Game Story

Pitt, ranked No. 25 by Associated Press, opens the 2008 season at Heinz Field against Bowling Green of the Mid-American Conference. The '08 campaign marks the 119th football season in school history.

Pitt has won 10 of its last 11 season openers and is 25-5 in opening contests over the last 30 years.

Pitt has played Bowling Green just twice before and is 2-0 in those contests, winning 34-16 on the road in 2000 and 30-10 at Pitt Stadium in 1999.

Pitt is 25-2 all-time versus the Mid-American Conference with both losses occurring on the road. The Panthers are 8-0 against the MAC in season-opening contests.

Notes & Anecdotes

Offensive Notes

1,000-Yard Club: LeSean McCoy joined a small but elite fraternity in reaching the 1,000-yard rushing mark last year. The unanimous Freshman All-American rushed for 1,328 yards and in the process became:

- Pitt's first 1,000-yard rusher since the 2000 season (Kevan Barlow, 1,167).
- The first Pitt freshman to rush for 1,000 yards since 1988 (Curvin Richards, 1,228) and only the third all-time. Tony Dorsett had 1,686 yards during his All-America freshman season in 1973.
- McCoy additionally became just the third true frosh in Big East history to rush for 1,000 yards. His 1,328 yards set a Big East freshman rushing record.

Big East Frosh Rushing: LeSean McCoy is just the third true freshman in Big East history to rush for 1,000 yards, joining West Virginia's Steve Slaton, who had 1,128, and Rutgers' Ray Rice, who had 1,120, both in 2005. (Three redshirt freshmen have accomplished the feat.) McCoy set a Big East freshman record with 1,328 yards, surpassing Terrell Willis' (Rutgers) mark of 1,261 set in 1993.

A Look at Pitt's Top Frosh Backs: LeSean McCoy rushed for the second highest yardage by a Pitt freshman in school history. McCoy was second only to the legendary Tony Dorsett in yardage but surpassed the Hall of Famer in freshman rushing TDs.

LeSean's Impressive Point Production: LeSean McCoy totaled 90 points last season (15 TDs), the most ever by a Pitt freshman and the third highest single-season point total by a Pitt player in the last 30 years. Only receivers Larry Fitzgerald (132 as a sophomore in 2003) and Julius Dawkins (96 as a junior in 1981) scored more points in a season during that stretch. Tony Dorsett holds the single-season scoring record at Pitt, totalling 140 points as a senior during the Panthers' 1976 national championship season.

Rookie Rushing TD Record: LeSean McCoy's 14 rushing touchdowns are the most ever by a Pitt freshman. With his three rushing TDs against USF Nov. 24, 2007, McCoy surpassed the legendary Tony Dorsett, who scored 13 rushing TDs during his All-America freshman year in 1973. Dave Wannstedt was a senior offensive tackle in '73, when the Panthers went 6-4-1 and earned a Fiesta Bowl berth under Coach John Majors.

Century Games: LeSean McCoy had seven 100-yard rushing performances last season, the second most by a Pitt freshman. Tony Dorsett holds the Pitt freshman record for 100-yard performances. Dorsett had nine 100-yard games during the regular season and 10 total, including his Fiesta Bowl performance vs. Arizona State that year.

No Goose Eggs: Pitt has scored in 137 consecutive games, the longest active streak among Big East members. The last time Pitt was shut out was a 45-0 loss at Miami on Sept. 28, 1996.

Defensive Notes

The Nation's Leader: All-America linebacker Scott McKillop led the entire country in tackles per game last year, averaging 12.58. He was also second in solo tackles per game with an 8.17 average. Pitt has now had three players in the prior five years finish the season as the leader in a national statistical category. In 2003, receiver Larry Fitzgerald paced the country in receiving yards per game (128.62) and TD catches (22). In 2006, linebacker Clint Session led the nation in forced fumbles (tied with 0.42 per game).

