TV: The Pitt-Utah game will be a national telecast on Versus. Joe Beninati (play-by-play), Kelly Stouffer (color) and Lindsay Soto (sideline) form the broadcast crew.

PITT RADIO: The new radio home for Pitt football is 50,000-watt flagship KDKA-FM, Sportsradio 93.7 The Fan. Games are also carried on the Pitt Sports Radio Network. Rob King (play-by-play) and three-time Pitt All-American Bill Fralic (color) will call the action from Salt Lake City.

SATELLITE RADIO: The Pitt-Utah game will be aired on Sirius channel 152 and XM channel 203.

Game Story

Pitt plays at Utah in one of the biggest opening games of the 2010 college football season. The game is a matchup of Top 25 teams, with the Panthers ranked No. 15 in both polls, while the Utes boast a No. 24 ranking (tied) in the *USA Today* coaches poll.

This will be Pitt's first season opener on the road featuring two Top 25 teams since its national title year in 1976, when the No. 9 Panthers won at No. 11 Notre Dame, 31-10.

Pitt hasn't opened a season on the road since 1993, when it defeated host Southern Mississippi, 14-10. The Panthers last opened a season in the state of Utah in 1987, when they defeated BYU, 27-17.

Pitt is 20-7 over its last 27 games, the Panthers' winningest stretch since the 2001-03 seasons when they went 21-6.

PITT Notes & Anecdotes

Series Notes

This is just the second meeting ever between Pitt and Utah, and the first regular-season game between the two schools... the only prior meeting occurred during the postseason when the Utes capped a 12-0 campaign with a 35-7 victory over the Big East champion Panthers in the Jan. 1, 2005 Fiesta Bowl... it was the final game for the head coaches at each respective school (Walt Harris at Pitt and Urban Meyer at Utah)...the Utes finished ranked as high as No. 4 in the final polls following their bowl victory, while Pitt finished 25th in the AP poll.... following the 2010 game, Utah is slated to make a return trip to Pittsburgh for an Oct. 15, 2011 contest...the Panthers have played in the state of Utah once before, and that game also was a season opener...Pitt opened the '87 season at BYU and won, 27-17, over the host Cougars on Sept. 2, 1987.

Panther Notes

Pitt Preseason Rankings: The Panthers enter their season opener at Utah ranked No. 15 in the *USA Today* coaches poll and No. 15 by The Associated Press. It marks Pitt's highest preseason rankings since 2003, when the Panthers were ranked No. 10 by AP and 11th by the coaches.

Top 25 Road Opener: The Pitt-Utah opener features a clash of Top 25 teams. In addition to the Panthers' rankings, the Utes are rated No. 24 (tied) in the *USA Today* coaches poll. It is the first time Pitt will play a season opener on the road featuring two Top 25 teams since its 1976 national championship year, when the preseason No. 9 Panthers played at No. 11 Notre Dame. Pitt rolled past the host Irish, 31-10, en route to a 12-0 record and the unanimous national title.

Rare Road Opener: Pitt's game at Utah marks its first season-opening contest on the road since 1993, when the Panthers defeated host Southern Mississippi, 14-10. That game, incidentally, marked the return of head coach John Majors, who began his second Pitt tenure (1993-96) with the victory at USM. Majors' original Pitt tour was from 1973-76, after which he coached at Tennessee from 1977-92.

Pitt has played its season opener on the road just 34 times in its 120-year history and is 22-11-1 (.662) in those games. Since 1970, the Panthers have opened on the road only 10 times, but are 9-0-1 in those games. (The tie, incidentally, was a 7-7 affair at Georgia in 1973, Dave Wannstedt's senior year and the debut game for freshman tailback Tony Dorsett.)

In 2004, the Panthers were scheduled to open on the road at USF on Sept. 6. However, the game was postponed due to Hurricane Frances and the season opener became a home contest against Ohio at Heinz Field, a 24-3 victory.

Pitt won the rescheduled game with USF, 43-14, in Tampa on Dec. 4, which clinched a berth in the Fiesta Bowl.

Openers Overall: Pitt has historically fared well in season-opening contests. The Panthers are 78-40-2 (.658) all-time in openers. Since 1970, Pitt is 30-9-1 (.763) in its initial game. Pitt is 8-2 in season openers over the past decade, including a 3-2 mark under Dave Wannstedt.

Chalking up W's: Pitt is 20-7 over its last 27 games, dating back to the 2007 regular-season finale at West Virginia when it upset the heavily favored Mountaineers, 13-9.

It marks the Panthers' winningest stretch since the 2001-03 seasons when they went 21-6 over a 27-game period.

Heartbreak Hotel: Pitt's 10-3 record in 2009 marked its winningest campaign since 1981. The Panthers, however, were an eyelash away from perhaps an undefeated regular season. Their three losses came by a combined 11 points, an average of just 3.6 points per game.

Pitt's defeats included a 45-44 setback to Cincinnati in a game that decided the Big East title, a 19-16 decision at West Virginia that came down to a field goal as time expired, and a 38-31 loss at NC State.

