NOTES

This Week: The No. 17 Pepperdine women's soccer team stays returns to Malibu for its lone game this week, taking on Gonzaga on Sunday at 1 p.m.

Game #13: Sunday (Oct. 15) at Tari Frahm Rokus Field in Malibu, Calif.: Pepperdine (9-2-2, 3-0-0) vs. Gonzaga (10-3-1, 2-2-0) at 1 p.m.

Series vs. Gonzaga: Pepperdine leads, 17-5-2. The Waves are 10-2 at home against the Bulldogs and have not lost to Gonzaga since 2010, going 5-0-1 in that span.

Last Week: The Waves played one game against PCH Cup rival LMU, beating the Lions 1-0 on the road thanks to a 74th minute goal from Calista Reyes. LMU was the second highest ranked team in the WCC coming into the game.

On a Roll: Pepperdine is unbeaten in its last seven games, going 6-0-1 during that stretch. The Waves have also not allowed a goal in its last four games, including all three WCC matchups so far.

On the Defensive: The Pepperdine defense has been stellar this year, giving up just five goals in 13 games and posting eight shutouts. The Waves currently have a 434 minute scoreless streak going and had a 338 minute scoreless streak snapped earlier in the year. The team's 0.37 goals against average ranks 6th in the country and first in the WCC.

Waves in the Rankings: Pepperdine busted into the national rankings last week at No. 18 in the coaches poll and moved up to No. 17 this week. The Waves also sit at No. 22 in the Top Drawer Soccer rankings, No. 25 in the Soccer America Rankings and are No. 15 in RPI. Pepperdine is ranked fourth in the West Region coaches poll.

Beating the Broncos: Pepperdine's 5-0 win at Santa Clara marked the team's largest offensive output of the season and also gave the Waves their first-ever road win in the series between the teams. Neither team had won a road game in the series since 2000. The 5-0 victory was also the worst loss at home for the perennial powerhouse since 2008.

Drawing the Bruins: Pepperdine picked up a thrilling draw at top-ranked UCLA earlier this year, breaking a seven-game win streak for the then undefeated Bruins. Jamie Van Horn scored the equalizing goal in the 77th minute and Brielle Preece made a career-high nine saves.

NOTES

The Road Ahead: Pepperdine hits the road again next week for its final two road games of the regular season, before closing WCC play with three games at home.

WCC Preseason Poll: Pepperdine was selected to finish third in the WCC Preseason Poll. Santa Clara edged BYU for the top spot in the poll. Bri Visalli was also named to the preseason all-conference team. It was the third straight year the Waves have been picked to finish third in the WCC preseason poll. Pepperdine outperformed that prediction last year with a WCC Championship.

2017 Roster: Pepperdine returns 18 players from its 2016 roster and brings in an 11-player freshman class. The Waves lost 10 players from last year's roster.

WCC Title: Pepperdine is coming off of its third WCC title last year. The Waves won their previous titles in 2011 and in 2002 before that. Pepperdine and BYU shared the championship with 7-1-1 records, but the Waves earned the conference's automatic bid to the NCAA Tournament by beating the Cougars in their lone meeting last year.

25th Anniversary: Pepperdine women's soccer is celebrating its 25th anniversary this year and to commemorate the program's silver season, the Waves are releasing messages on social media from various alumni. Tim Ward: Ward picked up his fourth WCC Coach of the Year award and second in the last three years in 2016 and now heads into his 20th year at the helm for Pepperdine. He guided the Waves to a third conference title and ninth NCAA Tournament appearance last year. Ward now has 219 career wins as the winningest coach in program history. He has overseen 15 winning seasons and has led the Waves to 13 10-win seasons and nine years with at least 12 wins.

