SCHEDULE

Navy, American and Colgate each earned victories in their final tune-up before Patriot League action begins on Saturday. The Mids scored the final eight points of the game in the last 1:52 to rally for a 66-62 win at Elon on Monday. Navy finished its non-League slate with an 11-4 record, matching the 1998-99 and 1999-00 teams for the most wins in non-League action. American continued its hot play of late on Monday, leading by as many as 21 points in a 62-50 victory at home against Columbia. The Eagles have won three consecutive games, all of which were decided by double digits. Colgate snapped a three-game losing skid with a double-digit victory of its own, knocking off NC Central, 68-58, on the road.

The remaining Patriot League squads all fell in their contests, as the Patriot League recorded a 49-64 non-League mark heading into League action. Navy, American, Army and Holy Cross have all completed their non-League schedules, while Lehigh will not play another non-League contest if its postponed game at Washington is not made up. Lafayette, Colgate and Bucknell each have one more non-League game scheduled for February.

WHAT TO WATCH FOR

The 2009 Patriot League season gets underway on Saturday with four afternoon contests. Lehigh visits American in a matchup of the League's top two teams in the preseason poll at 2 p.m., while Bucknell is at Navy in an ESPNU-televised contest at 5 p.m. In between, Lafayette visits Holy Cross and Colgate goes to Army to complete the opening slate of games.

PATRIOT LEAGUE NOTEBOOK

STREAKS ON THE LINE IN ANNAPOLIS

A national television audience on ESPNU will tune in to see a matchup between Navy and Bucknell that features plenty of streaks. The Mids are trying to stay perfect at home with a 7-0 mark coming into the day, while the Bison are trying to end this year's 0-8 mark on the road and nine-game road losing streak. Navy is also trying to end a seven-game losing streak in Patriot League openers. The Mids have not won their first League game since defeating Bucknell at home on Jan. 10, 2001.

NAVY, LEHIGH ENTER LEAGUE PLAY WITH DOUBLE-DIGIT WINS

Navy and Lehigh both finished impressive non-League campaigns with double-digit victories. The Mids have won 11 non-League contests for just the third time as a Patriot League member, doing so in back-to-back years in 1998-99 and 1999-00. Lehigh set school records with 10 non-League victories and five non-League road wins. No team had double-digit victories before Patriot League play last season, though Holy Cross did record a 10th non-League win later in the year.

EAGLES, MOUNTAIN HAWKS AMONG NATION'S BEST ON ROAD

Only 11 Division I teams have recorded five or more road victories this season, and two of those squads reside in the Patriot League. Lehigh (5-2) and American (5-5) have each notched five victories on the road, trailing only the six of Butler, St. Bonaventure and VMI for the Division I lead. The Mountain Hawks have a chance to join the group with six road wins when they play at American on Saturday, while the Eagles are on a four-game homestand after being one of eight squads in the country to play 10 of their first 12 games on the road.

NAVY COMPLETES PERFECT NON-LEAGUE HOME RECORD

For the first time in its Patriot League history, Navy will begin League action on Saturday with an unblemished home record. The Mids completed a 7-0 mark in their non-League home schedule with a 75-70 victory over Wofford on Jan. 2. It is Navy's first ever perfect non-League home mark, and the Mids have won nine consecutive non-League home games overall.

WEST COAST BIAS

The Patriot League is firmly cemented in the Eastern part of the United States, but a group of players from well outside the region are making sure the Western influence is felt throughout the League. Four of the League's top five scorers come from the Western part of the country, with Navy's Kaleo Kina (Arizona) in first at 19.2 points per game, American's Garrison Carr (Washington) next at 18.4 per game, Lafayette's Andrew Brown (Colorado) in fourth with 15.1 points per contest and Lehigh's Marquis Hall (Oregon) fifth with 14.4 points per game.

CHECKING UP ON THE CAREER LISTS

In addition to this season's scoring outburst, the quartet from the west is also carving out impressive numbers in the Patriot League career record book. Kina, Brown and Carr are the top three active career scorers in the Patriot League, and have all joined the League's 1,000-point club. Kina and Brown are both over 1,200 points, with Kina holding the top mark among active players with 1,275 career points. American's Derrick Mercer is the final active member with 1,000 points, and leads all active players and places ninth in League annals with 429 career assists. Hall is next among active players with 327 career assists, with Kina and Brown right behind to join Mercer as players with more than 1,000 points and 300 assists. Colgate's Alex Woodhouse is 10th with 140 career blocks, while Kina places 18th with 160 steals. Brown and Carr both have impressive standing in the three-point career leaderboard. Brown is sixth all-time with 258 three-pointers. Carr's 239 three-pointers are ninth in Patriot League annals, and his 41.3 three-point percentage is fourth in League history.

