### WAVEPOINTS

- After a prolific victory in the home opener, the Pepperdine men's basketball team will look to make it two in a row with Friday's home contest against Northern Colorado.
- This is the second of four consecutive home games for the Waves, the last two of which are part of the Progressive Legends Classic.
- This is only the second-ever meeting between the Waves and Bears and the first one came 53 seasons ago (a Pepperdine victory).
- The game will be shown on TheW.tv with Al Epstein on the call.
- The Waves are coming off a 107-point performance vs. Cal Lutheran, the first time hitting the century mark since the 2007-08 season. Six Waves scored in double-figures, the first time that had happened since December 2012.
- After two years of major injury issues, things aren't off to a great start in 2017-18 as two expected starters — **Amadi Udenyi** (concussion) and **Eric Cooper Jr.** (shoulder) — have missed time.
- Newcomers have scored 60.4% of the points so far this season, led by freshman **Trae Berhow** (12.0 ppg).
- **Kameron Edwards** has made a nice return from injury, averaging 12.0 points and 7.0 rebounds in his first two games back.
- **Amadi Udenyi** needs nine assists to move into Pepperdine's all-time top 10 (and 10 to knock head coach **Marty Wilson** out of the top 10).
- Pepperdine next hosts a subregional in the Progressive Legends Classic, a four-team event with UC Santa Barbara, Montana and Oral Roberts, next Monday and Tuesday (Nov. 20-21).

### SERIES

The Waves and Bears have only played once, and it came 53 seasons ago. Pepperdine won 85-80 in December 1964 in a home game. **Roland Betts** scored 22 points to lead the Waves.

### CONNECTIONS

The Waves have one Coloradoan (**Colbey Ross**) while the Bears have one Californian (Andre Spight).

### BEARS

Northern Colorado has opened the season with losses to Colorado and UC Davis, both by margins of 15 points. Andre Spight (19.5 ppg) is the only Bear averaging in double-figures through two games. Last season, the Bears finished 11-18 overall and 7-11 in the Big Sky for a tie for eighth place. They were picked fourth in the preseason Big Sky coaches' poll and junior guard Jordan Davis made the preseason All-Big Sky team.

**LAST GAME** — The Waves hit the century mark for the first time since 2008 and six players scored in double-figures in a 107-82 win over Division III Cal Lutheran on Tuesday night. It was Pepperdine's home opener. Six Waves scored in double-figures, the first time that had happened since December 2012. **Darnell Dunn** led the Waves with 18 points, followed by **Kameron Edwards** (17 plus 10 rebounds), **Nolan Taylor** (15), **Matthew Atewe** (career-high 12), **Trae Berhow** (11) and **Knox Hellums** (11).

**LEGENDS CLASSIC** — The Waves are playing in four games as part of the 2017 Progressive Legends Classic. The opener at Oklahoma State was one of them. On November 20 and 21, the Waves will host a four-team subregional. Pepperdine will play UC Santa Barbara and Montana will take on Oral Roberts on the first night. Finally, the Waves will visit Texas A&M on November 24 for the last contest.

**HOME OPENERS** — After beating Cal Lutheran, since 1944-45, the Waves have a record of 56-18 in home openers (and 36-9 in Firestone Fieldhouse), with seven consecutive wins.

**INJURIES** — After two consecutive seasons of dire injury woes, the Waves have their fingers crossed for a better 2017-18 season. But, two expected starters have already missed time. **Amadi Udenyi** was held out of the Cal Lutheran game (concussion protocol) and **Eric Cooper Jr.** (shoulder) has yet to play this season.

The Waves put together a winning season in 2015-16 despite losing three shooting guards to season-ending injuries. But last season, the Waves were down three starters and four players in all by the end of the year, by far the largest reason for last year's slide. There were a total of 99 player-games lost due to injury or illness (60 by projected starters).

