2007-08 Women's Basketball Season Kicks Off

The 2007-08 women's basketball season will commence a week earlier than in past years starting Friday, Nov. 9. American, Bucknell and Navy will be the first three teams to step on the court this season. By the end of the weekend six of the Patriot League's eight teams will have competed - American, Bucknell, Colgate, Holy Cross, Lehigh and Navy.

Navy will be the only team playing in a tournament during the first weekend of the season. The Mids will travel to Rock Hill, S.C., to compete in the Winthrop Tournament. Navy will face the host Eagles, Rice and North Texas.

Lafayette and Army will be the last two Patriot League teams to kick off the 2007-08 campaign. Lafayette's first game is scheduled for Monday, Nov. 12 at home versus Monmouth. Army will begin the year on Tuesday, Nov. 13 versus St. John's in West Point, N.Y.

The Patriot League portion of the season will start on Saturday, Jan. 12 with all four teams in action.

BUCKNELL PICKED FIRST IN PRESEASON POLL

Bucknell topped the Patriot League Women's Basketball Preseason Poll with 10 first-place votes and 92 total votes. Three other teams garnered first-place votes including Army with four and Holy Cross and American each with one. The Black Knights came in second in the preseason poll with 83 total points, followed by the Crusaders (77 points) and the Eagles (62). Lehigh finished fifth with 46 points, while Lafayette and Navy tied for sixth with 33 points each. Colgate rounded out the poll in eighth with 22 points.

In other preseason poll voting, the reigning Patriot League Player of the Year, Bucknell's Hope Foster, was tabbed for the same award for the 2007-08 campaign. Foster was one of five members of the 2007-08 Patriot League Preseason All-League Team. Others voted to the team were American's Liz Hayes, Army's Cara Enright, Bucknell's Amanda Brown and Holy Cross' Bethany O'Dell.

PATRIOT LEAGUE ESPNU PACKAGE

Two women's regular-season matchups and the Patriot League Women's Basketball Tournament Championship Game will be aired on ESPNU as a part of the Patriot League's basketball television agreement.

On Sunday, Jan. 20 ESPNU will broadcast the Holy Cross at Bucknell game at Noon. The other regular-season game to air will be the Army at Navy contest on Sunday, Jan. 27 at 2:30 p.m. The Patriot League Tournament Championship Game will take place on Wednesday, March 12.

Bob Socci will provide play-by-play for the women's basketball games on ESPNU, while Leah Secondo will serve as the color analyst.

ALSO ON THE TUBE

Including the Patriot League's three ESPNU games, 23 contests involving League teams will be shown on television during the 2007-08 season. Thanks to Army's partnership with ESPNU one additional Patriot League game will be shown on the network this year. Colgate will show two games on Time Warner Sports. Lafayette will broadcast nine games on RCN, including all seven home Patriot League matches. Lehigh will display nine games on Service Electric 2 Sports and cover all seven of its Patriot League home contests as well.

KEEP AN EYE ON

Bucknell's Hope Foster, who is entering her senior season, is ranked second all-time in Patriot League history with 260 career blocks. The Patriot League career mark is held by Holy Cross' Kathy Courtney (1994-97) with 309. Foster needs just 50 blocks to break the Patriot League career record. In her three previous years she has posted single-season totals of 72 (2004-05), 95 (2005-06) and 93 (2006-07).

Foster is the only active player heading into this season with 500+ rebounds. She ranks 21st in the Patriot League annals with 674.

Army's Cara Enright stands as the only active Patriot League student-athlete with more than 1,000 career points. Enright heads into her senior campaign 27th all-time with 1,329 points. She is also ranked 20th all-time in three-point field goals made with 133.

RETURNING TALENT

All three major award winners from 2006-07 will be back in action this season including Bucknell's Hope Foster and Kesha Campion, who were named Patriot League Player and Defensive Player of the Year, respectively. Patriot League Rookie of the Year Bethany O'Dell will appear in a Holy Cross uniform again this season. Eight of 10 All-Patriot League selections are returning for the 2007-08 campaign, as well as five-of-six All-Rookie team honorees.

