Patriot League Roundup

American University remained unbeaten with a convincing 77-50 victory over cross-town foe Howard on Wednesday. The Eagles are joined in the unbeaten ranks by Bucknell, which improved to 2-0 with a last-second 73-70 win over Yale. Navy improved to 2-1 with a hard-fought road win at Winston-Salem State. Also 2-1 is Lehigh, which routed Fairleigh Dickinson, 90-54. Earning its first win of the season was Army. The Black Knights topped Maryland-Eastern Shore, 66-43. Three teams are still looking for their first wins of the season. Lafayette, which received a week-long break after its loss to Middle Tennessee State, will be in Cullowhee, N.C. for its Preseason WNIT second round match-up with Western Carolina. Preseason League favorite Holy Cross dropped to 0-3 with losses to Boston College and Harvard, while Colgate suffered its third defeat of the season with a 66-41 loss to Binghamton.

On Deck

Three Patriot League teams will compete in tournaments this weekend. Navy opened the Tyler Ugolyn Columbia Classic on Friday with a loss to Texas State. The Mids will remain in New York for the second day of the tournament. They will play either Long Island or host Columbia on Saturday. Lafayette will resume play in the Preseason WNIT against Western Carolina on Friday. On Saturday, the Leopards will play either Liberty or UC-Riverside. American will put its undefeated record on the line this weekend at the Minnesota Tournament in Minneapolis, Minn. The Eagles will square off against host Minnesota on Saturday. American will then take on North Carolina State or Yale on Sunday. Also on Saturday, Bucknell will put its unblemished mark on the line at Fordham. Colgate will host St. Francis (N.Y.) while Lehigh will travel to St. Francis (Pa.). On Sunday, Army will look to even its record against Loyola.

Honorable Mention Performances Last Week

MICHELLE KIRK, AMERICAN

So., G/F, Painted Post, N.Y.

Kirk helped American to a pair of victories, averaging 14 points, three rebounds and two assists. She scored a career-high 20 points against Drexel. She shot 9-of-13 and made three steals in 27 minutes against the Dragons.

ERIN ANTHONY, ARMY

So., F, Allentown, Pa.

Anthony led Army in scoring in a pair of losses. She averaged 14 points in both contests, which is one shy of a career-high. She also averaged 4.5 rebounds and drained her first career three-pointer.

AMANDA BROWN, BUCKNELL

Sr., G, Richardson, Texas

Brown scored 22 points and dished out six assists in Bucknell's road win over George Mason. She knocked down 4-of-7 three-point attempts and sank all four of her free throw attempts.

SAMI KOZLOWSKI, COLGATE

So., G, New Market, Md.

Kozlowski averaged 14 points in two contests last week. She poured in 26 points against Rider. Kozlowski knocked down 5-of-6 three-pointers against the Broncs and connected on all five free throw attempts. She also averaged three rebounds and three assists.

BRIANA MCFADDEN, HOLY CROSS

Jr., G, Wheaton, Md.

McFadden had 24 points, seven rebounds and three assists in the Crusaders' loss to Yale. She made 12-of-13 free throw attempts to lead Holy Cross in scoring.

EMILY GARNER, LAFAYETTE

Sr., F, Fairfax Station, Va.

Garner finished two rebounds shy of a double-double, closing with 13 points and eight rebounds against Middle Tennessee State in the opening round of the Preseason WNIT. She also added an assist and a steal.

WHITNEY DAVIDSON, NAVY

Sr., G, New Oxford, Pa.

Davidson averaged 12 points and two rebounds as Navy went 1-1 on opening weekend. She made 7-of-8 free throws while scoring a team-high 15 points in the Mids' win over Howard on Sunday.

Baden Player of the Week (Nov. 10-16)

ERICA PROSSER, LEHIGH *So., G, Pittsburgh, Pa.*

Prosser averaged 18 points in two games, helping the Mountain Hawks to a 1-1 weekend record. Prosser scored 16 points on 6-of-12 shooting in the Mountain Hawks' 83-52 win over Penn. She knocked down a pair of three-pointers against the Quakers, while also recording four assists and two steals. Her 16 points against the Quakers helped the Mountain Hawks establish a new school-record for points in a season-opener. Against Saint Joseph's, the sophomore guard poured in 20 points on 7-of-15 shooting.

Baden Rookie of the Week (Nov. 10-16)

CANDICE GREEN, COLGATE *Fr., G, Brunswick, N.J.*

Green averaged nine points in a pair of contests. In her first collegiate outing, Green paced Colgate with a team-high 10 points against Mount St. Mary's. She finished 3-of-6 from the field and knocked down both of her three-point attempts. She also connected on both of her free throw attempts. She played all 40 minutes in the Raiders' loss to Rider, finishing with eight points, three assists and a block.