**UDENYI** — Fifth-year senior point guard **Amadi Udenyi** might have given **Jeremy Major** a run at who would become the Waves' all-time leader in assists first. Unfortunately, injuries have robbed Udenyi of parts of three of his first four seasons.

Still, he's currently ranked 11th all-time in assists at Pepperdine with 333. He needs just nine more to break into the top 10 (which would knock head coach **Marty Wilson** off the list). It would take a big year, but it's not inconceivable that Udenyi could pass Major's record of 494. Udenyi is also a tenacious perimeter defender who helped the Waves post some impressive defensive numbers in previous seasons.

Udenyi missed 10 games as a freshman due to a knee injury. He then tore his left Achilles tendon in the 26th game of his sophomore season. He played his entire junior year and averaged 4.9 points and 4.5 assists while ranking second in the WCC and 20th nationally in assist/turnover ratio (3.0).

The Waves started last season 4-1 with a healthy Udenyi, but struggled the rest of the way after he went down with a torn right Achilles tendon in game seven. Rather than call it a career, Udenyi decided to make another comeback, apply for a medical redshirt and use his fifth year of eligibility.

**EDWARDS** — **Kameron Edwards**, who earned WCC All-Freshman honors two seasons ago (7.2 ppg, 4.2 rpg) and might challenge Udenyi as the team's top returning defender, saw no action in 2016-17 after suffering a fractured jaw during a preseason scrimmage. He was expected to be a big contributor last season and now looks to make a leap in his redshirt sophomore year. He had his first career double-double vs. Cal Lutheran (11/14) with 17 points and 10 rebounds. He shares the team lead at 12.0 points per game.

**TAYLOR** — The graduation of last year's leading players leaves sophomore forward **Nolan Taylor** as the team's top returner in scoring (7.1) and rebounding (3.7). He's a standout on and off the floor, as he serves as a co-vice president of Pepperdine Athletics' Waves Leadership Council (our version of SAAC).

**ATEWE** — This is the third time in five years that the Waves will feature a graduate transfer from the Pac-12 in the post. The Waves hope that **Matthew Atewe**, a Toronto native who has played at both Auburn and Washington, can make the same kind of leap as the previous two. His previous career high was six points but he had 12 vs. Cal Lutheran (11/14).

Atewe averaged 2.2 points and 2.3 rebounds with the Huskies last season. **Brendan Lane** (2014 WCC Defensive Player of the Year and All-WCC honorable mention) went from 1.6 points and 1.8 rebounds in his last year at UCLA to 13.0 and 7.3 with the Waves. **Chris Reyes** (2017 All-WCC honorable mention) went from 2.6 points and 2.3 rebounds at Utah to 13.4 and 7.9 at Pepperdine.

**HEMPY** — **Kevin Hempy** had a remarkable season last year, going from making the team via a walk-on tryout to starting the final three games of the season. Though he graduated in the spring, he decided to return for his final year of eligibility despite facing the rigors of being a first-year law student at Pepperdine. There are only a couple of other known instances of a Division I men's basketball student-athlete who has attended law school at the same time.

**NEWCOMERS** — Newcomers to the program have scored 60.4% of the points through the first two games, led by **Trae Berhow** at 12.0 ppg. Berhow is also averaging a team-high 8.0 rebounds. Fellow freshmen **Colbey Ross** (5.5 assists) and **Jade Smith** (2.5 steals) are tops in those two categories.

**ROSTER NUMBERS** — The breakdown is two graduate students, one redshirt senior, three juniors, five sophomores, one redshirt freshman and five true freshmen. The scholarship breakdown is one graduate student, one redshirt senior, three juniors, four sophomores, one redshirt freshman and three true freshmen.

Returning players account for 23.3% of last year’s points, 25.3% of the rebounds, 36.2% of the assists, 11.9% of the blocks, 40.8% of the steals and 32.6% of the minutes played.