On the Road: Dating back to 2007, Pitt is 9-3 in its last 12 road contests, the Panthers' best away stretch since winning 13 in a row on the road over the 1980-82 seasons. Pitt's three road losses during that stretch are by a combined 17 points, an average of just 5.6 points per game.

Bringin' Heat: Bolstered by an outstanding defensive front, Pitt led the country in quarterback sacks in 2009, averaging 3.62 sacks per game.

The Panthers totaled 47 sacks in 13 games. Incredibly, that impressive total was compiled without an abundance of blitzing. The defensive line accounted for 37 of Pitt's sacks (79%). Greg Romeus, the reigning Big East Defensive Player of the Year, led Pitt with eight sacks.

Pitt's 2009 sack total was its highest since 1987, when the Panthers recorded an astounding 54 sacks in 12 games.

To Serve and Protect: As potent as Pitt's pass rush was in 2009, the Panthers were equally air tight on their own pass protection. Pitt gave up just 15 sacks (1.15 sacks/game) to rank first in the Big East (tied) and 16th nationally (tied).

Lauding Lewis: Dion Lewis enjoyed one of the greatest seasons by a running back in Pitt history last year. Lewis finished with 1,799 yards and 17 touchdowns on 325 carries (5.5 avg.), the second highest yardage in Pitt annals. Only the legendary Tony Dorsett, who eclipsed 2,000 yards during his 1976 Heisman Trophy campaign, rushed for more yards in a single season at Pitt.

PITT'S PATHWAY TO CANTON

Pitt's sparkling legacy in the NFL added two more crown jewels this year with the induction of offensive lineman Russ Grimm and defensive end Rickey Jackson into the Pro Football Hall of Fame. Their election brings Pitt's total to six inductees in Canton, joining linebacker Joe Schmidt (inducted in 1973), tight end Mike Ditka (1988), running back Tony Dorsett (1994) and quarterback Dan Marino (2005). Both Grimm and Jackson starred at Pitt from 1977-80.

A member of Washington's famed "Hogs" offensive line, Grimm (top photo) went on to start 11 seasons at guard for the Redskins (1981-91) and helped lead the team to four Super Bowl appearances and three victories. Jackson spent 15 seasons in the NFL, including 13 with New Orleans (1981-93) and two with San Francisco (1994-95), helping the 49ers to a victory in Super Bowl XXIX. He compiled an incredible 128 sacks, which ranked third all-time when he retired following the '95 campaign.

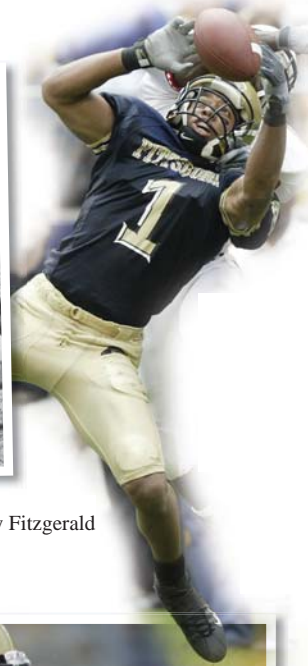

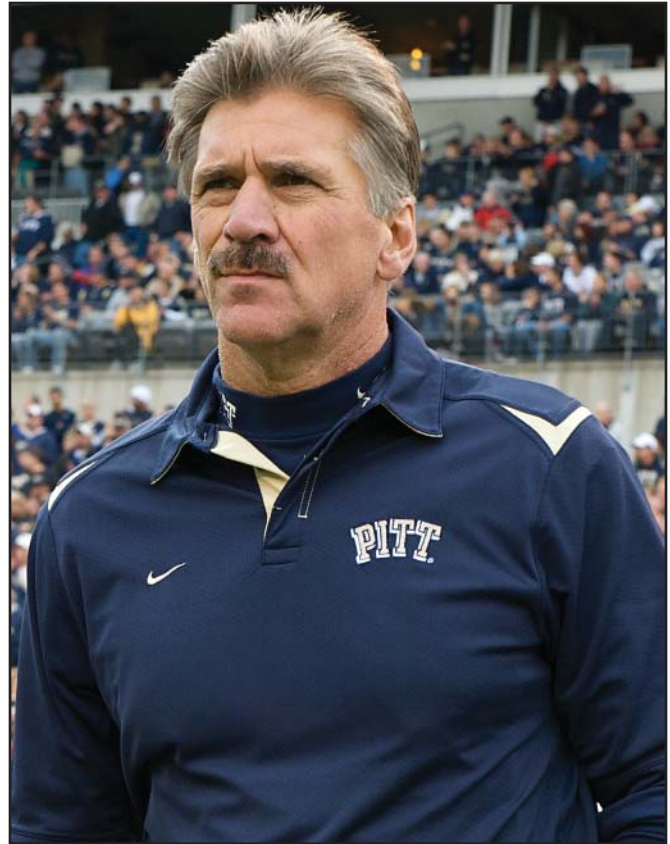