About Pepperdine University: Pepperdine boasts a one-of-a-kind athletic department with unprecedented success for a school of its size. The Waves have won NCAA Division I championships in five different men's sports – one of just 18 schools to have accomplished this feat – and nine overall. Of this elite group, Pepperdine has the smallest undergraduate enrollment and is the only school not affiliated with a BCS-level conference. The Waves have earned the Division I-AAA All-Sports Trophy, an award based on postseason success that's given to the top non-football school, three times (most recently in 2011-12). Located in scenic Malibu, Calif., the university overlooks the Pacific Ocean and its campus and athletic facilities are regularly voted among the nation's most beautiful. Pepperdine, which is affiliated with the Church of Christ, ranks #46 overall on U.S. News and World Report's list of America's best colleges.

WAVES AT TARI FRAHM ROKUS FIELD

- ▶ With a 6-3-1 record at home in 2016, Pepperdine still has not experienced a losing season on its home pitch.
- ▶ The Waves went a perfect 10-0-0 in 2002 and did not lose a home match in 2006 (7-0-2) and 2010 (6-0-3).
- ▶ The Waves concluded their 24th season at Tari Frahm Rokus Field in 2016, with a record of 159-49-29 (.732).
- ▶ Posted a 27-match regular season unbeaten string from 2009-2012.

- ▶ Hired as the third head coach in program history in 1998 after spending four seasons as an assistant for the Waves.
- ▶ Guided Waves to five consecutive NCAA Postseasons from 2001-05 and back-to-back berths in 2011-12.
- ▶ Directed Pepperdine to a share of the program's first West Coast Conference title in 2002 and matched the feat in 2011 and 2016.
- ▶ Has recruited and coached five All-Americans, including 2014 NSCAA first team selection Lynn Williams.
- ▶ Waves have earned All-WCC honors on 97 occasions since 1998.
- ▶ Since 1998, Waves have earned NSCAA All-West Region 31 times.
- ▶ Waves have earned 53 WCC All-Academic awards since 1998.
- ▶ Named NSCAA West Region Coach of the Year in 2002 and 2014.
- ▶ Guided Waves to 15 winning seasons and 13 campaigns with 10 or more victories.
- ▶ Directed Pepperdine to three NCAA Sweet-16 appearances ('02, 05, '14). The Waves own a 7-9-2 overall record in the NCAA Postseason.
- ▶ Four-year letter-winner at Cal Lutheran, helping the Kingsmen to a 57-18-8 slate.

2017 SEASON PREVIEW

THE KEEPERS...

Coach Ward on the Goalkeepers: "Brielle Preece is our senior leader and incumbent to take over for Hannah in goal. She had a wonderful spring in training and what I really love about Brielle is that the girls love having her in the net behind them. Hannah was incredibly talented and a great leader, and the transition to Brielle has been about as seamless as it could be so far, so that's really a testament to her leadership abilities. She also has two years of eligibility, which is great. And then we have Zoe Clevely, a freshman, who has come in and is really pushing Brielle in training, which is great for both of them to have that competition. Zoe has all the ability to be an outstanding goalie for this program. Brielle is our starter right now, but we really look at it like we have two starting caliber players back there, which is excellent for us."

The Breakdown: After backing up Seabert for the past two years, Preece has appeared in five games for a total of 55 minutes coming into 2017 ... Clevely comes to Pepperdine from Edison HS in Huntington Beach, Calif. where she was All-CIF first team and League MVP.

THE BACK LINE...

Coach Ward on the Defense: "We return almost our whole back line from last year, except for Meghan Schoen, who ended the year as a right back, but you replace her with Hailey Harbison. She'll join Michelle Maemone, Danielle Thomas and Jamie Van Horn on what I think is a really good starting back line. What we are adding are two sophomores, Brooke Zenner and Tara Morris, who showed in the spring that they are very much starting caliber defenders for us. We feel we have six potential starters in the back row. On top of that, we've added three true freshman defenders in Laura Ishikawa, who's a wide back, Erin Sinai, who's a wide back or a center back, and Emily Sample, who's a center back. We haven't had this much depth back there in a long time, which is great for our program not only this year and going forward, but it helps our strikers to have to try to score against this group every day in training. This year I think what you'll see is us be a bit more liberal with how we rotate our defenders."