PATRIOT LEAGUE NOTEBOOK

ANACONDA PLAYER OF THE WEEK (DEC. 29-JAN. 4)

GARRISON CARR, AMERICAN Sr., G, 5'11, 165, Bellevue, Wash./Issaquah

Carr earns his second Patriot League/Anaconda Player of the Week honor of the season, and fifth of his career, after leading the Eagles to a pair of wins last week. He posted 20-point efforts in each of the contests, with 21 points in a 60-48 victory at Manhattan on Dec. 29 and 22 points in American's 68-53 triumph over Brown on Jan. 2. Carr made five three-pointers in each of the games, including a 5-for-7 effort in the win over Brown. He also matched a career-high with four assists in the victory. Carr averaged 21.5 points, 2.5 rebounds and 2.5 assists per game in the two victories, while shooting 48.3 percent (14-for-29) from the field and 55.6 percent (10-for-18) from three-point range. Carr has connected on 44 three-pointers this season, tied for 19th place on the Division I leaderboard. He is five three-pointers away from moving into the Patriot League career top 10, and is currently in fifth place in League annals in career three-point field goal percentage. Carr is second in the Patriot League with 18.0 points per game.

ANACONDA ROOKIE OF THE WEEK (DEC. 29-JAN. 4)

R.J. EVANS, HOLY CROSS Fr., G, 6'3, 200, Salem, Conn./Norwich Free Academy

Evans posted two more solid efforts to pick up his fifth Patriot League/Anaconda Rookie of the Week honor of the season. He led the Crusaders with 21 points in an 83-71 loss to Siena on Dec. 30, while also playing a strong floor game with six rebounds, five assists and four steals in the contest. The assist mark was a career-high, while he tied his career best in steals. The 21 points were the second-highest of his career. Evans notched 12 points and six rebounds in Holy Cross' 68-49 win at Boston University on Jan. 2. He has now scored in double figures in eight consecutive games, and 11 times overall this season. Evans leads the Crusaders and is sixth in the Patriot League with 13.4 points per game. Evans receives consecutive Rookie of the Week honors for the second time this season after winning the award on Dec. 8 and 15. He has received four of the last five Rookie of the Week honors.

THIS AND THAT

Lehigh's Matt Szalachowski is one of 30 candidates for the 2008-09 Lowe's Senior CLASS Award, presented to a student-athlete based on classroom, character, community and competition...American's Derrick Mercer and Garrison Carr are the first set of Eagle teammates to both have over 1,000 career points in the same season since 1996...Army has already had 12 different players score in double figures this season...Navy senior guard Kaleo Kina became the fifth student-athlete in Patriot League history to earn three consecutive Player of the Week awards on Dec. 14. Kina was also one of four finalists for CollegeHoops.net Mid-Major Player of the Week honors on the same week...Lehigh junior guard Marquis Hall is on the nominee list for the Bob Cousy Award, presented to the top guard in college basketball...After posting a 2-1 record from Dec. 1-7, Navy was honored as the Mid-Major Team of the Week by Jeff Goodman in the FoxSports.com Weekly Wrap. The Mids had improved to 7-2 at the time...Navy has the best single-game shooting performance in the nation. The Mids' connected on 71.4 percent of their shots (25-for-35) in a 78-65 win over UT-San Antonio on Dec. 2...Lehigh's 76-71 win over Rutgers on Nov. 26 was the first for the Mountain Hawks against a Big East team in their Patriot League history, and first for the Patriot League against the Big East since 2005.

47 PATRIOT LEAGUE GAMES SET FOR BROADCAST TV

The eight Patriot League men's basketball teams have a combined 47 games on broadcast television. The television schedule is highlighted by the Patriot League's contract with the ESPN Networks. Six Patriot League men's basketball regular season games will be shown on ESPNU via the League's package. The Patriot League Men's Basketball Championship will be shown on ESPN2 at 4:45 p.m. on March 13. The men's television slate features 18 non-League games and 29 League contests, with games on ESPNU, Comcast Sports Net and the Mid-Atlantic Sports Network (MASN) in the non-League action.

2009 PATRIOT LEAGUE TOURNAMENT

The Patriot League Tournament will once again be played on campus sites. The quarterfinal round is set for March 4, the semifinals will take place on March 8 and the Patriot League Championship will be decided on Friday, March 13 at 4:45 p.m. on ESPN2.

