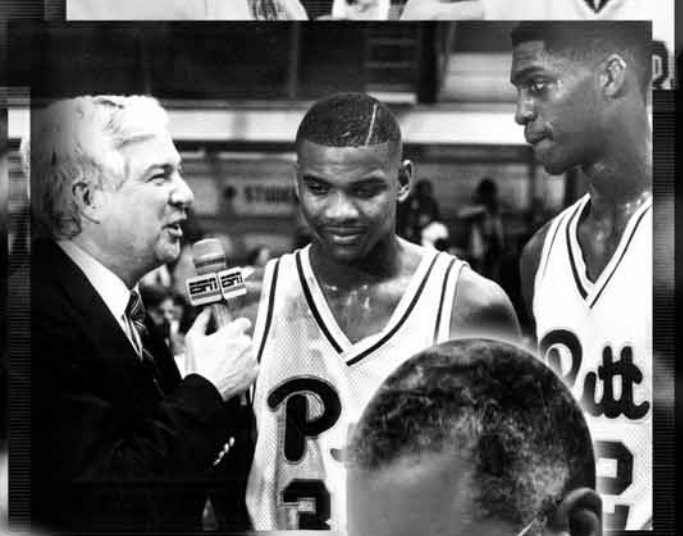

■ CREDENTIALS

Credentials for Pitt home games are issued to working media only and should be requested as early as possible due to space limitations, parking limitations and demand. All credential requests should be made online at www.sportssystem.com/pitthoops.

Media members are required to make credential arrangements at least 24 hours in advance of the game in question.

Credentials are limited to members of the working media only. A media pass allows accredited media access to the Media Interview Room, Beano Cook Media Workroom, Press Row and floor access for photographers/camera crews. Only Web sites of each participating institution with contractual rights and accredited news Web sites will be issued credentials.

Each visiting opponent SID submits a list of attending media members. To get on that list, please inform the respective sports information contact.

■ MEDIA WILL CALL/ENTRANCE

All media members must pick up credentials and enter the arena at Media Will Call. Pitt's Media Will Call/Media Entrance will open two hours prior to tipoff. It is located at the Miller Administrative Entrance off Terrace Street (across from the University of Pittsburgh School of Medicine) and to the left of the Petersen Events Center's main ticket office. Due to time constraints, credentials will not be mailed. Visiting radio and TV broadcasters/producers may pick up their credentials at shootaround or through their respective sports information contacts.

Once you have received your pass at Media Will Call, follow the signs and proceed down the hallway to the elevator. Take the elevator up to the Event Level (EL) where you can access the Beano Cook Media

Workroom, Media Interview Room, Press Row and basketball court. The Media Interview Room is on your left, the Media Workroom is on your right and the court/media seating may be accessed at the first hallway to your left. A media relations representative will be stationed at Media Will Call to assist you.

■ PARKING

Parking passes may only be obtained/approved through the Athletic Media Relations Office. Parking is limited as all requests must be made at least 24 hours in advance of the game in question.

Media parking will be at the same location as in 2007-08: O'Hara Garage. Media members must access O'Hara Garage off of University Drive (for directions, please refer to the map on page 204). Media members must call the Athletic Media Relations Office to confirm a parking space as a list will be at the O'Hara Garage gate.

Due to class, practice, game and study schedules, time is at a premium. Every effort will be made to fulfill requests.

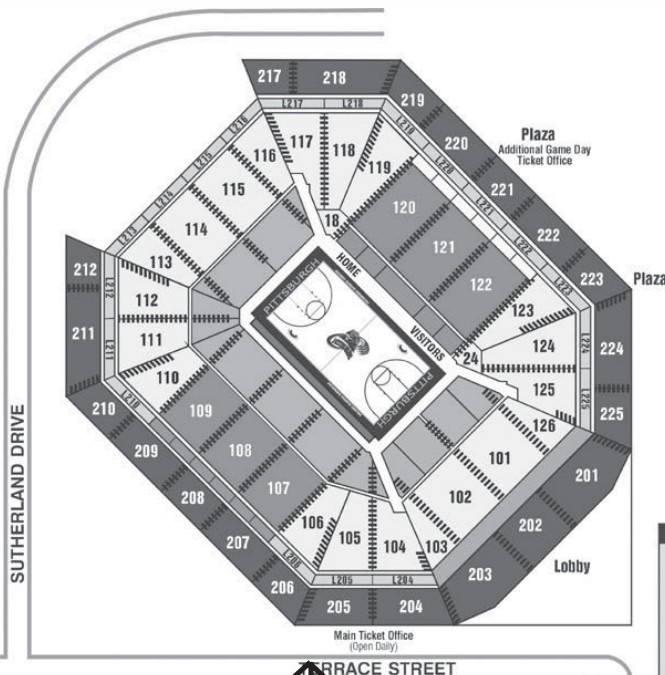

■ MEDIA SEATING ON PRESS ROW

Seating on press row is limited and will be assigned on a priority basis. The priority basis is as follows: 1. Representatives of Pittsburgh district papers and metropolitan papers filing for deadline, other newspapers covering the respective teams. 2. Radio and television commentators, 3. National publications, and 4. Scouts. All media members must confirm their attendance to guarantee working space.