Patriot League Notebook

MORE RETURNERS

Patriot League teams returned a total of 28 starters from a year ago. Leading the pack were Lehigh and Navy which will returned all five of their starters. Colgate and Lafayette each have four back in uniform.

CROSS COUNTRY

Patriot League rosters for the 2008-09 season include student-athletes from 31 of the 50 states.

WELCOMING TWO NEW COACHES

Both American and Navy will sport new head coaches this season with Matt Corkery taking over the reigns in the nation's capital and Stefanie Pemper heading up the squad in Annapolis, Md. Corkery was the associate head coach at American in 2007-08 and has been on the Eagles staff for four seasons. In his first season at the helm, he has compiled a 3-0 record. Pemper came to Navy after a spending 10 years as the head coach of Bowdoin. Pemper compiled an incredible 235-48 (.830) record in 10 seasons at Bowdoin and led the program to nine NCAA Tournament appearances, including five Elite Eight appearances and an appearance in the NCAA championship game in 2004. She currently holds a 2-2 record as the head coach of the Mids.

2009 PATRIOT LEAGUE TOURNAMENT

The 2009 Patriot League Women's Basketball Tournament Quarterfinal and Semifinals will be held in Bethlehem, Pa. at Lehigh University's Stabler Arena. Lehigh has previously hosted the tournament in 1992, 97, 05. The tournament is a full-field event with all eight teams competing for the championship title. Quarterfinal action will take place on Saturday, March 7, with semifinal games on Sunday, March 8. The 2009 Patriot League Women's Basketball Championship game will be played on Wednesday, March 11 at the site of the highest remaining seed. The Patriot League champion will earn the Patriot League's automatic bid to the NCAA Tournament.



AMERICAN The Eagles improved to 3-0 with a 77-50 victory over cross-city foe Howard on Wednesday. Talicia Jackson and Michelle Kirk each tallied a game-high 13 points against the Bison, while freshman Ebony Edwards scored a career-high 11 points off the bench. The Eagles will spend the weekend in Minneapolis for the Minnesota Tournament. American will play Minnesota on Saturday before matching up against North Carolina State or Yale on Sunday.



ARMY The Black Knights captured their first win of the season with a 56-43 home triumph over Maryland-Eastern Shore on Wednesday. The Black Knights made all seven of their free throw attempts and scored 11 of the final 13 points to secure the victory. Sophomore Lauara Beranek led three Army players in double-figures with 13 points. The Black Knights will remain at home for a Sunday pairing with Loyola.



BUCKNELL The Bison snuck past Yale, 73-70, to improve to 2-0 on the season. Down three points with under a minute to play, senior Amanda Brown hit a pair of three-pointers, the first to tie, the second to win. After picking up back-to-back road wins, Bucknell will remain on the road for a Saturday showdown with Fordham.



COLGATE The Raiders dropped to 0-3 with a 66-41 loss to Binghamton. Sophomore Georgia Gier led Colgate with nine points and six rebounds in defeat. Colgate will pursue its first win of the season with a home match-up against St. Francis (N.Y.) on Saturday. The Raiders will then travel south to take on Presbyterian on Monday.



HOLY CROSS The preseason favorites in the Patriot League dropped to 0-3 in non-League action with a pair of home losses during the week. The Crusaders were topped by Boston College, 82-69, on Tuesday. Holy Cross then fell to Harvard, 73-57, on Friday. Preseason Patriot League Player of the Year Briana McFadden averaged 15.5 points per game in the two losses. Holy Cross will look for its first win of the season on Tuesday when the Crusaders host St. Peter's.



LAFAYETTE The Leopards spent the week preparing for their second game in the Preseason Women's National Invitation Tournament. After falling to Middle Tennessee State in its season-opener, Lafayette will be in Cullowhee, N.C. to take on Western Carolina on Friday. After Friday's game, the Leopards will battle either Liberty or UC-Riverside on Saturday.



LEHIGH Lehigh improved to 2-1 with a convincing road win at Fairleigh Dickinson. The Mountain Hawks routed the Knights, 90-54. Lehigh used a 59-point first half to put the Knights away early. Tricia Smith fell one point shy of a double-double, with nine points, but the senior guard set a new career high with 13 rebounds in the game. Erica Prosser led all scorers with a 17-point effort, adding four rebounds and six assists. Lehigh will play at St. Francis (Pa.) on Friday.



NAVY The Mids improved to 2-1 by topping Winston-Salem State on the road. Angela Myers scored six of Navy's final eight points and sank a pair of free throws with 6.8 seconds left to play to help Navy hold off the Rams, 53-49. The Mids dropped to 2-2 on Friday with a loss to Texas State in the Tyler Ugolyn Columbia Classic in New York. On Saturday, Navy will remain in New York for the second day of the tournament. The Mids will play either Long Island or host Columbia.
