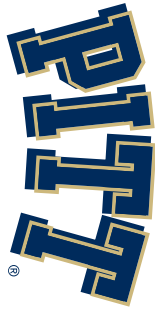

DAY CAMP DISCOUNTS

- A 10% discount will be given to University of Pittsburgh, Carnegie Mellon University, Carlow University, and UPMC employees (a copy of staff/faculty ID is required with this application).
- A 10% discount for two or more children from the same household who register for camp.
- A 10% discount per player for any team of five or more players who register for camp (all applications must be submitted together with a check from each player).
- A 10% discount for anyone who registers for more than one day camp or any camper who has her team registered for the team camp.

Discounts cannot be combined, and meal fees are added after the discount is subtracted.

DAY CAMP MEALS

Day campers have the option to purchase lunch for the entire camp week for an additional \$35. *Orders must be submitted at least one week prior to camp.* If you do not purchase lunch, you should bring a bag lunch.

FACILITIES

The University has four athletic venues for basketball that house 10 total courts: the Petersen Events Center arena (two courts), the Petersen Events Center practice gym (two courts), the Fitzgerald Field House (three courts), and Trees Hall (three courts). Camp enrollment numbers will dictate which courts will be available for the various sessions and instruction.

PAYMENT

- Full payment must accompany each application. Make checks payable to **Agnus Berenato Camps**.
- We are no longer accepting online credit card payments.
- Each camper will be assessed a \$50 administrative fee for each camp cancellation.

MEDICAL RELEASE

Parent’s consent:

The undersigned, being a parent or legal guardian of the child requesting camp admittance, does hereby affirm that the applicant is in good health and suffers from no illness, disability, or condition that requires the taking of medication on a regular basis unless that condition is disclosed and approved.

Furthermore, the undersigned has no knowledge of any reason the applicant cannot participate in rigorous physical activity. The undersigned hereby expressly agrees to be responsible for any medical bill incurred in the treatment of any illness or accident. In the event of any such accident or injury, I hereby consent to allowing any of the camp supervisors to procure any medical treatment deemed advisable on behalf of my child or ward without prior consent.

I understand that as a condition of admittance as a camper, the undersigned, on behalf of all parents and guardians, and on behalf of the applicant, hereby releases the Agnus Berenato Basketball Camp, the University of Pittsburgh, Agnus Berenato, and all other employees or agents of the camp from any and all liability from injury or illness, mental or physical, suffered by the camper during or related to camp unless caused by willful or gross negligence by the person or entity against whom the claim is made.
