PATRIOT LEAGUE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR

CAROLYN SCHLIE FEMOVICH

Appointed the fourth Executive Director of the Patriot League in July 1999, Carolyn Schlie Femovich's selection by the Patriot League Council of Presidents continued its adherence to equity and innovation in its approach to inter-collegiate athletics.

One of two women to hold the top post of a combined men and women's conference at the NCAA Division I level, Femovich brought with her 17 years of experience in NCAA Division I athletics.

During her first year as Executive Director of the Patriot League, membership was enhanced with the announcement that American University would become a full League member in the fall of 2001, and that Georgetown University would join the Patriot League in football beginning with the 2001 season.

Femovich focused her energies on setting a strategic direction for the future of the Patriot League during the 2001-02 academic year. In recent years, primary efforts have aimed at increasing League visibility and competitiveness, as well as the quality of services to the membership.

Femovich recently finished a four-year term as the Patriot League's representative on the NCAA Management Council and is currently serving as chair of the NCAA Championship and Competition Cabinet and NCAA Women's Basketball Issues Committee. She was also the chairperson of the prestigious Collegiate Women's Sports Awards Program and continues to serve on the Board.

Prior to her appointment as Executive Director, Femovich served in a leadership role in the administration of a highly-successful Ivy League athletic program at the University of Pennsylvania.

During her tenure as Senior Associate Athletics Director (1986-99) and Associate Athletics Director (1982-85), her responsibilities included administration of intercollegiate sports and recreation programs, strategic planning and facilities development, human resource management and event planning.

In her first position at Penn, Femovich oversaw 15 intercollegiate programs, coaching staffs and athletics facilities. She also served as Penn's Interim Director of Athletics in 1985. Femovich represented the University in a variety of external capacities with the Ivy League and NCAA, and on a number of sports committees and boards.

Femovich's career in intercollegiate athletics began in 1974 at Indiana University as a graduate teaching assistant. In 1975, she moved to Gettysburg College as head coach of the women's basketball and tennis programs as well as assistant professor of health and physical education and the Coordinator of Women's Athletics.

Included in the impressive list of regional and national committees Femovich has served on are the NCAA Division I Women's Basketball Committee, the NCAA Basketball Marketing Sub-Committee and the NCAA Division I Business/Finance Cabinet and the NCAA Division I Women's

Basketball Committee.

She played a primary role in bringing the 2000 NCAA Women's Basketball Final Four to Philadelphia and is a member of the executive board of the Philadelphia Sports Congress. She also held the office of President of the Eastern College Athletic Conference (ECAC) in 1996, which now includes more than 300 member institutions.

A graduate of Valparaiso University, Femovich received a masters of science degree from Indiana University. She and her husband, Robert, reside in Hellertown, Pa.

PATRIOT LEAGUE ACADEMIC AND ATHLETIC SUCCESSES

In its second decade of combining academic and athletic excellence, the Patriot League sponsors championships in 23 men and women's sports. Initially started as an NCAA Division I-AA football conference in 1986, the Patriot League became an all-sport conference in 1990 and includes American, Army, Bucknell, Colgate, Holy Cross, Lafayette, Lehigh and Navy as full members, and Fordham and Georgetown as associate members. These institutions are among the oldest and most prestigious in the nation and their alumni have, and continue to play leadership roles in shaping our country.

Since 1998, the Patriot League has ranked first each year among all Division I conferences awarding athletic aid in the NCAA Graduation Rate Report. In addition, the Patriot League finished first in the new NCAA Academic Progress Report (APR) among all Division I conferences awarding athletic aid (combining with all eight of its full-time member institutions for an average of 984 out of 1,000). The APR is used to measure academic eligibility, retention and graduation of student-athletes.

Patriot League student-athletes and teams continue to enjoy success at the national level, with opening round victories coming in several NCAA Championships, including consecutive wins in men's basketball, a final four appearance in men's lacrosse and a sixth-place finish at the NCAA Cross Country Championship.

