Series: The two schools meet for the fourth time in series history with Michigan State holding a 2-1 advantage. The two teams last played on Dec. 17, 1955, an 82-81 MSU win.

Other matchups occurred in 1953-54 (82-51 MSU win) and on Feb. 18, 1927 (36-34 Pitt win).

No. 4 seed and 2008 Big East Champion Pitt (27-9, 10-8 Big East) advances to NCAA Tournament Second Round play for the sixth time in the last seven years when faces No. 5 seed Michigan State (26-8, 12-6 Big Ten) at the Pepsi Center in Denver, Colo. Tipoff on Saturday is at approximately 9:10 p.m. ET/7:10 p.m. MT.

The contest will be televised nationally on CBS. Gus Johnson (play-by-play) and Len Elmore (color analysis) will make the call. Steve Scheer will produce.

Pitt advanced to NCAA Tournament Second Round play after defeating No. 13 seed Oral Roberts 82-63 in Thursday's NCAA First Round. LeVance Fields led five Pitt double figure scorers with a near-career-high 23 points

on 8-15 shooting (4-7 3FG) and seven assists. Sam Young scored 14 points (6-11 FG), Keith Benjamin finished with 12 points, nine rebounds and five assists, Ronald Ramon contributed 10 points and Gilbert Brown finished with 12 points (6-10) off the bench. Pitt's 19-point victory ranked as the fourth largest NCAA Tournament win in school history.

Pitt is attempting to advance to NCAA Sweet Sixteen play for the fifth time in the last seven years. Over the last six years, Pitt has advanced to the NCAA Sweet Sixteen play in four seasons (2002, 2003, 2004 and 2007). Only one school has surpassed that achievement (Duke-5) and three schools nationwide have matched it (Texas-4, Connecticut-4, Kansas-4). Pitt is playing in its school record

TODAY'S TOP STORYLINES

- A win would give Pitt its fifth NCAA Sweet Sixteen appearance in the last seven years. Only one school has advanced to more Sweet Sixteens over the last six years (Duke-5) and three others have matched Pitt's accomplishment of four (Texas-4, Kansas-4, Connecticut-4).
- Pitt is riding a six-game win streak. The Panthers have won eight of their last nine games.
- With its win over Oral Roberts, Pitt advanced to NCAA Second Round play in six of the last seven seasons.
- Pitt is competing in a school record seventh consecutive NCAA Tournament. Pitt is one of only nine schools to advance to each of the last seven consecutive NCAA tournaments. It is the only Big East program to play in the NCAA Tournament in each of the last seven years.

Tournament title last week. Pitt has now won Big East Tournament titles in both 2003 and 2008 and has appeared in the tournament title game in seven of the last eight seasons.

Over the last seven years (2002-08), Pitt has proven to be the winningest Big East Conference basketball program. From 2001-07, Pitt owns the league's top records for league play (81-33) and overall games (188-50). It has averaged 11.6 league wins and 26 overall wins per year during that period, the best totals in the Big East. Pitt is the only Big East Conference school to win 20 or more overall games and 10 or more league contests in each of the last seven seasons. This year, Pitt also set a school record with its seventh consecutive 20-overall win and 10-league win season. Prior to the 2001-02 season, Pitt won 20 or more games in only two consecutive seasons. It marks Pitt's 15th all-time 20-win season.

As one of the hottest teams in America and winners of eight of its last nine games, Pitt entered the NCAA Tournament after defeating three consecutive nationally ranked teams in No. 12 Louisville (OT), No. 25 Marquette and No. 9 Georgetown in the Big East Championship Final.

