2005 NCAA Tournament Game Recaps

Arizona dominant in 12-0 win over Lehigh at NCAAs

Tucson, AZ – Lehigh was paired up with the No. 3 seed Arizona in their 2005 NCAA Regional and the Wildcats showed why they are one of the nation's top teams on Friday night. A trio of Wildcat pitchers held Lehigh without a hit in Arizona's 12-0, five inning win at Hillenbrand Stadium. The Wildcats ripped 10 hits including three home runs as they improve to 40-10 and move on to face Oklahoma State in the winners bracket. Lehigh will take on Princeton in an elimination game on Saturday.

Offensively, the Wildcats poured it on from the very beginning. A single and two walks off senior starter Emily Ling loaded the bases, before Jackie Coburn put U of A up 2-0 with an RBI single to right field. Shelly Schultz followed up with a three-run homer to dead centerfield and the Wildcats led 5-0 before the Mountain Hawks could record an out.

The Wildcats tacked on two more runs in the second and one more in the third. In the fourth inning Arizona got a pair of two-run home runs from Callista Balko and Caitlin Lowe off of sophomore Heather Hamasaki to put the game out of reach.

Lowe was 4-for-4 with four runs scored, while Coburn was 2-for-2 with five runs batted in.

Arizona pitchers retired the first 14 batters they faced. Alicia Hollowell struck out five in the first two innings, Leslie Wolfe followed with two perfect frames and then Taryne Mowatt came within one out of a perfect game before hitting Lauren Haney to give the Mountain Hawks their only baserunner. The game was halted after four and a half innings due to the eight run rule. Wolfe was credited with the win, while Ling took the loss and fell to 20-6 on the season.

"We hadn't played a game since May 9th and we were a little rusty," said Lehigh head coach Fran Troyan after the game. "You simply can not give a team like Arizona those kinds of opportunities early."

Senior second baseman Jessica Young looked forward to a chance for redemption on Saturday.

"We wanted to come in here and show them that we could fight.," Young said. "We look at tomorrow as if it's a whole new day and we look forward to coming out and giving our all."

Late Princeton rally ends Lehigh's season in Tucson

Tucson, AZ – Lehigh led Princeton 1-0 after five innings of Saturday afternoon's NCAA Tournament elimination game at Arizona's Hillenbrand Stadium. The Mountain Hawks however, were unable to hold the lead as the Tigers scored three times in the top of the sixth, then held off Lehigh rallies in each of the final two innings to win the game 3-1 and end the Mountain Hawks season. The loss is Lehigh's second of the double-elimination regional as the Brown and White wrap up another successful season with a final record of 41-10.

After being no-hit against Arizona on Friday night the Mountain Hawks picked up their first hit of the regional tournament when senior Jess Young delivered a first inning single. Young later put Lehigh ahead 1-0 with a monstrous home run to left field in the bottom of the fourth inning.

Emily Ling started in the circle for the Mountain Hawks, and pitched well through the first five innings, working her way out of a couple jams without any damage done. The Tigers finally got to Ling in the top of the sixth inning as Princeton took the lead on three consecutive two-out singles. Ty Ries gave Princeton the lead with a two run single, then Tiffany Andres singled to right field to tack on an insurance run.

The Mountain Hawks had chances in each of the final two frames. They loaded the bases with two outs in the sixth, but pinch hitter Lauren Haney was retired on a pop-up to second base. In its final at-bat Lehigh had runners on second and third base with two out, but freshman Taryn Hanley popped up to first base to end the game.

"It's a game of inches and today we came up a bit short," said Lehigh head coach Fran Troyan.

CONFERENCE NOTEBOOK

- ♦ Lehigh ended the season 41-10 overall after facing only two opponents in the NCAA Tournament, being eliminated with losses to No. 3 Arizona and Princeton.
- ♦ The Mountain Hawks opened NCAA play with Arizona on the Wildcats' home field in Tucson. The team was no-hit by the Wildcats, falling by a score of 12-0 as the game ended in the fifth. The margin of loss was the most by a Patriot League team in the NCAA postseason, while two other contests have ended before the full seven innings were played (1999 - No. 1 Washington 8, Colgate 0 & 2002 - No. 1 UCLA 8, Colgate 0).
- ♦ The 12 runs scored on the Mountain Hawks were the most they have given up this season.
- ♦ Game two was against a familiar face as the Mountain Hawks battled Princeton earlier this season. The defeat marked their third loss to the Tigers this year, dropping a 3-1 game. The lone run was produced by senior second baseman **Jessica Young**, who homered to give the Mountain Hawks a 1-0 lead. The blast was the first home run for the Brown and White in the NCAA Tournament.
- ♦ **Emily Ling's** ERA rose from 1.19 to 1.59, being tagged with 11 earned runs in two starts. Ling added four strikeouts to bring her Patriot League-leading career total to 610, while falling to 20-6 on the year.
- ♦ Patriot League teams are 2-14 in the NCAA Tournament, with Lehigh posting a 1-6 record.
