OFFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

DOMINIC RANDOLPH, HOLY CROSS Sr., QB, 6'3, 223, Amelia, Ohio/St. Xavier

Randolph set or tied five Patriot League career records on a huge day that included two fourth-quarter touchdown passes to lead Holy Cross to a 20-7 victory over Georgetown in the Patriot League opener. Randolph completed 36-of-56 passes for 414 yards and led Holy Cross back from a 7-6 fourth-quarter deficit. He also rushed for 17 yards to finish with 431 yards of total offense. Randolph set Patriot League career records for passing yardage, total offense, and 400-yard total offense games, while tying career marks for touchdowns responsible for and 400-yard passing games. Randolph became the first Patriot League quarterback to go over 10,000 passing yards (10,093), and now holds or is tied for eight different Patriot League career records. It is the 13th Offensive Player of the Week honor of his career.



DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

B.J. BENNING, LEHIGH Sr., DL, 6'0, 285, Ellicott City, Md./River Mill

Benning had a strong effort in a season-opening loss for the Mountain Hawks, recording a career-high 12 tackles with 1.5 tackles for loss and a sack in the 28-21 defeat to Central Connecticut State. He had four solo and eight assisted tackles to record his first career double-figure tackle game. He had five tackles in the second quarter, and another four in the fourth. Benning earns his first Defensive Player of the Week award.



SPECIAL TEAMS PLAYER OF THE WEEK

JOHN KENNEDY, LEHIGH Jr., DB/KR, 5'10, 185, Philadelphia, Pa./Central

Kennedy earns his first Special Teams Player of the Week award after returning a kickoff 92 yards for a touchdown in Lehigh's 28-21 loss to Central Connecticut State. The return put Lehigh on the board and evened the score at 7-7 in the first quarter. It was the first kickoff return for a touchdown in his career, and first for any Mountain Hawk player since Gerran Walker in 2004.



ROOKIE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

EDDIE HOUGHTON, HOLY CROSS Fr., RB, Toronto, Ontario/St. Michael's

Houghton carried seven times for 52 yards and also caught a pass for nine yards in his first collegiate contest to help Holy Cross past Georgetown, 20-7. He led the Crusader rushing attack, and had a long run of 17 yards. Houghton's brother, Charlie, was at running back for Georgetown. Charlie Houghton won the 2006 Patriot League Rookie of the Year award.

So., RB, 5'10, 206, Drums, Pa./Hazleton

Eachus ran for 139 yards and three touchdowns, going over the 1,000-yard career rushing mark in the first game of his sophomore season, in a 35-23 win over Monmouth.

JOHN SKELTON, FORDHAM

Sr., QB, 6'5, 258, El Paso, Texas/Burges

Skelton completed 28-of-42 passes for 302 yards and a touchdown, and also ran for 54 yards and two scores, in Fordham's 41-28 loss to Rhode Island.

SEAN LAMKIN, HOLY CROSS

Sr., LB, 6'1, 225, Jenks, Okla./Jenks

Lamkin had his first career interception and also posted four tackles and a tackle for loss in Holy Cross' 20-7 win over Georgetown.

JOHN VON PARIS, BUCKNELL

Jr., DL, 6'2, 248, Upper Falls, Md./John Carroll

Von Paris had career highs with five tackles and two sacks in Bucknell's 24-19 loss at Duquesne.

PATRIOT LEAGUE NOTEBOOK

HOLY CROSS OPENS LEAGUE SCHEDULE WITH A WIN

It didn't come easy, but preseason favorite Holy Cross opened its Patriot League schedule with a 20-7 victory over Georgetown on Saturday. The Crusaders gave up the opening touchdown and still trailed, 7-6, going into the fourth quarter before scoring a pair of touchdowns in the final period. Holy Cross won't return to League action until hosting defending champion Colgate on Oct. 24.

COLGATE CLAIMS FIRST NIGHT GAME AT ANDY KERR STADIUM

The suddenly bright lights of their home field suited Colgate just fine, as the Raiders earned a 35-23 victory over Monmouth in the first-ever night game at Andy Kerr Stadium. Colgate came back from a 16-14 halftime deficit by scoring the first three touchdowns of the second half. The Raiders won their ninth consecutive regular-season game, and fourth straight home outing, going back to last year. The results were not as good for other Patriot League teams in non-League action, as Lehigh, Fordham and Bucknell all lost.

LIGHTS, PATRIOT LEAGUE ACTION AT GEORGETOWN SATURDAY

Another Patriot League team will play its first home night contest this weekend, and it will come in League action. Georgetown will host Lafayette in a Patriot League contest at 6 p.m. in the first night game at Multi-Sport Field. The Hoyas are 0-1 in the League, while the Leopards play their first game of the year. Holy Cross (Sacred Heart), Colgate (Stony Brook) and Bucknell (Robert Morris) will host non-League games, while Lehigh faces a very stiff test with a trip to No. 3/3 Villanova. Fordham has its bye week.

HOLY CROSS' RANDOLPH ALL OVER THE RECORD BOOK NOW

After throwing for 414 yards and two touchdowns in Saturday's win over Georgetown, Holy Cross quarterback Dominic Randolph now lays claim to nearly every career Patriot League passing and total offense record. Randolph broke or tied five Patriot League career records in the game, and now has the lead in eight different categories in the League career record book. Randolph took over as the Patriot League all-time leader in passing yardage (10,093), becoming the first Patriot Leaguer to crack the 10,000-yard barrier. He also became the all-time League leader in total offense (10,415). He tied the mark for most career 400-yard passing games (6), and now holds sole possession of the record for most games with 400 yards or more of total offense (7). He also tied the record for most touchdowns responsible for (94). Randolph extended his career League records for completions, passing touchdowns and 300-yard passing games, as the Walter Payton Award candidate threw for 300 yards or more for the ninth consecutive game and 19th time overall.

PATRIOT LEAGUE OFFENSIVE STARS AMONG NATION'S BEST

Randolph isn't the only Patriot Leaguer to put up a big-time performance on the season's first weekend, as three other schools also boast an individual among the top 10 in the Football Championship Subdivision in at least one offensive category. Randolph is second nationally in passing yards, completions and total offense per game, while Fordham senior quarterback John Skelton is in the top 10 in each category as well as in points responsible for. Skelton also moved into the Patriot League career top 10 in completions, attempts, touchdowns responsible for and total offense. Colgate running back Nate Eachus and Bucknell counterpart C.J. Hopson are both in the top 10 in rushing average, with Eachus at No. 9 with 139.0 and Hopson right behind at 136.0. Eachus is also tied for the national lead in scoring after notching three touchdowns against Monmouth. He has already passed the 1,000-yard rushing mark in his career while playing just nine games at running back.

HOLY CROSS REMAINS AT NO. 25

Holy Cross maintained its spot at No. 25 in this week's Sports Network FCS rankings, and is closing in on a spot in the FCS Coaches Poll where it ranks 26th. When they were ranked in the preseason, it marked the first time that the Crusaders had appeared in the poll since Sept. 16, 2002. The Crusaders also became the first Patriot League team ranked by The Sports Network in the preseason since Lehigh in 2005.

PATRIOT LEAGUE NOTEBOOK

PATRIOT LEAGUE TEAMS HIT THE AIRWAVES

Patriot League fans won't have to go far to keep track of the action in 2009, with 24 games already scheduled for regional or national television. The highlight comes on Oct. 8, when Colgate visits Princeton in a nationally-televised game on ESPNU. There will be at least two televised games every week during the 2009 season, with Lafayette once again televising each of its contests through the Lafayette Sports Network. Lehigh will have nine televised games, including each home game live on Service Electric 2 Sports. Holy Cross and Colgate each have three home games televised regionally. Every Patriot League team will appear on television at least once during the 2009 season.

HOME COOKING ON NON-LEAGUE SCHEDULE

Fans will have plenty of opportunities to see their team in action in 2009, as 21 of the 35 non-League contests will be played at the home of the Patriot League school. Lehigh has four of its five non-League contests at home, while every other team except Bucknell plays three non-League games at home. The Patriot League plays an all Division I schedule, facing off with five FCS conferences. The slate includes 18 games against Ivy League foes.

UNDER THE LIGHTS

With new lights installed, Colgate defeated Monmouth in the first night action at Andy Kerr Stadium on Saturday. The Raiders will play two more home night games this month. Georgetown follows with its first night contest at Multi-Sport Field on Saturday against Lafayette. Bucknell, Fordham and Lafayette will also play at least one home game under the lights this season, as Patriot League teams host 10 night games in September and October.

FORMER LAFAYETTE STAR COSTANZO ACTIVE WITH CLEVELAND BROWNS

Blake Costanzo will begin his third season on an NFL active roster on Sunday, as the former All-Patriot League linebacker from Lafayette has earned a spot with the Cleveland Browns. Costanzo played 19 games over the past two years with the Buffalo Bills, including all 16 contests in the 2008 campaign. Former Colgate offensive lineman Nick Hennessey, who was a consensus All-America selection last year, starts the year on the Bills' practice squad.

18 PATRIOT LEAGUERS RECEIVE PRESEASON ALL-AMERICA HONORS

A host of Patriot Leaguers have earned at least one All-America mention going into the 2009 campaign, with 18 players named on one list or more. The group includes six players that were placed on a first, second or third team by one or more organizations. Holy Cross quarterback Dominic Randolph and Colgate wide receiver Pat Simonds were second-team selections by both The Sports Network and Phil Steele's 2009 College Football Preview, while Lehigh linebacker Matt Cohen earned the League's lone first-team nod on the Phil Steele's list. Lafayette placekicker Davis Rodriguez was a second-team pick by The Sports Network, while Lehigh offensive lineman Will Rackley and Bucknell wide receiver Shaun Pasternak were each placed on the organization's third team. All of the players except Simonds also received at least one honorable mention nod. Also receiving honorable mention plaudits were: Bucknell RB/RS A.J. Kizekai, Bucknell DB Ahkiel White, Fordham QB John Skelton, Fordham DB James Crockett, Holy Cross OL Aaron Jones, Holy Cross DB Michael Wright, Lafayette OL Brian Wycinowski, Lafayette DL Andrew Poulson, Lafayette LB Mark Leggiero, Lehigh DL B.J. Benning, Lehigh DB John Kennedy and Lehigh DB Jarard Cribbs. Skelton was also chosen as the ninth-rated senior quarterback prospect in the country by Gil Brandt of NFL.com.

HOLY CROSS, COLGATE RANKED IN PRESEASON PUBLICATIONS

Holy Cross and Colgate each received spots in the top 25 of various preseason magazines. The Crusaders captured the highest ranking at No. 13 in *Phil Steele's 2009 College Football Preview*, and were also picked 18th in *Athlon* and 21st by *Lindy's*. Defending Patriot League champion Colgate came in at No. 20 in *Sporting News* and No. 22 in *USA Today Sports Weekly*.

Lafayette opens its season by traveling to Georgetown for a Patriot League contest, where the Hoyas will play the first night game at Multi-Sport Field in their home opener...The Leopards have opened their Patriot League schedule with a win over Georgetown for the past two seasons, and have not dropped a Patriot League opener since 2003...Lafayette has a seven-game winning streak in overall season openers on the line, with the last loss coming against Towson in 2001...Lafayette Head Coach Frank Tavani is 7-2 in season openers...Georgetown is trying to avoid starting 0-2 in League action for the fourth straight year.

LAFAYETTE The Leopards were idle for the first week of the season...Lafayette had a share of third place in the Patriot League pre-season poll...The Leopards have 12 returning starters, with six on both offense and defense...Patriot League Preseason Defensive Player of the Year Mark Leggiero is part of that group at line-backer...Leggiero, placekicker Davis Rodriguez, defensive lineman Andrew Poulson and offensive lineman Brian Wycinowski were all named preseason All-Americans...Leggiero and Rodriguez were also named All-Patriot League players last year, along with offensive lineman Ryan Hart-Predmore...The Leopards open their home schedule next week against Liberty.



GEORGETOWN The Hoyas took an early lead with upset on their mind, but gave up two fourth-quarter touchdowns in a 20-7 loss to Holy Cross on Saturday...Georgetown went up, 7-0, by scoring on its opening drive, and held a 7-6 lead early in the fourth quarter...It was Georgetown's 10th straight loss to Holy Cross, including all nine in Patriot League play...The Hoyas dropped their League opener for the fourth year in a row...Wayne Heimuli had five tackles and three tackles for loss, while Rick Rattay had a pair of interceptions off Holy Cross quarterback Dominic Randolph...The Hoyas are playing the first of a three-game homestand, with Yale coming next week and Howard in a cross-town matchup on Sept. 26.

Holy Cross tries to get off to a 2-0 start for the first time since 2005 when it hosts Sacred Heart in the second of a three-game homestand on Saturday...The 2-0 start in 2005 also came in home games against Sacred Heart and Georgetown, with the Crusaders winning the opener over Sacred Heart, 56-21, in the only all-time meeting between the schools...Holy Cross puts a four-game home winning streak on the line...Patriot League teams are 2-0 all-time against Sacred Heart, with Lafayette earning the other victory in 2006.

HOLY CROSS The Crusaders trailed going into the fourth quarter at home against Georgetown, but Patriot League Preseason Offensive Player of the Year Dominic Randolph threw a pair of touchdown passes to lead the team to a 20-7 win...Randolph was 36-for-56 for 414 yards and two touchdowns, and set or tied five Patriot League career records in the game...He became the first player in League history with more than 10,000 passing yards (10,093), and also set career marks for total offense (10,415) and 400-yard total offense games (7) while tying marks for touchdowns responsible for (94) and 400-yard passing games (6)...The Crusaders had a 519-169 edge in total offense...Holy Cross won its 10th straight game against Georgetown, including all nine in League action...The Crusaders opened their Patriot League schedule with a win over Georgetown for the fifth straight year...It was the first season-opening win for the Crusaders since beating Georgetown in 2006...Holy Cross concludes its season-opening three-game homestand next week when it takes on Harvard.
