## WHAT TO WATCH FOR

Colgate heads to the NCAA Division I Football Championship for the first time since 2005, where the No. 16 Raiders will travel to No. 6/7 Villanova in the first round on Saturday. Colgate earned the Patriot League's automatic berth in the field with a 28-27 victory over Holy Cross on Saturday to complete the first undefeated Patriot League season since 2003. The Raiders' are making their sixth postseason appearance as a Patriot League member, and their eighth overall. Colgate is 3-5 in the postseason as a League member.

## No. 16 COLGATE TO FACE No. 6 VILLANOVA IN FIRST ROUND OF NCAA DIVISION I FOOTBALL CHAMPIONSHIP

After winning the Patriot League Championship and automatic berth to the postseason, the No. 16 Colgate Raiders will travel to No. 6 Villanova University in first-round action of the NCAA Division I Football Championship on Saturday.

Colgate (9-2, 5-0 Patriot League) completed a perfect Patriot League season by rallying from a 10-point halftime deficit to defeat Holy Cross at home on Saturday. The Raiders enter the postseason on an eight-game winning streak, behind only James Madison and No. 2 seed Appalachian State for the longest stretch in the nation. Colgate was the first team to finish with an undefeated mark in League play since 2003, when the Raiders went 7-0 in the Patriot League and won their first 15 games overall on their way to an appearance in the national championship game.



Colgate is in the postseason for the first time since 2005, and for the eighth time overall. The Raiders made the field as a Patriot League member in 1997, 1998, 1999, 2003 and 2005, while they also went in 1982 and 1983 before the formation of the League. Colgate's six playoff appearances as a Patriot League member are more than any other program in the League. The Raiders captured their sixth Patriot League title this season, with all of the crowns coming under 13th-year Head Coach Dick Biddle.

Colgate will travel to Villanova for a playoff contest for the second time. The first matchup came in the first postseason appearance for a Patriot League team, as No. 1 Villanova scored 22 consecutive fourth-quarter points to defeat the Raiders, 49-28, in a first-round matchup on Nov. 29, 1997. Villanova holds a 3-1 advantage in the all-time series.

Patriot League teams are 0-2 all-time against Villanova in the postseason. Fordham lost at Villanova, 24-10, in the quarterfinals in 2002. The Wildcats will join Delaware with the second-most matchups against Patriot League teams in the postseason with three, behind only the four with Massachusetts.

The winner of the Colgate/Villanova contest will face the winner of the matchup between Wofford and No. 1 seed James Madison in the quarterfinals.

## PATRIOT LEAGUE NCAA FCS PLAYOFF NOTEBOOK

### COLGATE WINS FIRST PATRIOT LEAGUE TITLE SINCE 2005

Colgate won its first Patriot League title since 2005 with a 28-27 victory over Holy Cross on Saturday. The Raiders' title was their sixth in League annals, with the five previous titles coming in 1997, 1999, 2002, 2003 and 2005. The Raiders' previous undefeated campaigns came in 1997 and 2003. Colgate's 5-0 Patriot League record was the first perfect mark for a League squad since the Raiders finished at 7-0 on their way to the national title game in 2003. The Raiders are only the second team in the last seven seasons to complete a perfect record in League play. Colgate's six titles are tied with Lafayette for the second-most in League history, behind only the eight of Lehigh. The Raiders' crowns have come under 13th-year Head Coach Dick Biddle.

### RAIDERS BACK IN THE POSTSEASON

The No. 16 Raiders are in the FCS postseason for the eighth time overall, and the sixth as a Patriot League member when they face off with No. 6/7 Villanova on Saturday. They previously made the field as a Patriot League member in 1997, 1998, 1999, 2003 and 2005, while they also went in 1982 and 1983 before the formation of the League. Colgate's six playoff appearances as a Patriot League member are more than any other program in the League.

### DEJA VU FOR RAIDERS AND WILDCATS

Colgate will play a first-round game at Villanova for the second time, and this contest will come 11 years to the day of the first postseason meeting between the schools. The first matchup came in the first postseason appearance for a Patriot League team, as No. 1 Villanova scored 22 consecutive fourth-quarter points to defeat the Raiders, 49-28, in a first-round matchup on Nov. 29, 1997. Oddly enough, Colgate also made that postseason that year after winning the Patriot League title on the final weekend in a matchup of undefeated squads. That year, Colgate beat Bucknell, 48-14, in Hamilton to claim the Patriot League title.

