**2008 Patriot League Men's Soccer Tournament**

### No. 4 Lafayette (8-5-5, 3-1-3) at No. 1 Colgate (10-5-3, 5-1-1), 4 p.m.

The Raiders and Leopards met Oct. 11 in Hamilton, where Colgate won, 1-0. Colgate comes into Friday's semifinal with a 2-0-1 record in its last three Patriot League games. The Raiders have seven All-Patriot League honorees on the squad, including Second-Team selection Steven Miller, First-Team defender Glenn Volk and First-Team goalkeeper David Cappuccio. Miller led the League in shots (62) and game-winning goals (5). Defensively, the Raiders will rely on Volk to continue to lead a stingy Colgate defense that tied with Holy Cross for the fewest goals allowed this season (13). Cappuccio is one of the best goalkeepers in Colgate and Patriot League history, where his 23 shutouts are the best in program history and third all-time in the Patriot League. The senior goalkeeper is third in the League in saves (64) and goals-against average (0.74). Lafayette has been playing some of its best soccer all season heading into the Tournament. The Leopards are 5-0-2 in their last seven games and have given up only three goals in that span. Offensively, Head Coach Dennis Bohn has a weapon in sophomore B.J. Glenn, who is seventh in the Patriot League with 14 points and has scored two game-winning goals. Second-Team All-League pick Stephen Macurdy is third in the League in assists, and has helped lead a Lafayette offense that is tied for third in the League for goals scored with 26. On defense, the Leopards will rely on the veteran leadership of John Griffith and Chad Barbieri, who anchored a defense that allowed only 17 goals this season. Goalkeeper Phil Nelson sports a 0.64 goals-against average in League play, and has allowed only five goals in Patriot League action.

### No. 3 Holy Cross (9-4-4, 4-1-2) vs. No. 2 American (9-7-2, 5-1-1), 7 p.m.

The Eagles and Crusaders met Oct. 25 in Washington, D.C., where American got the 1-0 victory. American went 5-1-1 in the Patriot League to make it into the Tournament, despite being picked to finish sixth in the League in the 2008 Preseason Poll. The Eagles will be led offensively by senior forward and First-Team All-League selection Phil Purdy, who helped American's offense score 27 goals, good for second-best in the League. Defensively, the Eagles can depend on All-League picks Karsten Smith and Cooper Bryant, who each tallied Patriot League Defensive Player of the Week honors and led a unit that gave up 22 goals in 18 games this season. Freshman phenom Matt Makowski has been solid in goal for American, as he is second in the League in both saves (68) and shutouts (6). The Crusaders are making their second-straight Tournament appearance and are looking to win their first League title since 2002. 2007 Patriot League Rookie of the Year and 2008 First-Team forward Kyle Miller is a huge offensive threat, having scored eight of Holy Cross' 21 goals this season. Defensively, the Crusaders will have the veteran leadership of First-Team defenders Alejandro Melean and Jerry Dickinson. Dickinson and Melean are the pillars of a Crusader defense that was second in the League in shutouts (8) and goals-against average (0.71). Second-Team goalkeeper Thomas Booth earned back-to-back Goalkeeper of the Week awards this season, and finished with seven shutouts and 64 saves on the year.

## PATRIOT LEAGUE NOTEBOOK

### TOURNAMENT FIELD SET

The Patriot League Men's Soccer Championship kicks off Friday when No. 4 Lafayette takes on No. 1 Colgate at 4 p.m. No. 3 Holy Cross will face No. 2 American in the second semifinal game at 7 p.m. The winners of each of the semifinals will advance to the championship match on Sunday at 1 p.m.

### TOURNAMENT STREAKS

Lafayette is making its seventh-straight Patriot League Tournament appearance, tied with Holy Cross (1997-03) and Lehigh (2000-06) for the second longest streak behind Colgate's eight straight appearances from 1992-99. The Raiders are making their fourth consecutive appearance, while Holy Cross is making its second straight postseason appearance. American is in its first Patriot League Tournament since 2005.

### CHAMPIONSHIPS

The Raiders will look for their fourth overall and second consecutive crown under Head Coach Erik Ronning. Colgate won the title in 1992, 1997 and 2007. The Eagles are on the hunt for their third title, having won the Championship in 2001 and 2004 under Head Coach Todd West. Holy Cross hosted the tournament in 2007 and will look for its second Patriot League title under Head Coach Elvis Comrie. The Crusaders last won the championship in 2002. Lafayette has the most Patriot League titles in League history with six, and will look for its seventh championship.

### REGULAR SEASON MATCHUPS

American beat Holy Cross, 1-0, on Oct. 25, while Colgate defeated Lafayette by an identical score on Oct. 11. In potential Championship matchups, American tied Lafayette 1-1 on Oct. 4 while the Eagles were defeated by Colgate, 1-0 on Nov. 1. Holy Cross beat Colgate, 1-0 on Sept. 27 and the Crusaders had a scoreless tie with Lafayette on Nov. 8.

### ALL-TIME TOURNAMENT RECORDS

In the Patriot League Tournament, No. 1 Colgate is 1-2 all-time vs. Lafayette, 0-1 vs. American and has never met Holy Cross in the postseason. No. 2 American is 1-0 vs. Holy Cross, 1-0 vs. Colgate and 1-1 against Lafayette all-time in the Patriot League Tournament. Lafayette is 8-1 all-time against Holy Cross in the Tournament.

### ARMY'S GLUBZINSKI NAMED LOWE'S SENIOR CLASS AWARD FINALIST

Army's A.J. Glubzinski is one of 10 finalists in the men's soccer division for the 2008 Lowe's Senior CLASS Award. Glubzinski's name has been placed on the official ballot for a nationwide vote that began Oct. 16 and will conclude Nov. 19.

Non-League contests completed before the Monday prior to the Championship will be included in the tie-breaker formula, if necessary. Any non-League contest played on or after the Monday prior to the Championship will not be included in the tie-breaker formula.

a. In the case of a two-way between teams in the final standings for regular season League play, the following process will be used until all ties are broken and the seeding process is completed (ties will be broken in rank order beginning with the highest seed):

i. Head-to-head competition - the higher seed will go to the team that has won the most League contests played against the other team involved in the tie (in the sport of volleyball, both matches and individual games will be considered).

ii. If a tie still exists, a comparison of records will be made between the tied institutions starting at the highest possible seed and continuing through the lowest seed, if necessary.

iii. Sport specific tie-breaking procedure, if any (see Sport Specific regulations).

iv. Comparison of records versus out-of-League common opponents.

v. Coin flip.

b. In the case of multiple ties (more than two teams tied for the same spot), the following process will be used: Note: The entire process for multiple-team ties must be completed. The Patriot League does not revert back to the two-way tie formula once the multiple-team tie has been resolved.

i. Records between the tied teams will be evaluated to determine if one team won more contests against the other tied institutions (in the sport of volleyball, both matches and individual games will be considered).

ii. If a tie still exists, a comparison of records will be conducted for each team starting with the highest seed not involved in the tie and continuing through the lowest seed, if necessary.

iii. Sport specific tie-breaking procedure, if any (see Sport Specific regulations).

iv. Comparison of records versus out-of-League common opponents.

v. Coin flip (two teams) or draw (multiple teams).