Great Scott: Scott McKillop was named to four postseason All-America squads and selected first team All-Big East last year. McKillop additionally was CollegeFootballNews.com's Big East Defensive Player of the Year. He enters 2008 as a strong candidate for the nation's top defensive honors, including the Butkus Award, which goes to college football's top linebacker, and such prestigious defensive player of the year awards as the Bednarik Award and Bronko Nagurski Trophy.

Stellar Defensive Rankings: In 2007, Pitt boasted one of its most productive defenses in recent years. The Panthers ranked fifth nationally and first in the Big East in total defense, yielding just 297.67 yards per game. Pitt also earned lofty national rankings in pass defense (third, 167.25 yards/game), sacks (20th, 2.92 sacks/game), pass efficiency defense (26th, 113.96 rating) and rush defense (33rd, 130.42 yards/game).

Sack Attack: Pitt ranked 20th nationally in sacks, averaging 2.92 per game (35 total). The Panthers far surpassed their sack total from all of 2006, when they compiled only 21. The Panthers' 35 sacks were their most since the 2001 season when they totaled 38.

Air Defense: Pitt consistently ranked among the nation's top pass defenses last season. The Panthers yielded only 167.25 passing yards per game to rank third nationally and first in the Big East. Only three teams passed for more than 200 yards against Pitt last year.

Special Teams Notes

75 and Counting: Placekicker Conor Lee has converted a school-record 75 consecutive extra points. Lee was 47 of 47 in 2006 and 28 of 28 last year. He eclipsed a 32-year-old school record for consecutive PATs during his 6-of-6 performance against Navy last Oct. 10. The prior mark was held by Carson Long, who made 60 in a row over the 1974 and 1975 seasons.

Lee Point Production: Conor Lee has 165 career points to rank 12th among the Panthers' all-time leading scorers.

Mr. (Nearly) Automatic: Conor Lee is about as close to perfection as a placekicker can get. Since taking over Pitt's starting kicking duties in 2006, Lee has missed only six placements (all field goals). He is perfect on 75 extra-point attempts and 30 of 36 (.833) in field goals. His 83.3% field goal success rate ranks him fifth among active career leaders in Division I-A (Football Bowl Subdivision).

Pittsburgh

Years/Position: 1975-76, graduate assistant; 1977-78, receivers and special teams.

Highlights: Pitt advances to bowl games each season of his four-year tenure, winning three... finishes in the nation's Top 15 three times and the Top 10 twice...Pitt wins the 1976 national championship with a 12-0 record...Panthers' compile 37-10-1 four-year mark (.781).

Oklahoma State

Years/Position: 1979-81, defensive line; 1982, defensive coordinator.

Highlights: Helped OSU earn its first bowl invite in five years (1981 Independence Bowl).

Southern California

Years/Position: 1983-85, defensive line.

Highlights: USC earned two bowl berths...Trojans finish in the Top 10 in 1984 following a 9-3 record and Rose Bowl victory over Ohio State (20-17).

Miami (Fla.)

Years/Position: 1986-88, defensive coordinator.

Highlights: Miami compiles a three-year record of 34-2 (.944)...advances to three New Year's Day bowl games (1987 Fiesta, 1988 and 1989 Orange)... wins the 1987 national title with a 12-0 mark...UM's defense holds opponents to three-year averages of 2.2 yards/rush and 10.9 points/game.

Pittsburgh

Years/Position: 2005-present, head coach.

Highlights: Named head coach on Dec. 23, 2004...becomes the 34th coach in program's history and ninth Pitt graduate to lead the Panthers...signs three consecutive recruiting classes (2006-08) rated the best in the Big East and among the top 25 nationally...the 2006 and 2007 classes were rated No. 10 and No. 8, respectively, in Scout.com's national rankings...produces consecutive first-round NFL Draft choices in cornerback Darrelle Revis (New York Jets) and Jeff Otah (Carolina Panthers)...linebacker H.B.