### RAIDERS ROLLING INTO POSTSEASON

Colgate enters the postseason on an eight-game winning streak, behind only No. 1 seed James Madison and No. 2 seed Appalachian State for the longest stretch in the nation. The Raiders have not lost since falling at home to Furman on Sept. 13.

### DESTINY'S DARLINGS?

Colgate had to rally for a win and survive late in the game against Holy Cross, but that was nothing new for the Raiders. The Raiders had to rally in the second half in four of their five Patriot League victories this season. Colgate came back from an early 14-0 deficit and scored the winning points with nine seconds left in a 31-24 triumph at Fordham on Sept. 27. The Raiders' comeback ability has been on display throughout the month of November. Colgate was down, 10-0, at halftime against Lafayette before coming back for a 21-13 win. The Raiders rallied from a 33-21 second-half deficit for a 34-33 victory at Lehigh on Nov. 8. Finally, they trailed Holy Cross, 24-14, at halftime before rallying for the 28-27 victory. Colgate also came back in the second half for non-League victories against Coastal Carolina, Princeton and Dartmouth.

### COLGATE'S POSTSEASON HISTORY

Colgate has a 3-5 record in postseason games as a Patriot League member, with all of the wins coming in its march to the national championship game in 2003. In addition to the contest with Villanova in 1997, the Raiders also faced a team from the Colonial Athletic Association in the first round in 2003 and 2005. Colgate knocked off Massachusetts, 19-7, in the first round in 2003, and fell to New Hampshire, 55-21, in its last appearance in the first round in 2005. The Raiders are 1-3 as a Patriot League member against CAA opponents in the postseason, a mark that also includes the loss to Delaware in the 2003 national title game.

### PATRIOT LEAGUE VERSUS VILLANOVA IN THE PLAYOFFS

Patriot League teams are 0-2 all-time against Villanova in the postseason. In addition to Colgate's 1997 game, Fordham lost at Villanova, 24-10, in the quarterfinals in 2002. The Wildcats join Delaware with the second-most matchups against Patriot League teams in the postseason with three, behind only the four with Massachusetts.

## PATRIOT LEAGUE NCAA FCS PLAYOFF NOTEBOOK

### PATRIOT LEAGUE IN THE FIRST ROUND

Patriot League teams have a 7-15 all-time record in the postseason, and a 5-10 mark in first-round action. Saturday's game will add another chapter in the long playoff history against the Colonial Athletic Association. The Patriot League has a 4-11 record against CAA teams, and has faced at least one CAA opponent in every season since first entering the playoffs in 1997. The League's success against the CAA has all come in the first round, with a 4-7 all-time record in opening matchups.

### RAIDERS, WILDCATS BOTH LIKE TO RUN

Rushing yardage and time of possession could both prove crucial to Saturday's matchup, as Colgate and Villanova have each excelled in both categories throughout the season. The Raiders are fourth in the nation with 273.4 rushing yards per game, while the Wildcats are 13th with 210.2 yards per contest. Colgate is up to No. 1 in the country in time of possession after controlling the ball for more than 42 minutes against Holy Cross, but Villanova is not far behind at 13th in the country in time of possession. Colgate will have to maintain its rushing dominance against a tough Villanova defense that ranks sixth nationally against the run and allows just 2.8 yards per carry.

### COLGATE'S SCOTT SETS ANOTHER RECORD; ONE MORE TO GO

Colgate running back Jordan Scott rushed for 82 yards before exiting with an injury against Holy Cross on Saturday, and it was enough to make him the eighth player in FCS annals and first Patriot Leaguer with four 1,000-yard seasons in his career. Scott has 1,054 yards on the ground this season. He is just two carries away from tying the Division I record of 1,215 (Steve Bartalo, Colorado State 1983-86). Earlier in the year, Scott broke the Patriot League career record for rushing yardage, rushing touchdowns, 100-yard games, consecutive 100-yard games, carries and scoring earlier in the year. He is the active FCS leader in rushing yardage, all-purpose yardage, carries and touchdowns. Scott also did damage in his lone FCS playoff appearance, rushing for 205 yards and three touchdowns in Colgate's loss to New Hampshire in 2005.

