## **Patriot League Announces Women's Soccer Academic Honor Roll**

*Bucknell's Shannon Curd named Scholar-Athlete of the Year and  
headlines 104 student-athletes on the Academic Honor Roll.*

**Center Valley, Pa.** – Bucknell's **Shannon Curd** was named the 2006 Patriot League Women's Soccer Scholar-Athlete of the Year and was one of 104 student-athletes on this year's academic honor roll announced Executive Director **Carolyn Schlie Femovich** Thursday. Curd, along with 11 other student-athletes, posted a 4.00 or better grade-point average this past fall.

The third Bison to be named Patriot League Women's Soccer Scholar-Athlete of the Year, Curd claims a 3.94 cumulative grade-point average, while majoring in education and psychology. The senior captain was an *ESPN The Magazine* 2006 Academic All-America Third-Team selection along with being named to the NSCAA Scholar All-East Region's Second Team. She has been a member of the Patriot League Academic Honor Roll for four-straight years.

Curd, a Second-Team All-Patriot League member as well as a Patriot League All-Tournament Team selection, appeared in 68 career games with 49 starts and scored seven goals and added five assists for 19 career points.

Joining Curd with a 4.00 or above GPA during the fall semester were: American's **Siobhan Gillan**, Army's **Elizabeth Betterbed** and **Sarah Goss**, Bucknell's **Lauren Bayne**, Lafayette's **Carolyn Fisher**, Lehigh's **Allison Caldwell** and **Meredith Talbot** and Navy's **Lizzie Barnes**, **Lauren Bresnahan**, **Beth Reed** and **Kari Weniger**.

To be eligible for the Academic Honor Roll, a student-athlete must earn a 3.20 grade-point average in the fall semester and be awarded a varsity letter in one of the Patriot League's seven fall championship sports.

A total of 532 student-athletes were named to the Patriot League's Fall Academic Honor Roll, which includes the sports of men and women's cross country, field hockey, football, men and women's soccer and volleyball.