**EXPERIENCE** — Eight returning players have appeared in a game for the Waves, through three of them were injured last season and received redshirts. Three players began the season having made 20 or more career starts.

**WCC** — The Waves were picked seventh in the annual preseason coaches’ poll but they believe they will be better than that. The order went Saint Mary’s, Gonzaga, BYU, San Francisco, Santa Clara, San Diego, Pepperdine, Pacific, Portland and Loyola Marymount.

**2016-17 SEASON** — The Waves expected to have another good season (they were picked fourth in the preseason coaches’ poll) but one injury after another took its toll and the Waves slid to 9-22 overall and eighth place in the WCC. **Lamond Murray Jr.** led the conference in scoring (21.4), the eighth-highest mark in program history, and made the All-WCC first team. **Jeremy Major** left as the program’s all-time leader in assists and games started.

**ACADEMICS** — **Marty Wilson** takes his team’s academics very seriously, and the results have been very good. Since Wilson’s return to the program in 2008-09, players have earned 12 spots on the NABC Honors Court, 12 WCC All-Academic nods and 32 WCC Commissioner’s Honor Roll appearances. **Malte Kramer** was Pepperdine’s co-Valedictorian and became the program’s first-ever CoSIDA Academic All-American in 2014.

**PEPPERDINE BASKETBALL** — This is the 80th season of Pepperdine men’s basketball, and the 45th season that the Waves have called Firestone Fieldhouse home. The Waves began the campaign with an all-time record of 1,212-1,058 (.534). Pepperdine has been to the NCAA Tournament 13 times (last in 2002) and has won 12 West Coast Conference regular-season titles (last in 2002) and three WCC Tournament crowns (last in 1994).

**WAVES IN THE PROS** — Pepperdine once had a streak of 34 consecutive seasons with at least one Pepperdine alum on an NBA roster, which began in 1976-77 after the ABA/NBA merger and ended in 2010-11. Seventeen former Pepperdine players have seen action in the NBA, a list that includes notables such as **Dennis Johnson** (a 2010 Naismith Hall of Fame inductee, the 1979 NBA Finals MVP and a three-time NBA champion) and **Doug Christie** (a 15-year NBA veteran who was a mainstay on the All-Defensive Team). **Mychel Thompson** is the most recent Wave to play in the NBA, appearing in five games for the Cleveland Cavaliers in 2011-12. Two Waves — **Yakhouba Diawara** (2012/France) and **Marcos Leite** (1972, 1980, 1984/Brazil) — have competed at the Olympics.

Several alums are currently playing overseas, including recent graduates **Stacy Davis** (France), **Lamond Murray Jr.** (Greece), **Jeremy Major** (Cyprus), **Chris Reyes** (Austria), **Brendan Lane** (Japan) and **Nikolas Skouen** (Norway).

**NCAA WEST REGIONAL** — Pepperdine University is once again the host institution for the NCAA Division I Men’s Basketball West Regional Championship in 2018. The Waves partnered with AEG/Staples Center and the Los Angeles Sports & Entertainment Commission to bring NCAA postseason basketball to the City of Angels for the first time since 1994 with previous hosting stints in 2013 and 2015. And, with the 2020 West Regional also awarded to L.A., that’ll be four regionals in eight seasons put on by Pepperdine.

# MARTY WILSON



This is **Marty Wilson's** seventh year as head coach at Pepperdine and his 21st season in Malibu in any capacity. He has compiled an impressive record here beginning as a student-athlete (1985-89), continuing as an assistant coach (1991-96, which included a brief stint as the interim head coach) and then returning as the associate head coach for three seasons (2009-11) under **Tom Asbury**. He was elevated to the position of head coach following Asbury's retirement after the 2010-11 season. He signed a five-year contract extension that will take him through the 2020-21 season. Wilson was also an assistant at San Diego, UC Santa Barbara and Utah in between stints at Pepperdine and he is now in his 28th season as a Division I coach. He ended his playing career #5 all-time in assists at Pepperdine with 342 (he's now #10). The team went to the NCAA Tournament twice and the NIT twice in Wilson's four seasons on the court. As a Pepperdine assistant, the team took part in the NCAA Tournament three times and the NIT once. The Waves have played in the CBI twice while he's been head coach. Wilson's son Jalon, a junior at Pepperdine, is one of the team's student managers. Wilson entered the 2017-18 season with an 82-103 record as Pepperdine's full-time head coach (85-113 including his time as the interim coach).