### PATRIOT LEAGUE ANNOUNCES MAJOR AWARD WINNERS

For the first time in Patriot League history, both the Offensive and Defensive Player of the Year honors in football are repeat selections. Holy Cross senior quarterback Dominic Randolph earns the Patriot League Offensive Player of the Year award for the second year in a row, while Lafayette senior linebacker Andy Romans won his second straight Patriot League Defensive Player of the Year award, it was announced on Tuesday. The remaining major award winners both come from Patriot League champion Colgate, as Head Coach Dick Biddle tied a League record with his fourth Coach of the Year honor and freshman Nate Eachus became the fifth consecutive running back to win the League's Rookie of the Year honor. Holy Cross senior tight end Ryan McGuire was voted the 2008 Patriot League Football Scholar-Athlete of the Year. McGuire is the first Crusader football student-athlete to win the award. ### RANDOLPH, ROMANS, BIDDLE UP FOR FCS AWARDS

Randolph is on the finalist list for the Walter Payton Award (Most Outstanding Player in the FCS), while Romans is a finalist for the Buck Buchanan Award (Top Defensive Player) and Biddle is a contender for the Eddie Robinson Award (Top Coach).

### PATRIOT LEAGUE RECORDS 20 NON-LEAGUE WINS

The Patriot League heads into the postseason with a 20-16 non-League record. Patriot League teams have clinched the League's first winning mark in non-League games since 2004, when they combined for a 21-16 record. The 20 wins are the most since that campaign.

### GEORGETOWN/COLGATE MATCHUP CANCELLED

The Oct. 4 contest between Georgetown and Colgate was cancelled due to an outbreak of norovirus on Georgetown's campus. It was agreed that the game will be listed as an un-played game in the League standings and overall school records for the 2008 season.

**Colgate Notebook** No. 16 Colgate heads into the postseason after winning its sixth Patriot League title with a 28-27 triumph over Holy Cross on Saturday...The Raiders won their first outright crown since 2003, and completed the first undefeated campaign for any Patriot League team since they went 7-0 that season... Colgate earns its sixth Patriot League title and postseason berth under Head Coach Dick Biddle...Colgate's six titles tie Lafayette for the second-most in League history...The Raiders won four of their five League games by eight points or less, with one-point wins over both Lehigh and Holy Cross...It was the first matchup between two undefeated teams on the final weekend of the regular season since Colgate beat Bucknell in 1997...The Raiders also won their eighth consecutive game overall...Colgate has won seven of the last eight and 10 of the last 12 in the series with the Crusaders...The Raiders have won the last four contests with Holy Cross at home, with one-point wins in the last two matchups in Hamilton...Colgate rallied from a 24-14 halftime deficit to defeat the Crusaders...The Raiders came within three on a 10-minute drive to start the third quarter, and scored the game-winning points on a five-yard run by Nate Eachus with 13:05 to play...Colgate halted Holy Cross' next drive on an interception by Wayne Moten at the Holy Cross 11...The Raiders ran out the final 4:37, with Eachus picking up nine yards on a 3rd-and-5 play at the Holy Cross 10 to seal the victory...Eachus slid down at the one to run out the clock...Jordan Scott had 22 carries for 82 yards and a touchdown in the game...Scott became the eighth player in FCS history and first Patriot Leaguer with four 1,000-yard rushing seasons in his career...He also pulled within two carries of tying the all-time Division I record of 1,215...Colgate held a 283-19 advantage in rushing yardage, and a 42:27 to 17:33 edge in time of possession...Eachus had 118 rushing yards and a touchdown...Quarterback Greg Sullivan ran for 76 yards and completed 8-of-12 passes for 129 yards with two touchdowns.

**Lafayette Notebook** Lafayette saw its four-game win streak against rival Lehigh come to an end with a 31-15 loss at home on Saturday...The Leopards had not lost to the Mountain Hawks since 2003, and had won three consecutive home contests in the series...Lafayette still holds a 76-63-5 edge in the all-time series, and has won four of the last five and five of the last seven meetings...Lafayette finishes the season 7-4 overall, and 3-3 in Patriot League action...The Leopards won at least seven games for the fourth time in the last five years, and finished .500 or better in the Patriot League for the fifth consecutive season...Lafayette was 5-1 on the road in 2008, but just 2-3 at home...Shaun Adair had a 62-yard touchdown run in the first quarter against Lehigh...Adair finished his career as one of the top receivers in Lafayette history...His 2,190 yards rank third on the career receiving yards list and his 148 career receptions ranks fourth...Andy Romans led the Leopards with nine tackles.



