THE WAVES: Pepperdine has gone 18-1 this season thus far, with the Waves only loss coming against top-ranked North Carolina in the ITA National Team Indoor Championships. Pepperdine has gone 11-0 at home, 4-1 on neutral courts and 3-0 on foreign courts this season thus far.

As a team, the Waves have produced a 73-13 record in singles dual action, including a 12-1 record in the No. 1 position. No. 25 **Luisa Stefani** leads in that position with a 9-1 record, while No. 16 **Ashley Lahey** has gone 3-0 in the No. 1 position and 5-1 in the No. 2 position. Pepperdine has gone 12-2 in the No. 2 position, 14-2 in the No. 3 position, 13-1 in the No. 4 position, 12-4 in the No. 5 spot and 10-3 in the No. 6 slot. No. 19 **Mayar Sherif** has amassed a 14-1 output with an untarnished 8-0 record at the No. 3 spot and a 6-1 record in the No. 2 position. No. 67 **Evgeniya Levashova** has gone 14-1 in dual action, No. 88 **Laura Gulbe** has put up a 12-2 output and **Dzina Milovanovic** and **Adrijana Lekaj** possess 10-4 and 6-2 dual records respectively.

In doubles action, Pepperdine has put in a 37-9 overall dual record, with the No. 1 pair going 16-2, No. 2 going 9-4 and No. 3 going 12-3 this season. At No. 1, Stefani and Sherif lead with a 12-1 record. Levashova and Milovanovic have spent the most time together in the No. 2 position for an 8-4 record and three pairings have played at No. 3 with Lahey and Lekaj leading with a 9-0 record this season.

WEEKLY ACCOLADES: **Mayar Sherif** and **Luisa Stefani** garnered their second-straight doubles honor on April 10. The Waves have earned seven West Coast Conference weekly honors this season thus far, with **Luisa Stefani** tabbing her second singles player of the week honor on March 6, to tally her 10th-career weekly singles honor. She also received singles accolades on February 6. **Ashley Lahey** and **Mayar Sherif** continued with the honors by sweeping the singles and doubles awards on February 13 and **Laura Gulbe** and **Evgeniya Levashova** also earned singles acclaim in March and April respectively.

LAST WEEK: The Waves earned their sixth and seventh-straight sweeps last weekend, with a pair of 4-0 wins over San Diego and BYU last week. The Waves have gone 7-0 this season in WCC action, with all but one with a sweeping result. In last week's opener against USD, Pepperdine opened with big doubles action. No. 8 **Luisa Stefani** and **Mayar Sherif** and **Ashley Lahey** and **Adrijana Lekaj** downed their opponents on courts one and three with 6-2 and 6-0 results respectively to clinch the doubles point. In singles action, No. 67 **Evgeniya Levashova** opened with a 6-0, 6-1 win over Maria-Paula Torres in the No. 3 position. She was followed by No. 88 **Laura Gulbe's** 6-1, 6-1 win over Kati Kukaras on court four to put the Waves in a position to clinch. No. 19 Sherif would do the honors as she downed Daniela Morales 6-3, 6-1 to clinch the sweep for the Waves.

In the final match of the week against BYU, the Waves once again won the doubles point quickly with victories on courts two and three. Lekaj and Lahey opened with a 6-0 win in the No. 3 spot to set the tone and No. 90 Evgeniya Levashova and Dzina Milovanovic downed their opponents 6-3 in the No. 2 position to clinch. In singles play, Gulbe opened with a pair of 6-2 set wins over Kate Cusick and **Dzina Milovanovic** bested Madeline Almeida 6-1, 6-2 to put the Waves in a clinching opportunity. Sherif did the honors for the second-straight match with a 6-4, 6-0 win over Polina Malykh in the No. 3 spot.

OPPONENTS: UCLA leads the Waves with a 54-16 all-time record against, dating back to 1977 when the Bruins went 22-1 through the 1991 season over Pepperdine. The Waves won four-straight matches from 2000-01 before the Bruins went on another pair of streaks. In recent years, the Waves have won three-consecutive matches since 2016, including the last 4-1 win in the second round of the NCAA tournament in 2017. This season, UCLA ranks 14th in the Oracle/ITA rankings after posting a 16-4 overall record. The Bruins have four ranked singles (#15 Ena Shibahar, #35 Jada Hart, #55 Abi Altick and #98 Alaina Miller) and four ranked doubles pairs with many of the duos having the same player in them (#7 Jada Hart/Terri Fleming, #19 Hart/Ena Shibahara, #34 Hart/Gabby Andrews, #52 Andrews/Ayan Broomfield).

Against the WCC opponents San Francisco and Santa Clara, the Waves have never been beaten, holding a 14-0 record against the Dons since 1997 and an 18-0 record against the Broncos since 1984. Against USF, nine of the 14 wins have been sweeps including three in the last three years. Against SCU, 11-of-18 wins have been sweeps including five in the last four years. This season, San Francisco has gone 3-15 overall and 1-5 against WCC opponents and Santa Clara has put up an 8-10 overall record and a 3-4 record in WCC play.