The Patriot League's mission is simple, to provide successful competitive athletic experiences while maintaining high academic standards, and to prepare its student-athletes to be leaders in society.

During the 2006-07 academic year, Patriot League student-athletes and teams accomplished the following:

*Fourteen Patriot League student-athletes were named *ESPN The Magazine* Academic All-Americans including American's Heidi Hershberger (field hockey), Army's Nick Hill (baseball), Lindsey Gerheim (softball) and Patrick Beverly (golf), Bucknell's Shannon Curd (women's soccer), David Frisbey (football) and Melanie Buczko (women's cross country/track and field), Lafayette's James Conrad (baseball) and Navy's Lizzie Barnes (women's soccer), Kari Weniger (women's soccer), Chris Renninger (golf), Kelly Zalka (women's swimming and diving), Michael Niemi (men's cross country/track and field) and Kirsten Andrews (women's cross country/track and field).

*54 Patriot League student-athletes earned *ESPN The Magazine* All-District Academic All-America honors.

*American field hockey spent the entire season ranked in the top-20 in the NFHCA national poll.

*Three Patriot League field hockey student-athletes were named NFHCA All-Americans including American's Camila Infante and Denise Infante on the Second-Team and American's Irene Schickhardt on the Third-Team.

*Colgate's Mike Gallihugh led the Football Championship Subdivision in tackles and was a finalist for the Buck Buchanan Award.

*Lehigh was the first team in Patriot League history to receive a first-round bye in the NCAA Men's Soccer Tournament and the second to advance to the third round.

*The Patriot League had two teams win a game in the NCAA Men's Soccer Tournament for the first time in its history (Bucknell and Lehigh), with 2006 being the second year it sent multiple teams to the postseason.

*Lehigh women's soccer student-athlete Daniela Molina was selected to play for the Colombian National Team at the World Cup.

*Navy women's soccer owned the longest winning streak among NCAA Division I schools, posting 19-straight victories, and captured its first NCAA Tournament victory.

*Navy goalkeeper Lizzie Barnes posted the seventh-longest shutout streak in NCAA women's soccer history.

*American volleyball twin freshmen Ann and Clair Recht were featured on national morning shows for setting the record of being the tallest female twins in the Guinness Book of World Records.

*The Patriot League had two post-season participants in the sport of women's basketball for the first time since 2002 with Holy Cross playing in the NCAA Tournament and Bucknell in the WNIT.

*Holy Cross' Keith Simmons was named All-America Honorable Mention by the *Associated Press* in the sport of men's basketball.

*Navy's Paul Harris earned All-America status after finishing sixth in the 800 meters at the NCAA Indoor Track and Field Championship.

*Four different men's lacrosse teams spent time in the national polls, including Army, Bucknell, Colgate and Navy. Navy ended the year ranked a Patriot League-best eighth in the nation.

*Three Patriot League student-athletes were chosen in the Major League Lacrosse Draft including Navy's Billy Looney (first round, fifth pick), Colgate's Colin Hulme (second round, 16th pick) and Navy's Ian Dingman (third round, 30th pick). Looney became the highest drafted Patriot League student-athlete into MLL.

*Four Patriot League student-athletes were named USILA All-Americans including Navy's Billy Looney on the First-Team and Navy's Jordan DiNola and Colgate's Colin Hulme and Brandon Corp as Honorable Mentions.

*Bucknell's Nick Sciubba ended the year ranked first in the nation in goals against average and save percentage in the sport of men's lacrosse.

*Seventeen Patriot League rowers were named CRCA National Scholar-Athletes.

*Bucknell's Katherine Brewster-Duffy and Navy's Lindsey Spiese were named CRCA All-Americans.

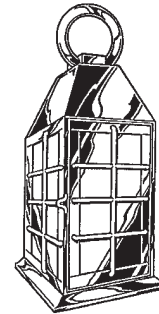
*Five Patriot League student-athletes were selected in the MLB draft including Army's Nick Hill and Milan Dinga, Bucknell's Jason Buursma and Navy's Mitch Harris and Jonathan Johnston.

