## Game Story

Pitt meets the Iowa Hawkeyes for the first time in 56 years. The Panthers last played Iowa during the 1952 season. This is only the fourth all-time meeting between the two schools.

The game marks a homecoming for Iowa coach Kirk Ferentz, a graduate of nearby Upper St. Clair High School and former graduate assistant on Jackie Sherrill's 1980 Pitt coaching staff.

Pitt seeks a 2-1 start for the third consecutive year and eighth time in the past 10 years.

The Panthers seek their first win over a Big Ten foe since defeating Penn State, 12-0, in 2000. In its most recent Big Ten encounter, Pitt lost to host Michigan State, 17-13, last year.

## Series Notes

Pitt and Iowa will meet for the first time in 56 years and only the fourth time ever...the Panthers hold a 2-1 edge in the brief series and claimed the last meeting, 26-14, during the 1952 season in Pitt Stadium...the other two encounters were both played in Iowa...the Hawkeyes defeated Pitt, 34-17, during the 1951 season...in the inaugural meeting, the Panthers defeated Iowa, 20-0, in 1931.

## Pitt vs. the Big Ten

The Panthers have played only three Big Ten teams since the 1996 season — Ohio State, Penn State (four times between 1997-2000) and Michigan State (twice).

Pitt's last Big Ten encounter was against Michigan State on the road in 2007, a 17-13 loss. (Pitt also lost to the Spartans in 2006 at Heinz Field, 38-23.)

Prior to Michigan State in 2006-07, Pitt faced Penn State in 2000 and blanked the Nittany Lions, 12-0, in Three Rivers Stadium.

Overall, Pitt owns a 65-107-6 record against current members of the Big Ten.

**Eying the All-Time Tackle List:** Senior middle linebacker Scott McKillop, last year's NCAA statistical champion in total tackles (12.6 per game), is ready to make a dent on Pitt's career tackles list.

Only in his second year as a starter, McKillop has 228 career stops (including 151 during his all-star junior season). If he maintains his season average of 10.5 per game, he will crack the top 12.

**A Tackling Machine:** Since becoming Pitt's starting middle linebacker at the beginning of the 2007 season, Scott McKillop has gone on to establish a national reputation as a "tackling machine." **Big East Frosh Rushing:** LeSean McCoy last year was just the third true freshman in Big East history to rush for 1,000 yards, joining West Virginia's Steve Slaton, who had 1,128, and Rutgers' Ray Rice, who had 1,120, both in 2005. (Three redshirt freshmen have accomplished the feat.) McCoy set a Big East freshman record with 1,328 yards, surpassing Terrell Willis' (Rutgers) mark of 1,261 set in 1993.

**A Look at Pitt's Top Frosh Backs:** LeSean McCoy rushed for the second highest yardage by a Pitt freshman in school history. McCoy was second only to the legendary Tony Dorsett in yardage but surpassed the Hall of Famer in freshman rushing TDs.

**Rookie Rushing TD Record:** LeSean McCoy's 14 rushing touchdowns last year are the most ever by a Pitt freshman. With his three rushing TDs against USF on Nov. 24, 2007, McCoy surpassed the legendary Tony Dorsett, who scored 13 rushing TDs during his All-America freshman year in 1973. Dave Wannstedt was a senior offensive tackle in '73, when the Panthers went 6-4-1 and earned a Fiesta Bowl berth under Coach John Majors.

McCoy has continued to pile up TDs into his sophomore year. He has four rushing TDs through two games to rank fifth nationally (tied) in scoring (12.0 points/game).

**80 and Counting:** Senior placekicker Conor Lee remains perfect on extra points for his career, converting a school-record 80 consecutive PATs. Lee is 5 for 5 through two games in 2008. He was 28 of 28 last year and 47 of 47 in 2006. Lee eclipsed a 32-year-old school record for consecutive PATs during his 6-of-6 performance against Navy on Oct. 10, 2007. The prior mark was held by Carson Long, who made 60 in a row over the 1974 and 1975 seasons.

**Lee Point Production:** Conor Lee has 179 career points to rank 11th among the Panthers' all-time leading scorers. He is one point away from reaching the top 10.

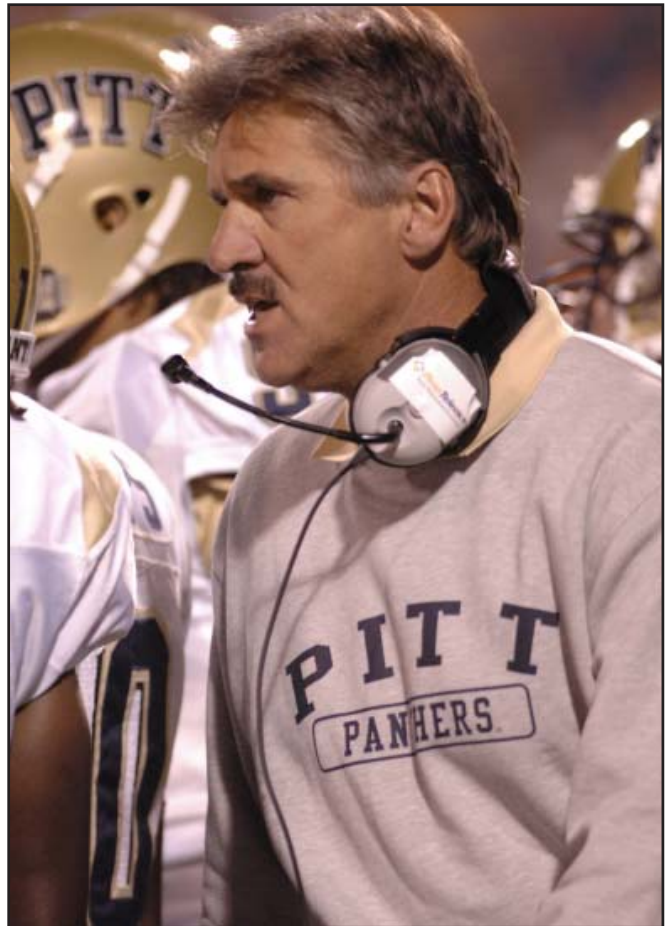