■ PHOTOGRAPHERS

Still photographers and TV news cameramen will receive a regular media pass and be assigned a position on the floor at the baseline. Photographers must remain in the

space designated. Be prepared to show identification if asked to identify yourself. Strobe lights are prohibited.

■ VISITING RADIO BROADCAST

The visiting radio broadcast crew will be issued space next to the visitor's bench at the scorers table. As per Big East rules, one ISDN line and one analog phone line will be available for broadcast.

A facility representative will be available prior to the game to answer any questions and/or assist with technological needs.

It is recommended that each visiting radio crew attend shootaround to setup equipment.

There is a \$100 fee for visiting non-conference radio crews.

■ LIVE TV TRUCKS

Local television trucks have been assigned parking on Sutherland Drive (see map on page 202, street leading into the loading dock). Please notify the Athletic Media Relations Office if there is an access problem.

■ SCOUTS

Scouts are required to make credential arrangements through the Athletic Media Relations Office via e-mail and will be given both a ticket and media credential. Scouts may pick up their credential and ticket at Media Will Call. There is no parking available for scouts.

■ WIRELESS ACCESS

Wireless internet service is available in the Petersen Events Center's Beano Cook Media Workroom. For a username and password, please access the dry erase board in the Media Workroom.

■ TELEPHONES

A total of 10 courtesy phone lines will be available for media use following the game either in the Beano Cook Media Workroom or on Press Row. Dial "9" to get outside the system.

■ POSTGAME PROCEDURE

Following a 10-minute "cooling off" period, requested/selected student-athletes will be available for interviews in the Media Interview Room. Pitt Head Coach Jamie Dixon will be available for questions following his 15-minute postgame radio show. The visiting coach and players will also be available in the interview room.

Pitt's regular post-game procedure in the Interview Room is as follows: 1. Requested/selected Pitt student-athletes, 2. Opponent coach and/or student-athletes, 3. Pitt Head Coach Jamie Dixon.

Opposing teams may make their student-athletes available in the lockerroom or in the hallway. Please read the board in the Beano Cook Media Workroom for information on post-game procedure.

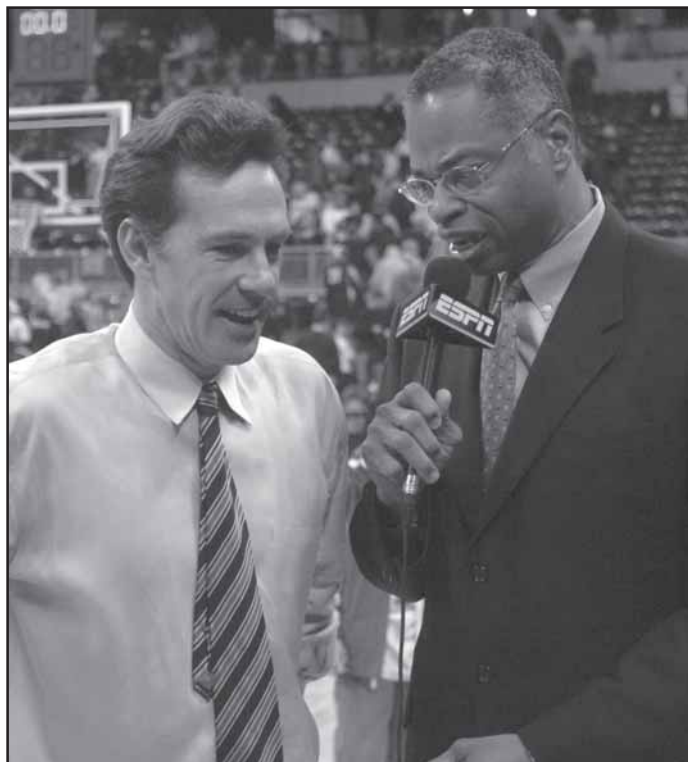

DIRECTIONS TO THE PETERSEN EVENTS CENTER

FROM PITTSBURGH INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT

- Take I-279 toward Pittsburgh. Pass through the Fort Pitt Tunnel in the right lane. Bear right at the first ramp over the bridge, following signs for I-376.
- Exit I-376 at the Oakland/Forbes Avenue exit.
- Turn left at the third traffic light (McKee Place).
- Continue through light.
- Take right at second light (Terrace Street).
- The Petersen Events Center is on your left.