*Lehigh's Kate Marvel ranked first in the nation in triples per game in the sport of softball, while Lehigh as a team ranked first in the same category.

*Navy's Kevin Teague became the first male diver in Patriot League history to win four consecutive 1-meter and 3-meter Patriot League Championship titles and to be named Patriot League Diver of the Meet four times

PATRIOT LEAGUE HISTORY

- 1986** The Colonial League is founded and begins full round-robin play in football only; Lafayette College Associate Professor Alan Childs is named Executive Director.
- 1989** Carl Ullrich appointed as first full-time Executive Director.
- 1990** Colonial League changes its name to Patriot League.
- 1990-91** Patriot League becomes an all-sport conference, sponsoring 22 - 11 for women and 11 for men; Membership includes Bucknell University, Colgate University, Fordham University, College of the Holy Cross, Lafayette College, Lehigh University and the United States Military Academy.
- 1991** The United States Naval Academy joins the Patriot League as a full member.
- 1993** Constance (Connie) H. Hurlbut is named Executive Director of the Patriot League, becoming the first woman and youngest person to be selected as the leader of an NCAA Division I conference.
- 1995** Fordham University resigns its full membership, but remains in the Patriot League as an associate member in football.
- 1996** Change in Patriot League policy allows basketball scholarships beginning with the class entering in the fall of 1998.
- 1997** Creation of the Patriot League television package, which grows to 12 games on DIRECTV and ESPN, beginning with the 2002-03 season.
- 1999** Carolyn Schlie Femovich is selected as the fourth Executive Director of the Patriot League.
- 2000-01** Patriot League celebrates its 10th Anniversary; Patriot League policy regarding merit aid expanded to include all sports except football, beginning with the class entering in the fall of 2001.
- 2001** American University joins the Patriot League as a full member; Georgetown University joins as an associate member in football.
- 2003** United States Naval Academy increases participation from 12 sports to 18 by joining Patriot League in men's lacrosse, men's swimming and diving and men's and women's cross country and track and field.
- 2004** Women's rowing added as Patriot League's 23rd sport.
- 2005** Patriot League celebrates 20th anniversary for the sport of football.
- 2007** Patriot League unveils broadband package for men and women's basketball. Nearly 100 regular-season and a dozen Patriot League Tournament games are streamed. A two-year agreement for basketball TV package with ESPN2 begins. Patriot League men's basketball 'Game of the Week' package on SIRIUS Satellite Radio debuts.



2008 PATRIOT LEAGUE SPRING NOTES

MAJOR AWARD WINNERS BACK IN 2008

All of the Patriot League's 2007 individual award winners return for the 2008 campaign. Holy Cross quarterback Dominic Randolph is back after placing in the top five nationally in most major categories a year ago and winning the Offensive Player of the Year. Lafayette linebacker Andy Romans, the 2007 Defensive Player of the Year, returns after helping the Leopards to the No. 1 rank in total defense a year ago. Fordham running back Xavier Martin enters his sophomore season after taking Rookie of the Year honors in 2007, while his head coach, Tom Masella, has the reigns for a third year after his 2007 Coach of the Year award.

LEAGUE BOASTS TOP PASSER, RUSHER IN NATION

The Patriot League is home to the top quarterback and running back in the Football Championship Subdivision going into the 2008 campaign. Randolph leads all qualified NCAA players with 292 passing yards and 303 yards of total offense per game in his career, which are also the top current marks in League annals. Colgate running back Jordan Scott has top marks with 4,473 rushing yards and 135.5 rushing yards per game, and comes off a 2007 campaign where he led the nation with 170.45 rushing yards per contest. Scott and Randolph were both finalists for the Walter Payton Award, given to the most outstanding player in the Football Championship Subdivision. They are two of only eight finalists returning in 2008.

