Looking At The Panthers

No. 18 Pitt holds a 16-1-1 record entering the Edinboro match -- the final of the season, including a perfect 5-0 record in Eastern Wrestling League action.

The Panthers have not suffered a loss since they fell 24-9 to then-No. 17-ranked Lehigh on Nov. 15. Pitt's only other blemish was a 19-19 tie to No. 14 Penn State on Dec. 12.

At rival West Virginia on Feb. 9, the Panthers picked up their school-record 15th dual match win, breaking the previous record of 14, originally set by the 1994-95 squad.

The end of Pitt's lineup has been exceptionally strong this year as Zac Thomusseit (184), Matt Wilps (197) and Ryan Tomei (285) are a combined 46-7 in duals. In addition, Pitt has swept those three weight classes in 13 of Pitt's 18 matches to date.

Pitt vs. Edinboro

Pitt's match vs. Edinboro on Friday night sets up as the regular season EWL championship with both teams' undefeated league record also on the line.

No. 25 Edinboro enters the weekend with a 9-5 overall record and a 4-0 EWL mark. The Scots have just West Virginia remaining on the schedule after their matchup with the Panthers -- a Feb. 20 match in Morgantown.

Series History

Edinboro holds a 15-6 series advantage over the Panthers, dating back to the 1988-89 season. Pitt earned a 23-12 win that season and started the series 4-1. The Panthers have dropped 11 straight to Edinboro, with the last Pitt victory coming in 1998 with an 18-15 home win.

Making History

Pitt, at 16-1-1 recently set the school record for dual wins in a season with 15 with their 19-15 win at West Virginia on Feb. 9. The 1994-95 team set the previous record, totalling 14 wins (14-9-0).

Pitt's 5-0 record in EWL action ties the most league wins by the Panthers in a season. If they can defeat Edinboro Friday night, it would give Pitt the most EWL wins in school history.

The Panthers are also on pace to have their best winning percentage (currently .917) since the 1955-56 team went undefeated at 10-0 (1.000).

20-20

Pitt currently has five wrestlers with 20 wins on the year (Zanetta 31, Wilps 29, Nauman 29, Tomei 28 and Sullivan 20). Zanetta and Wilps, however, will only be able to count 30 and 28 wins respectively with a win coming against Division III Waynesburg.

Pin Party

Pitt has recorded 50 pins this season. Heavyweight **Ryan Tomei** has totalled a team-high 12 falls and **Tyler Nauman** (141) is second with nine falls on the year.

Movin' On Up

Redshirt sophomore **Tyler Nauman** entered the 2009-10 season No. 15 on the all-time pins list in Pitt history. Nauman has climbed into a tie for fifth on the list with nine falls this season and a total of 27. Last year, Nauman won over a third of his matches by fall, finishing the year with 11 — then the seventh most in a single season by a Pitt wrestler.

Rookie Review...

Freshman **Anthony Zanetta** recently broke into the top 10 for wins by a freshman, as he currently holds a 30-8 mark on the season, which ties him for seventh. Zanetta recently passed teammate Tyler Nauman, who recorded a 29-9 record in the 2008-09

season. Wrestling at 125, Zanetta's 30 wins are the most on the squad.

Oh Brother...

Pitt currently has two sets of brothers on the squad including sophomore **Chris Albright** and his brother, redshirt senior **Eric Albright**; as well as freshman **P.J. Tasser** and his brother, redshirt freshman **Donnie Tasser**.

In addition, in Pitt's signing class, two more sets of brothers are set to join the squad. Sophomore **Zac Thomsseit's** brother Max signed a letter of intent with the Panthers, as well as **Matt Wilps'** brother Tyler.

Stottlemeyer's 30-Year Stint

Pitt head coach **Rande Stottlemeyer** is in his 31st season at the helm of the Panther program. In his 31st season, Stottlemeyer is the winningest coach in Pitt history, recording a 267-216-12 record, including a 4-7-1 mark last season and 16-1-1 this season in dual action.