FROM PENNSYLVANIA TURNPIKE (EAST)

- Take the Pittsburgh/Monroeville Exit (Exit 57). Follow I-376 toward Pittsburgh.
- Take the Oakland Exit (Exit 3B). Bear right and proceed up the hill to the first traffic light.
- Take a left at Boulevard of the

- Allies, then a right at Halket.
- Proceed to Forbes Ave. and take a right.
- Make the left after the light (McKee Place).
- Continue through light.
- Take right at second light (Terrace Street).
- The Petersen Events Center is on your left.

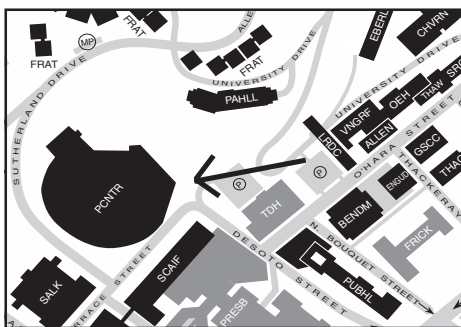
FROM THE NORTH

- Take I-79 South to I-279 South to I-579 (across the Veterans Bridge).
- Exit at the Boulevard of the Allies (Exit 14) toward Monroeville/Oakland.
- Turn left at Halket Street.
- Turn right on Forbes Avenue.
- Make the left at McKee Place.
- Continue through light.
- Take right at second light (Terrace Street)
- The Petersen Events Center is on your left.

DIRECTIONS TO MEDIA PARKING LOCATION: O'HARA GARAGE

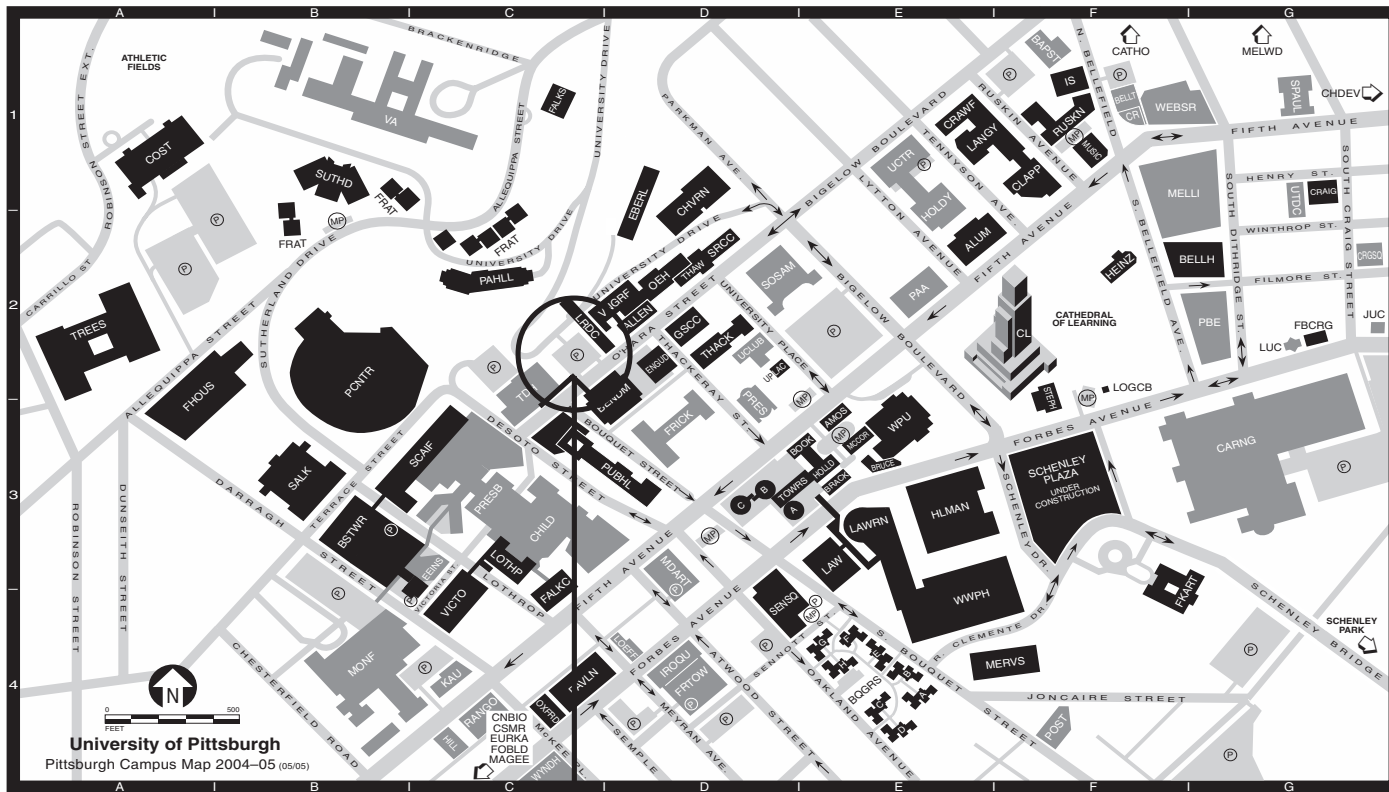
- Proceed on Forbes Avenue toward the Cathedral of Learning.
- Make a left onto Bigelow Blvd. (street runs between the Cathedral and Student Union).
- Proceed on Bigelow through two lights at both Fifth Avenue and O'Hara Street.
- After O'Hara Street, take an immediate left onto University Drive.
- Proceed up the hill. O'Hara