## WILSONISMS

Some of these may be borrowed from other programs, but **Marty Wilson** has several expressions and acronyms he often uses that help define his coaching philosophy. Both Feet In: Players are expected to fully buy in to the program. When Wilson is speaking to the team at center court, everyone must have both feet in the jump circle ... OKGs: Wilson looks to recruit "our kind of guys," student-athletes who will represent Pepperdine well and succeed academically and athletically ... Show Me, Don't Tell Me: Actions speak louder than words ... GID: There isn't always a perfect way to accomplish something, so players just have to "get it done" ... DAT: The Waves use the words "discipline, accountability and trust" as part of a triangle and expect their student-athletes to embrace these ideals.

## ASSISTANTS

Pepperdine's list of coaches has gone unchanged for the fifth consecutive season, giving the program much-needed stability. Associate head coaches **Mark Amaral** and **Bryant Moore** are both in their seventh seasons (Moore was promoted before the 2016-17 season). Amaral and **Marty Wilson** were assistants together at UC Santa Barbara for four years. Moore worked with the Cleveland Cavaliers for five seasons in a variety of roles, including player development coordinator, during the first LeBron James era. **John Impelman**, who was the director of operations for two years, was promoted to assistant coach before the 2013-14 season. Impelman is the great-grandson of UCLA coaching legend John Wooden, and his father Craig is a former Pepperdine assistant coach. **Brandon Veltri** is in his first season as the director of operations.

# PEPPERDINE

Pepperdine boasts a one-of-a-kind athletic department with unprecedented success for a school of its size. The Waves have won NCAA Division I championships in five different men's sports — one of just 18 schools to have accomplished this feat — and nine overall. Of this elite group, Pepperdine has the smallest undergraduate enrollment, is the only school without football and is the only university that has not been affiliated with a "major" conference. The Waves have won a total of 25 team or individual national championships in their history. Pepperdine has also earned the Division I-AAA All-Sports Trophy, an award based on postseason success that's given to the top non-football school, three times (most recently in 2011-12). Located in scenic Malibu, California, the university overlooks the Pacific Ocean and its campus and athletic facilities are regularly voted among the nation's most beautiful. Pepperdine, which is affiliated with the Church of Christ, ranks #46 overall on U.S. News and World Report's list of America's best colleges.

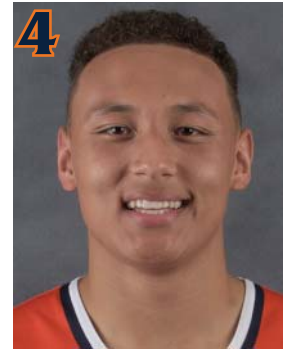

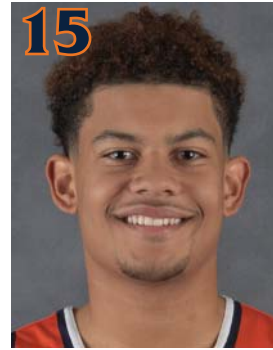

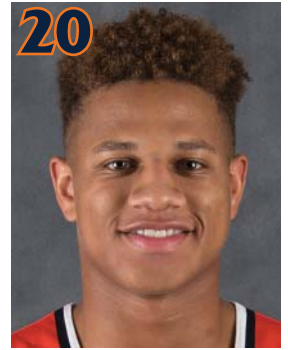