JORDAN SCOTT RECORD WATCH

Jordan Scott set or tied five Patriot League season or career records in 2007, including a season-best 170.45 rushing yards per game. Now, the Colgate running back has a chance to go out as one of the top players in League and NCAA history. Scott is 362 yards away from breaking the all-time Patriot League rushing mark of 4,834 (Lafayette's Erik Marsh, 1991-94), and is within 59 points of becoming the League's all-time leading scorer. He enters the year with 13 consecutive 100-yard rushing games and 24 total 100-yard efforts, both four games away from tying the League marks of Bucknell's Rich Lemon (1993-96). Scott's 1,019 carries are just eight shy of Marsh's Patriot League mark and 196 from a Division I record. Scott has already tied League records with six 200-yard games and three 1,000-yard seasons in his career. Another 1,000-yard campaign would make Scott the first Patriot League and only the seventh player in FCS history to reach the feat all four of his seasons.

24 ALL-LEAGUE PERFORMERS RETURN IN 2008

Randolph, Scott and Romans headline a group of 24 student-athletes that earned 2007 All-League honors and come back to the field in 2008. Nine First-Team All-League performers are part of that group, with Scott, Romans and Lehigh's Brian Jackson returning after earning All-America or ECAC recognition a year ago.

MORE RETURNING TALENT

While the All-League players are most noteworthy, the overall numbers of starters returning are very solid throughout the League. Every team has at least 13 starters back out of their groups on offense and defense, with Colgate leading the way with 16 starters returning.

PATRIOT LEAGUE FACES OFF WITH SEVEN FCS CONFERENCES

Every Patriot League team will once again take on a schedule entirely composed of FCS opponents, and the League will square off with seven different conferences. The slate features 18 games against Ivy League opponents and five against teams from the Colonial Athletic Association.

COACHING STABILITY

Each Patriot League head coach enters at least his third season at the helm, with Colgate's Dick Biddle the elder statesman of the group in his 13th year in Hamilton. Biddle has already set Patriot League records for overall wins (95), League games coached (73) and League wins (57). He trails only Lafayette's Bill Russo (1986-99) for the longest tenure in League history.

TEAM NOTES

BUCKNELL The Bison have two new assistant coaches in 2008, with Harold Nichols taking over as offensive coordinator and Bill McCord as cornerbacks coach...A.J. Kizekai returns after earning First-Team All-Patriot League status as a kick returner and setting a new League and Bucknell mark with 1,113 kick return yards in 2007...The Bison were flagged for only 29 penalties in 2007, while no other FCS team had fewer than 41...Of the five departed offensive starters, four were on the offensive line...First-Team All-Patriot League defensive end Josh Eden is taking the next two years off to serve a Mormon mission.

FORDHAM CLAIMS FIRST OUTRIGHT PATRIOT LEAGUE TITLE

Fordham fell in its regular-season finale against Bucknell after clinching the Patriot League's automatic NCAA berth two weeks before against Holy Cross. But before the Bucknell game had concluded, the Rams learned that they would claim sole possession of the Patriot League crown as Holy Cross beat Colgate, 27-20. The Rams are the first Patriot League team to claim the title outright since Colgate in 2003. They fell to Massachusetts, 49-35, in the first round of the NCAA Division I Football Championship. The Rams finished in the top 20 in the FCS Coaches Poll (No. 19) and *Sports Network* poll (No. 20.)

DEPTH IN THE STANDINGS

Three teams finished just one game behind Fordham in the Patriot League standings, and it gave the Patriot League one of its deepest pools of quality teams in its 22-year history. Holy Cross' victory over Colgate on the final day of the season gave both teams identical 4-2 marks in the League, and Lafayette joined them for a three-way tie after a 21-17 victory over archrival Lehigh. All three teams also finished with 7-4 overall marks, and combined with Fordham's final record gave the Patriot League a strong group at the top. It was just the second time in the League history that four teams finished at 4-2 or better in League play, and only the sixth time that four teams closed the year with seven overall wins or more. Both feats were most recently accomplished in 2004.

