DAY CAMP: \$250

- ◆ Monday-Thursday, 9am-4pm
- ◆ Ages 7-17
- ◆ Each camper receives a report card, basketball and a T-shirt
- ◆ Day Camp II is not available to campers entering 9th grade or older. Only girls entering 8th grade and under may apply for Day Camp II.

ELITE CAMP: \$150

- ◆ Friday and Saturday
- ◆ High School Varsity experience is recommended but not required for advanced instruction and preparation for the college level
- ◆ Campers will be evaluated and ranked by the University of Pittsburgh Coaching staff and will also learn about the recruiting experience

CAMP DISCOUNTS* (For Day or Guard/Post)

- ◆ A 10% discount will be given to University of Pittsburgh, Carnegie Mellon University, Carlow University, and UPMC employees (a copy of staff/faculty ID must accompany your camp application).
- ◆ A 10% discount for two or more children from the same household who register for camp.
- ◆ A 10% discount per player for any group of five or more registering for camp together (applications and checks should be sent in together).
- ◆ A 10% discount for anyone who registers for more than one camp session.

DAY CAMP MEALS

Day campers have the option to purchase lunch for the four days of camp for an additional \$35. *We will not accept lunch payments after registration on Monday morning of camp. Lunch can only be purchased as a four day, \$35 package.* If you do not purchase lunch, you should bring a bag lunch.

FACILITIES

The University of Pittsburgh has four venues that house a total of 10 basketball courts: the Petersen Events Center (two courts on the main floor and two in the auxiliary gym), the Fitzgerald Field House (three courts), and Trees Hall (three courts). Camp enrollment numbers will dictate which courts will be available for each session.

PAYMENT

- ◆ Applications will not be accepted until full payment is made. We cannot reserve spots.
- ◆ Please make checks payable to **Agnus Berenato Camps.**
- ◆ Each camper will be assessed a \$50 administrative fee for each camp cancellation.

MEDICAL RELEASE

Parent or legal guardian's consent:
