OFFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

DOMINIC RANDOLPH, HOLY CROSS Sr., QB, 6'3, 223, Amelia, Ohio/St. Xavier

Another outstanding performance gives Randolph his third consecutive Offensive Player of the Week honor, and his fourth in the last five weeks. Randolph completed 35-of-59 passes for 407 yards and a season-high five touchdowns with three interceptions as Holy Cross improved to 4-0 in the Patriot League with a 38-17 victory over Fordham. Randolph threw all of his touchdowns in the first three quarters as Holy Cross rolled to a 38-3 lead entering the fourth. He set a Holy Cross record with 77 career touchdown passes, just one off the Patriot League mark of 78 held by Lehigh's Phil Stambaugh (1996-99). Randolph recorded his sixth consecutive 300-yard game, and his 16th career 300-yard effort to extend his Patriot League record. It was also his second 400-yard passing day this season, and fourth of his career. The Offensive Player of the Week award is the 11th of Randolph's career.



DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

GREG HADLEY, COLGATE Jr., LB, 5'11, 223, Fayetteville, N.Y./CBA

Hadley earns Defensive Player of the Week honors for the second week in a row after recording a game-high 11 tackles and both forcing and recovering a fumble in Colgate's 34-33 victory at Lehigh. The fumble recovery came early in the first quarter to set up Colgate's first touchdown of the game.



SPECIAL TEAMS PLAYER OF THE WEEK

A.J. KIZEKAI, BUCKNELL Jr., RB/KR, 5'9, 189, Pawtucket, R.I./Blair (N.J.) Academy

Kizekai set a Bucknell record with 210 kickoff return yards, including a 100-yard kickoff return for a touchdown, in Bucknell's 38-21 loss to Lafayette on Saturday. He averaged 35.0 yards on six kickoff returns. The 100-yard return was a Bucknell record and tied the score at 7-7 in the first quarter. It also made Kizekai the sixth Patriot Leaguer with two career kickoff return touchdowns. Kizekai also became Bucknell's career leader in kickoff return yards. He totaled a career-high 285 all-purpose yards in the game. Kizekai earns his first Special Teams Award this season, and the third of his career.



ROOKIE OF THE WEEK

NATE EACHUS, COLGATE Fr., RB, 5'11, 195, Drums, Pa./Hazleton Area

Eachus earns his fourth consecutive Rookie of the Week honor after carrying 26 times for 103 yards and a touchdown in Colgate's 34-33 victory at Lehigh. He has gone over 100 yards rushing in each of the last four games. Eachus has 754 rushing yards and nine touchdowns this year.

PERFORMANCES LAST WEEK

PAT SIMONDS, WR, COLGATE

Simonds caught seven passes for 148 yards and a career-high and school-record tying three touchdowns in Colgate's 34-33 win at Lehigh. He pulled in a seven-yard touchdown for the game-winning score with 2:28 to play.

JB CLARK, QB, LEHIGH

Clark completed 24-of-39 passes for a career-high 338 yards and a career-high tying four touchdowns with no interceptions in Lehigh's 34-33 loss to Colgate.

MARC QUILLING, QB, LAFAYETTE

Quilling went 17-of-26 for 274 yards with three touchdowns and no interceptions in his first career start in Lafayette's 38-21 victory at Bucknell.

PATRIOT LEAGUE NOTEBOOK

COLGATE AND HOLY CROSS KEEP WINNING, STAY IN FIRST-PLACE TIE

One of them needed a fourth-quarter comeback, while the other rolled to an easy win. They did it in different fashions, but Colgate and Holy Cross remained in a tie for first place in the Patriot League football standings by each posting victories on Saturday to move to 4-0 in the League. The Raiders got a seven-yard touchdown pass from Greg Sullivan to Pat Simonds with 2:28 left to complete a comeback from a 12-point deficit and win at Lehigh, 34-33. The Crusaders opened up a 38-3 lead behind five touchdown passes from quarterback Dominic Randolph on their way to a 38-17 victory in their home finale against Fordham. Lafayette stayed in the hunt for the League title with a 38-21 win at Bucknell. With a bye week coming up, No. 23/24 Colgate is guaranteed to play for the outright League title and automatic FCS playoff berth when it hosts Holy Cross on Nov. 22.

LAFAYETTE'S TITLE HOPES ON THE LINE AT HOME AGAINST HOLY CROSS

There's no doubt about what Patriot League game means the most this weekend. Patriot League co-leader Holy Cross puts its 4-0 mark on the line at Lafayette, which is still in the race for the League title and automatic playoff berth with a 3-1 League record. A Holy Cross victory would set up a showdown of undefeated squads for the League title on Nov. 22 at Colgate, which is idle Saturday. A Lafayette win would put both the Leopards and Crusaders one game behind the Raiders in the standings and keep all three teams in the mix for the League title and automatic FCS playoff berth. Bucknell is at Lehigh and Georgetown visits Fordham to complete Saturday's slate.

GEORGETOWN MAKES IT AN EVEN 20

With Georgetown's 13-12 win over Marist on Saturday, Patriot League teams have 20 non-League victories for the first time since 2004. With the regular-season non-League schedule complete with a 20-16 record, the teams have clinched the League's first winning mark in non-League games since 2004, when they combined for a 21-16 record.

COLGATE IN BOTH TOP 25 POLLS

Colgate has a spot in both of the major FCS polls, as the Raiders cracked the FCS Coaches Poll at No. 24 on Monday. They also moved up one spot to No. 23 in *The Sports Network* top 25. Lafayette and Holy Cross are close to joining the Raiders, finishing just outside the top 25 in both rankings.

RAIDERS, LEOPARDS IN ECAC RANKINGS

Colgate came in eighth and Lafayette was 10th in the latest ECAC Lambert Meadowlands FCS poll. Both teams were also in the rankings last week.

COLGATE AND HOLY CROSS POSTING IMPRESSIVE WIN STREAKS

Colgate is 4-0 in the Patriot League and has seven consecutive wins overall for the first time since the 2003 season, when they won their first 15 games of the year before falling in the national championship contest. Their seven-game win streak is tied for the second-longest active streak in the FCS, behind only the eight of No. 1-ranked James Madison. Holy Cross is not far behind, as the Crusaders have won five games in a row. The Crusaders are 4-0 in the Patriot League for the first time since 1991, and will try to win their sixth consecutive game for the first time since 1991.

RANDOLPH ON A PATRIOT LEAGUE RECORD CHASE

Holy Cross senior quarterback Dominic Randolph continues to shine among all FCS quarterbacks, and his performances are earning him impressive spots in both the Patriot League and FCS leaderboards. Randolph threw for five touchdowns on Saturday against Fordham, giving him a school-record 77 touchdown passes in his career. That is just one shy of the Patriot League record of 78 held by Lehigh's Phil Stambaugh (1996-99). Randolph already holds the League record for career 300-yard games, with his 16th such effort on Saturday. He has six 300-yard games this season, one shy of the Patriot League record that he tied a year ago. Randolph has been responsible for 32 touchdowns this year (28 passing/4 rushing), just two off the League record that he tied last season. Finally, he is 43 completions away from tying the Patriot League career record of 820 held by Lafayette's Marko Glavic (2000-03).

PATRIOT LEAGUE NOTEBOOK

COLGATE'S SCOTT STILL ON FCS, DIVISION I RECORD HUNT

Colgate Jordan Scott had his chase for FCS and Division I records halted, as injuries have kept him out of all or most of each of the last four games. Still, he is very much in range of the some prominent records. Scott needs 25 carries to break the all-time Division I record of 1,215 (Steve Bartalo, Colorado State 1983-86). He is 81 away from breaking the all Divisions carries mark of 1,271. Scott has 972 rushing yards for the season, and is just 28 yards away from becoming the eighth player in FCS history and first Patriot Leaguer to record four 1,000-yard campaigns in his career. Scott has 5,445 career rushing yards, and the all-time Patriot League and Colgate rushing leader is now sixth on the FCS career rushing list. He leads all active FCS players in career rushing yardage, all-purpose yardage and scoring.

RANDOLPH MAINTAINS HIGH SPOTS IN FCS STATISTICS

With his sixth consecutive 300-yard passing day, Holy Cross quarterback Dominic Randolph strengthened his position in the FCS statistics. Randolph leads all FCS players in completions (32.9), passing yardage (344.4) and total offense (352.9) per game, while placing second in points responsible for (21.3) per contest. Bucknell's A.J. Kizekai is making a run at leading the nation in a statistical category as well, as he ranks second in the FCS with 193.6 all-purpose yards per game.

THROW AWAY THE WHISTLES

Patriot League teams are showing that discipline can be a good thing, as the League is littered with squads that are among the best in the nation at staying penalty-free. Bucknell and Colgate are in the top five in the nation in fewest penalties per game, while Lafayette and Holy Cross are in the top 20. Six of the seven Patriot League teams are among the FCS top 20 in fewest yards penalized per game, with Colgate (fourth), Georgetown (eighth), Lehigh (11th), Bucknell (12th), Fordham (14th) and Lafayette (18th) all in strong position.

TOP PATRIOT LEAGUE TEAMS WINNING TIME OF POSSESSION BATTLE

Holy Cross, Colgate and Lafayette have a lot in common at the top of the Patriot League standings, but perhaps nothing more so than the way they are winning their games. All three teams rank in the top seven in the FCS in time of possession, with Holy Cross in third in the nation at 33:58 per game. Colgate comes in sixth and Lafayette is in seventh. Converting first downs has been a key, as Holy Cross leads the nation with 26.9 first downs per game and Colgate ranks seventh.

CLOSE NON-LEAGUE CONTESTS COMPLETED

Patriot League teams finished the regular season 11-8 in non-League games decided by seven points or less, and held a 4-8 record in games decided by three points or less. More than half of the 36 non-League games were decided by seven points or less. So far, only three of the first 14 League contests have been within seven points.

PATRIOT LEAGUERS CLAIMING NATIONAL HONORS

Bucknell's A.J. Kizekai became the latest national award winner on Monday, as he earned Special Teams Player of the Week honors from *The Sports Network*. The long list of Patriot League award winners also includes: Holy Cross senior quarterback Dominic Randolph (*The Sports Network*, ECAC Offensive Player of the Week (twice), Colgate running back Jordan Scott (*College Sporting News* (twice), ECAC (twice), *The Sports Network*), Lafayette linebacker Andy Romans (*College Sporting News*), Colgate running back Nate Eachus (*College Sporting News*) Holy Cross running back Mike Kielt (ECAC) and Georgetown linebacker Nick Parrish (ECAC).

GEORGETOWN/COLGATE MATCHUP WILL NOT BE RESCHEDULED

The Patriot League office, in consultation with the League's football athletic directors, determined that the Georgetown at Colgate football game that was postponed on Oct. 4 due to a norovirus outbreak on Georgetown's campus will not be rescheduled this season. It was agreed that the game will be listed as an un-played game in the League standings and overall school records for the 2008 season. A tie in the season-ending standings or tiebreaking procedures will exist if teams have the same number of losses. The decision was endorsed by a 7-0 vote of the football athletic directors. Holy Cross tries to stay perfect in Patriot League play, while Lafayette attempts to stay in the hunt for the League title when the two meet in Easton on Saturday...The Crusaders are tied with Colgate at 4-0 in the League, while the Leopards are just one game behind at 3-1...They are the only three teams that can still claim the League title and automatic berth to the FCS playoffs...Lafayette has won five of the last six games in the series, including a 31-21 victory at Holy Cross last season...The Leopards have scored 28 points or more in each of the last eight matchups, going 6-2 in that span...The road team has won the last three games in the series, with Holy Cross claiming a 38-28 victory in the last meeting in Easton in 2006...All 22 of the all-time matchups between the schools have been Patriot League games, with Lafayette holding a 14-8 edge in the series...Holy Cross is trying to go to 5-0 in the Patriot League for the first time since finishing with that perfect record in their last League title season in 1991...The Crusaders are also going for their sixth consecutive victory overall, which they have not done since posting a perfect 11-0 mark in that 1991 campaign...Lafayette goes for a 4-1 record in the League for the fourth time in the last five years.

Holy Cross Notebook Holy Cross moved to 4-0 in the Patriot League and remained in a first-place tie with Colgate with a 38-17 victory at home against Fordham on Saturday...The Crusaders are 4-0 in League play for the first time since their last title season in 1991...They also have a five-game winning streak for the second time in the last three years...Holy Cross has scored at least 34 points in each of the five straight victories...The Crusaders have won each of their last two home games against Fordham...They finished their 2008 home schedule with a 4-1 record...They also won four home contests last season...Dominic Randolph completed 35-of-59 passes for 407 yards with five touchdowns in the win...He has 77 career touchdown passes, one off the Patriot League record of 78 held by Lehigh's Phil Stambaugh (1996-99)...He extended his Patriot League record to 16 career 300-yard passing games...Jon Brock caught eight passes for 105 yards and a career-high three touchdowns...Brock now has 12 touchdown catches on the season, standing just one shy of the school single season record (13 by Chris Summers in 1993)...Ten different players had at least one reception...Holy Cross held a 491-258 edge in total yardage and a 31-13 advantage in first downs...The Crusaders lead the nation with 26.9 first downs per game...They are third nationally in passing offense and sixth in total offense.



Lafayette Notebook Lafayette stayed in the race for the Patriot League title with a 38-21 victory at Bucknell on Saturday...Lafayette is 3-1 through four League games for the fourth time in the last five years...The Leopards completed their five-game road trip with a 4-1 record, and finished their road slate for the season with a 5-1 mark...The five-game trip was the longest since 1986...It was Lafayette's seventh consecutive victory against Bucknell, and fourth straight in Lewisburg...The Leopards have scored 31 points or more in each of the last four matchups with the Bison...Backup quarterback Marc Quilling started in place of the injured Rob Curley and went 17-of-26 for 274 yards and three touchdowns in his first career start...Tyrell Coon ran for 169 yards and a score in his return to the lineup, while Michael Conte had 118 receiving yards and a touchdown...Quilling's 51-yard touchdown pass to Conte was Lafayette's longest pass play of the season...Lafayette out-gained Bucknell, 474-222, with strong advantages in rushing (200-90) and passing (274-132) yardage...Shaun Adair had five receptions for 85 yards and a touchdown...Mark Leggiero and Andy Romans each had nine tackles to lead the Leopard defense...The Leopards are fourth in the nation in scoring defense, allowing just 15 points per game.

Lehigh and Bucknell meet up in Bethlehem on Saturday...The Mountain Hawks have a 10-game win streak in the series with the Bison...It is the longest active winning streak in any Patriot League series...The Mountain Hawks have scored 38 points or more in each of the last five matchups...Lehigh has also won by 23 points or more in each of the last six games against Bucknell...Bucknell's last victory against Lehigh was a 21-14 triumph at home in 1997...The Bison's last victory in Bethlehem came by a 7-6 score in 1996...Lehigh is 15-6-1 against the Bison in Patriot League matchups, and 39-29-3 in the series overall...Lehigh is trying to secure a League record of .500 or better for the 10th time in the last 11 years...Bucknell will try to snap a three-game losing streak, and finish with four victories on the road for the first time since winning six in 1997.

Bucknell Notebook Bucknell dropped its third consecutive League game, falling at home to Lafayette, 38-21, on Saturday...It was Bucknell's seventh consecutive loss to the Leopards...Bucknell has lost four consecutive home games for the first time since 1991...A.J. Kizekai starred for the Bison, notching a 100-yard kickoff return for a touchdown and 210 kickoff return yards in the game...Both marks are Bucknell records...He also set the program record with 2,039 kickoff return yards in his career...He holds five of the top eight single-game marks in school history...Kizekai has tied a Patriot League record with two kickoff returns for touchdowns in his career...He is one of six players to accomplish the feat...He also had a career-high 285 all-purpose yards in the game...Kizekai is second in the nation with 193.6 all-purpose yards per game, and 15th in kickoff return average...Bucknell is fifth nationally with a 23.4 team kickoff return average...Shaun Pasternak caught seven passes for 82 yards and two touchdowns in the game...He now has 10 touchdown receptions this season, equaling the Bucknell record held by Lester Erb...Pasternak is 19th nationally in receiving yards per game.



Lehigh Notebook Lehigh lost in heartbreaking fashion to Colgate, 34-33, on Saturday in Bethlehem...The Mountain Hawks fell to 2-2 in Patriot League play and were eliminated from contention for the League title...It was their first home loss to the Raiders since 2002...Lehigh's four losses to Princeton, Cornell, Harvard and Colgate have come by a combined total of eight points...The Mountain Hawks lost despite an outstanding effort from sophomore quarterback J.B. TEAM NOTEBOOK

No. 23/24 COLGATE (8-2, 4-0)

Colgate Notebook No. 24 Colgate won its seventh consecutive game and remained in a first-place tie in the Patriot League by moving to 4-0 in League action with a 34-33 victory at Lehigh on Saturday...The Raiders improved to 4-0 in the League for the first time since 2003, and have also won seven consecutive contests for the first time since claiming their first 15 and making the national title game that season...Colgate won at Lehigh for the first time since 2002...They beat the Mountain Hawks for the second year in a row...Colgate Head Coach Dick Biddle improved to 7-6 against the Mountain Hawks, giving him a winning record against all six Patriot League opponents...This is the sixth time under Biddle that Colgate has won eight or more games in a season...The seven-game winning streak is tied for the second-longest in the FCS, trailing only the eight-game streak of No. 1-ranked James Madison....The Raiders rallied from a 33-21 deficit in the second half, scoring the winning points on a seven-yard touchdown pass from Greg Sullivan to Pat Simonds with 2:28 left...Simonds had seven receptions for 148 yards and a career-high three touchdowns, including a 79-yarder in the first quarter...The three receiving touchdowns also tied a Colgate record...It was his fourth game over 100 yards this season, and 21st straight game with a catch...Sullivan threw for 218 yards and three touchdowns while also running for 81 yards and a score...He needs 44 yards to break Colgate's single season record for rushing yardage by a quarterback...The record is held by Tom Parr with 833 yards during the 1973 season when Colgate was running the wishbone..Nate Eachus carried 26 times for 103 yards and a touchdown in place of the injured Jordan Scott...The Raiders held a 175-60 edge in rushing yardage...They rank third in the FCS with 272.2 rushing yards per game this season...Scott needs 28 yards to become the first Patriot Leaguer and eighth player in FCS history with four 1,000-yard rushing seasons, and 25 carries to become the all-time Division I leader in that category...Colgate closes out its regular season at home against Holy Cross on Nov. 22...The Raiders will be trying to win their first Patriot League title since 2005, and earn their first outright title and undefeated League season since 2003.



TIEBREAKING PROCEDURE

In the case of ties in the final standings for regular season League play, the following process will be used until all ties are broken and the seeding process is completed (ties will be broken in rank order beginning with the highest seed):

***A tie in the regular-season standings will exist if teams have the same number of losses.**

1. Head-to-head competition - the higher seed will go to the team that has won the most League contests played against the other team(s) involved in the tie.

2. If a tie still exists, a comparison of records will be made between the tied institutions starting at the highest possible seed and continuing through the lowest seed, if necessary. Ties will exist if the tied teams have the same number of losses against an opponent.

3. Sport-specific tie-breaking procedure.

a. A comparison of records against common out-of-League opponents will be made.

b. If a tie still exists, a committee consisting of the athletic directors of each of the institutions not involved in the tie will make a final decision considering each of the following, in no particular order:

- *strength of schedule
- *overall record
- *computer rankings

The committee will meet immediately following the conclusion of the final game of the season's final weekend. A three-fourths vote of the members of the committee will be needed to determine the champion.

5. Coin flip (two teams) or draw (multiple teams).

* The winner of the tiebreaker in the Patriot League for football earns the League's automatic bid to the NCAA Division I Football Championship.

PATRIOT LEAGUE WEEKEND RECAP

One of them needed a fourth-quarter comeback, while the other rolled to an easy win. They did it in different fashions, but Colgate and Holy Cross remained in a tie for first place in the Patriot League football standings by each posting victories on Saturday.

The Raiders got a seven-yard touchdown pass from Greg Sullivan to Pat Simonds with 2:28 left to complete a comeback from a 12-point deficit and win at Lehigh, 34-33. The Crusaders opened up a 38-3 lead behind five touchdown passes from quarterback Dominic Randolph on their way to a 38-17 victory in their home finale against Fordham.

With two weeks to play, Lafayette is the only other team that is still in contention for a share of the Patriot League title and potential automatic berth in the Division I Football Championship Subdivision postseason. The Leopards moved to 3-1 in League action with a 38-21 victory at Bucknell on Saturday.

Georgetown earned a 13-12 victory in a non-League contest at home against Marist. The victory gave the Patriot League 20 wins in non-League action for the first time since 2004.

Colgate (8-2, 4-0 Patriot League) won its seventh consecutive game, but it did not come easy at Lehigh (3-6, 2-2). The Raiders had to rally from a 33-21 deficit late in the third quarter, but came back to move to 4-0 in League action for the first time since 2003.

It looked like the Raiders would pull away early on, as Colgate opened up a 21-6 lead in with 8:42 left in the second quarter on a five-yard touchdown run by Nate Eachus. But Lehigh took over for the next quarter of play. The Mountain Hawks cut the deficit to 21-20 by halftime, and took a 27-21 lead on a 23-yard touchdown pass from J.B. Clark to Mike Fitzgerald with 10:42 left in the third quarter. Clark connected with Fitzgerald from 39 yards out less than three minutes later to give the Mountain Hawks a 33-21 edge.

Colgate got back within one score five minutes later. Sullivan hit Simonds from 19 yards out to cut the Lehigh lead to 33-28 with 2:48 left in the third quarter. The Mountain Hawks missed a field goal on their next possession. After an exchange of punts, the Raiders took over the ball at the Lehigh 47 with 7:29 left. It took 10 plays for Colgate to find the endzone, with Sullivan throwing a third-down slant pass to Simonds for the seven-yard touchdown with 2:28 to go. Lehigh had a final possession with a chance to win, but Clark's fourth-and-two pass to Sekou Yansane from the Lehigh 45 was just out of bounds.

While Colgate was winning dramatically, Holy Cross' (6-3, 4-0) position at the top of the League standings was secure shortly after halftime. The Crusaders built a 24-3 halftime lead and extended it to 38-3 by the end of the third quarter in a 38-17 victory over Fordham (4-5, 0-4) in the home finale in Worcester. It was the fifth consecutive win for the Crusaders, who are 4-0 in League play for the first time since their claiming their last League title in 1991.

Holy Cross senior quarterback Dominic Randolph had another outstanding effort, completing 35-of-59 passes for 407 yards and five touchdowns. Randolph set a Holy Cross record with 77 career touchdown passes, and is now just one shy of the Patriot League mark of 78 held by Lehigh's Phil Stambaugh (1996-99). Randolph posted his sixth consecutive 300-yard game, and extended his Patriot League record to 16 career 300-yard efforts. Holy Cross held a 491-258 edge in total yardage and a 31-13 advantage in first downs.

Randolph got the Crusaders on the board with a 43-yard touchdown pass to Brett McDermott in the first quarter, and made it 17-0 in the second quarter with a four-yard strike to Ryan McGuire. After Fordham posted a field goal, Randolph gave the Crusaders the 24-3 halftime advantage with a nine-yard touchdown pass to Jon Brock with just seven seconds left before the break. Randolph and Brock put the game away in the third quarter, connecting on touchdown passes of 21 and 25 yards to open up the 38-3 lead.

Lafayette (7-2, 3-1) still has an opportunity to win a share of the Patriot League title after a 38-21 victory at Bucknell. The Leopards have a pair of home games left against Holy Cross and Lehigh after finishing their season-long five-game road trip with a 4-1 record.

The Leopards did it with reserves on offense, as backup quarterback Marc Quilling completed 17-of-26 passes for 274 yards and three touchdowns and Tyrell Coon ran for 169 yards and a touchdown. Lafayette outgained Bucknell, 474-222, with strong advantages in rushing (200-90) and passing (274-132) yardage.

Lafayette got on the board in the first quarter with a 23-yard touchdown pass from Quilling to Joe Russo, but Bucknell answered right away with a 100-yard kickoff return touchdown by A.J. Kizekai. The teams traded touchdowns again before Lafayette took a 17-14 lead into halftime on a field goal by Davis Rodriguez with one second left before the break.

Lafayette extended the lead to 24-14 with a 51-yard touchdown pass from Quilling to Michael Conte, but Bucknell closed to 24-21 on a 37-yard strike from Justin Pelgrano to Shaun Pasternak. The Leopards finished the scoring from there, with a Coon touchdown run and a 34-yard pass from Quilling to Shaun Adair making it 38-21 early in the fourth quarter.