SEVEN PATRIOT LEAGUERS NAMED ALL-AMERICANS

Three Patriot Leaguers were named to multiple All-America teams, while seven student-athletes earned at least one All-America nod. Lafayette offensive lineman Jesse Padilla was named to the American Football Coaches Association All-America team and earned Second-Team honors from the Associated Press. Colgate linebacker Mike Gallihugh and Fordham punter Benjamin Dato earned Second-Team AP honors, while Dato was a first-team pick and Gallihugh a second-team selection by The Sports Network. Lehigh's Brian Jackson was also a second-team pick by TSN, while Colgate's Jordan Scott and Pat Nolan earned third-team honors. The AFCA named only one team, and Holy Cross wide receiver Ryan Maher joined Padilla on the list. It was the highest number of individual Patriot League student-athletes since nine were honored in 2003, and the 10 overall selections to the four major lists were the most since 2004.

FOUR PATRIOT LEAGUERS IN FINAL FCS AWARDS VOTING

The Patriot League had a representative on all three of the major FCS awards ballots for the first time since 2004. Fordham Head Coach Tom Masella placed seventh in the Eddie Robinson Award voting, and was tied for fifth in first-place votes with eight. Holy Cross' Dominic Randolph finished 12th and Colgate's Jordan Scott was 14th in the Walter Payton Award voting for most outstanding player in the FCS. Colgate linebacker Mike Gallihugh was on the Buck Buchanan Award ballot for defensive player of the year honors for the second year in a row, and placed 11th in the voting.

HOLY CROSS' SMITH, BUCKNELL'S MOZAL NAMED ACADEMIC ALL-STARS

A pair of Patriot League offensive linemen received praise for their work in the classroom, as Holy Cross junior Chris Smith and Bucknell senior Nick Mozal were two of 51 student-athletes selected to the 2007 FCS Athletic Directors Association Academic All-Star Team. Both student-athletes carried a GPA above 3.5, as Smith majors in economics and accounting and Mozal in economics and political science.

MASELLA EARNS AFCA REGIONAL CO-COACH OF YEAR HONOR

Fordham Head Coach Tom Masella was named the American Football Coaches Association's Region 1 Co-Coach of the Year. Masella was one of six Football Championship Subdivision coaches to earn regional honors. He shared the Region 1 Coach of the Year award with Richmond Head Coach Dave Clawson.

SCOTT AND RANDOLPH LEAD WAY IN FINAL NCAA STATISTICS

Colgate running back Jordan Scott and Holy Cross quarterback Dominic Randolph went back and forth with huge efforts throughout the 2007 campaign, and it paid off with high finishes in the final NCAA statistics. Scott led the nation in rushing with 170.45 yards per game. He became the first Patriot Leaguer to lead the nation in rushing since former Raider Kenny Gamble did it in the inaugural season of 1986, and Scott also set the Patriot League record for rushing yards per game. Scott was third nationally in total rushing yards with 1,875, and seventh in all-purpose rushing and scoring. Randolph placed second in passing yards, total offense and completions per game, and in the top five in total passing yards and points responsible for. His 3,604-yard passing total was the third-best mark in League annals. Fordham punter Benjamin Dato had a solid finish in NCAA stats, as his 44.66 average was No. 3 in the nation.

PATRIOT LEAGUE TEAMS PLACE HIGH IN NCAA STATS, TOO

They flirted with the top spot all year, and in the end the Lafayette Leopards can claim the title as the No. 1 defense in the country. Lafayette led the nation with 260.91 yards allowed per game, which was nearly four yards per contest better than second-place Morgan State. The Leopards' average was the fourth-best mark in Patriot League history, and trailed only Bucknell in 2001 (260.1 ypg) for the top spot since 1988. Lafayette also placed eighth nationally in scoring defense and fourth against the rush. Holy Cross was on the other end of the spectrum, as the Crusaders placed in the top five nationally in total and passing offense, while putting up the best season for a Patriot League team since 1999 in both categories. They also finished first in the nation in fewest tackles for loss allowed. Fordham and Bucknell figured prominently in team statistics as well, as the Rams led the nation in net punting and punt return defense and the Bison led the way in fewest penalties per game.