### LEHIGH (5-6, 4-2 PATRIOT LEAGUE)

**Lehigh Notebook** Lehigh snapped a four-game losing streak to rival Lafayette with a 31-15 victory in Easton on Saturday...The Mountain Hawks finish their season at 5-6 overall and 4-2 in the Patriot League, claiming third place in the League standings...Lehigh won its first game against Lafayette since 2003, and its first in Easton since 2000...The Mountain Hawks have also now won five games or more for 11 consecutive seasons, and have finished with a winning Patriot League record in 10 of the last 11 years...It was the 144th meeting of the most-played rivalry in college football...J.B. Clark completed 12-of-22 passes for 201 yards and two touchdowns to earn game MVP honors...He became the first Lehigh sophomore quarterback to earn MVP honors since 1983...John Kennedy sealed the win with a 94-yard interception return for a touchdown late in the fourth quarter...The Lehigh defense registered a season-best eight sacks, led by Brian Jackson who sacked the Leopard quarterbacks three-and-a-half times...The 3.5 sacks were a career high for Jackson, who recorded a sack for the first time since Nov. 8, 1997...Two of his sacks came on consecutive plays in the first half...He finishes his career with nine sacks...Mike Fitzgerald caught five passes for 101 yards and a touchdown...It was his second-career 100-yard receiving game...His 11 touchdown receptions this year were the most for a Mountain Hawk since 2001...Jason Leo averaged 42.9 yards on seven punts in the game...Leo ranks seventh nationally with a 43.0 punting average, while the Mountain Hawks are third in net punting...Tim Diamond finished with a game-high 11 tackles, pushing him over 100 for the second consecutive season...It marks the first time a Lehigh player registered back-to-back 100 tackle seasons since Ian Eason in 1996 and 1997.

## COLGATE DEFEATS HOLY CROSS, 28-27, TO WIN PATRIOT LEAGUE FOOTBALL CHAMPIONSHIP

For the first time since 2005, the Colgate Raiders have captured the Patriot League Football Championship. Down by 10 points at the half to Holy Cross, No. 21 Colgate scored the game-winning touchdown on a five-yard run by Nate Eachus with 13:05 to play and used a strong running game and defense to hold on the rest of the way for a 28-27 victory over the Crusaders on Saturday at Andy Kerr Stadium.

Colgate also earns the Patriot League's automatic bid to the NCAA Football Championship Subdivision playoffs for the first time since that 2005 season. The Raiders (9-2, 5-0) won their first outright crown since 2003, and completed the first undefeated campaign for any Patriot League team since they went 7-0 that season. Colgate earns its sixth Patriot League title and postseason berth under Head Coach Dick Biddle. The Raiders also won their eighth consecutive game overall. Holy Cross (7-4, 5-1) saw its six-game winning streak come to an end.

On a cold, snowy day in Hamilton, both offenses came out hot. Holy Cross started the scoring on the game's second play, as Dominic Randolph threw a strike down the middle of the field to Jon Brock that went for a 75-yard touchdown pass to give the Crusaders the 7-0 advantage less than a minute into the game. After an exchange of punts, Colgate evened the score with a big passing play of its own. A pair of runs set up a first-down play-action fake by Greg Sullivan, and he tossed a perfect 50-yard touchdown pass down the middle of the field to Pat Simonds to tie the game at 7-7 with 8:28 left in the first quarter.

Holy Cross engineered another fast scoring drive to regain the lead. Randolph completed a pair of passes to move the Crusaders to the Colgate 42 yard line, then found a wide open Bill Edger for a 42-yard catch and run touchdown to make it a 14-7 Holy Cross advantage with 7:06 left in the quarter. The Crusaders went 75 yards on the drive in three plays, and took just 1:15 off the clock. Colgate went to its bread and butter on the next drive to tie the score at 14-14. The Raiders ran on every play of a 14-play, 63-yard drive that took 7:31 off the clock, and converted a pair of fourth downs to keep the drive alive. Jordan Scott ran for 12 yards on a fourth-and-inches play from the 13 to start the second quarter, then scored on a one-yard run on the next play to even the score with 14:30 left in the period. On the 12-yard run, Scott became the eighth player in FCS history and the first Patriot Leaguer with four 1,000-yard rushing seasons in his career.