- Parking Lot is on your left.
- Each media member's name will be on a list at the gate. You may be asked to provide photo identification.
- After your car is parked, take the elevator up to the top level (R-B level).
- Walk back up University Drive, find walkway/stairway to Petersen Events Center.
- Enter at Media Will Call.

PITT ISP SPORTS RADIO NETWORK

Pitt's "Hall of Fame" broadcast team

The University of Pittsburgh and its multi-media rights holder ISP Sports provide the Panthers with thoroughly comprehensive radio coverage. Pitt men's basketball is broadcast on the Pitt ISP Sports Network, presented by First Commonwealth. Game broadcasts air over a loyal network of stations, including flagships 94.5 3WS (WWSW-FM) and Fox Sports Radio 970 (WBGG-AM).

- Broadcasts include:
- A 30-minute pre-game show and 30-minute post-game coverage.
 - "Panthers Hotline," an hour-long call-

JAMIE DIXON RADIO SHOW

The Jamie Dixon Radio Show, presented by The Hartford, will broadcast live on Fox Sports Radio 970 (WBGG-AM) and other affiliates of the Pitt ISP Sports Radio Network. The show will air once per week in the evening starting in January, 2008. Dates and times will be released at a later date.

There are 10 total regular season shows with possible additional shows to be announced at a later date. The last two shows are scheduled for Mondays, the week of the Big East Tournament and the NCAA Tournament first and second rounds.

Hosted by the "Voice of the Panthers," Bill Hillgrove and Dixon, The Jamie Dixon Show originates from Lot 17 in Bloomfield (4617 Liberty Avenue, Pittsburgh, PA 15224).

- A weekly Jamie Dixon radio show on Fox Sports Radio 970, airing live from Lot 17 in Bloomfield from 6 to 7 p.m. on Thursdays.

In his 39th consecutive year, **BILL HILLGROVE** is the "Voice of the Panthers." Hillgrove's informative and enthusiastic play-by-play descriptions have been a Panthers trademark since 1969. A 1962 graduate of Duquesne University, Hillgrove has also served as the play-by-play broadcaster for Panthers football for the past 34 years.

His longevity as a sportscaster has made him one of Pittsburgh's most recognizable and favorite media personalities. Hillgrove was named the Pittsburgh Steelers' play-by-play announcer in 1994. Hillgrove was awarded the National Football Foundation's 2007 Chris Schenkel Award, which honors a sports

broadcaster who has enjoyed a long and distinguished career.

Joining Hillgrove courtside for his 29th straight year is color analyst **DICK GROAT**. A Pittsburgh native, Groat is one of the city's most enduring sports legends, making his mark in two different sports. A 2007 College Basketball Hall of Fame inductee, he was a four-time All-America basketball and baseball player at Duke, where he is one of only 11 Blue Devils to have his number retired. Groat was named the 1952 College Basketball Player of the Year after becoming the first and only player in NCAA history to lead the nation in both scoring and assists in the same season. Groat played one year for the

Fort Wayne Pistons before concentrating solely on professional baseball.

As a member of the Pittsburgh Pirates, Groat captured the National League batting championship as well as Most Valuable Player honors in 1960. That same year, the Pirates won the World Series over the Yankees in a dramatic seven games. He later went on to play for the St. Louis Cardinals, where he was a key figure on the 1964 World Series championship team.