ORACLE/ITA RANKINGS: The Waves are currently ranked No. 10 in the Oracle/ITA rankings. In the singles rankings, Ashley Lahey and Mayar Sherif rank 16th and 19th respectively, while Luisa Stefani is at the No. 25-spot. Evgeniya Levashova and Laura Gulbe rank No. 67 and No. 88 respectively.

In doubles, Sherif ranks twice with a No. 8 ranking alongside Stefani and No. 35 ranking when playing with Lahey. Levashova and Milovanovic rank ranked No. 90.

ITA NATIONAL TEAM INDOOR RUNNER-UP: Pepperdine put in a solid performance at the ITA National Team Indoor Championships two weeks ago, finishing as runners-up. The Waves went 3-1 in the tournament, defeating No. 12 Auburn 4-2, No. 7 Georgia Tech 4-2 and No. 2 Vanderbilt 4-3 to reach the title bout against No. 5 North Carolina. The Waves posted a big battle against the Tar Heels, eventually falling 4-2 to close the weekend.

PEPPERDINE ROSTER: This season, the Waves have two seniors with **Mayar Sherif** and **Laura Gulbe**. Three juniors have returned or joined the squad as **Dzina Milovanovic** and **Luisa Stefani** returned. **Jessica Failla** also joined the squad as a junior transfer from USC at the beginning of the fall. Stefani has ranked as high as No. 2 in the Oracle/ITA singles rankings. **Ashley Lahey** also returns to the Waves' lineup and has ranked as high as No. 3 throughout the fall season. **Adrijana Lekaj** will hit the court as a sophomore for the Waves this season as well. The last addition this spring is **Evgeniya Levashova** who joins the squad with a career-high juniors ITF ranking of No. 12.

ITA SOUTHWEST REGIONAL: For the third-consecutive season, the Waves have won the ITA Southwest Regional singles draw. **Ashley Lahey** won the tournament for the second straight year, and this season she faced fellow Wave **Mayar Sherif** in the final match-up to earn them both a bid to the Oracle ITA Fall National Championship. Lahey won the tournament with wins against Alaina Miller (UCLA), Sydney Van Alphen (USC), Elisabeta Volodko (UCSB), Eva Voracek (LMU), Avan Broomfield (UCLA) and Mayar Sherif (Pepperdine). Sherif reached the final after collecting victories over Calota Casasampere (LBSU), Becca Weissmann (USC), Lena Pacholski (LBSU), No. 73 Jada Hart (UCLA) and Veronika Miroshnichenko (LMU).

OTHER FALL TOURNAMENTS: In addition to the regional, the Waves competed in five other fall tournaments, including the Oracle/ITA Masters and the Oracle ITA National Fall Championships. In the Oracle/ITA Masters, Mayar Sherif reached the semifinal round against Alle Sanford, the 6th-ranked newcomer from UNC, before falling in a three-set bout. At the fall championships, Ashley Lahey made her sophomore season debut and reached the quarterfinal round.

A GLANCE AT 2016-17: In the 2016-17 season, the Waves posted a 24-5 overall record and marked a second-consecutive appearance in the NCAA National Championship quarterfinals. Pepperdine also marked the fifth-consecutive WCC Tournament Championship title as well as the sixth-straight regular season crown. As a team, Pepperdine produced a .689 overall singles winning percentage with a 146-66 overall record. The team also posted a .686 winning percentage in doubles with a 72-33 overall record.

NILSSON: Per Nilsson returned to Pepperdine in June 2014 to succeed Gualberto Escudero as head coach of the women's tennis team. In his three years with the Waves, he has been named West Coast Conference Coach of the Year on three-consecutive occasions. In 2016 and 2017, he led the Waves to a NCAA Championship quarterfinal appearances and #9 and #8 final ranking in the ITA/Oracle rankings respectively. He was an assistant coach for the Pepperdine men's tennis team from 2003-07 under head coach Adam Steinberg, where the Waves went 119-38 in those five seasons. Pepperdine won the NCAA team championship in 2006 with Nilsson on the sidelines. He was the head men's coach at Mississippi State, his alma mater, for seven seasons from 2008-2014. Nilsson compiled a record of 95-76 during his time at MSU.

Of this elite group, Pepperdine has the smallest undergraduate enrollment, is the only school without football and is the only university that has not been affiliated with a "major" conference. The Waves have won a total of 25 team or individual national championships in their history. Pepperdine has also earned the Division I-AAA All-Sports Trophy, an award based on postseason success that's given to the top non-football school, three times (most recently in 2011-12). Located in scenic Malibu, Calif., the university overlooks the Pacific Ocean and its campus and athletic facilities are regularly voted among the nation's most beautiful. Pepperdine, which is affiliated with the Church of Christ, ranks No. 46 overall on U.S. News and World Report's list of America's best colleges.
