Patriot League Announces Men's Soccer Academic Honor Roll

*Army's Bill Watts named Scholar-Athlete of the Year and
headlines 84 student-athletes on the Academic Honor Roll.*

Center Valley, Pa. – Army's **Bill Watts** was named the 2006 Patriot League Men's Soccer Scholar-Athlete of the Year and was one of 84 student-athletes on this year's academic honor roll announced Executive Director **Carolyn Schlie Femovich** Thursday. Among the 84 student-athletes, Army's Andrew Glubzinski and Navy's Evan Barnes posted a 4.00 or better grade-point average this past fall.

While majoring in chemical engineering, Watts holds down a 3.689 cumulative grade-point average. The Dean's List student and Gold Star recipient has been a Patriot League Academic Honor Roll member throughout his career. For the second-consecutive year, Watts was named to the Men's Soccer CoSIDA/*ESPN The Magazine* University Division District I All-Academic squad. This year he was a first-team selection.

The senior forward appeared in 15 of 17 games with 13 starts, closing out the year with one goal and four assists.

Watts became the third Patriot League Men's Soccer Scholar-Athlete of the Year for Army. Jeremy Pamplin (1996) and John McDougall (1999) preceded him.

To be eligible for the Academic Honor Roll, a student-athlete must earn a 3.20 grade-point average in the fall semester and be awarded a varsity letter in one of the Patriot League's seven fall championship sports.

A total of 532 student-athletes were named to the Patriot League's Fall Academic Honor Roll, which includes the sports of men and women's cross country, field hockey, football, men and women's soccer and volleyball.