The Breakdown: The Pepperdine defensive line posted a school record-tying 11 shutouts in 2016, allowing just 0.71 goals per game ... Hailey Harbison – 40 games played, two goals, three assists ... Maemone – 40 games played, one goal, two assists ... Thomas – 38 games played, three goals ... Van Horn – 59 games played, two goals, one assist ... Zenner – nine games played in 2016 ... Morris – five games played in 2016 ... Ishikawa – scholar-athlete and CIF semi-finalist at Westlake HS ... Sinai – All-League player at Carlsbad HS ... Sample – three-time All-District and Defensive MVP at Plano West HS in Plano, Texas.

IN THE MIDDLE...

Coach Ward on the Midfield: "We return our whole starting midfield this season with Meagan Harbison, Bri Visalli and Christina Settles all coming back, and they were great for us last year. In addition, we feel we have several other people who are competing for minutes there. Courtney Merrill and Ashley Buck, much like Brooke Zenner and Tara Morris, were awesome in the spring and they are both playing at the next level and could easily start for us. Add to that Katy Byrne, who played a little bit up front for us last year, but we think she's going to be transitioning into more of a midfield role as a junior. She comes in with great experience and is a good ball-winner. Then, as a freshman coming in, Joelle Anderson is the real deal and she's going to see a lot of time. We also add Maddie Cook as a newcomer to the group. Like the back line, we're running at least two-deep at each position, which is excellent."

The Breakdown: Meagan Harbison – 60 games played, two goals, four assists ... Visalli – 62 games played, 11 goals, four assists (Waves' leading returning scorer) ... Settles – 39 games played, four goals, two assists ... Merrill – seven games played in 2016 ... Buck – six games played in 2016 ... Byrne – 36 games played, three goals, two assists ... Anderson – scored 101 goals and 35 assists in three varsity seasons at The Harker School in San Jose, Calif., played club for ... Cook – 14 goals and eight assists as a team MVP at Tesoro HS in Las Flores, Calif.

UP FRONT...

Coach Ward on the strikers: "We have nine or 10 girls on this team that can play striker and that doesn't even include Hailey Harbison or Michelle Maemone, who we have in the back row, but have also played up front. I think what you'll see is our returners, Alex Marmureanu and Hailey Stenberg, play a lot of minutes like they did last year. They are going to be vital to our attack. We have some other veteran players like Meghan Healy and Emily Tanaka who are coming back and look better than they've ever looked. And we've added to that a ton of younger players. Brie Welch is a freshman, but was also with us in the spring so she has already put in some great training. Devyn Gilfoy and Calista Reyes, two more newcomers, made outstanding contributions in our first scrimmage already. Lauren Bateman is also coming off a redshirt year as well, so there is going to be a ton of competition in the front row among a good young group that also includes newcomers Chloe Gaynor and Aliyah Satterfield. We don't care who scores or creates the goals, we just care that we are getting goals. They understand that they have to be producing day in and day out in training to get on the field. I think, though, that we will likely go five or six deep up front, with the way we plan to defend and press, if you're not working hard, someone else is going to be ready to go."

The Breakdown: Marmureanu – 21 games played since transferring from Texas Tech ... Stenberg – 21 games played, three goals, two assists all in 2016 ... Healy – five games played ... Tanaka – 18 games played, one goal ... Bateman – redshirted 2016 season, was an offensive MVP at Woodinville HS ... Welch – 38 goals and 26 assists as an All-CIF player at Arroyo Grande HS ... Gilfoy – 46 goals and 38 assists as an All-CIF player at Liberty HS in Brentwood, Calif. ... Reyes – scored 56 goals as an All-Southern Nevada player at Sierra Vista HS in Las Vegas ... Gaynor – All-League player and track star at Dana Hills HS in Dana Point, Calif. ... Satterfield – All-League player at West Ranch HS in Valencia, Calif.