2008 PATRIOT LEAGUE TOURNAMENT

The 2008 Patriot League Women's Basketball Tournament will be held Saturday-Sunday, March 8-9 and Wednesday, March 12. Army will host the quarterfinal and semifinal rounds at Christl Arena in West Point, N.Y. on March 8-9. The Patriot League Tournament Championship Game will take place at the site of the highest remaining seed on March 12. The championship game will be broadcast on ESPNU.

AMERICAN American kicks off the season on Friday at Longwood. The Eagles tuned up for the year with an exhibition game last week at home against M.I. Express and earned a 94-46 win. Over the summer, American traveled to Australia from Aug. 14-25 to play in three games "Down Under". The Eagles visited both Melbourne and Sydney. The squad went 2-1 on the trip, facing Frankston, the ITC Squad and Bendigo. Senior guard Liz Hayes was one of five student-athletes named to the 2007-08 Patriot League Preseason All-League Team and is the reigning Patriot League Women's Basketball Scholar-Athlete of the Year.



ARMY The 2007-08 season will begin for Army next Tuesday at home against St. John's. The Black Knights will also play St. Francis (N.Y.) next week. Senior guard Cara Enright returns as the Black Knights' leading scorer at a 14.9 per game clip last season. Enright was named to the Patriot League Preseason All-League Team and was a First-Team All-League performer a year ago. Junior Alex McGuire was a Second-team All-Patriot League honoree in 2007 after averaging 12.1 ppg.



BUCKNELL Senior Hope Foster and junior Amanda Brown were both members of the Patriot League Preseason All-League Team, while Foster was tabbed the Preseason Player of the Year. Foster was the Patriot League Player of the Year last season, while Kesha Champion was the Patriot League Defensive Player of the Year. Foster and Brown, both First-Team All-Patriot League selections, combined for 25.4 points per outing. Bucknell begins the 2007-08 season on Friday at St. Bonaventure.



COLGATE Colgate is under direction of the only new head coach in the Patriot League this season - Pam Bass. Bass has one year of previous head coaching experience, leading Longwood during the 2006-07 season. The Raiders will play in their first game of the year against Niagara on Saturday at home. Colgate opened with Niagara last year, resulting in a 76-62 loss and are 13-22 versus the Purple Eagles all-time. Last year, Caitlin Gillard chipped in 9.8 points per outing, while Gretchen Polinski led the team in rebounding with 6.5 boards per game.



HOLY CROSS The 2007-08 season will kick off for Holy Cross on Sunday at home against Vermont. The Crusaders have won their season opener the last three years. Holy Cross quickly moves on to tough competition next week, facing No. 2/2 Connecticut next Wednesday. The team welcomes back the 2006-07 Patriot League Rookie of the Year and 2007 Patriot League Tournament Most Valuable Player Bethany O'Dell. O'Dell ranked first in the Patriot League in both three-point field goal percentage (.422) and three-point field goals per game (2.72). After sitting out due to injury last season, Laura Aloisi will return to the hardwood. Aloisi averaged 4.41 assists and 6.7 points per game in 2005-06.



LAFAYETTE The Leopards will wait until next week to start the 2007-08 campaign. Lafayette opens the season at home on Monday against Monmouth. The Leopards will also travel to Cornell and host Mount Saint Mary's next week. Senior Vanessa Van De Venter will lead Lafayette after being named Second-Team All-Patriot League a year ago. Van De Venter averaged 12.0 points and 4.8 rebounds per game. The junior duo of Emily Garner and Jessica Spicer made an impact last season, scoring 10.8 and 9.8 points per game, respectively. Garner pulled down a team-high 6.6 boards per contest.



LEHIGH Lehigh hosts Saint Joseph's on Saturday at Stabler Arena to usher in the 2007-08 season. Lehigh welcomes back Claire Sullivan, who had to sit out last year due to injury. Sullivan averaged a Patriot League-best 6.43 assists per game in 2005-06 as a sophomore. The Mountain Hawks also have two Patriot League All-Rookie performers back from last year in Kristen Dalton and Alex Ross.



NAVY Navy will participate in the Winthrop Classic this weekend, facing Rice on Friday, Winthrop on Saturday and North Texas on Sunday. The Mids return junior guard Kalen Kroppa, whose 139 assists were the best total in the Patriot League last season. The Mids only have one senior on its 2007-08 roster - Ali Currier. She saw action in 17 games last season.