NCAA TOURNAMENT FIRST ROUND NOTES (ORAL ROBERTS)

- Pitt is riding a six-game win streak and has now won eight of its last nine games on the year.
- Pitt improved to 6-0 on the year in neutral site games on the year. It is 5-0 in games played at Madison Square Garden.
- Pitt made its 20th appearance in the NCAA Tournament. It improved to 18-20 overall in those appearances and improved to 13-7 in NCAA Tournament First Round games.
- Pitt is one of only nine programs to advance to the NCAA Tournament in each of the last seven seasons. The nine schools include: Arizona, Duke, Gonzaga, Kansas, Kentucky, Michigan State, Pitt, Texas and Wisconsin. Pitt has earned the most consecutive NCAA Tournament appearances in the Big East Conference with seven. Villanova is second with four and Marquette and Georgetown both have advanced to three straight.

- Pitt seniors Keith Benjamin and Ronald Ramon become the seventh and eighth players in school history to appear in four straight NCAA Tournaments.
- Pitt advanced to the NCAA Tournament Second Round for the third straight season and sixth time in the last seven years.
- With his season high 23 points, Levance Fields reached double figure scoring for the eighth game in a row. It also marked his fifth career 20-plus scoring game and 45th career double figure scoring game.
- With his 14 points, Sam Young has now reached double figure scoring in 35 of Pitt's 36 games this year and in 43 of his last 47 games played. Young has now led Pitt in scoring in 25 of 36 games.
- Keith Benjamin finished with 12 points and a career-high nine rebounds. It marked his 17th double figure scoring game of the year, his 24th of his career and 11th career 5-plus rebound game.
- With his 10 rebounds, DeJuan Blair registered his 17th double figure rebounding game of his career. Blair set Pitt's freshman season record for rebounds and now has 330 this year. He surpassed Sam Clancy (327 rebounds from 1977-78). He also set Pitt's freshman season record for most field goals and now has 164 for the year.
- With his 10 points, Ronald Ramon registered his 53rd career double figure scoring game and 16th time this year. He has hit at

least two 3-point field goals in each of his last six consecutive games.

- Gilbert Brown scored 12 points off the bench. It was his 11th double figure scoring game of his career. He tied a career-high with six field goals made.
- Jamie Dixon improves to 132-39 overall in his fifth season as Pitt's head basketball coach. The 132 victories tie for the third-most victories for an NCAA Division I coach after five seasons as a head coach.
- Dixon improved to 6-4 during his career in NCAA Tournament games.
- Pitt's 27 victories fifth among the all-time winningest seasons at Pitt. The school record is 31 set in 2003-04, Jamie Dixon's first year at Pitt. Dixon has guided five of Pitt's 15 winningest seasons. The only other seasons with more victories are: 31-5 in 2003-04, 29-6 in 2006-07, 29-8 in 2006-07 and 28-5 in 2002-03.
- Pitt's senior class of Keith Benjamin, Mike Cook, Ronald Ramon and Maurice Polen improved to 101-34 in their 135 games at Pitt.
- Pitt and Oral Roberts met for the first time in school history. Pitt is 1-0 vs. Oral Roberts.
- Pitt held Oral Roberts to 63 points on the evening. On the year, Pitt has now limited 26 of its 36 opponents to 70 points or less. Pitt has held each of its last five opponents to 70 points or less.

seventh consecutive NCAA Tournament berth. Previously, Pitt had made three straight NCAA Tournament appearances from 1987-89. Pitt is one of only nine schools nationally to advance to the NCAA Tournament in each of the last seven seasons. The other schools include Arizona, Duke, Gonzaga, Kansas, Kentucky, Michigan State, Pitt, Texas and Wisconsin. For the fourth time in school history, Pitt earns an automatic bid into the NCAA Tournament (1981, 1982, 2003 and 2008). Pitt has also advanced to NCAA Sweet Sixteen play in four of the last six seasons. Only one school (Duke-5) and three others (Texas-4, Connecticut-4 and Kansas-4) have surpassed or matched that accomplishment.

Pitt Head Coach Jamie Dixon (132-39) became the first head coach in school history to guide Pitt to five consecutive NCAA Tournaments. Additionally, Dixon has guided Pitt to NCAA Tournament appearances in each of his five seasons at Pitt.

Pitt is competing in its 20th all-time NCAA Tournament berth after winning its second-ever Big East