Stottlemeyer helped guide four wrestlers to the NCAA Tournament last season, with three of those returning in 2009-10.

Open Success

After a successful appearance at the Buffalo Open, the Panthers continued to make a mark at the Penn State Open on Dec. 6, where heavyweight **Ryan Tomei** (285) claimed a second place finish and five others placed.

Anthony Zanetta (125) and **Tyler Nauman** (141) both captured fifth place finishes while in State College after falling to the consolation bracket. After winning his first two matches of the day, Zanetta captured his fifth place finish with a marginal 9-8 decision over Matthew Snyder of Virginia. Nauman entered the open with a previously undefeated record, falling to Penn State's Colby Pisanni, 9-3, in his third match of the day.

Mark Powell (157) completed the day with a 6-2 record to clinch a seventh place finish after a 3-0 decision over Bucknell's Corey Lear. **Ethan Headlee** (174) wrestled unattached and finished sixth following a 14-6 major decision over Navy's Michael Billings.

At 197, sophomore **Matt Wilps** captured a fourth place finish at the Penn State Open when he tallied a 10-1 major decision over former Panther A.J. Brentzel of Pitt-Johnstown.

Ryan Tomei continued to make his presence known when he claimed the Panthers' best place of the day, finishing second in the heavyweight class. Tomei accrued four consecutive wins before appearing in the championship round where he fell to third-ranked Zachery Rey of Lehigh with a 3-2 decision.

He's Back!

Former Pitt wrestler **Matt Kocher** is back with the Panther program. This time, as an assistant coach. Kocher joined the Pitt staff this summer and has been an invaluable addition to the squad.

While at Pitt, Kocher was a four-time NCAA qualifier and currently sits at second on the all-time wins list in Pitt history at 151-45.

Panthers Fall in Season Finale to No. 13 Edinboro, 31-8

February 20, 2009 — Edinboro, Pa.

EDINBORO, Pa. — The University of Pittsburgh's bid for its first Eastern Wrestling League championship was brought to a halt by the No. 13 Edinboro University Fighting Scots, who took eight of 10 matches en route to a 31-8 win in the Panthers' season finale.

One of the lone highlights of the night for Pitt (4-7-1, 4-1-1 EWL) came in the 141-pound match when redshirt freshman and 12th-ranked Tyler Nauman put Pitt up 6-3 with a fall in the second period over Steve Waite. The win was Nauman's 25th of the year, moving him into a tie for 10th place on the all-time wins list by a Panther freshman. The fall, his 11th of the season moves him into sole possession of seventh place on the all-time single season pins list.

The action started at 133-pounds when 19th-ranked Ricky Deubel was a 4-3 winner by decision over No. 18 Jimmy Conroy. The slight 6-3 advantage for Pitt was quickly erased as Edinboro (14-4, 5-0 EWL) won the ensuing three matches, two of which earned bonus points for the Scots.

Torsten Gillespie pinned senior Mark Powell just over two minutes into the first period to recapture the lead at 9-6. Brother Gregor Gillespie, the top-ranked wrestler in the 157-pound class was a winner by an 11-0 count over sophomore Phil Sorrentino.

In the first of three sudden victory matches on the night, 11th-ranked Jarrod King was a 7-5 winner over sophomore Ethan Headlee at 165. A week after winning his first collegiate dual match, freshman Karl DiCiantis made it two in a row with a 16-9 decision over John Foley at 174 pounds.

No. 17 Chris Honeycutt extended the Edinboro lead to 19-9 with a 4-1 decision over freshman Zac Thomsusseit at 184. Pat Bradshaw was a 3-1 sudden victory winner over freshman Matt Wilps in the 197-pound match.

The heavyweight match featured two of the nation's best wrestlers in No. 12 Zach Sheaffer and No. 13 Joey Fendone. Ahead by a 2-1 margin in the closing seconds, Sheaffer was called for stalling for the second time in the match, bringing the score to 2-2 and calling for overtime. With just 11 seconds left on the clock in sudden victory, Fendone came up with a winning takedown, picking up his 25th win of the season.
