Game Story

Pitt seeks its first victory of the 2008 season when it hosts Buffalo at Heinz Field. The Panthers dropped their opener, 27-17, against Bowling Green.

This is the first-ever meeting between Pitt and Buffalo, a member of the Mid-American Conference.

Pitt is 25-3 all-time versus the Mid-American Conference. The Panthers are 24-1 against MAC schools in Pittsburgh.

The Panthers have opened a season 0-2 only three times in the last 36 years, the most recent occurrence coming in 2005. Pitt also opened 0-2 in 1984 and 1972 during that stretch.

PITT Notes & Anecdotes

Empire State Natives: Pitt has six New York state natives on its 2008 roster, including junior defensive back Irvan Brown (Brewerton), sophomore running back Kevin Collier (Rochester), freshman defensive lineman Keith Coleman (New York City), junior defensive end Doug Fulmer (Syracuse), senior wide receiver Derek Kinder (Albion) and senior linebacker Austin Ransom (Williamsville).

Three Pitt coaches also are New York state natives: tight ends coach Brian Angelichio (Ilion), running backs coach David Walker (Rochester) and offensive line coach Tony Wise (Newtonville).

MAC Encounters: Pitt is 25-3 all-time vs. Mid-American Conference foes. That includes a 24-1 mark in Pittsburgh. Last week's 27-17 loss to Bowling Green marked the Panthers' first home loss to a MAC team.

(Note: Temple, a recent addition to the MAC, is not included in this breakdown. Pitt and Temple were longtime eastern foes and the Panthers hold a 26-8-1 mark against the Owls. The teams last played in 2004 when Temple was in its last year as a Big East member.)

Starting Debuts: In the opener vs. Bowling Green, Pitt had six players make the first starts of their collegiate careers: center Robb Houser on offense and cornerback Jovani Chappel, strong safety Dom DeCicco, linebacker Austin Ransom, end Greg Romeus and end Jabaal Sheard on defense.

John Malecki, who previously had one career start at nose tackle, made his offensive debut against Bowling Green as Pitt's starting right offensive guard.

Big East Frosh Rushing: LeSean McCoy last year was just the third true freshman in Big East history to rush for 1,000 yards, joining West Virginia's Steve Slaton, who had 1,128, and Rutgers' Ray Rice, who had 1,120, both in 2005. (Three redshirt freshmen have accomplished the feat.) McCoy set a Big East freshman record with 1,328 yards, surpassing Terrell Willis' (Rutgers) mark of 1,261 set in 1993.

A Look at Pitt's Top Frosh Backs: LeSean McCoy rushed for the second highest yardage by a Pitt freshman in school history. McCoy was second only to the legendary Tony Dorsett in yardage but surpassed the Hall of Famer in freshman rushing TDs.

Rookie Rushing TD Record: LeSean McCoy's 14 rushing touchdowns are the most ever by a Pitt freshman. With his three rushing TDs against USF Nov. 24, 2007, McCoy surpassed the legendary Tony Dorsett, who scored 13 rushing TDs during his All-America freshman year in 1973. Dave Wannstedt was a senior offensive tackle in '73, when the Panthers went 6-4-1 and earned a Fiesta Bowl berth under Coach John Majors.

77 and Counting: Senior placekicker Conor Lee remains perfect on extra points for his career, converting a school-record 77 consecutive PATs. Lee was 2 of 2 vs. Bowling Green last week.

Lee was 47 of 47 in 2006 and 28 of 28 last year. He eclipsed a 32-year-old school record for consecutive PATs during his 6-of-6 performance against Navy last Oct. 10. The prior mark was held by Carson Long, who made 60 in a row over the 1974 and 1975 seasons.

Lee Point Production: Conor Lee has 170 career points to rank 12th among the Panthers' all-time leading scorers.

Mr. (Nearly) Automatic: Lou Groza Award candidate Conor Lee is about as close to perfection as a placekicker can get. Since taking over Pitt's starting kicking duties in 2006, Lee has missed only seven placements (all field goals). He is perfect on 77 extra-point attempts and 31 of 38 (.816) in field goals.