Holy Cross used a big kick return play to score another quick touchdown to take the lead right back. Brett McDermott returned the kickoff to the 49-yard line, and a 15-yard late hit penalty allowed Holy Cross to start its drive at the Colgate 36. The Crusaders marched down for a first-and-goal play, and Randolph tossed a seven-yard touchdown pass to McDermott in the back of the endzone for a 21-14 Holy Cross lead with 12:34 left in the second quarter. Colgate went on another long march on its next possession, but was forced into a 4th-and-2 play from the Holy Cross six-yard line. The Raiders went for it on fourth down again, but this time they were unsuccessful as Sullivan's pass fell just incomplete for a diving Nick Cvetis. Holy Cross started its next possession with 5:22 left until the half, and milked most of the clock before settling for a 36-yard Matt Partain field goal with 17 seconds left to take a 24-14 lead into the break.

Colgate got the ball to start the second half, and took more than 10 minutes off the clock before scoring a touchdown to pull back within 24-21. The Raiders ran 10:09 off the clock, and once again converted a huge fourth down to keep the drive going. Sullivan ran for five yards on a fourth-and-three play from the 15, then used his arm for a 10-yard touchdown pass to Simonds on third-and-goal with 4:51 left in the third quarter. Holy Cross continued to move quickly on its next possession, taking just three plays to get down to the Colgate 20 yard line. But the Colgate defense held from there, forcing three consecutive incompletions to force the Crusaders to settle for another Partain field goal for a 27-21 lead with 3:06 left in the third.

Colgate continued to move the ball successfully on its next possession, with Nate Eachus coming in for an injured Scott. Sullivan completed a 24-yard pass to Simonds down to the Holy Cross 39, and completed a 14-yard pass to Eachus on a third-and-eight play to move it to the Holy Cross 11. Eachus ran twice and got into the endzone from there, scoring on a five-yard rush for the 28-27 lead and eventual game-winning touchdown with 13:05 left.

Eachus and the Colgate defense combined to put the game away down the stretch. Holy Cross moved the ball all the way to the Colgate 31 in less than two minutes on its next possession, but Wayne Moten intercepted a Randolph pass at the 11 to halt the drive. The Raiders grinded out 39 yards and 5:02 off the clock on their next possession, but the Crusaders held on the 50-yard line to re-gain possession. Holy Cross started on its 12 yard line with 6:02 left, but a holding call and incompletions on second and third down forced a Crusader punt. Colgate took possession on its own 46 with 4:37 left in the game, and Eachus carried eight times on the final drive to seal the win. He gained nine yards on a third-and-five play from the Holy Cross 10, smartly sliding at the one-yard line to allow the Raiders to run out the clock and capture their first Patriot League title since 2005.

It was the first time since 1997 that two undefeated teams met for the Patriot League title on the final Saturday of the season. Colgate also won that game, defeating Bucknell, 48-14, for its first Patriot League title. Colgate's six titles tie Lafayette for the second-most in League history. The Raiders won four of their five League games by eight points or less, with one-point wins over both Lehigh and Holy Cross.

Scott and Randolph both set individual records in the contest. Scott became the eighth player in FCS history and first Patriot Leaguer with four 1,000-yard rushing seasons in his career. He also pulled within two carries of tying the all-time Division I record of 1,215. Randolph set a Patriot League career record with 821 completions, just breaking the mark of 820 held by Lafayette's Marko Glavic (2000-03). He also set a Patriot League record with eight 300-yard games this season, and extended his League record to 18 career 300-yard efforts. Randolph tied the League mark of 34 touchdown passes in a season, and extended his career touchdown passes record to 83. Colgate held a 283-19 advantage in rushing yardage, and a 42:27 to 17:33 edge in time of possession. Eachus had 118 rushing yards and a touchdown, while Scott finished with 82 yards on the ground and a score. Sullivan ran for 76 yards and completed 8-of-12 passes for 129 yards with two touchdowns.
