## **Patriot League Announces Field Hockey Academic Honor Roll**

*Sixty-seven student-athletes named to the Academic Honor Roll.*

**Center Valley, Pa.** – Sixty-seven student-athletes were named to the 2007 Patriot League Field Hockey Academic Honor Roll, announced Executive Director Carolyn Schlie Femovich Wednesday. Included on this year's academic honor roll are Bucknell's Katie Leinen, Colgate's Jackie Brown and Lafayette's Meghan Cicchi, who all earned 4.0 grade-point averages or above in the fall semester.

Also a member of the academic honor roll is Bucknell's Kelly Hoffman who was named the 2007 Patriot League Field Hockey Scholar-Athlete of the Year. Prior to the fall semester Hoffman owned a 3.94 cumulative grade-point average as an English major and psychology minor. She is a four-time Patriot League Academic Honor Roll member and has been named to the NFCHA All-Academic squad three times. On the field, Hoffman started in all 17 of Bucknell's game this season as a co-captain. The Second-Team All-Patriot League selection posted 17 points on seven goals and three assists.

To be eligible for the Academic Honor Roll, a student-athlete must earn a 3.20 grade-point average in the fall semester and be awarded a varsity letter in one of the Patriot League's seven fall championship sports.