Lehigh and American face off at Bender Arena in a matchup of the top two teams in the Patriot League preseason poll...American was picked to defend its title, while the Mountain Hawks were selected second...American swept the season series last year, including an 82-74 victory at home when the teams last met on Feb. 10...That victory started American's active streak of seven consecutive home wins against Patriot League opponents, including three in the Patriot League Tournament...Lehigh had won the previous four contests in the series before last year's American sweep...The teams are opening the League schedule against each other for the fifth year in a row...The Eagles hold a 17-11 lead in the all-time series, while the teams are tied, 7-7, in regular-season Patriot League matchups.

LEHIGH Lehigh saw its five-game winning streak come to an end with a 73-64 loss to Princeton on Wednesday...The Mountain Hawks fell for just the second time on the road, and are now 5-2 both at home and on the road to compile their 10-4 record...Zahir Carrington led the Mountain Hawks with 20 points and 11 rebounds, recording his Patriot League-best third double-double of the season...Marquis Hall had 11 points in the game...Lehigh hit just 32 percent of its shots, and made 27-of-41 free throw attempts...Lehigh had only five assists with 13 turnovers in the contest...Lehigh cut an 11-point deficit to four with 5:44 left, but would get no closer...The Mountain Hawks recorded a school record for non-League wins and non-League road wins this season...With a victory on Saturday at American, Lehigh would join a group of only three Division I teams that have recorded six road wins this season.



AMERICAN The Eagles earned their third straight victory with a 62-50 triumph over Columbia on Monday...All of the wins have come by double digits as American improved to 8-6 on the year, and 3-1 at home...The Eagles have played the first two of a four-game homestand, which continues against Lehigh and finishes up with Bucknell on Wednesday...American finishes its non-League slate with a winning record for the third year in a row...Garrison Carr had 23 points while connecting on 7-of-9 three-pointers after making his first seven from long range...Carr moved into the Patriot League career top 10 with 239 three-pointers...The Eagles shot 52.9 percent (9-of-17) from long range as a team...American held a 26-23 lead at the break, but started the second half on a 14-7 run to push the lead to double digits...The Eagles led by as many as 21 points later in the game...Derrick Mercer had 12 points and recorded game highs with seven rebounds and seven assists...Brian Gilmore had 11 points for the Eagles...American will try to match its season high with a fourth straight win when it faces Lehigh on Saturday.

Lafayette and Holy Cross begin their Patriot League schedules in Worcester on Saturday afternoon...The teams split the season series last year, with each winning on their own home court...Holy Cross notched a 77-57 win at home on Feb. 9 after Lafayette had snapped a seven-game series win streak for the Crusaders with a 60-52 victory to open the 2008 League schedule in Easton on Jan. 12...Lafayette has not posted a victory in Worcester since Jan. 17, 2004, as the Crusaders have won the last five meetings on their home court...Holy Cross holds a 28-14 edge in the all-time series, and a 24-12 advantage in regular-season Patriot League games.

LAFAYETTE The Leopards began a short two-game road trip with an 84-70 loss at Penn on Tuesday...Lafayette fell to 4-10 on the season and dropped its second consecutive game...Freshman Ryan Willen scored a career-high 17 points in the contest to lead three Leopards in double figures...Andrew Brown and Michael Gruner each recorded 12

points...Freshman Nick Petkovich also tallied a career-high with nine points...Lafayette fell behind by as many as 26 points, but was able to cut it to a 70-61 deficit with 2:53 remaining...Lafayette had an 18-for-21 effort at the foul line for its best free throw shooting night of the season...The Leopards are trying to begin Patriot League play with a win in consecutive seasons for the first time since 2004 and 2005.



HOLY CROSS The Crusaders finished up their non-League schedule with a 5-10 record after falling at Central Florida, 70-57, on Tuesday...Holy Cross also fell to 1-7 on the road...One game after setting a career-high with 15 points, sophomore Andrew Keister bettered that mark by scoring 18 points on Tuesday...Keister hit 7-of-10 shots in the contest...R.J. Evans and Andrew Beintert each contributed 14 points, with Evans notching a team-high eight rebounds...Holy Cross was close throughout, and trailed by just five points with 8:30 left before Central Florida began to pull away...The Crusaders are trying to open Patriot League play with a win for the third time in the last four years.

Colgate and Army play their Patriot League opener at Christl Arena on Saturday afternoon...Colgate has defeated Army in the Patriot League opener for the last four seasons...The Black Knights have not opened League play with a victory since 2002...Army snapped Colgate's seven-game series win streak with a 59-57 victory at home in overtime when the teams last met on Feb. 9, 2008...The series is tied, 51-51, overall, while Colgate holds a 30-6 edge in Patriot League regular-season competition against Army.
