THE STORYLINE

Nasir Robinson (pronounced Na-seer) is described as a hard-nosed and aggressive competitor who can play multiple positions. A passionate player who brings outstanding energy, Robinson spent the 2008-09 season coming off the bench at three different positions: power forward, small forward and center. He is a strong, hard-working and fearless player who has a sturdy body and excels at passing and slashing to the hoop. A workhorse and natural floor leader who attacks the basket, the relentless and versatile Robinson can handle the ball, is explosive off the dribble, powerful off the glass and is a rebounding machine. He rebounds far better than his size indicates.

HIGH SCHOOL

A 2008 graduate of Chester High School where he played for Head Coach Fred Pickett...Named an EA Sports Second Team All-America selection...Two-time PIAA Class 4A All-State First Team selection while leading Chester to a 58-7 two-year record and two state title game appearances...Guided Chester to a school-best 33-1 overall record, No. 3 national ranking by *USA Today* and the PIAA Class 4A state title as a senior...Concluded season on a 24-game winning streak...Selected First Team All-State after averaging 16.5 points, 11.5 rebounds, 3.9 assists and 1.1 blocks per game...Won state title with an 81-77 win over Norristown in the championship game...Registered double-double (14 points/15 rebounds) in state title game...Selected to the *Philadelphia Daily News* and *Philadelphia Inquirer* All-Area First Team...Scored 10 points in the fourth quarter to lead Chester to a 65-56 win over Pennsbury in the state semifinal...Registered 22 points and 18 rebounds in a win over Methacton...Named MVP for the Hoop Group Festival...Earned All-Tournament Team honors at the City of the Palms Tournament in Fort Myers, Fla. after scoring 26 points and grabbing 11 rebounds...Named First Team All-State after averaging 18.0 points and 11.0 rebounds per game as a junior...

Played in 29 games and 186 minutes off the bench as a small forward...Finished season with 34 points and 35 rebounds...Shot 48.4 percent (15-31) from the floor on year...Earned team's Most Improved Player Award at team banquet... Played 16 minutes, grabbed four rebounds and dished out three assists vs. Belmont, 11/25...Played a career-high 21 minutes vs. Indiana, Pa., 11/22...Scored six points (3-6 FG) with four rebounds vs. Miami, Ohio, 11/17...Scored four points and grabbed four rebounds in career debut vs. Fairleigh Dickinson, 11/14.

Finished with a game-high 22 points (11-13 FG) in the state semifinal win over Souderton (85-57)...Scored 33 points (16-21 FG) and grabbed 12 rebounds in a state quarterfinal win over West Lawn Wilson...Selected to the *Philadelphia Daily News* and *Philadelphia Inquirer* All-Area Second Team... Named All-Area by the *Delaware County Times* and *Bucks County Times* as a junior...Transferred to Chester after playing his first two years at American Christian Academy...Averaged 19.0 points and 10.0 rebounds per game as a sophomore while leading ACA to a 22-9 record...Played in the Eddie Griffin Challenge (New Jersey vs. Philadelphia area All-Star preps)... Played AAU basketball with Team Final, who is coached by Rob Brown...Helped team win an AAU national title in 2004...One of only 10 underclassmen.
